## SOMETHING TO TALK ABOUT

Farnsworth Stables' **Gozzip Girl** (Dynaformer) unleashed a devastating turn of foot to run away with Sunday's GI American Oaks at Hollywood Park. Coming

off a wire-to-wire win in the GII Sands Point S. at Belmont May 30, Gozzip Girl used much different tactics this time, rating well off the pace in a crowded 14-horse field. The public's 2-1 choice came between rivals in upper stretch under Kent Desormeaux and, when asked for her best at the furlong grounds, burst clear en route to the four-length tally over **Well Monied** (Maria's Mon). "She's very much a lovely ride," Desormeaux said. "She's very graceful. She really loomed up boldly and got to that first flight quickly. It was

just a matter of picking a gap and giving her somewhere to run. I know she's very talented, but she really ran fantastic today. She won handily." Farnsworth Stables is the nom de course of the Ocala-based father-son team of Robert (61) and Myron Miller (33). **Cont. p2**

## PRAISE THE LORD

Rebounding from a 12th in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in May, **Lord Shanakill** (Speightstown) got back on track with a third in last month's G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, and finally bagged the top-level success his portfolio so richly deserved with a head win in yesterday's G1 Etihad Airways Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly. Settled second under a tight hold, the 69-10 chance took control approaching the final quarter mile and was driven out to just hold the late surge of **Oiseau de Feu** (Stravinsky). "We came here to win, as we thought we had a favorite's chance, so I was surprised at his starting odds," said winning trainer Karl Burke. "We've been to France a few times before and had placed horses, but that's our first winner here." **Cont. 3**

**All-American Girl...**

Gozzip Girl, third in a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 15, collected back-to-back stakes wins in the Coconut Grove S. in Hallandale Feb. 15 and the grassy, nine-furlong GIII Herecomesthebride S. Mar. 15. She ran a bang-up race to finish a neck adrift of Hooh Why (Cloud Hopping) in the GI Ashland S. in her first try over a

synthetic track at Keeneland Apr. 4. Back to the turf last time, she was put on the front and set slow fractions in Belmont's Sands Point and led every step. In the American Oaks, Gozzip Girl was content to lay back as Afternoon Stroll (Stroll)

raced out and set a legitimate half in :47 2/5. The closers began to get into the action in upper stretch, with Gozzip Girl proving much the best once they straightened for home. "This was her toughest assignment she had to face so far," said winning trainer Tom Albertrani. "She's done so well and she seems like she's improving all the time. We're almost thinking about trying her back on the dirt. We're going to talk about it, but the Alabama might be in our sights at Saratoga. She handled the poly track. She won her last three out of four, I think, and she is very consistent. She is very versatile. She can win on the lead and come from behind. She looks like she is just getting stronger and improving all the time." Trainer Howard Zucker was happy with Well Monied's runner-up effort. "We overcame a lot to be second," he commented. "This was like a Breeders' Cup field. What a job they did with this race. We just needed a better trip. None of them tried harder than my horse."

The 7-1 chance Mrs Kipling (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) was eased late, finishing 12th, and was dismounted soon after the wire. Jockey David Flores said he was just being cautious, however, and the filly did not appear to be in distress. **Dynamite Day for Dynaformer...**

On a day when Speightstown was represented by Group 1 and Grade II winners, the veteran Dynaformer did the young up-and-comer one better by coming up with a pair of winners at the highest level. In addition to Gozzip Girl, Dynaformer was represented by Weiner Walzer (Ger), who notched his first Group 1 in the Deutsches Derby in Germany. Of note, both Gozzip Girl and Weiner Walzer are out of Kingmambo mares.

