## RAHY PENSIONED

Officials at Robert Clay's Three Chimneys Farm have announced that **Rahy** (Blushing Groom {Fr}--Glorious Song, by Halo), the sire of 82 black-type winners, including Serena's Song, Fantastic Light, Dreaming of Anna and Noverre, has been pensioned from stud duties due to declining fertility. "Rahy is one of the most important stallions we've had," said Case Clay, President of Three Chimneys. Rahy will

remain at Three Chimneys throughout his retirement. "Not only was standing him a great opportunity for Three Chimneys, but it allowed us to begin a very enjoyable and successful partnership with the Maktoum family. While it's too bad Rahy won't have anymore crops going forward, we're excited to have his son Lewis Michael here to carry on his legacy." From 19 crops to race, Rahy is responsible for 40 graded stakes winners and three champions--Serena's Song, Fantastic Light and Dreaming of Anna.

## Bred for Success...

Campaigned by Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum and trained in Europe by Sir Michael Stoute, where Rahy won the Listed Sirenia S. and was second in the G1 Middle Park S. at two. A winner of one of three starts during his sophomore season, he came to the U.S. in 1988, and posted a 10-length victory in the GII Bel Air H. and was runner-up in the GIII Goodwood H. and GIII Harold C. Ramser Sr. H. Bred by Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Kentucky, the chestnut is produced by European champion miler and subsequent leading sire in England Blushing Groom (Fr) (Red God). Rahy's dam Glorious Song (Halo) brought equally impressive qualifications to the table. A Canadian Horse of the Year and two-time champion older mare in that country, the full sister to champion Devil's Bag and leading sire Saint Ballado, also produced multiple champion Singspiel (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}). **Rahy as a Broodmare sire..cont. p3**

**WITH THE BREEDERS'**  
**CUP BOARD OF**  
**DIRECTORS CANDIDATES**

**Why do you want the opportunity to serve on the 13-member Breeders' Cup Board of Directors?**

**TOM LUDT**

I think my three years' experience on the Board has helped me learn the philosophical and structural part of the Breeders' Cup by serving on many of the subcommittees. Still, currently serving on the Kentucky Racing Commission has also helped me experience and see how best to work within the political environment of racing, and how best to patiently work through the dynamics of trying to create positive change. All this, while running Vinery's breeding and racing operation, gives me a perspective of the many facets our game. I

think this really enables me to serve our owners and breeders on the Breeders' Cup board in a way that will help the organization and the game further our mission and goals.

**RICHARD SANTULLI**

I believe I can affect positive change if elected to the Breeders' Cup Board of Directors. In today's environment--with a combination of a poor economy and the negative publicity we have received in the racing business--some positive change is necessary. Outside of my racing experience, I have created an industry, built a large brand and am heavily involved in event and sports marketing. At NetJets, we have staged the Sampras-Federer match at Madison Square Garden, along with tennis events, golf events, and others. Through

that experience, I believe I can help in making the Breeders' Cup event a better event than it is now. My business acumen is such that I believe I can help the business of the Breeders' Cup as well.

Since my nomination, I have heard rumors that my being named to the board of 13 would give the Sentient Flight Group a reason to no longer be a Breeders' Cup sponsor. While I'm sure that's not in their contract, if there is anyone who believes that I would not recuse myself from any Sentient discussions or negotiations, they shouldn't vote for me to be on the Board. My integrity is more important than anything else.

**DUNCAN TAYLOR**

I would like to serve on the board of 13 primarily to ensure that we are focusing on the customers who are behind our revenue streams. I think we need to create the experiences that they want. We also need to focus on our potential customers. I think it would be beneficial to make the Breeders' Cup more fan-friendly by creating an understandable structure--giving the events leading up to the championship event more meaning, and thereby giving the final event greater importance as well. We need newcomers, casual fans and hardcore fans to understand that each event doesn't exist in a vacuum, but has some relevance to those which preceded and follow it, especially the championship event.

I will be an advocate of two-way communication with the nominators systematic communications that ask for input and informs the nominators of decisions that are made with a logical explanation of why the decisions were made.

Those are my primary goals.

