## SEATTLE WINS THE BATTLE

Mercedes Stables's **Seattle Smooth** (Quiet American) made it five in a row since joining Anthony Dutrow's barn, scoring by 1 1/4 lengths over **Seventh Street** (Street Cry {Ire}) in yesterday's GI Ogden Phipps H. Sent off as the 2-1 second choice, the bay saved ground in fourth as Seventh Street mixed it up on the lead through a half mile in :46.36. With Ramon Dominguez in the irons, Seattle Smooth was swung out four deep approaching the quarter pole and fought her way past the game pacesetter to post her first victory at the highest level. "We're so overwhelmed, so humbled and proud of her," Dutrow said, adding that his charge would start next in Saratoga's GI Go For Wand S. Aug. 2. "I hope everyone in racing gets to experience what we just experienced." MGISW **Music Note** (A.P. Indy), making her first start since finishing third in the GI Ladies Classic, tired to finish a well-beaten fifth.

## FANTASY OR FACT?

Classic success seemed more than a possibility for **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) this spring, but George Strawbridge's acquisition heads to post for today's G1 Prix de Diane with a point to prove. After tearing up Goodwood's G3 Prestige S. in August and chasing home fellow Augustin colorbearer Rainbow View (Dynaformer) when second in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot a month later, she dominated Newmarket's G3 Nell Gwyn S. by seven lengths Apr. 15 in her first start at three. While her subsequent third in the May 10 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp was highly respectable, there was a sense that the brilliance that marked her earlier wins was absent. Trainer Luca Cumani is hopeful she can rekindle the magic at Chantilly. "It's hard to say if she has improved since the French Guineas, but she has certainly never been in better form than she is at the moment," Cumani told the *Racing Post*. "She is a very straightforward filly and the complete professional."

**Have Faith...**

A week after watching Fuisse (Fr) (Green Tune) come so close to Classic glory in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club here, the Head family re-engage in battle with their homebred **Denomination** (Smart Strike). The filly beat ⚡ **"TDN Rising Star"** ⚡ **Ana Americana** (Fr) (American Post {GB}) in the Listed Prix Finlande at Longchamp Apr. 5 before besting **Celebra** (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux back there three weeks later. Kept fresh for this, she will bid to provide trainer Criquette Head-Maarek with a third renewal, and become the fourth winner of the Vanteaux to taste victory here since 1982. His Highness The Aga Khan and Alain de Royer-Dupre paired up to take this four times in the nineties, and were the combination behind possibly the greatest of them all in last year's winner Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar). While their representative **Shediyama** (Fr) (Red Ransom) does not have strong credentials on the bare result of her third in the Listed Prix de la Seine at Longchamp last time May 10, the homebred suffered a troubled trip on that occasion and could be open to any amount of improvement. Gerard Laboureau's **Celimene** (Ire) (Dr Fong) had ⚡ **"TDN Rising Star"** ⚡ **Plumania** (GB) (Anabaa) 1 1/2 lengths back in second in the G3 Prix Penelope at Saint-Cloud last time Apr. 13. The latter was disappointing when only fifth behind **Stacelita** (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 17. The Wertheimer homebred may have an excuse there, however, as the ground was heavy.

Seattle Smooth enjoyed some success while campaigned on the West Coast by trainer Julio Canani, placing a close second in last term's California Oaks at Golden Gate and annexing the Bay Meadows Oaks in April. She rallied to complete the trifecta in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. in May, then closed out her tenure for Canani with a ninth-place finish in the grassy GII San Clemente H. at Del Mar in late July. Transferred to Anthony Dutrow, Seattle Smooth rolled by 7 1/4 lengths in Delaware's Go For Wand S. in August before closing out her sophomore campaign with a tally over champion Proud Spell (Proud Citizen) in Philly Park's GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. Sept. 20. She picked up right where she left off in Aqueduct's seven-furlong GII Bed O' Roses H. Apr. 18, and just got up to deliver as the 1-5 chalk in Belmont's GII Shuvee H. last out May 16. - Macho Again sports erratic PPs, with nearly as many misses as hits, but he won the GII Jim Dandy S. and the Derby Trial and ran second in the GI Preakness S. and GII Super Derby at three. Off the board in the Dec. 20 Woodchopper S. on the Fair Grounds turf and in the Jan. 24 Sunshine Millions Classic on the dirt at Gulfstream, the grey rebounded to take the Mar. 14 GII New Orleans H. at 10-1, then ran sixth as the 5-2 chalk in the May 1 GIII Alysheba S. at Churchill. The late-running colt has had a tough time of it when rated off a half in :48 or slower, but he overcame that scenario here. Last through a half in :48.13, Macho Again had only one behind him after six panels in 1:12.71, and had the option of taking the overland route into the stretch. That move paid off. Einstein and Asiatic Boy, rallying just ahead of him, tried to close from between horses, and were involved in a bumping match, but Macho Again had clear sailing on the outside, driving to the front at the eighth pole before edging clear. Informed, claimed for \$25,000 by Doug O'Neill out of a winning effort last June, annexed a \$62,000 optional claimer at Hollywood in December before coming within a nose of delivering in the GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 10. Fourth in the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 8, Informed made his next start in Dubai, crossing the line seventh in the G2 Godolphin Mile Mar. 28, then held on to finish a close fourth in Churchill's GIII Alysheba S. last time May 1. Overlooked a bit here, he tracked in fourth as Ball Four (Grand Slam) and Rail Trip led the way through fractions of :23.51 and :47.65. Asked to quicken on the turn for home, Informed revved up to challenge for the lead while racing three wide and fought his way past Rail Trip in the stretch to pull off the upset. "This is a horse with a big heart," jockey Tyler Baze said. "He's got that one three-eighths mile run. I knew if I could time it right, not move him too early or too late, I could get him there."

