

STACELITA POWERS TO DIANE GLORY

Before this season, Jean-Claude Rouget had knocked on the door of Classic success without response, but the Pau-based trainer's fortunes reversed with wins in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and G1 Prix du Jockey Club. His hot streak continued in the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly yesterday, when Martin Schwartz and Ecurie Monastic's 13-10 favorite **Stacelita (Fr)** (Monsun {Ger}) maintained her unbeaten

record with an impressive display to provide Rouget with a fifth Group 1 victory of the year; stablemate **Tamazirte (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) was four lengths behind in second. "What a day, it is amazing to complete the Derby-Oaks double, and to do it in the space of just one week is unbelievable," beamed a delighted Rouget. "It is something you can't even begin to dream of, and when you see such great trainers as Francois Mathet, Francois Boutin, Andre Fabre and Alain de Rouyer-Dupre, who were unable to win both in the same year, the achievement is something to be especially proud of. I shall need some time to realize that it has actually happened." Cont. p2

INDIAN BLESSING FOURTH IN RETURN

It was a rough day for horses making their first starts since Dubai. First, 3-4 favorite **Kip Deville** (Kipling) faded to fourth behind **Sailor's Cap** (Distant View) in the Gill Poker S. at Belmont Park (*result, p5*), and, less than an hour later, champion **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie) came up empty in the lane in the \$70,000 Desert Stormer at Hollywood Park. Off at 1-2, she chased winner **Coco Belle** (Storm Boot) early, but had nothing left in the lane and crossed the line fourth. Kip Deville had not raced since finishing 10th in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Duty Free S.; Indian Blessing was last seen finishing second in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen. But trainer Bob Baffert blamed the track as much as the overseas jaunt and subsequent break for Indian Blessing's disappointing effort. "She just wasn't getting over [the Hollywood Cushion] like she usually can," Baffert said. "It wasn't her. Usually she cruises up there pretty easy and just kicks on. Today, at the top of the stretch I could tell [Victor Espinoza] was out of horse." He added, "You never know how they're going to react after Dubai, that's why I wanted to run her here. Maybe she needs a little more time, but we'll just regroup and send her back east, where she loves to be. I wanted to keep her here if I could, but it didn't work out. Some horses like different synthetics." *Desert Stormer result, p3, ATW*

Commencing her education with provincial victories at Salon-de-Provence and Toulouse, Stacelita bagged a wide-margin success in the Mar. 14 Listed Prix Rose de

Mai at Saint-Cloud and registered a fourth straight score in the May 17 G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp last time. She raced in a prominent second from the outset here and took over from Ecurie Wildenstein's rabbit Onega Lake (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) once straightening for home.

Bounding clear of toiling rivals approaching the final furlong, she ran on strongly after receiving two cursory flicks of Christophe Lemaire's whip to easily outpoint stablemate Tamazirte and retain her perfect record. "This filly is a champion," said trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. "I know she won the Prix Saint-Alary easily, but that was on very soft going and there was always a question mark as to whether or not she could reproduce that form on good ground here. She did so in style, and that is the mark of great horses. She was in front from the top of the straight, she kept finding more--and that was exceptional. We will take time to savor the moment and will not make any commitments until we see how [Stacelita and Tamazirte] come out of the race." Part-owner Martin Schwartz, who also owns G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine Elusive Wave (Ire) (Elusive City), added, "It's great fun to be in France. I bought a 50 percent interest in Stacelita after she won the Prix Saint-Alary. I certainly do not regret it, as she is just magnificent." Tamazirte at the Double...

Tamazirte, who played second fiddle to stablemate Elusive Wave in the May 10 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp, had to settle for the same berth in another Classic. "I am very proud of Tamazirte," said Rouget. "She ran a great race, but is just unlucky to be born in the same year as her two stable companions, who have proved superior in two Classics this year." Politician and part-owner Herve Morin was not downcast either and added, "What a great moment to be back in the major league only two years after [G1 Champion S. winner] Literato (Fr) (Kendor {Fr}). She ran a great race, and I was convinced she'd win beforehand as she was assigned box number 27 upon arrival at the track, which is the number of my department [in Normandy]."

