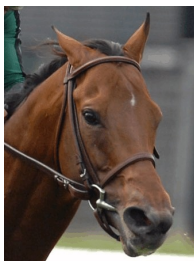

“He was so relaxed when he came by the stands the first time, and that’s something we’ve really been working on,” Ellis said afterwards. “All the races that he’s run have been a build-up to this. It’s pretty satisfying when a plan works out. He was my Derby horse as a

two-year-old. I pushed him as far as I could, but finally he ended up with a chip in his ankle and we took it out. Once he missed the Derby, we gave him plenty of time because we thought he would make a good older horse.” Rail Trip’s final time of 2:00.75 established a new track record on the Cushion Track. **Cont. p3**

G1 Darley Irish Oaks

BEAUTY CONTEST

While connections of **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) and **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) ponder the rematch of the G1 Epsom Oaks first and second, it could be that one has crept up on their blind side in today’s G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh. Twice raced and unbeaten, Neil Jones’ **Beauty O’ Gwaun (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest) was not put forward for the English Classic following her defeat of her elders in the G3 Blue Wind S. at Naas May 13, but she is ready to tackle that duo in her own back yard here. Trainer John Oxx, whose already substantial reputation has been sent skyward by Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) this season, told *PA Sport*, “We are probably going to get quite a lot of rain and that would do her chances no harm at all, as she goes in the soft. She doesn’t show much at home, but when we put the blinkers on her she certainly smartened up, and if there is ever a time to use them, it is in a Classic. The first two from Epsom look well ahead though, and the race probably lacks a little strength in depth, but you never now.” **Oaks Cont. 2**

On the Crest of a Wave...

One of the weighing room's quiet men, Tom Queally, has been in the headlines recently, courtesy of his G1 Golden Jubilee S. and G1 July Cup successes, and he renews his partnership with Khalid Abdullah's Mid-day. She took the May 9 Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial by six lengths before her eclipse by Sariska in the June 5 Classic. Having met interference after the bend there, the homebred could have something more to give this time. "We are hopeful, as we only went down by the narrowest of margins and maybe didn't get the ideal run through," Queally said. "We'll have another crack at her." Sariska's Epsom form took a knock last Saturday when show horse High Heeled (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) could only dead heat for third in the G3 Lancashire Oaks, but the fact **Oh Goodness Me (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) could only finish seventh suggests the race will hold up. June Judd's G3 Park Express S. scorer had previously finished third in the May 24 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and Jim Bolger will be another domestic trainer hoping that home advantage can swing matters his way. It is unusual that Aidan O'Brien saddles outsiders in an Irish Classic, but Susan Magnier's **Roman Empress (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) faces an uphill task attempting to prolong Coolmore's relentless run of success in these events. She was sixth in the G1 Pretty Polly S. at this venue last time June 27, which was a fair effort coming just eight days after her maiden win at Limerick. Gita Weld's **Grace O'Malley (Ire)** (Refuse to Bend {Ire}) is another looking to defy being pitched in the deep end and showed battling qualities when taking the G3 Noblesse S. at Cork last time June 14.