The business I'm in is the horse business. It means a lot to me. This is my life, and my family's life, and I'm going to try to do the best thing to provide our fans and wagerers a great experience and thereby grow the sport.

**THOR-BRED EYES FIRST STAKES IN PRIORESS**

Pavla and Erik Nygaard's Thor-Bred Stable has only been in business a few years, but has already enjoyed considerable success. The stable could take a huge step forward Saturday when **Reforestation** (Forestry) goes postward in the G1 Prioress S. at Belmont Park.



"We had two other Grade I starters in California," Pavla Nygaard said from the couple's Del Mar home. "And we have had four horses placed at the stakes

level, but we haven't had a winner yet at the stakes level. We are excited and honored to have a horse that can even start at a level like that."

The Nygaards' progression in racing was gradual, but Pavla admits it has its origins in her lifelong love of horses.

"I've loved horses ever since I could see," she said. "I have my personal horse who came off the track. I wasn't involved with racing per se, but I was a definite horse lover. And my husband had gone to the track here and there when we were living in New York. He would go to Saratoga in the summer and enjoy the races and handicapping a little bit here and there."

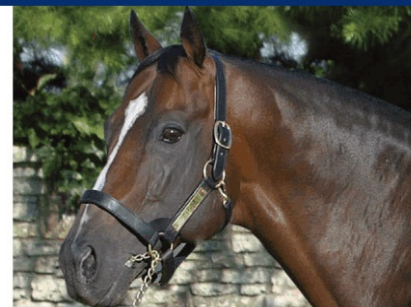

Their participation in racing escalated with the seemingly innocuous purchase of a horse farm in Florida.

"At some point we ended up buying a farm in Ocala that originally was just to be an investment," Nygaard, a native of the Czech Republic, recalled. "It had an existing Thoroughbred business on it and, from that, we kind of just got sucked in."

Thor-Bred made the 610-acre Ocala Jockey Club its farm base, and the Nygaards set about discovering where exactly their racing interests lay.

"At the beginning, when we got into the business, J.J. Pletcher told us that for people starting out, it was a good idea to dabble in everything to find out what really suited them," Nygaard explained. "We did a little bit of breeding. We did some yearling to two-year-old pinhooking, and we've done some racing. We've probably enjoyed the racing the most. We may end up breeding some ourselves to race, but it would be on a pretty limited basis. I don't foresee doing commercial breeding or commercial pinhooking. Possibly here and there, but what we really enjoy is being able to race without the commercial pressures."

Thor-Bred enjoyed its biggest success on the track when Ginger Pop (El Prado {Ire}) finished second behind champion Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) in last year's GI La Brea S. It also campaigned Sekira (Holy Bull) to a third-place finish in the 2007 GII Santa Ynez S. and Beresford (Touch Gold) to a fourth in the 2007 GI Norfolk S.

Reforestation will be making her 10th lifetime start in the six-furlong Prioress, and it will be her first try in graded stakes company. The dark bay filly went through the sales ring at the 2007 Keeneland September Yearling auction, but failed to sell at \$120,000.

It was at that sale that she attracted the notice of the Nygaards.

"She was in the Taylor Made consignment at the Keeneland yearling sale," Nygaard explained. "She RNA'd, so we went out to Taylor Made and they paraded a bunch of horses around us. Many of them--there seemed like there was a good reason why they RNA'd, but she certainly caught my eye."

Thor-Bred purchased the yearling with the expectation of reselling her at the juvenile auctions, but that plan failed to pan out.

"She was intended to be a two-year-old pinhook, but she RNA'd at the Ocala March sale. She RNA'd for \$42,000, and we just felt that she had a lot more value than that. And to date she has proven that."

Reforestation got off to a somewhat slow start to her racing career. Making four starts as a juvenile last fall in New York, the dark bay filly was second twice and fourth twice.

"Our trainer [Bill Turner] liked her from day one when he got her," Nygaard said. "But she was quite a tough filly right from the beginning, so she has been a long time in development. She has started a number of times--she had seconditis at first. She showed good talent, but she didn't show the talent that [Turner] thought she had as early as he thought that she would be showing it."