Plumania Bounces Back...

Alain and Gerard Wertheimer's Plumania failed to act in the mud when fifth behind Stacelita in the May 17 G1 Prix Saint-Alary, but finished much closer when staying on from the rear on better ground here. However, racing manager Pierre-Yves Bureau was realistic about the **TDN Rising Star**'s proximity this time and said, "She ran a great race and there are no excuses, but the winner is definitely superior. She has erased the memory of her bad performance in the Saint-Alary, where the ground was just too soft for her."

Celimene Undone by Draw...

Gerard Laboureau's Celimene (Ire) (Dr Fong) stayed on from the rear in the straight to finish a never-nearer fourth. Trainer Carlos Lerner was adamant her wide draw, in 11 of 12, was a decisive factor in losing her unbeaten record. "Because of her bad draw, Celimene was unable to take a good position early on. She was therefore left with too much to do, but she ran well nonetheless."

STACELITA (FR) (Monsun {Ger})

In the span of five weeks, American owner Martin Schwartz has now won two French Classics--the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches with **Elusive Wave (Ire)**

(Elusive City) at Longchamp May 15, and yesterday's G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly with **Stacelita**, whom he co-owns with breeder Jean-Pierre-Joseph Dubois. It's a huge achievement that isn't lost on Schwartz.

"I told my wife, 'we just climbed Mt. Everest,'" Schwartz said yesterday, shortly after arriving back in his hotel room in Paris. "It's good stuff, the thrill of a lifetime...until the next one. I texted Kieran McLaughlin

right after the race and said, 'my French trainer just won me two Group 1 races in five weeks--how are we doing over there in the U.S.?'"

While Schwartz purchased Elusive Wave at auction at the end of her two-year-old season, he acquired a half-interest in Stacelita privately in a transaction completed just 10 days before the Prix de Diane. The deal was brokered by a pair of Schwartz's advisors, the Lexington-based Mike Levy and the French-based Michel Zerolo. Both had also worked on Elusive Wave's purchase.

"Marty had a good experience in the Guineas and was fired up, and we'd been watching this filly for awhile," Levy explained of how the chips fell into place for Stacelita. "Fortunately, we were able to work out a deal with the breeder [Dubois]. It was a very good team effort, as our other team member, Michel Zerolo, is very good friends with the breeder.

"We struck a deal for half of her and closed on it 10 days ago. Really, all credit goes to Marty for stepping up with the check."

Leading up to the Prix de Diane, Schwartz said he tried to keep his expectations under control.

"I try to keep my emotions down, because I'm not so positive," he said. "But I really didn't see how any horse could touch her. I do a lot of my own research on horses after they're brought to me, and I've never seen numbers like hers, and might never see another horse like her. She's won all her races by open lengths, which on turf is pretty astonishing. She won the G1 Prix Saint-Alary by six, and this one she won by four."

Schwartz said that he was especially impressed with the way Stacelita--whom he described as decent-sized and "beautifully proportioned"--handled herself in the run-up to the Prix de Diane.

"In the stall and in the walking ring before the race, she was just cool as a cucumber," he said. "The only thing is that, in Europe, they don't use lead ponies--the groom goes out onto the track with them and then let's them go. And this horse just wanted to explode when he let go of the reins."

Though a trip to America is likely in the cards for Elusive Wave later in the season, Schwartz said that Stacelita will almost definitely remain in Europe for the remainder of the year.

"Right now, she's 7-1 for the Arc," he explained.

Asked about other plans for the future, such as a possible four-year-old campaign, Schwartz said, "In horse racing, you take it one race at a time. I just wanted to enjoy the day today, so I didn't ask. A race like this, it's like winning the Kentucky Derby. Chantilly is a small place, but it's one of the most beautiful settings you'll ever see in racing, and the crowd was fantastic."

So, with all the time he's been spending in Paris, how's his French coming along?