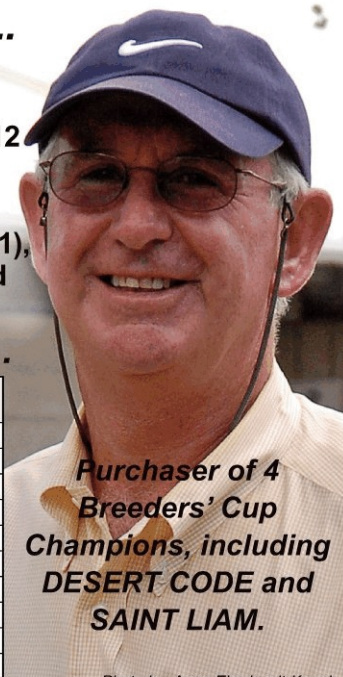

Rail Trip was tabbed a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ when he took his debut at Hollywood last November. He won his next three easily, all in allowance company, then was all out to win the Santana Mile H. at Santa Anita Apr. 4. Rail Trip was second in his last two, the 1 1/16-mile GII Mervyn Leroy H. at Hollywood May 9 and 1 1/18-mile GII Californian H. June 13, and some wondered if the gelding had distance limitations. Putting that idea to rest at generous 9-1 odds, he allowed Tres Borrachos a long leash through splits of :47 4/5 and 1:11 4/5. He came and got that foe in upper stretch and bounded away. As for what's next, Ron Ellis commented, "I don't know. He's had a long grind to get to this point. I think obviously now the Breeders' Cup [Classic] would be our main goal. We wanted to see if the Classic--or the [BC Dirt] Mile--was our goal." Gio Ponti solidified his status as the best turf horse in the country with a third straight Grade I victory. The bay, winner of the GII Virginia Derby last term, broke through at the highest level in the GI Frank E. Kilroe H. at Hollywood Mar. 7. Given a 7-2 chance in the GI Manhattan H., he successfully handled the 10 furlongs over Belmont's sod and won by 1 1/2 lengths June 6. In search of the hat trick, he raced well wide into the first turn while a few lengths off as Musketier prompted a slow pace. Still wide up the backstretch and into the turn, Gio Ponti began to inch closer three furlongs out, struck the front at the furlong grounds and was full of run late. Trainer Christophe Clement said the next start for Gio Ponti would likely be the GI Arlington Million at Arlington Aug. 8. Taking advantage of the absence of champion Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie), Game Face offered up a career effort to annex her first Grade I victory. The always game Zabeel colorbearer was never worse than third in her first 11 career efforts, a stretch that included four graded wins capped by a tally in the Mar. 15 GII Inside Information S. at Gulfstream. She was favored against Informed Decision (Monarchos) in the GI Humana Distaff at Churchill May 2, but could do better than sixth that day, then came back with a dismal fifth in the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont May 24. Turning it around here, she settled into the slipstream of the first flank, powered up to challenge at the quarter pole and needed only a modest hand ride to get the job done. "In the Vagrancy, I think she just ran back a little too close, and she didn't seem to like that track all that much," said Omar Trevino, racing manager for Zabeel. Eaton's Gift, winner of the 6 1/2-furlong GII Swale S. at Gulfstream in the winter of 2008, added Churchill's six-furlong Matt Winn S. later that May. Given some time off, the bay was well-beaten seventh in the GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga July 28 before closing out his sophomore campaign with a fourth in the seven-furlong GIII Perryville S. over Keeneland's Polytrack Oct. 11. In his 2009 reappearance, the four-year-old crossed the wire third while trying the turf for the first time in a \$100,000 optional claiming sprint test at Churchill June 28. Given little regard at 14-1 in his return to the dirt, Eaton's Gift was content to track Ikigai (Whywhywhy) through opening splits of :21.86 and :45.04, rallied to catch the front runner at the top of the stretch and drew clear to score by 1 1/2 lengths over the rallying Benny the Bull. "He's always been a nice horse, but I didn't really know going in if he was good enough to beat Benny the Bull if he ran his race," said winning trainer Dale Romans. "I did think [yesterday] was the best chance if you were going to beat [Benny the Bull] after [that horse] had a hard race when he came back [off a layoff] in the [GII] True North [H. June 6]." Explaining his colt's extended time off over the winter, Romans added, "[Eaton's Gift] had minor surgery to remove a little chip in his knee after his last race last year. I've had success bringing horses back from a layoff in a turf sprint before and, obviously, it worked good for him." Benny the Bull, winner of this event last year, was near the back of the pack in the early stages and couldn't get to the winner in time to record the repeat. "My horse ran his race, I can't fault him at all," explained Edgar Prado. "The track is favoring speed today, so that hurt us a little, but he tried hard all the way. colt was a close runner-up to Kinsella (Mr. Greeley) in Hallandale Mar. 14. He showed sharp acceleration to graduate by a head in a seven-furlong test over the Keeneland Poly Apr. 17 and cut it even closer in his latest, getting his nose down on the wire to clear his