Reforestation broke through in her third start as a sophomore, taking an Apr. 30 Belmont maiden by five lengths. She followed that maiden-breaking effort with a 4 1/2-length triumph in an Apr. 30 Belmont allowance and is coming off a runner-up effort over a sloppy track in the June 5 Alyssum S.

Nygaard knows they are asking a lot of Reforestation, but thinks the timing is right.

"Bill feels she is training better now than she had been training, and she's come out of the second spot from the last stakes well," she commented. "Granted, it's a huge step up in competition, but he felt that, in terms of the other fillies that are going to be running in the race and where she was at, that if we were going to try her at this level, this was as good a spot as any."

Reforestation, at 20-1 on the morning line, will be a longshot on Saturday, but that is just fine with Nygaard.

"It is a mixture of scary and exciting," Nygaard said of having a horse entered in a Grade I race. "I'm one who doesn't seek publicity and I think both my husband and I are that way. We prefer to have the horse's performance speak for itself, rather than talk a horse up ahead of time. We certainly don't like making any huge predictions. When Ginger Pop placed second behind Indian Blessing, that was just absolutely amazing, and that filly was going in as a longshot in the race. That is possibly more in my comfort level, in terms of having a horse going in and showing that she belongs there. Hopefully that is going to happen here."

Nygaard may be able to avoid the spotlight if travel plans make it impossible to be in New York for the Prioress.

"We need to be in Vancouver for my best friend's wedding reception over the weekend, so [being at Belmont Saturday] would involve dragging ourselves to the East Coast on a red eye on Friday night and then another red eye flight coming out of New York to Vancouver."

There is one member of the clan who would have no problem with the long travel.

"We've got a two-year-old daughter and we just had a long trip to Europe to meet her grandfather," Nygaard said. "She loves to travel--it seems like she wants to get on any airplane that she sees."

A first stakes win and two long flights could make the whole family happy. -*Jessica Martini*

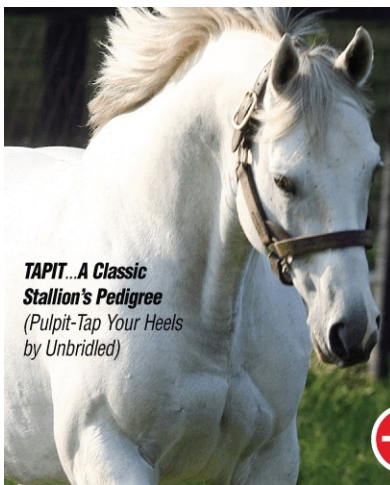

# RACING Round-Up

### Arch Misses Eclipse Gig...

**Archipenko** (Kingmambo) has been forced out of tomorrow's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown after swelling was found on the five-year-old's fetlock. Trainer Mike de Kock's assistant Juan Nel revealed the news on Sheikh Mohammed Bin Khalifa Al Maktoum's G1 QEII Cup winner and told *PA Sport*, "It's a race we've been targeting for a long time and it's very hard to take. We discovered the problem early on Thursday morning, and it's a huge disappointment. We haven't had a full prognosis yet, so we're a little bit in the dark in terms of when he'll be back."

### Naaqoos out of Jean Prat...

Trainer Freddy Head yesterday revealed that **Naaqoos** (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) would miss Sunday's G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly after returning a bad scope. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner was expected to start favorite for the one-mile contest. "Naaqoos coughed and scoped badly, so we have decided not to run him," Head told the *Racing Post*.

### Blast Set for Gallop...

Elio Anthony Galante's G1 King's Stand S. winner **Scenic Blast** (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}) is due to take part in a racecourse gallop at Newmarket ahead of Friday's G1 Darley July Cup. Connections took the five-year-old onto the July Course last week and will go back again ahead of the six-furlong contest. "He's worked over the course once before and will do so again before the race," conditioner Danny Morton told *PA Sport*. "It's a big help to be based at Newmarket and it's definitely a different test to Ascot. The course is more undulating with a stiff finish. He came out of the Ascot race great, and I have been very pleased with him since. Everything has gone according to plan."

