## VIRGINIA IS FOR...GI ONE-TWO FINISHERS

The Edward P. Evans duo of Virginia homebreds **Cat Moves** (Tale of the Cat) and **Light Green** (Pleasantly Perfect) keyed a one-two finish in yesterday's GI Prioress S. at Belmont. The former, unbeaten in her first two starts, raced in midpack after lunging at the break. Meanwhile, Light Green pressed **Heart Ashley** (Lion Heart) through crisp early fractions of :21.56 and :44.01. With Ramon Dominguez aboard, Cat Moves began to pick off horses on the outside on the turn for home and came with a sustained stretch run to reel in her stablemate. Cont. p4

## STAR STRUCK

His odds of 4-7 suggested **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) would have little difficulty adding yesterday's G1 Coral-Eclipse to his tally of G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Derby, but **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) made him fight for his legacy all the way up the Sandown hill. Always traveling with his now-customary elan behind the trio of pacemakers, Christopher Tsui's homebred was committed by Mick Kinane with a quarter mile remaining as the speed collapsed. Chased all the way to the line by Ballydoyle's raider, he pulled away after being briefly joined at the furlong pole to score by a length. In doing so, the handsome bay emulated Nashwan, who followed up his Newmarket and Epsom Classic successes with victory here in 1989. "His versatility and unique pace make him exceptional and he has the temperament to go with it," Kinane said after registering his fourth Eclipse on a horse he has been closely involved with from an early point. "The world is your oyster with this horse, and he can only be better as he matures."

The Curragh's G2 Juddmonte Beresford S. is an unlikely place to find a Guineas winner, and Sea the Stars was far from flashy when successfully capping a brief two-year-old campaign with a professional performance in that mile contest in September. His next sighting at Newmarket May 2 proved John Oxx's incumbent was no follower of trends, and his easy defeat of Delegator (GB) (Dansili {GB}) was marked as much by his fluency through the early and middle portions of the race as his strong finish. Approaching Epsom with an element of trepidation after that display of speed, connections reaped the reward of setting him down the Derby trail as he thrived with equal measure in the mile-and-a-half test. While his class was firmly established on the first Saturday in June, stamina questions remained due to the lack of fast fractions in the Blue Riband. Sunday's furiously run Irish equivalent--won by the Epsom runner-up Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire})--would have answered more questions in that regard, but the star attraction was re-routed after heavy rain proved The Curragh's loss and Sandown's gain.

Blessed with a quicker surface and back at a trip that his pedigree suggests would be more in his comfort zone, Sea the Stars broke with the lightness and eagerness of a sprinter, and even the strong pace laid on by the Stoute and O'Brien rabbits failed to diminish his keenness. He was tracked by the smooth-traveling Rip Van Winkle and Jimmy Fortune throughout, and the pair soon had it between them after the favorite was left in front two out. Stretching away from Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) up the rising ground, Sea the Stars was always holding the initiative and had the most to give where it mattered. "He is so quick out of the stalls and even though they were flying, they weren't going quick enough for me," Kinane commented. "I got in front too soon and he only just does enough when he's there, but this is a not a place where you should be stopping and, when the second horse came, he just picked up again. You are always in control of a race with him and that's a great feeling. My only concern beforehand was dropping him back after bringing him to a peak for last weekend, but when I rode him on Tuesday morning it was as if nothing had happened. Nothing seems to ruffle his feathers and there is more to come." Oxx added that he will take his time deciding on the next target for Sea the Stars, who recorded a sharp time on these Esher slopes. "The G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 5] would be a major objective, but we have to see how he comes out of this, and see if he runs once before in either the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 25] or G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 18]," Oxx said. "He comes through his races very well and he'll tell us." Kinane has his own thoughts on the colt's career path from here. "He gets very fresh and is hard to ride at home, so we took a view to keep going with him through the summer, and that might make the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4] doubtful," Kinane opined. **No Excuses...**

Aidan O'Brien was not offering Rip Van Winkle's late hock injury scare as a reason for his defeat, and was happy to take a positive view of the runner-up's effort. "Jimmy [Fortune] said when he came to challenge, he was still very green and a bit babyish as he's only really had a couple of serious races," the Ballydoyle conditioner told *PA Sport*. "He's had lots of problems and he had a hock the other day, which meant we were not sure he would even get here, so we are really happy with his performance." Ballymacoll Stud's Conduit briefly threatened to take a role in the finish when brought wide from rear passing the quarter pole, but stayed on to take a clear third. "We didn't plan to be that far back, but there was a lot of scrimmaging and it got a bit messy," jockey Ryan Moore said. "I thought two out I was going to get involved and that Sea the Stars was a nice target to run at, but he wasn't doing a lot, and when Mick [Kinane] asked him he has gone away again and found plenty. Conduit had a little hold-up in the spring and I think there is a good deal more to come, so hopefully he'll get back to the level he was at last year."