Lord Shanakill was the model of consistency during a busy juvenile season and backed up a third in last June's G2 Coventry S. at the Royal Ascot jamboree by improving one spot in the G2 Vintage S. at Glorious Goodwood the following month. Hitting the board again in August's G1 Prix Morny at Deauville, he slipped to fifth in the G2 Flying Childers S. at Doncaster before claiming a personal best in September's G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury. He concluded his freshman campaign in October's G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket, finishing second, by a nose, to Intense Focus (Giant's Causeway). Lord Shanakill was unable to land a blow when 12th in the May 2 G1 2000 Guineas back at the Rowley Mile track on seasonal return, but resumed normal service with an excellent third in the June 16 G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot last time.

Positioned in second under a tight hold for most of this, the eventual winner was allowed an inch of rein and took over with 500 meters to go. He was ridden along to maintain control approaching the final furlong and responded to every call from the saddle in the closing stages as Oiseau de Feu's late surge proved in vain. "He's a very good and consistent racehorse and it was always the plan--after the St James's Palace--to come here for this, as it's the last Group 1 race restricted to three-year-olds," explained trainer Karl Burke, who was also saddling his first Group One winner. "The [G1] Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 16] is a possibility, and he's also in the [G1] Sussex S. [at Goodwood July 29]. The [G1] Prix Maurice de Gheest [at Deauville Aug. 9] is another possibility as he has a lot of speed and the 6 1/2 furlongs [of that race] should not be a problem for him. It'll be one of those three, but we were concentrating on getting the Group 1 win for his for his stud C.V. and we managed to do that, so we're delighted." **Seau near and yet seau far...**

Oiseau de Feu looked a serious threat to the eventual winner when making ominous progress passing the furlong marker and was closing with every stride until running out of real estate. However, owner Bernard Weill was not downcast and said, "Oiseau de Feu ran a very good race, but, on form, Lord Shanakill was the horse to beat. With a furlong to go it looked as though we might beat him, but the winner kicked on again and the best horse won."

Just weeks after the death of the Late Baronin Karin von Ullmann, Wiener Walzer became the 19th Derby winner bred and raised at Gestut Schlenderhan and the 18th to win in the famed stud's colors. First successful at Bremen Apr. 10, the bay stepped up to add the June 14 G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen to his tally at Cologne last time. Settled in fourth early by Scandinavian jockey Fredrik Johansson, the homebred was shuffled back a couple of places halfway down the back straight before he commenced a rally on the home turn. Grabbing the lead with 350 meters remaining, he was driven out in the closing stages to hold the wide challenges of Sordino and Toughness Danon. "Both our runners had worked really well and we are happy that Wiener Walzer got to win it," commented trainer Jens Hirschberger, who also saddled Adlerflug (Ger) (In the Wings {GB}) to win under the same rider in 2007. "He is not as good as Adlerflug, but he is a very good horse." Johansson added, "This is amazing, as I only come to Germany for a few rides. The people at Schlenderhan are always very nice to me and, although I think Adlerflug was more advanced at the time of his Derby victory, Wiener Walzer is a horse with scope for improvement. Zensational has blossomed into a sprint force to be reckoned with for trainer Bob Baffert. The gray was accorded ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status when he took his seasonal debut in 1:08 3/5 at Santa Anita Feb. 21. Stretched to a mile in an optional claimer Mar. 27, he tired to second after fast fractions, then bulled his way to another sharp score, this time in a Hollywood optional claiming sprint May 29. Here, the Zayat colorbearer was under a stranglehold early as jockey Victor Espinoza throttled his speed through :22 1/5 and :45 flat splits while racing wide. He came in a bit on fellow three-year-old Bet On Victor (Yankee Victor) turning the corner for home, continued to assert down the lane and held longshot Rush With Thunder safe. While stewards never posted the inquiry sign, an angry Vladimir Cerin, trainer of Bet On Victor, called up to complain about the contact turning for home, but no action was taken. "I wanted to keep him wide down the backstretch, because when he's close to other horses, he likes to fight," Espinoza explained of the tactics. Baffert said of future plans, "The race we're looking at next would be the [GI] King's Bishop S. [at Saratoga Aug. 29]. He won't run for a while. I just don't want to run him too many times. I want him fresh for the Breeders' Cup." Zensational was the race's first three-year-old winner since Debonaire Junior in 1984. Munnings capped off a big day for his sophomore sire with a second straight Grade II victory. The handsome chestnut, tabbed a **TDN Rising Star** after a first-out victory at Saratoga last July, ran third in the GI Hopeful S. and was second in the GI Champagne S. before closing out the year with a 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. In his return to the races, Munnings completed the exacta under Warrior's Reward (Medaglia d'Oro) in a hot Churchill allowance May 1, then had a break-out performance in a dazzling win in the GII Woody Stephens S. on the Belmont S. undercard June 6. Trainer Todd Pletcher opted to try older horses in this spot, and saw the job get markedly easier when Fabulous Strike was scratched. Under John Velazquez, Munnings stalked in the early going behind dueling leaders, got a dream run up the rail when Riley Tucker came a bit wide into the lane, and powered away to a four-length success.