entry-level allowance condition at Churchill May 29. Allowed to race in sixth, just ahead of odds-on Giant Oak (Giant's Causeway), while saving ground down the backside, Reb was full of run, but void of running room and was shuffled to seventh as No Inflation showed the way into the lane. Angled off the fence, he was forced to alter course entering the final furlong, but flew home once clear to score....narrowly, of course. Giant Oak, looking to build on his victory in the May 23 Arlington Classic, lacked the same finishing kick he displayed that day and finished out of the money. Oil Man (Ire) (Pyrus) crossed the line third, but was disqualified to fifth for interference in the stretch. “He’s a good horse who we’ve always held in high regard, but he’s had a lot of injuries,” said winning rider Richard Hills. “It has taken us a little time this year just to get him back to where we wanted him to be. He was slowly away [here], but latched on after a furlong. He gets a mile well, so I wanted to make sure I got started early in the straight just to take the speed out of some of the others, and he had enough in reserve.” Trainer William Haggas elaborated on Aqlaam’s injury woes and also hinted at future plans, “This horse fractured a pelvis when winning the Jersey S. last year and has taken a long time to come back,” Haggas told *PA Sport*. “It’s one of the hardest things in racing to have a talented horse like him and not being able to find the key to him. He was working very free early in the spring and ran like that in the Lockinge, but he really pleased me in the Queen Anne--and I don’t think I’ve ever been so thrilled to be third. Hopefully, he will improve again and I really hope he can go forward from here. Sheikh Hamdan has Ghanaati [Giant’s Causeway] going for the G1 Sussex S., so I may take him to France for the [G1] Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 16]. CHAMPION LAWYER RON EUTHANIZED

Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr--Donation, by Lord Avie), who set a Saratoga track record in winning the GI Whitney H. and was named champion older horse of 2007, was euthanized late Friday evening due to complications from recent colic surgery. The six-year-old was standing his second year at stud at Stonewall Farm. "Not only was he a superior racehorse, but his physical presence and contagious personality captivated everyone that saw him," said Clark Shepherd, manager of Stonewall Farm Stallions. "His first foals are tremendous. When breeders call in to report their Lawyer Ron foals being born, they all have a story to tell. This is obviously a huge loss for us, as well as for the racing and breeding community." Bred by the late James T. Hines Jr., Lawyer Ron was a stakes winner in his final start at two for trainer Bob Holthus, then burst on to the Triple Crown trail with a win in the GIII Risen Star S. prior to sweeping the Southwest S., the GIII Rebel S. and the GII Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Park. Prior to his unplaced effort in the GI Kentucky Derby, an 80-percent interest in Lawyer Ron was acquired by Stonewall Farm, who turned the colt over to trainer Todd Pletcher following a runner-up effort in the GII Super Derby in September 2006. Four-for-eight during his championship season, the chestnut posted Beyer Speed Figures in excess of 111 on four separate occasions, and set a Saratoga track record in taking the Whitney in 1:46 3/5. He added an 8 1/4-length score in the GI Woodward S. and was beaten a neck by subsequent Horse of the Year Curlin (Smart Strike) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. He retired to Stonewall with 12 wins and eight minor placings from 26 career starts and earned \$2,790,008.

TAKEOVER TARGET RETIRED Joe and Ben Janiak's globetrotter **Takeover Target (Aus)** (Celtic Swing {GB}--Shady Stream {Aus}, by Archregent) has been retired after fracturing a cannon bone in Friday's G1 July Cup at Newmarket, it was announced yesterday. "Thankfully, it's all [relatively] good news," trainer Joe Janiak told *Racing Post*. "Takeover Target cracked a cannon bone, but he's had five screws inserted and will be box rested at [Newmarket's veterinary] hospital for a couple of months. He seems fine after the operation and he needs to rest. He has been a fantastic horse and we have had some great adventures with him." The nine-year-old gelding, who bagged seven top-level victories, retires with a career record of 41-21-6-4 and earnings of £2,590,934.

PACO BOY OPTIONS OPEN The Calvera Partnership's G1 Queen Anne S. hero **Paco Boy (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) is set to step up in trip after finishing a commendable fourth in Friday's six-furlong G1 July Cup at Newmarket, according to trainer Richard Hannon. "We will look at the [one-mile G1] Sussex S. at Goodwood July 29, but if we don't fancy that we'll run in the [G1] Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 9. The 6 1/2 furlongs [of the latter race] on ground likely to be on the soft side would be perfect."