"We were high on both fillies, probably higher on the second finisher [Light Green] because she had more of a record," Edward P. Evans offered. "Man, they both ran fantastic!" It was the second Grade I winner of the Belmont meeting for Anthony Dutrow, who saddled Seattle Smooth (Quiet American) to a win in the GI Ogden Phipps H. June 13. "I came over here today thinking she was live," Dutrow offered. "I was so confident this filly was going to run a great race. I was OK all during the race--I didn't know if we were going to win it, but I knew it was going to be an exciting stretch. It was a big effort for [Cat Moves] today. We'll consider the [GI] Test [at Saratoga Aug. 8], but we will have to see how she comes out of this race and, of course, discuss it with Mr. Evans."

**Staying Perfect...**

Cat Moves showed promise in her debut, airing by 8 1/4 lengths after showing speed at the Big A Apr. 26. The bay took her show on the road to Delaware Park, and rallied from third to post a 4 3/4-length tally in the slop June 2. Ramon Dominguez has been aboard in all three of her career attempts. "She's getting better and it's amazing--it's only her third start," Dominguez said. "She's extremely professional. It's really remarkable, regardless of how good she is, for such a short campaign to step it up and run that good, that fast, and just did it the right way. My filly has enough tactical speed where I thought I would actually be a little closer, but I was just trying to focus on getting her to the right spot. But I was pretty certain that they had to be going pretty quick because there was so much speed in the race, when I came to my entymate she seemed like she had a little extra, but my filly just kept on battling and she got up. Previous Passion used bold front-running tactics to successfully defend his title in the GI United Nations S. The chestnut led by an astounding 20 lengths through a half mile in :45.20 and six furlongs in 1:09.81, and had enough left in the tank to hang on. "I think it was a super performance," trainer Mary Hartman said of her charge's course record-setting performance. "He's really grown up and matured. He's got his helmet on now and his mind on running. I'm hoping to go to the Breeders' Cup with him. If all goes well and he stays healthy, it's very likely. I don't know where we'll go next." Previous Passion, a good second in Santa Anita's Sunshine Millions Turf S. Jan. 24, posted a game win in Gulfstream's GII Mac Diarmida S. Feb. 21 before placing second in the off-the-turf GIII Pan American S. Mar. 21. He resurfaced off the bench to gamely win the Monmouth S. by a nose last time June 13. Dry Martini, previously trained by Billy Turner, was runner-up to It's a Bird in the Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Jan. 24 in his first start for conditioner Barclay Tagg. He checked in fourth in GII New Orleans H. Mar. 14, then picked up the pieces to complete the trifecta in the Charles Town Classic Apr. 18. In against

Dry Martini, unhurried in the opening stages here, waited for room while saving ground around the bend. After coming off the rail at the top of the stretch, he made a determined rally from between horses to become racing's latest millionaire. "With all the speed in there, I thought it would work out," Tagg said. "There was a very fast half-mile and it worked out well for us. I guess we'll have to look now at the [GI] Whitney [H. at Saratoga Aug. 8]. Asiatic Boy, who made his second start in the United States yesterday, will also be pointed towards the Whitney. Heavily favored Warrior's Reward was up against it after a stumbling beginning, and it was Kensei who stepped up with a career high. Kensei sat a stalking trip in third as Just Ben (Speightstown) blazed the way through fractions of :23.23 and :45.71. The Stonestreet and Gulf Coast colorbearer made a sharp move to challenge for the lead on the turn for home, prompting jockey Edgar Prado to take a look in the rear view mirror. The bay quickly began to open daylight in the stretch and left little doubt about the outcome. "He was within himself, which I liked," owner Jess Jackson said of Kensei, who was making his first start beyond 7 1/2 furlongs. "Saratoga is on our screen, but we have to look at other alternatives, as well. We have hard decisions, but first we have to see how he comes out of the race. Curlin spoiled me; now these horses [Rachel Alexandra and Kensei] are spoiling me. I'm very delighted Kensei came along as he did." Kensei earned his diploma at first asking at Saratoga last August, before concluding his juvenile season with a sixth-place finish in the GII Futurity S. at Belmont Sept. 13. He resurfaced with an optional claiming victory at Oaklawn Apr. 2, then placed second in the GIII Derby Trial S. Apr. 25. He entered the Dwyer off a troubled third-place finish in the GII Woody Stephens S. June 6. When he's right, he's right. Monterey Jazz put in another tour-de-force to secure his fourth career win at the graded level. Having paired up wins in the GIII Sir Beaufort S. and GII Strub S. on Santa Anita's turf and synthetic, respectively, last winter, the dark bay faded to 12th in the 2008 GI Santa Anita H., but rebounded with an eight-length triumph in the GIII Texas Mile at Lone Star in April before heading to the sidelines. **BELATED FIREWORKS LIKELY FOR OAKS**