Pletcher admitted afterwards, "I was a little bit uneasy running against older horses this early in the year, but I just felt like it was the right race for him. The one thing I felt was that sometimes, when you win races like this, it carries a lot of weight toward the end of the year for championship honors and those sorts of things, so I just thought, worst cast scenario, we were going to run against Fabulous Strike and see where we were. Right now, the plan is the King's Bishop [GI, Saratoga, Aug. 29], and we'll most likely stick to that plan, but I don't know that he needs seven weeks or whatever it is. "The Vanderbilt going three-quarters is a much better distance for him," the conditioner remarked, adding, "Some extra time will be good for him."

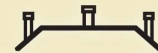

She doubled up with a conditions victory back there last time June 4 and showed a willing attitude in this pattern-race bow to garner a career high in a bobbing finish. Ridden with patience in a midfield sixth through the early fractions, Wilside made smooth headway rounding the home turn to enter the stretch run in third. Given the hurry-up with 450 meters remaining, she was ridden along to challenge approaching the final eighth and kept on in determined fashion under forceful urging to prevail in a three-way go. Musket Man won the GIII Tampa Bay Derby and GII Illinois Derby before running third in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S.

**U.S. WAGERING FIGURES DECLINE** Wagering on U.S. racing declined by double digits in both month and year comparison figures released yesterday by Equibase. For the month of June, handle on U.S. races, including worldwide commingled wagering on U.S. races, dropped 16.89 percent from June 2008--from \$1,195,562,620 to \$993,578,873. In year-to-date comparisons, wagering fell 10.48 percent--from \$7,265,400,239 to \$6,503,994,769. U.S. purses in June totaled \$101,126,923, down 10.30 percent from last June, while total race days for the month fell 5.63 percent to 620 days. Purses for the year to date fell 6.04 percent to \$507,165,548 and total race days decreased 2.05 percent to 2,814.

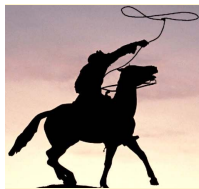

**AGE LIMIT FOR MARES AT AUCTION** The Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers (SITA), at a meeting during Royal Ascot, unanimously agreed to adopt a policy that will exclude broodmares aged 18 or older from being offered for sale by major international auction companies. In addition, new guidelines will discourage the sale of mares that have been barren for three straight seasons, although mares selling as part of dispersals may be exempt. The policy mirrors the one already in place at the Keeneland sales. "For as long as I have been here, Keeneland has had a policy of not selling mares who are 18 years and older who are not in foal, or mares that haven't been in foal for three years," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell said. "This came up at the last SITA meeting and, in the interest of making things more uniform, all the sales companies agreed to it." Henry Beeby, the chief executive for Goffs and Doncaster Bloodstock Sales, cited the welfare of the older mares as a catalyst for the policy. "SITA representatives were persuaded by the arguments that there is a welfare issue in selling aged mares and, to a lesser degree, those that have failed to get in foal, and the guidelines have been introduced with immediate effect," Beeby told *Racing Post*. "There's little potential benefit from seeing older mares being sold for buttons, and going through a pretty stressful experience in the process. It's up to the auction houses always to adopt a responsible attitude to welfare issues, and this is one way we can demonstrate we are doing so."



