Today's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby lost its main attraction yesterday after John Oxx withdrew **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) due to the soft ground, which along with the scratch of Ballydoyle's outsider

Hail Caesar (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) leaves 11 hopefuls to chase the prize. Oxx brought forward the decision to yesterday morning and will take Christopher Tsui's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Derby hero to Saturday's G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown. That appears to hand the contest to the mercy of Aidan O'Brien, who supplies the market leaders **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and

**Masterofthehorse (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). The former, who carries the Derrick Smith colors, had his stable companion a neck behind when they filled second and third in the June 6 G1 Epsom Derby, and jockey Johnny Murtagh has opted for him. **Cont. p10**

### CITY BANKER STARS IN ESTRELLAS

Classic winner **City Banker (Arg)** (Lode) rolled home impressively to a two-length score in the 19th edition of the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Classic, Argentina's equivalent of the Breeders' Cup Classic, at San Isidro in Buenos Aires. Under Adrian Gianetti, the three-year-old sat just off the pace along the rail, split rivals entering the straight and drew off convincingly. GI Preakness S. winner **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) and undefeated **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) would take care of business in the GI Mother Goose S. and the GI Vanity H., respectively, go ahead and take it to the windows. Stonestreet Stables and Hal McCormick's Rachel

Alexandra was first to grab a bat and turned in as dominating a performance as she did in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1, taking the Mother Goose by 19 1/4 lengths in stakes-record time of 1:46.33. About 13 minutes later in Tinseltown, Zenyatta put her 10-race unbeaten skein on the line. Toting a hefty 129 pounds, the imposing mare looked to be in some danger for a few strides in the stretch, but kicked it in leaving the eighth pole and won by an ultimately comfortable 2 1/2 lengths. **Cont p2 & 3**

**RACHEL ROMPS IN THE MOTHER GOOSE**

A small field was entered against GI Preakness S. winner **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro), but two early scratches reduced the field to three. At least the vanquished were guaranteed a Grade I placing, and in the end, that's about all they were left with. Providing jockey Calvin Borel with a bit of redemption following his third in the GI Belmont S. astride Mine That Bird (Birdstone), Rachel Alexandra bided her time as **Malibu Prayer** (Malibu Moon) and **Flashing** (A.P. Indy) dueled each other into submission through a half-mile in a suicidal :44.66. Stalking on a loose rein, the GI Kentucky Oaks heroine split her two rivals decisively at the three-eighths marker, and was tapped lightly on the shoulder by Borel in upper stretch. There was no real need for that, and Borel, as he did when winning the GI Fair Grounds Oaks and again beneath the Twin Spires, threw down the anchor at the sixteenth pole and let his filly canter under the wire, a new stakes-record time in the bag. Trainer Steve Asmussen gave full credit to his rider. "I can't say enough about Calvin Borel's ride," he commented. "They took it right to her with 44 and change, the 1-9 shot and all the pressure in the world. He just let them go about their business and did what's best for her and he needs to keep doing that." While no decision has been made on her next start, Rachel Alexandra ships to Saratoga, where her day-to-day training will be overseen by Scott Blasi. The final time broke Lakeway's stakes record from 1994, while the margin of victory eclipsed that of Ruffian, who scored by 13 1/2 lengths in 1975. 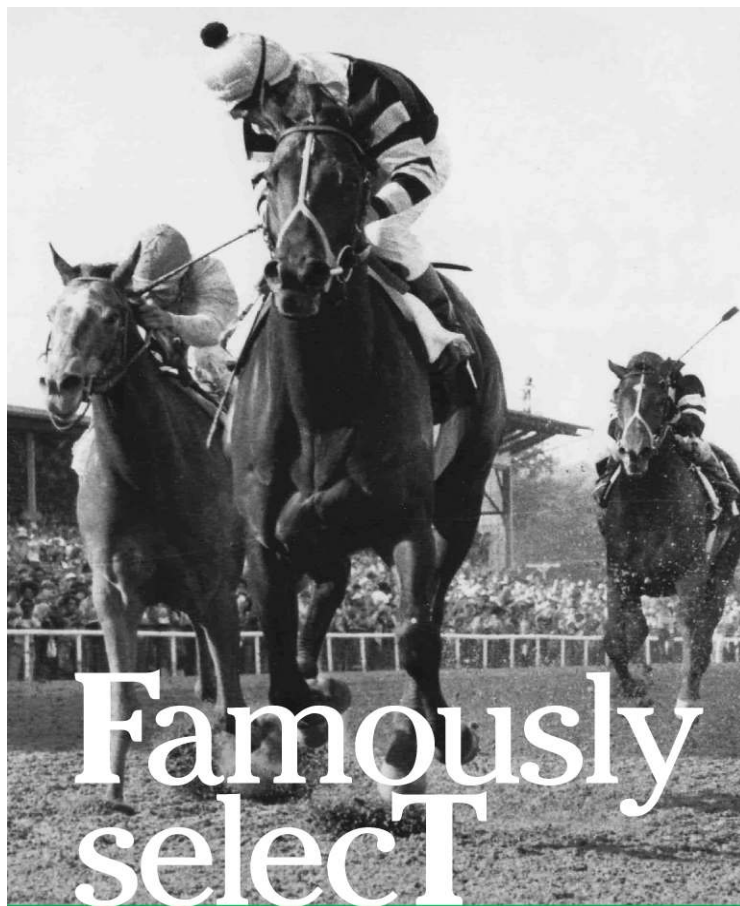