There's something for everyone in today's GI American Oaks at Hollywood Park, which has attracted a full field. Winner of a listed event at Rome last September, **Mrs Kipling** was a good third in the G3 Cornwallis S. Oct. 11, finishing ahead of no fewer than 16 rivals while two lengths behind the winner. Subsequently purchased by celebrity chef Bobby Flay, the bay filly made a favorable impression in her stateside debut, rallying four wide into the Santa Anita stretch before just failing by a half-length to catch **Acting Lady** in the one-mile GII Providencia S. Apr. 4. Bet down to 2-1 favoritism for the GIII Senorita S. at this venue May 3, Mrs Kipling put in another wide rally that was good enough for a 2 1/2-length victory. As with most of today's field, the 10-furlong distance must be something of a question, but her broodmare sire was a true stayer and her running style is conducive to seeing out the trip.

**Gozzip Girl**, the morning-line favorite, is the best from the East Coast this season. Effective on or off the pace and over sound and less sound surfaces, the dark bay rallied to take Gulfstream's GIII Herecomesthebride S. Mar. 15, then overcame a stumble at the start of the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 4 to miss by a neck to pacesetter Hooh Why (Cloud Hopping). When none of her competitors wanted the lead in the GII Sands Point S. last time out May 30, Gozzip Girl made the running and sprinted home to lead a 1-2-3 sweep for her sire. Trainer Dermot Weld took the 2003 American Oaks with Dimitrova (Swain {Ire}) and is always dangerous when he sends one to the States. **Rare Ransom** made a successful seasonal debut, taking a Gowran Park conditions event May 14, but, back on just 10 days' rest, finished a respectable fourth of 16 to Again (Ire) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas over ground that may have been far softer than she prefers.

Ascot was really his first run of the season, as he was all wrong before the Guineas, so we are very hopeful." In terms of reward for effort, **Westphalia** deserves a major prize after game runs when second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita in October and two Classic placings already this term. Runner-up to Warrior's Reward (Medaglia d'Oro) in a May 1 allowance at Churchill Downs, the \$1.7-million FTFFEB purchase got an ideal set-up in the GII Woody Stephens S. June 6 and charged home to score by 5 1/4 lengths. He gets an 11-pound pull in the weights with the favorite and could take some beating.

## RACING Round-Up

**SMITH TO RIDE MINE THAT BIRD** Jockey Mike Smith, who rode GI Kentucky Derby hero **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) to a runner-up effort behind Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI Preakness S. May 16, has given trainer Chip Woolley a two-race commitment to ride the gelding in the GIII West Virginia Derby Aug. 1 and the GI Shadwell Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 29. Smith picked up the mount on Mine That Bird in the Preakness when Calvin Borel opted to ride the GI Kentucky Oaks winner in the second leg of the Triple Crown. Borel was back aboard the Sovereign Award winner in the GI Belmont S. June 6, where they combined for a third-place finish, but Borel refused to give Woolley the call for upcoming races, instead opting to keep his options open with Warrior's Reward (Medaglia d'Oro), third in yesterday's GII Dwyer S., who is likely to make his next appearance in the GII Jim Dandy S., also Aug. 1. Smith, who was at Churchill Downs Saturday to ride Thorn Song (Unbridled's Song) in the GII Firecracker H., said, "I'm very happy to have the opportunity to get back on him. Hopefully I can make amends for what happened the last time and get him home this time." Woolley did not get a commitment from Smith, the regular rider of undefeated Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}), for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 7.