## RACING ROUND-UP

### *No Decision on Stars...*

Mick Kinane paid further tribute to **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) yesterday, but gave no indication as to where the G1 2000 Guineas, G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Eclipse S. winner would be seen next. Capping the unique treble in Saturday's 10-furlong Sandown contest, Christopher Tsui's homebred could stay at that trip or return to the 12-furlong distance over which he won at Epsom. "He's the first horse I've ridden capable of winning a Guineas, a Group 1 at 10 furlongs, and the Derby, so he's a unique horse," Kinane said. "John [Oxx] and I will sit down this week and speak to the owner about where we go."

### *Conduit King George-Bound...*

Ballymacoll Stud's **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) is set to the head to Ascot for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. July 12, connections confirmed yesterday. Third behind Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown, the four-year-old will return to the 12-furlong trip over which he was successful in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf. "We were delighted with his run, and we have always said he is a horse who would be at his best later in the season," the Stud's Peter Reynolds told *PA Sport*. "He has beaten most of the horses well and was just beaten by two very good horses on the day. The King George is the plan at the moment, and a mile and a half is probably our optimum distance. We'll take anything on over that trip and we're looking forward now."

### *Warrior's Reward None the Worse for Wear...*

**Warrior's Reward** (Medaglia d'Oro), third in Saturday's GII Dwyer S. after stumbling badly at the start, exited the race in good order, trainer Ian Wilkes reported. "He came out of the race with a few little cuts, but otherwise looked fine," Wilkes said. He added, "Obviously, the race did not develop the way we hoped. To rally from that far back to get third, I was really proud of him. We are going to go on to the Jim Dandy [GII, Saratoga, Aug. 1] as long as he is OK." The colt is scheduled to ship from New York to Kentucky Tuesday before heading to the Spa later this month.

# op/ed feedback

### DAVID P. BANKS

My name is David Banks. I have been a breeder, owner and licensed trainer for Thoroughbred race horses in the state of Kentucky for over 25 years. I own a farm in Fayette County and am heavily invested in the Kentucky Thoroughbred breeding and racing venues. This vanishing industry is the reason for my response to Mr. [Arthur] Hancock's remarks ([Alternative to Slots, TDN, 7/2/09](#)). I have been a friend and "sometimes" trainer for Mr. Hancock since my arrival in Kentucky. I have great respect for Mr. Hancock as a friend, as a horseman and for having the courage of his convictions, but I respectfully disagree on several points.

I agree with Mr. Hancock that VLT's at the race tracks are not the solution for the decline of racing, but I do believe they or the lack thereof are the reason for that decline in Kentucky. As a trainer, I have been accessing race tracks with slot-fueled purse structures for 10 years while fighting for Kentucky to keep up. Thoroughbred industry issues such as overpopulation of the breed, race day medication and consequences of overages, etc., are non-slot-related issues, but issues that do need addressing.

Racing's overall health is gauged by handle--betting on the racing product. Handle is directly linked to field size. Field size is linked to purse. Large purses attract large fields, which initiate a large handle. Presently, large purses and full fields are in the slot-fueled states. In the big picture, the industry needs to develop a way to attract gambling on the racing product.

Whether by lowering the takeout, marketing integrity, and/or what else, that is for more creative minds than mine. But we are talking short term--here and now--because it has come down to "do or die." Neither KEEP nor racetracks need to convince me. I am experiencing the loss personally. Our Thoroughbred product has been lost to surrounding slot-fueled states. The Kentucky Thoroughbred industry is in a vicious downward spiral. Horses are gone. Jobs are lost. Families are separated (mine). Goods and services no longer needed. Tax base reduced.