**ZENYATTA WORTH THE WEIGHT**

About 15 minutes after Rachel Alexandra's stroll around Big Sandy, it was **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire})'s turn in the equine version of the game of H-O-R-S-E. In the end, it wasn't accomplished with the same sort of authority as her younger counterpart, but her undefeated mark remained intact at 11 from 11. The reigning Eclipse Award-winning distaffer took her streak to nine with her thorough defeat of Godolphin's Cocoa Beach (Chi) (Doneraile Court) and Music Note (A.P. Indy) in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic Oct. 24. She was to make her seasonal debut and just the second start of her career on the main track in Churchill's GII Louisville Distaff S., but a sloppy track resulted in a return trip to the Golden State. Zenyatta instead resurfaced in the GII Milady H. May 23, and the end result was an easy 1 3/4-length score over stable companion Life Is Sweet (Storm Cat). Toting 129 pounds here, Zenyatta found herself closer to the front, as **Briecat** (Adcat) got away with a half in :48.02 and three-quarters in 1:11.28. Ridden along three deep into the lane, Zenyatta still had a 2 1/2-length gap to bridge inside the final furlong, but found her best stride late and won it easily. "She was very steady throughout the race," said trainer John Shirreffs. "Mike [Smith] said he timed his ride. He didn't want to move too soon. As we all know, when they step into the starting gate, anything can happen." Shirreffs indicated that Zenyatta's next start would likely come in the newly upgraded GI Clement Hirsch S. at Del Mar Aug. 9. 

Dar Re Mi finally broke through at the top level here when outgaming Beach Bunny and surviving a subsequent stewards' inquiry. After earning **Ⓢ "TDN Rising Star" Ⓢ** status at Sandown last April, the homebred had maintained an admirable level of consistency, and had never been out of the first three since. Her confidence-boosting win in Deauville's G3 Prix Minerve led to a career-best second to Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at Newmarket just eight days later, and only Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) proved her better in the following month's G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp. Signing off with a third in the G2 Prix de Royallieu back at that track in October, the bay returned to be beaten a short head by Crystal Capella (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) after a battle royal in York's G3 Middleton S. last time May 14. Dar Re Mi, soon in front here, dug in when challenged by Beach Bunny inside the final quarter and, despite wandering and hanging into that rival, clung on bravely to prevail.

Ever durable and always game, the seven-year-old Jonesboro earned a well-deserved first Grade II tally in this event after three previous Grade III victories. A winner of four of nine starts in 2008, Jonesboro opened 2009 with a runner-up try in a Oaklawn allowance in January. Sixth as the favorite in the GIII Razorback H. Mar. 7, he was third to It's a Bird (Birdonthewire) in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 4, then captured his first win of the year in the GIII Texas Mile at Lone Star Apr. 25. He was dead-game when a head adrift of It's a Bird in the GIII Lone Star Park H. May 25 and was given a 5-1 chance in this facing My Pal Charlie, who was coming off a close-up fourth in the GI Metropolitan H. Away alertly from the outside post, Jonesboro avoided traffic issues into the first turn as he raced up to press Shadowbdancing through :23.60, :47.48 and 1:11.33 splits. **You were optimistic going over to Ascot, but in your heart of hearts, did you really expect a win?** Well,

of course you wouldn't go unless you thought you were going to win--that's how I approach all my races. But realistically, if we had just run well, that would have been fantastic. Going over and winning was amazing.

**What were the differences that struck you between racing in the U.S. and Britain?** The whole country is into horse racing, unlike here.

You go into every bar--and I mean every bar--and they have horse racing on. So everyone knows the integral players in the game--the jockeys, trainers and owners, and they're like celebrities there.