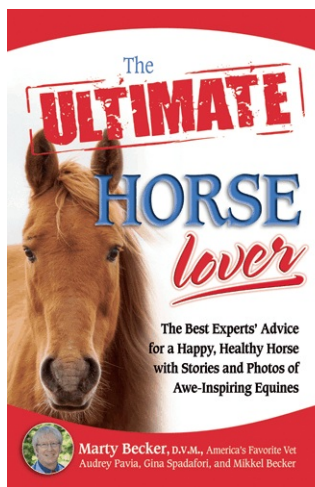
### J J Flying...

**RMTC Board Implements Initiatives:**

The Racing Medication and Testing Consortium board of directors has approved new national laboratory standards for testing, the implementation of a laboratory accreditation program and a new independent Equine Quality Assurance Program at the board meeting in Baltimore June 18. In addition, the board approved the three-year funding of a graduate/ post-doctoral research fellowship and a frozen sample and retrospective testing program. The initiatives are part of reforms in U.S. racing's drug testing recommended by Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association CEO and RMTC Vice Chairman Alan M. Foreman at The Jockey Club's 2008 Round Table Conference. "The RMTC has adopted standards that all testing laboratories will have to meet to gain accreditation and we have begun the actual accreditation process," said Foreman. "The new Equine Quality Assurance Program will provide an independent, third-party examination of equine drug testing laboratories, which is a totally new concept for the horse racing industry. This work is unprecedented and ultimately will change the face of drug testing in this country." RMTC Executive Director Dr. Scot Waterman also provided board members with an update on the status of administration studies funded by the RMTC on a number of essential non-raceday therapeutic medications. The RMTC Scientific Advisory Committee will continue to review available data from these studies for withdrawal time recommendations. "We are very close to completing the first phase of our withdrawal times recommendations, which we believe will reduce the number of violations for therapeutic medications across the country once adopted," said Dr. Waterman. "This will benefit the entire industry." **BULLS AND BEARS (Holy Bull)**

As the field rounded the turn in the fourth race, trainer Rick Violette Jr. had his binoculars trained on Bulls and Bears in fourth, and breathed a sigh of relief when the juvenile gamely rallied up the rail to take his debut.

"He's shown us that he has some pretty serious talent," Violette acknowledged. "Although a two-year-old filly I ran [Wednesday] I liked, too, and she got beat about 20 lengths, so I was scared to death today."

That filly, Quantitativeeasing (Officer), is also owned by the partnership of Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence, and showed early foot before fading to seventh. But the presence of mind displayed by Bulls and Bears more than made up for that disappointment.

"At the 5/16th pole, I thought [jockey Alan Garcia] was waiting to angle out; he kind of leaned out a little bit, and then he just figured [the colt] was taking the dirt so well and was just sitting on ready," Violette continued. "If something opened up, [Garcia] thought he'd explode through, and he did. We had him schooled pretty well--he's taken dirt in his face a couple of times in the morning. But even well-schooled horses need to have the desire to do that, and he just dove in to get to the lead. He's obviously pretty handy--he has a future."

Having answered one question, a class test is likely next for Bulls and Bears.

"Depending on how he comes out of it, we'll certainly have our eye on the first stakes at Saratoga [GII Sanford S. at six furlongs July 30]," Violette confirmed. "He got a heck of an education today; it's a lot better than just going to the lead and winning off. He got dirt in his face, split horses and was quite patient behind horses, so it was like he got three races in one here."

Eisaman Equine purchased the grey colt for \$47,000 as a yearling at KEESEP, and pinhooked him for \$135,000 at OBSMAR.

"I thought that was probably pretty dear for him," Violette opined. "He's by Holy Bull and I don't know that there's a lot of pedigree on the bottom side, so in that market it certainly wasn't bottom-of-the-barrel pricing. It was a good fair price for a horse that looked like he could run."

Violette added, "We're trying to get two-year-olds that are going to make good three-year-olds. He's got a great hip and shoulder. He's about medium-sized and he'll grow a little bit more. He's got a terrific mind on him. Right now, he has all the makings of a nice horse."

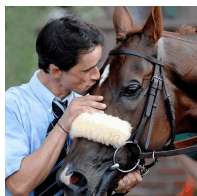