Senator David Williams's aid package to boost breeding and racing in Kentucky is not a viable solution. Funding his aid package by a 10-percent surcharge on lottery tickets does not attract more play, I suspect, and to increase the takeout/tax on simulcast betting is to commit wagering suicide. Bettors will look for a more rewarding betting venue. To minimize the betting dollar is to throttle down the betting engine that drives the purse structure.

Morality cannot be legislated. Those who like to gamble will gamble--on slots, on race horses, on lottery tickets, on Bingo. As I write this, Kentuckians with Kentucky money are gambling in Indiana fueling the Indiana Thoroughbred breeding and racing program and boosting Indiana revenue. Why allow that money with its revenue to be eliminated from Kentucky's general fund? In the future picture, I cannot say if slots will open the door for casinos, but in the here and now, I can say don't underestimate what we--the Thoroughbred industry in Kentucky--are presently experiencing, and the importance of the horse industry's sector of the economy to Kentucky through taxes, tourism, consumerism, even "green space." The trickle down effect, either positive or negative, is real.

**DIRECTORS CANDIDATES**

*Why do you want the opportunity to serve on the 13-member Breeders' Cup Board of Directors?*

**JOHN G. SIKURA**

The Breeders' Cup remains the shining event in our sport. I feel the on-site experience can be improved with more interaction amongst horsemen, fans and media. It should be a requirement of participants to be accessible on a designated media day. Our telecast should follow the same theme, with an interactive approach that allows fans to observe pre-race strategy. Food, service and amenities should be world-class, with ticket prices allowing for full participation. Venues such as Keeneland would serve those goals, and create an experience that does not exist in larger markets. We must blend the goals of maximizing event revenues and holding the event in an environment where racing is celebrated.



It is imperative that the Breeders' Cup continues to seek the participation of Latin American, Japanese and Australasian horses to attract global handle, and advance the Breeders' Cup as a world brand.

All nominators to the Breeders' Cup have a stake in its success. It is vitally important to be immediate and candid to members with any radical change, such as the proposed cancellation of the Breeders' Cup stakes supplement. This consideration must also be applied to the electorate process to give nominators confidence that those standing for election are involved, committed and without an agenda other than the advancement of our sport.

Finally, I think a poll of a majority of contributors would indicate that nominators expect monies to go to purses. The severe market correction of this year showed the hazard of diluting our focus on racing. While a reserve may be necessary, I think harm was done by exposing nominator monies to investments other than racing. My core belief is that funding the Championship day is preeminent.

A lifetime horseman, I am committed to doing my part. If elected, I will give of myself. If not, I will continue to serve, as I can and speak strongly about issues I feel need to be addressed.

**Pincay Award to Merlin Volzke:**

Becoming the first jockey to be so honored, 83-year-old retired jockey Merlin Volzke has been named the 2009 recipient of the Laffit Pincay Jr. Award. The Pincay Award, established in 2004, is given annually to someone who has "served the sport with integrity, extraordinary dedication, determination and distinction." Volzke, 83, hung up his helmet in 1979, then served 26 years as a steward at Bay Meadows and Los Alamitos before retiring in 2005. "Merlin was a well-liked guy," Pincay said. "He was a good rider--he didn't have the opportunities some other riders have. He could ride a horse very well. The best thing I liked about him was his demeanor. He was very quiet, a very nice guy to be around." The Hall of Famer added, "I think it's very special he is the first jockey to get the award. I never saw him get upset, no matter what happened in a race. I think that would have served him well as a steward. He was very respected." The leading rider at Longacres in 1948, Volzke was voted the George Woolf Memorial Jockey Award by his fellow reinsmen in 1958. His most prestigious win came aboard Hanalei Bay in the 1970 Hollywood Derby. He also guided Native Diver to his first-ever black-type score in the 1961 El Camino H.