### Paco May Swerve July Cup...

Trainer Richard Hannon has virtually ruled **Paco Boy (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) out of next Friday's G1 Darley July Cup, despite declaring the four-year-old for the Newmarket sprint. One of 14 horses remaining in the six-furlong contest at the five-day stage, the G1 Queen Anne S. winner will not run unless the current good-to-firm ground eases. "It makes sense to keep our options open, but the ground at Newmarket is good to firm and, with only light showers forecast for Monday and Tuesday and the prediction of predominately dry weather after that, it could well be lightning-fast come Friday, and there is no way that we would risk Paco Boy in those conditions," Hannon explained. "We will probably wait for the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 9. The G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville is the following Sunday and also comes into the mix, while we have certainly not ruled out the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood on July 29." Among the intended runners in third and final British leg of the Global Sprint Challenge are the G1 King's Stand S. winner **Scenic Blast (Aus)** (Scenic {Ire}) and **Takeover Target (Aus)** (Celtic Swing {GB}), while the Criquelette Head-Maarek-trained 2008 G1 Sprint Cup heroine **African Rose (GB)** (Observatory) is likely to represent France.

### Setback for Better Talk Now...

Brushwood Stables's **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man), scratched from yesterday's GI United Nations S. at Monmouth, suffered a minor splint bone injury, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "I don't know that it's that serious, it's just enough to stop him from running [in the U.N.]," trainer Graham Motion told *DRF*. "I don't want to run him if he's not 100 percent." The 10-year-old, who has bankrolled more than \$4.2 million, was last seen rallying for third in the GI Manhattan H. on the GI Belmont S. undercard.

### Star Sighting...

Champion **Stardom Bound** (Tapit), freshened since placing third in the GI Ashland S. Apr. 4, has returned to Churchill Downs and is scheduled to join Rick Dutrow's New York string Monday. "She has been on vacation, and [Friday] was the first day she had tack on since she went on vacation," said Michelle Nevin, assistant to trainer Rick Dutrow. "We are going to put her back in training and start all over again." The gray, purchased for \$5.7 million at FTKNOV by a group headed by IEAH Stables, was taken out of consideration for the GI Kentucky Oaks after failing to impress in her training.

**July 7, 1934...**Mary Hirsch became the first female to be licensed as a Thoroughbred trainer, in Illinois. Hirsch subsequently was licensed in Michigan that year and two years later, on April 9, she was licensed by The Jockey Club to train in New York.



### Financial Problems for Illinois Racing Board:

The *Daily Racing Form* reports that, due to declining handle in the state, the Illinois Racing Board will have to address a projected budget deficit of \$2.1 million for fiscal year 2010. The fiscal year began July 1. "It's a serious crisis, one we've never faced in racing operations," IRB Executive Director Marc Laino told *DRF*. "It's at a point where the industry is no longer self-sufficient." The IRB is funded by parimutuel taxes and, according to *DRF*, handle in Illinois has dropped 10 percent each of the last two years. There already have been staff cuts at the organization and, if a bill that would legalize account wagering is signed by Gov. Pat Quinn, the revenue derived could help alleviate the shortfall. The IRB has also floated the idea that racetracks shoulder some of its operational costs. "Some of these regulatory functions might have to be shifted to the racetracks," Laino added. But Arlington President Roy Arnold needs more information on that front. "What I don't think anybody should be asked to do is write a blank check," Arnold told *DRF*. "I think the [IRB] needs to give the tracks some idea of their budget. What are fixed costs? What are administrative costs?" He added, "It's difficult to think of next year without knowing the range of solutions the Board may be contemplating."

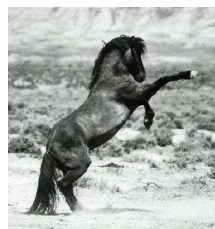

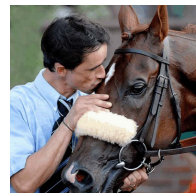

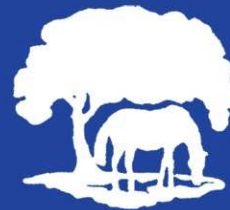