**Did you get a chance to do any sightseeing?** No, we were just so busy. We stayed at Newmarket the first two days, then went to Ascot. The last three days, we stayed with all the grooms who ship in from the different countries. They have a dormitory of sorts with three little beds per room, and my dad, son and I stayed in one room. The horses shipped from Newmarket at 4 a.m., and we would meet them at the track at 6 a.m.

**What is your favorite food or meal?** Italian.

**Drink of choice?** Red wine and Heineken.

**Favorite movie?** I think I've got to go with Good Fellas, because of [actor] Joe Pesci [Ward trained the Stormy Atlantic filly Pesci--whom the real Pesci owned part of, and still trains for the actor].

**Favorite band?** Steely Dan.

**First life concert?** Phil Collins in 1984.

**First job?** I started riding when I was 12 at the county fairs.

**Last purchase?** An iPhone. I love it.

**Favorite sport?** College basketball. I like a few different teams, but my favorite is Gonzaga. They're overachievers.

**What's the key to training horses?** I don't have all the answers, but I train each horse as an individual. As we're walking to the track, I may change my mind as to what I want to do. There's no set plan.

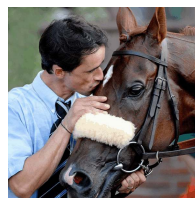

Despite the absence of Sea the Stars, John Oxx still saddles a live contender in His Highness the Aga Khan's **Mourayan (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}), who has to turn around a five-length beating by Fame and Glory when in receipt of three pounds in the May 10 G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown. That followed a third behind that same rival in the Apr. 19 G3 Ballysax S., but his trainer is hopeful he can reduce the deficit. "He disappointed us a little bit in the Derrinstown, but we're going to give him another chance," Oxx told *PA Sport*. "He ran well in the Ballysax, and maybe it was the faster ground that he didn't like in the Derrinstown. He also jumped a road crossing and was never going well after that, so maybe he just hurt himself a bit. We'd just like to see him go again and see if he can improve on that." Jim and Jackie Bolger's **Gan Amhras (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was third in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 2, but ran a shocker when only 11th at Epsom and needs to rebound.

Lady O'Reilly's **Recharge (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) accounted for that colt's stable companion Intense Focus (Giant's Causeway) in the Mar. 29 G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S. before finishing fourth in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas on heavy ground here May 23. He steps up markedly in trip, but conditioner Kevin Prendergast is hopeful he will get the extra distance. "I'm hoping the step up in trip will suit him, but we'll have to see," Prendergast commented. "He didn't run at all really in the Guineas, as the ground was bottomless, and he ran far better than we thought. He's really a dry-ground horse." Of the longshots, trainer Jessica Harrington provides an interesting contender in John Hennessy and John Wholey's **The Bull Hayes (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Having finished behind Sea the Stars, Masterofthehorse and Mourayan in maidens as a juvenile, he finally garnered a win at Navan Apr. 26 before finishing third in the G3 Gallinule S. over 10 furlongs at this venue last time May 24. "He ran in some good maidens last year, was fifth in the Goffs Million and finished third in the Gallinule, so is a horse who deserves to take his chance," Harrington said.

**Youmzain** shed the tag of Europe's "nearly horse" in this event 12 months ago, but normal service has resumed subsequently with a third in Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. in July and second consecutive runner-up placing in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October. It was a nose that kept him out of the winner's spot again on his return to Britain in the June 5 G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom, but trainer Mick Channon is keeping the faith. "He's in great heart and came out of his last race well," Channon said. "It is frustrating to be beaten, but he's very consistent as he only runs in Group 1s. He's been beaten by some of the best horses we've probably seen in the last decade, but there is always a hard luck story somewhere along the line with him." Not allowed to race in Britain at present due to his aversion to the stalls, **Spanish Moon** will bid to atone for a defeat by the minimum margin at the hands of Eastern Anthem (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}) in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba, while **Scintillo** provides a potent third string to the British bow. He upset the G3 Prix d'Hedouville hero Magadan in a slowly run renewal of the May 31 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly, and trainer Richard Hannon said, "Though this is another step up the ladder, he did win his Group 1 [Gran Criterium] in Italy as a two-year-old and deserves another shot at the big boys."

# Op/Ed feedback

In a recent Op/Ed feedback, Barry Irwin took exception with those racetrack executives who spend considerable time, energy and money promoting alternative gaming and called for a redirection of focus and more innovative thinkers. I applaud Barry for creating the Team Valor business model and being an innovator in his field. But what if Team Valor horses had to carry 20 pounds more than the other runners during their races, leaving them at a distinct disadvantage? No matter how much money was initially raised or how shrewdly the racing careers of Team Valor runners were managed, I doubt they would win much purse money. Without a reasonable chance for profit, would Team Valor be able to stay in business and be an industry innovator?

