No King George for Youmzain...

Jaber Abdullah's **Youmzain (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) will miss next Saturday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot after suffering a setback. Third in the 12-furlong feature 12 months ago, the six-year-old was found to have a swollen near-fore joint yesterday morning. "The horse isn't lame, but there's swelling round the joint, and we can't take any chances," trainer Mick Channon explained. "X-rays taken on the leg showed nothing for us to get worried about, and he'll hopefully be back later in the year."

Midday Nassau-Bound...

Khalid Abdullah's **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) is set to drop in trip for Goodwood's G1 Nassau S., connections announced yesterday. Runner-up in the June 5 G1 Epsom Oaks and third in the Irish equivalent on Sunday, the homebred will cut back a quarter-mile to contest the Aug. 1 feature. "She has come out of her run at the Curragh in good order, and I think it was just a question of the ground being too heavy for her there," the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said. "We are looking at the Nassau S." Cont. p2

What's the Aim?

Connections of Friday's G1 July Cup runner-up **Main Aim (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) are pondering several options for the four-year-old. Khalid Abdullah's bay was troubled when beaten 1 1/4 lengths by Fleeting Spirit (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the six-furlong Newmarket contest, and the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said yesterday, "I have to talk to Sir Michael [Stoute] about where we are going with Main Aim. The initial reaction after the July Cup was to go to Deauville with him for the [Aug. 9] G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest over an extended six furlongs, but we will give him an entry in the G2 Betfair Cup [at Goodwood July 28], and he also holds an entry in the G1 Sussex S. [at Goodwood July 29] as well. He added, "I think that he will go the sprinting route at this stage. I definitely think that we can win a Group 1 race with Main Aim. Whether he would have won or not is a different question, but, strictly on that form, he's going to be a pretty interesting sprinter."

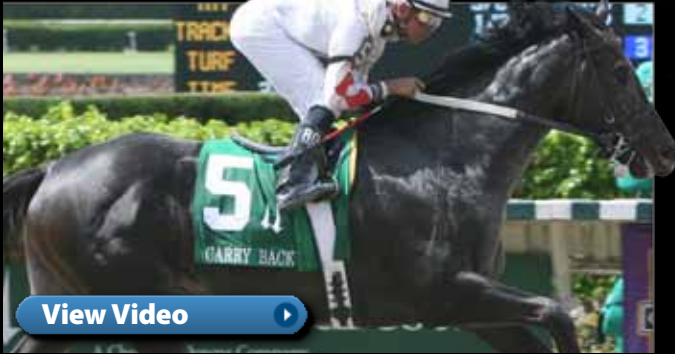

ASMUSSEN GETS SIX-MONTH BAN The Board of Stewards at Lone Star Park handed down a six-month suspension to trainer Steve Asmussen and levied a fine of \$1,500 after one of his horses tested positive for a lidocaine metabolite in 2008, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The state of Texas has a zero-tolerance policy on the Class 2 medication violation. The suspension, which can be appealed, is set to begin July 20 and run through Jan. 15, 2010. The ruling came down nearly a year to the date of the first scheduled hearing in the matter, but delay after delay saw the case finally come to a head following an eight-hour meeting July 7. Asmussen and his legal team requested and were ultimately granted a continuance on the first hearing date in order to obtain a blood sample and an additional split sample test prior to meeting with the stewards. Last week, Asmussen's attorneys Maggi Moss and Karen Murphy requested data on the original and split-test sample, additional split sample test data and testing of the blood sample from the horse in question. Stewards deliberated and considered the evidence presented by the Asmussen team and counsel for the Texas Racing Commission and ultimately denied that request, stating that there is no acceptable level of lidocaine in Texas. Asmussen vigorously defended himself in the *Form*, stating, "I know that I didn't do this. And I strongly believe that you know how important it is to avoid having something like this happen because you do not want to be in this sort of trouble over a three-year-old maiden when you have access to the Curlins and Rachel Alexandras of the world, which I have. And this sort of trouble jeopardizes that."