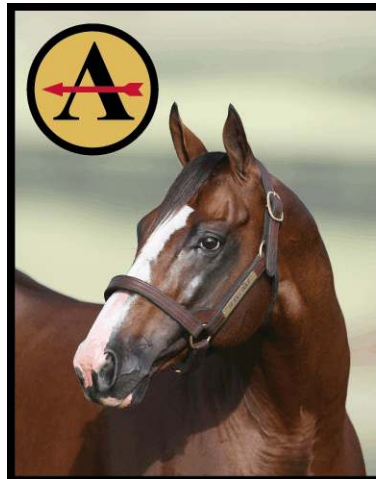

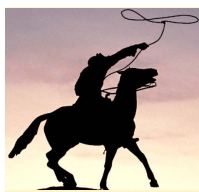

**Fillies race against colts on a regular basis in Europe, but when it happens in the U.S., it creates some controversy. How do you feel about fillies competing against colts?**

**ROBT DAWE**

After some 25 or so trips to the U.S. over the years, I find, personally, that U.S. owners and trainers are very delicate when it comes to placing the racehorse, and more so the girls against the boys. ### HOT DIXIE CHICK (Dixie Union)

Hot Dixie Chick has every license to be a good one. Just ask Mike Ryan, who advised William K. Warren to buy the dark bay as a FTSAUG yearling. The filly is out of the speedy Above Perfection (In Excess {Ire}), who came within a neck of beating champion Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat) when second in the GI Prioress S., and was seven-for-10 overall. She also brought to mind another daughter of Dixie Union, Sander Camillo.

Ryan bought Sander Camillo for \$160,000 at the FTKJUL sale in 2005, and she turned into a successful pinhooking venture, bringing \$500,000 from Robert Ogden at the 2006 FTFEB auction. The filly went on to win the G2 Cherry Hinton S. and G3 Albany S. in Britain.

For the Irish-bred horseman, it was a case of *deja vu* all over again at the Saratoga sale last summer.

"[Hot Dixie Chick] was very impressive at Saratoga," Ryan recalled. "She reminded me so much of Sander Camillo. She was very very like her."

Warren bought Hot Dixie Chick for \$340,000 at Saratoga. But, not long after signing the ticket on the filly, he had a change of heart.

"Mr. Warren was trying to focus more on colts, and for that reason and that reason alone, he decided he would sell her," Ryan explained.

Hot Dixie Chick was sent to Niall Brennan in Ocala to get ready for the Fasig-Tipton February sale, and her resemblance to Sander Camillo only deepened.

"Niall had her all winter and, even watching her train, she was so much like Sander Camillo in every way--her color, size, performance, just her character--it was amazing," Ryan said. "The composure of both of them was quite extraordinary--they were both just so relaxed, like a big pet Labrador."

But it wasn't just her attitude that impressed.

"This filly never broke a sweat in her life--she did everything so easy," Ryan remarked. "Her mother was very, very quick, and this filly just floated over the ground. There was never any effort to it. Every time we breezed her, she was always breezing on the bridle. Niall never lays 'em down anyway, but everything she did, she was doing it with so much left in the tank.

"We didn't really know how good she might be," he added. "She's so composed that you don't know how much is still there--she's an extraordinarily mature horse mentally. She has the mentality of an older horse."

Hot Dixie Chick, with blinkers on, covered a furlong in a bullet :10 1/5 at the FTFEB under tack show ([video](#)), and expectations were high for her second trip through the ring.

"We told Mr. Warren that it was entirely his call, but she was a high-class filly and she'd better bring plenty of money, otherwise she should be running in his pink silks," Ryan said.

Ryan continued, "But, for his young horses, he decided he wanted to focus more on colts--that's always been his premier interest, trying to have a Classic horse."

Hot Dixie Chick was very well-received at the FTFEB sale, finally going to Barbara Banke, the wife of Jess Jackson, for \$435,000. She carried the colors of Banke's Grace Stables to victory yesterday.

"You don't see many two-year-olds win that easy," Ryan said. "I don't care where they are--what country, what racetrack. That's as good as you can get it done."