In the race for quality Thoroughbreds, Kentucky tracks are carrying an extra 20 pounds. Virtually every state in the region has a competitive advantage by supplementing purses and breeders' awards from alternative forms of gaming. This is a trend which has increased in recent years and now has the Kentucky horse industry in crisis. It is impossible to be innovative when survival is at the top of the list.

Let's take Ellis Park as an example. Track owner Ron Geary has worked hard to present a first-class product. He brought the Claiming Crown to Ellis Park and also introduced a reduced takeout on certain wagers. 'Innovative' is the word that comes to mind. But now he finds himself trying to fund a racing program with around \$4 million in purses, while his competition in Indiana and Pennsylvania offers four to five times more. And, the gap is widening. Ron Geary, track innovator, has no chance, just like a Team Valor horse running with an extra 20 pounds in a race.

Now, for my situation. Barry mentioned that I am new to Kentucky and a racetrack executive. First of all, I have invested more money in Richland Hills, a stallion station and breeding farm in Midway, Kentucky, than I have in Kentucky Downs. I have owned mares in Kentucky since 2002. My partners and I have bred a multiple stakes winner, a stakes-placed runner and many solid winners in relatively few opportunities. We brought Honey Rose, a Grade 1 stakes winner in Argentina, to the U.S. and won a stakes race with her in North America. I love horse racing and breeding. I feel blessed to own and breed horses. I am motivated every day to improve our great sport and the lives of those who work so hard caring for the horses we appreciate so much.

With an increase in purse money, Kentucky Downs will be able to offer some of the finest turf racing in the world and introduce new fans from Nashville to our sport. But, without a new revenue source from VLTs like other states, those plans just remain dreams.

## RACING ROUND-UP

### *Terrain Euthanized Following Iowa Derby...*

Adele Dilschneider's **Terrain** (Sky Mesa) was euthanized following Friday night's Iowa Derby after suffering a fractured sesamoid and a condylar fracture in his right front leg during the race. Sent off the 11-10 favorite in the field of nine, the gelding missed the

break, but was making decent ground up the backstretch when he was pulled up abruptly by jockey Robby Albarado approaching the three-eighths marker. "He warmed up well, started off nice," trainer Al Stall Jr. told *DRF*. "Robby said he was like butter, but down the backside something went wrong." Terrain

was taken by horse ambulance back to the barn area, but his injuries proved catastrophic. Winner of the Mountaineer Juvenile S. at second asking, Terrain crossed the line third in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity, but was awarded the victory on a double disqualification. In his first three starts as a sophomore, he was third to Friesan Fire (A.P. Indy) in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 14, fourth to General Quarters (Sky Mesa) in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 11 and seventh in the GI Preakness S. Overall, Terrain won three of his 10 starts and earned \$512,084.

### *Summer Bird Back to Work...*

**Summer Bird** (Birdstone), who upset the GI Belmont S. at odds of 11-1 June 6, returned to the worktab for the first time since his New York effort, breezing five-eighths of a mile in an easy 1:04.42 at Louisiana Downs. "He went nice and easy," trainer Tim Ice commented. "He's a happy horse right now and we want to keep him that way." Ice reports that Summer Bird will make a brief appearance back at Churchill Downs this coming Thursday. "We are going to stop over there for about 10 hours and then get back on the road that night," explained Ice, who is shipping Summer Bird to Monmouth Park to prepare for the GI Haskell Invitational S. Aug. 3.

### *Shane Sellers to Return to Saddle...*

Jockey Shane Sellers, who retired from competitive race riding in late 2004, will launch a comeback at Evangeline Downs in Louisiana July 2. He has accepted the call on Ide Ball (Ide) for trainer and close friend Mark Guidry in the evening's first race. The 42-year-old native of Louisiana recorded 4,069 wins prior to his retirement, including Breeders' Cup victories aboard Buck's Boy and Countess Diana. Sellers was an outspoken advocate for better pay, health insurance and weight issues for riders. "It's no secret to why I've decided to come back and why I decided to come back to Evangeline," Sellers said in a release. "I rode my first winner here in 1983, and it's time for me to get back to my roots and what I love. I still believe in what I was fighting for back then, but over time I realized that my method or message was not always delivered in a respectable way. If I offended anyone, I apologize and want everyone to know that I am through with all of those causes," he continued. "I am so thankful for the open-armed response that I have received on my comeback and look forward to rekindling old friendships and relationships." Sellers's book will be handled by Anthony Martin.

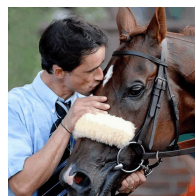