"I'm up to six words," he chuckled.

Schwartz's good run of late could extend well into the summer. This Friday, Elusive Wave will be one of the favorites in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. Another stable standout, the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Elusive Heat** (Elusive Quality), is being pointed toward a tilt in the GI Prioress S. at Belmont July 4.

"She breezed today, and we think we've got her problems figured out," said Schwartz. "We'll see how she comes out of the workout, and I'm hoping we can make the Prioress. But Kiaran's trying to keep me reined in and calm, which is sometimes hard to do."

Elusive Heat, who is trained by McLaughlin, worked three panels at Belmont Park in :36.04 (3/39).

As for Elusive Wave, Schwartz is hoping she ships from France to England with no issues and gives a good showing of herself at Ascot.

"It is a long trip, so I worry about that," he said. "We'll just make sure she's 100 percent for the race. I'm in Paris right now, and we're going to London on Tuesday. I've got my Monopoly Man suit--that's what my son calls it--and I'm ready to roll." -L Marquardt

Quijano first burst onto the scene during the 2007 Dubai Spring Carnival and registered his first black-type success in the G3 Dubai City of Gold S. at Nad Al Sheba. He bettered that when annexing that year's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, and his next visit to the winner's spot was in this contest 12 months ago. Runner-up in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Cologne in July, the bay was in that spot again in the GI Northern Dancer Turf S. at Woodbine in September. That was his third placing at the top level on the international stage following his efforts in the 2007 Canadian International and Hong Kong Vase, but he was not quite as sharp at Nad Al Sheba this year. Only sixth in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic after a second in the latest edition of the G2 Dubai City of Gold 23 days earlier, he rebounded here to become the first back-to-back winner of this prize since Tony Bin (Ire) in 1988. Sailor's Cap affirmed his fondness for a rain-soaked surface with this late-closing score. Beaten a neck when second in the GIII Crown Royal American Turf S. on the yielding Churchill course last May, he romped by 6 3/4 lengths on soft turf in the GIII Colonial Turf Cup in June. The bay was third in the July 19 GII Virginia Derby at Colonial and Oct. 23 John's Gold S. at Belmont, and hadn't been out since running ninth in the Nov. 30 GI Hollywood Derby. He was sitting on ready for his return. Sailor's Cap settled in fourth as 3-4 chalk Kip Deville (Kipling) hustled out to lead through a half in :47.17. He edged closer after six panels in 1:11.89, and kicked past the pacesetter down the lane. "He dropped back a little bit further than I thought," trainer Jimmy Toner said. "We were going to try to sit in the pocket, but the big horse looked like he was a little rank, so it worked out perfect." As for what's next, Toner added, "I could probably do the Fourstardave [Grade II, Aug. 2] at Saratoga, but we'll probably watch the Weather Channel first and see where it rains, and that's where we'll go." Grace O'Malley scored at first asking in a seven-furlong Curragh maiden last September, but could only manage a sixth following a tardy break on her only subsequent outing in the G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 19. If Ballydoyle's brilliant stayer can lift an unprecedented fourth straight G1 Gold Cup victory, there will be momentous scenes, but **Geordieland (Fr)** (Johann Quatz {Fr}) will attempt to spoil the party and make it third time lucky, having been runner-up in the last two editions. Last year, the Listed Chesham S. success of The Queen's Free Agent (GB) (Dr Fong) provided a keenly anticipated Royal winner, and there is a chance that the monarch's homebred **Enticement (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) could emulate that feat in the G2 Ribblesdale S. On Friday, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Ghanaati** (Giant's Causeway) will bid to win the G1 Coronation S. and emulate the double achieved by Attraction (GB) (Efisio {GB}) five years ago. Takeover Target is back at the ripe age of 10 to take on a star-studded cast in Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S., which includes South Africa's suitably named **J J the Jet Plane (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}).

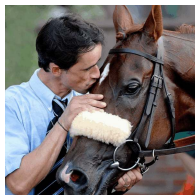
