### EYE OF THE LEOPARD RULES QUEEN'S PLATE

Eye of the Leopard (A.P. Indy) looked to have all the makings of a Classic winner and the regally bred colt from legendary Sam-Son Farms made it official yesterday as he drove to a neck victory over **Mr. Foricos Two U** (Porto Foricos) in the Queen's Plate S. at Woodbine. The 2-1 favorite, Eye of the Leopard was always within striking distance as Mr. Foricos Two U set a pressured pace through fractions of :24.05, :48.11 and 1:12.93. The favorite seemed to have dead aim on the pacesetter at midstretch, but began drifting out under left-handed urging from jockey Eurico da Silva. Straightened out

within the final furlong, Eye of the Leopard surged past a determined Mr. Foricos Two U late. **Cont. p2**

### OILED UP IN CINEMA

Trainer John Sadler's three-year-old colt **Oil Man (Ire)** (Pyrus) was well behind the slow pace being laid down by lone speed **Arcodoro** (Medaglia d'Oro), but unleashed a sparkling turn of foot in the lane and was up to defeat that foe in Sunday's GIII Cinema H. at Hollywood Park. A maiden winner in Britain last summer, Oil Man came to the States late in his juvenile season and showed some promise despite missing the board in his first four starts here. Seventh in the GIII Transylvania S. at Keeneland Apr. 3, he finally got his first U.S. win in a first-level grass allowance at Santa Anita Apr. 19. Freshened off that victory, Oil Man settled into a nice stride as Arcodoro was allowed a half in :48 2/5 and three-quarters in 1:13 flat. He kicked into gear two furlongs out, however, and came flying for his initial black-type win. Oil Man shaved :12 for his final eighth. "He'll stay forever," said Sadler, who added the colt would start next in the GII American Derby at Arlington Park July 11. "This horse has a chance to make a dent in some 1 1/4-, 1 1/2-mile races." **QUEEN'S PLATE**

The lightly raced Eye of the Leopard failed to land a blow while running eighth sprinting over Keeneland's Polytrack Apr. 15 in his debut, but quickly turned things around with a 2 3/4-length maiden win when stretched out to 1 1/16 miles at Woodbine May 10. He earned his way into the Queen's Plate with a late-charging victory in the nine-furlong Plate Trial S. May 31. Eye of the Leopard is the first foal of Eye of the Sphynx (Smart Strike), Canada's champion sophomore filly of 2004. He has an unraced two-year-old full-brother named Hotep and a yearling half-brother by Stormy Atlantic. Eye of the Sphynx was bred to Giant's Causeway this spring. The win gave Sam-Son Farms its fifth Queen's Plate. "We have been waiting for this day for a long time," said owner Mark Samuel, son of Sam-Son founder Ernie Samuel. "We have had some tragic things happen to our family over the last year, and we had some spirits up above cheering that horse. It is a special day for the family and we are going to savour this for a long time." The Samuel family suffered the losses of Liza Samuel, wife of Ernie, and their daughter Tammy Samuel-Balaz in the past year. Trainer Mark Frostad was winning his fourth Queen's Plate. "Well, it wasn't nearly as exciting as I had hoped," Frostad joked. "But we managed to win the race. The horse ran a super race. Mr. Foricos Two U ran a super race. Mike Smith was trying to steal it from us, but we got there." Smith admitted he hadn't originally planned to be on the front aboard the eventual runner-up. "Warming up, I kind of thought that was going to happen," Smith explained. "He was very much on his toes. When he got his head in front, he really relaxed. That was a big key. It was a gallant effort in defeat. I thought if Eye of the Leopard had been on my hip instead of Milwaukee Appeal, maybe I would have held him off. He didn't see him out there." **CONNOISSEUR TO JULY CUP**

Richard Green's G1 Golden Jubilee S. winner **Art Connoisseur (Ire)** (Lucky Story) is being aimed at the G1 July Cup, trainer Michael Bell revealed yesterday. Following the sophomore's neck defeat of Cannonball (Catienus) in Saturday's Ascot feature, his conditioner confirmed Newmarket's July 10 contest as the next step, ground permitting. "All being well, it's the July Cup, but fast ground is the key," he told *PA Sport*. "We will monitor the ground, that is a prerequisite for him, but that would be very much the plan"

**RECORD CROWD TO CLOSE ROYAL WEEK**

Officials at Ascot were celebrating Saturday's record attendance to close the latest Royal meeting. Despite falls in attendance throughout the week, the figure of 78,790 on the final afternoon represented an 11 percent gain on 2008 and helped the overall total, which was slightly down. Chief executive Charles Barnett said, "To conclude a memorable Royal Ascot with an all-time record crowd is extremely satisfying. Attendances all week have been broadly in line with our forecasts, and actually slightly better as we were predicting a reduction of between five and 10 percent but, thanks to a healthy walk up on the Heath today of 2,500, we actually finish just three percent behind last year's figure."

three--the GIII Shakertown S. at Keeneland in April, the Woodford S. at that track six months later and the Thomas Edison S. at the Meadowlands Oct. 24. Shelved for the winter, Smart Enough was beaten just 3/4 lengths when third in his

seasonal debut in the GIII Turf Sprint S. at Churchill Downs May 1, then led every step in a 1 3/4-length tally in the Wolf Hill S. at Monmouth May 30. Let go at 7-1 despite hitting the board in nine consecutive starts leading up to this, Smart Enough raced out from post five and laid down a fast half in :44.73. 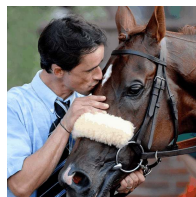