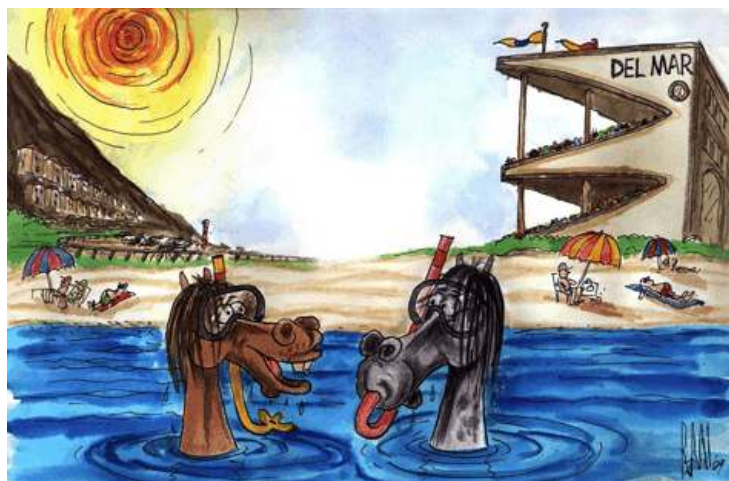

BREEDERS' CUP, TVG ENTER MULTI-YEAR AGREEMENT The Breeders' Cup and TVG Network have announced a three-year agreement that will make TVG an official media partner of the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships. Under the agreement, TVG remains the exclusive marketing partner in the Advance Deposit Wagering (ADW) category and becomes title sponsor of the \$2-million GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Also included in the deal, TVG will produce the Breeders' Cup simulcast show. The network will provide enhanced on-site coverage of the GII Del Mar Mile (Aug. 29); GI Woodbine Mile (Sept. 20); GI Oak Tree Mile (Oct. 10); GI Shadwell Turf Mile (Oct. 10), as well as live coverage of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 26. "TVG has been an outstanding partner of the Breeders' Cup for the past 10 years and a leader in televised racing and account wagering," said Breeders' Cup President and CEO Greg Avioli. "As we indicated in announcing our strategic review last week, long-term alliances like our relationship with TVG, are a key component of our plan moving forward. TVG will continue to help us grow the Breeders' Cup in the U.S. and overseas in the coming years." TVG sponsored the Breeders' Cup Sprint from 2005 through 2007 and sponsored the Dirt Mile last year. "The Breeders' Cup is one of the most, if not the most, prestigious international racing events in the world, which makes our continued support of this tremendous event and organization exceptionally rewarding," said Gerard Cunningham, president of Betfair US, TVG's holding company. "TVG is focused on promoting racing and horse ownership, so our multi-year sponsorship of the Breeders' Cup Mile aligns with our goal to further the sport in America."

Fifth through a brisk opening half of :45.31, the dark bay was angled to the outside with two furlongs left. The gelding quickly blew by his beleaguered rivals, then held safely from the late charges of Scientist and Pegasus Tommy D to post the \$42.00 upset. 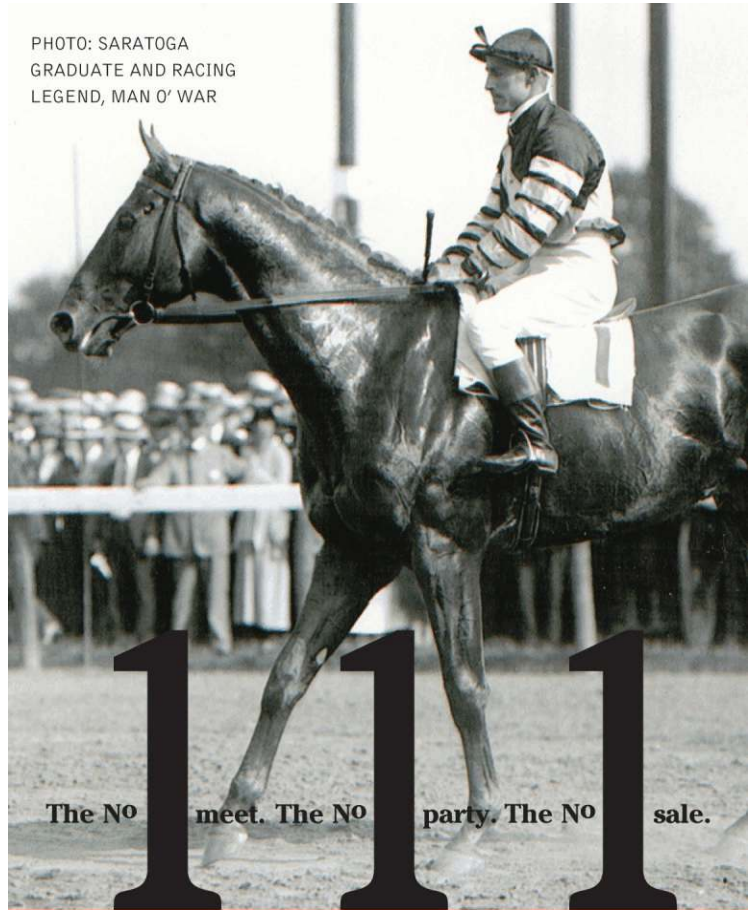