SITA TO CLARIFY MARE POLICY Following some confusion between various members over the wording of a new policy established at their June meeting, the Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers (SITA) will discuss the subject of older broodmares at their next meeting. The new policy stated that SITA members would not to offer broodmares aged 18 or over, but no mention was made as to the pregnancy status of such mares. Keeneland's Geoffrey Russell noted that the auction house's policy was not to offer mares aged 18 or more if they were not in foal, or mares that had been barren for three consecutive years. "It is very hard, if not impossible, to get every SITA member to attend our meetings given that our members are from every corner of the globe," said Henry Beeby, the group's chairman. "Since the minutes of the meeting were circulated, it appears there is some confusion on this subject which will need to be debated at a future meeting. However, SITA members already have strong guidelines in place on this subject as evidenced by the likes of Keeneland's existing policy. I apologize for any confusion that has arisen and, as the current chairman of SITA, take responsibility, but I am content that SITA members continue to work to the highest possible standards in all areas--it is simply a case of reaching some degree of uniformity on this specific subject going forward."

Munnings to Haskell?...

Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Munnings** (Speightstown), who has registered back-to-back impressive Grade II wins at seven furlongs, could stretch back out in distance for the G1 Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park Aug. 2, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The chestnut colt, a \$1.7-million purchase out of the 2008 Fasig-Tipton February sale, took the Woody Stephens S. by 5 1/4 lengths June 6 and defeated older rivals in the Tom Fool H. July 5, but trainer Todd Pletcher believes the time is right to try a distance of ground. "It's just going to depend on how he trains here the next couple of weeks, but at this point I'd say we're certainly under strong consideration for that race," Pletcher told the publication. "The horse is in such good form right now it might be worth taking a shot." The only other time Munnings has tried two turns was in last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, where he was 10th, but beaten less than five lengths behind Midshipman (Unbridled's Song). Pletcher had originally penciled in the G1 NetJets King's Bishop S. as the next start for Munnings. In the last dozen years, Hard Spun (Danzig), More Than Ready (Southern Halo), Forestry (Storm Cat) and Tale of the Cat, all won the King's Bishop after racing in the Haskell.

Long Lashes to Godolphin...

Godolphin, whose recent purchases include Delegator (GB) (Dansili {GB}), Evasive (GB) (Elusive Quality) and Jealous Again (Trippi), has added another high-profile horse with the acquisition of the Jessica Harrington-trained **Long Lashes** (Rock Hard Ten), according to www.godolphin.com. The juvenile filly earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status with an impressive debut victory in the Listed Ballygallon Stud S. at The Curragh June 26, her only start to date. "There are no immediate plans for the two-year-old Rock Hard Ten filly but, in the long term, she will be aimed at the UAE Guineas and UAE Oaks at Meydan in 2010," an official statement said.

Ankle Injury Means Red Light for Light Green...

Edward Evans's **Light Green** (Pleasantly Perfect), a good second to stablemate Cat Moves (Tale of the Cat) in the G1 Prioress S. at Belmont July 4, has suffered an ankle injury and will likely be shelved for at least the remainder of the summer, *Daily Racing Form* reports. "She'll likely get 60 days off," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "If things go well, we'll probably bring her back for the fall of the year and get started at Gulfstream."

BLACK TIE AFFAIR PENSIONED **Black Tie Affair (Ire)** (Miswaki--Hat Tab Girl, by Al Hattab), sire of GISW Evening Attire and damsire of this year's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danhill Dancer {Ire}), has been pensioned from stud duty due to declining fertility, according to published reports. The 23-year-old had been standing at O'Sullivan Farms in Charles Town, West Virginia. Retired to stud after winning the 1991 GI Breeders' Cup Classic en route to that year's Horse of the Year honors, the gray was represented by 410 winners from 683 runners who combined to earn over \$56 million. Black Tie Affair, also sire of Brazilian champion My Tie (Brz), had previously stood at Vinery Stud in Kentucky and East Stud in Japan.

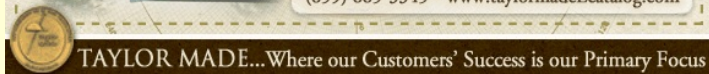