The desert wasn't kind to the gelding, however, as he was seventh in February's G3 Zabeel Mile and 13th in March's G2 Jebel Hatta. Back in the U.S. Belmont's Fort Marcy S. May 2, the bay set the pace before he settled for a tail-lashing second behind Cosmonaut (Lemon Drop Kid). The Godolphin colorbearer tried the Belmont turf once again in the June 14 GIII Poker S., but he completed the exacta once again as he could not track down the now-deceased Sailor's Cap (Distant View). Placed on the lead here, Tam Lin set moderate fractions of :24.75, :48.02 and 1:11.09 before he was put to a drive in the stretch. Pick Six bridged the gap narrowly in the stretch, but he never offered a serious threat, while the winner's stablemate Colony closed strongly to nab third. BROTHER KEITH (g, 3, **Johar--Hawa Mahal, by Hennessy**) went unplaced in three graded events at Santa Anita this winter--the GIII San Rafael S., the GII Robert B. Lewis S. and the GIII Baldwin S.--and was third against NW2L competition at Keeneland Apr. 3. Stretched out at Churchill Downs May 2 in the slop, the gelding broke in the air and was defeated 29 lengths as he reported home fourth of nine starters. He tried 6 1/2 panels in the mud at Belmont June 20 last time and ran an even third. Brother Keith, off at 9-2 here, patiently waited between horses behind a three-horse duel. Vigorously urged down the lane, he got the upper hand with a sixteenth left en route to a 1 1/2-length triumph over longshot Mike From Queens (Flatter). WILLIAM'S KITTEN (Kitten's Joy)

Claim to Fame, Ramseys Hope...

If freshman sire Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) fails to make it as a sire, it won't be for want of effort on behalf of his owners, Ken and Sarah Ramsey. The Ramseys, who bred and campaigned Kitten's Joy to a pair of Grade I victories and a turf championship in 2004, have heavily supported the young stallion during his initial years at stud. To find an example, one need only to look at the two Kitten's Joy runners who competed yesterday.

In the second at Belmont, a five-furlong maiden special weight, the Ramsey homebred King Kitten ran very well in his debut to be second to Not Macho Any More (Macho Uno), beaten 2 1/2 lengths while nearly nine lengths clear of the show horse. A half-hour later, the Ramsey homebred William's Kitten, making his turf and route debut in his second career start in the fifth at Ellis Park, fought hard to get up and win by 3/4 of a length, becoming Kitten's Joy's third winner.

In addition to being Ramsey homebreds, the two colts have something else in common--they were produced by mares that the Ramseys claimed as broodmare prospects. Blush (Menifee), dam of William's Kitten, was a \$30,000 claim; Santo Mio (Southern Halo), dam of King Kitten, was a \$50,000 claim. In fact, all three of Kitten's Joy's winners--William's Kitten, maiden special weight winner Maddie's Odyssey, and the filly Two Joys--were bred by the Ramseys and produced by mares acquired by way of the claim box.

"I'm going say, on average, I've claimed 50 to 60 horses a year in each of the last four or five years to breed to him," said Ken Ramsey. Yes, you read that correctly. Fifty to 60 a year, over numerous years.

"I subscribe to the *Daily Racing Form*, and every day, the first thing I do when it comes is to look through all the tracks I race at, and see if there are any broodmare claims in there," Ramsey commented. "I've got 190 broodmares right now." **Cont. p7**



Ramsey first began claiming mares for his Storm Cat stallion Catienus, who, fittingly, was a \$60,000 claim himself from Sheikh Mohammed before going on to become a stakes winner and, at stud, a successful young sire. But when Kitten's Joy was retired to his Ramsey Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky for the 2006 breeding season, Ramsey knew he was going to have to step it up.

"There is a bias against long-distance turf horses in this business--the quick money is on sprinters on the dirt--and so I knew I was going to have to support him as a stallion," Ramsey explained yesterday. "I am determined to make him as a sire. He has an outstanding pedigree as far as the gene pool goes. The first five sires in the sire line are all champions, and on mother's side, the first three dams are either Grade I winners, or have produced Grade I winners."

Ramsey said he went hunting, for the most part, in mid-level claimers for appropriate mares for Kitten's Joy.

"Most of the mares we claimed for him were at \$25,000 and up," he said. "I claimed a bunch at \$25,000, a bunch at \$35,000 at Saratoga, a number at \$50,000. I would say the mares I bred to him, if we averaged it out, were probably \$35,000 to \$40,000. A lot of them were horses that had nice pedigrees or were nice racehorses, but because their owners weren't breeders, they were dropped in for a tag. A got a few stakes winners for \$50,000 like that. But I also bought a number of mares at the sales. There's an Easy Goer mare bought for \$150,000, and a Danehill mare named Lily Elsie (Ire) I paid \$190,000 for."

By his measure, Ramsey bred roughly 85 of the 104 registered foals from Kitten's Joy's first crop and, after selling a number as yearlings, etc., still retains 27 juvenile homebreds. Ramsey currently has 80 yearling homebreds by Kitten's Joy and, this spring, bred 110 of his own mares to the chestnut. Ramsey anticipates he will sell 40 or 50 of the mares this fall.

"I'm not going to have to show a profit on them," he said. "If I can get back what I paid for the mares themselves, we'll give [the buyers] the stud fee, just to get the Kitten's Joys spread around the country."

Ramsey said he has started a half-dozen Kitten's Joy juveniles so far in 2009, and said his winner at Ellis Park yesterday--going two turns on the grass--was likely indicative of where the offspring of his stallion will excel.

"We think they're going to be really good stretched out on the turf, and stretched out on the Polytrack," said Ramsey. "But some of them, like the one who ran today at Belmont, King Kitten, have shown they can run on dirt. We would have liked to have won it, but we didn't have King Kitten 100 percent and asking for his best today going five furlongs. We'll run him up at Saratoga going 1 1/16 miles on the grass, and you can probably bet a little bit up there and show a profit. But Kitten's Joy is by El Prado, like Medaglia d'Oro is, and I hope he can come up with some dirt horses like Medaglia d'Oro has." -L Marquardt

UPPERLINE (Maria's Mon)

Inside information can be a beautiful thing.

For many years, John Adger was part of a very successful team at Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Stable, serving the operation as its racing and bloodstock manager. Since the acquisition of Stonerside by

Sheikh Mohammed's Darley in September 2008, Adger has stayed on in an advisory capacity, but took advantage of the opportunity earlier this year to purchase a two-year-old filly by Maria's Mon out of Snowflake (Ire) (Caerleon) in a pack-

age deal. The dark bay, now named **Upperline** and owned in partnership by Adger and the Oak Crest Farm of Jack and Theresa Hodge, made an immediate impression with a thoroughly professional debut score Wednesday at Arlington Park (Click for the [brisnet.com chart](http://www.brisnet.com/chart) or [video replay](#)).

"We were pleased the way she ran," Adger said yesterday from Houston. "She'd been training very well over the last few months. Nothing brilliant, just training right along, but it seems when she got to Arlington, she started to really develop and [trainer] Mike [Stidham] was pleased with her. To be frank with you, we really didn't think she'd come to hand this quickly."

That she has. Debuting at the tricky distance of seven furlongs Wednesday, Upperline was off slowly, then tugged Quincy Hamilton right into the race. Briefly short of room on the turn, she was angled off the inside, split rivals decisively in upper stretch and drew clear with authority to take it by 2 3/4 lengths.

"She's very professional in the morning, and the exercise riders said she'll do what she needs to do when they ask her to do it," says Adger. "Hopefully she'll keep moving forward."

Adger admits that the victory was especially satisfying, given his connection with Stonerside.

"Oh, absolutely it was great," Adger said of the win. "I have a great love of Stonerside horses. We had a great team for many years and, as I've said in the past, Darley is going to have great luck with their acquisition of Stonerside."

As for his filly, Adger believes that she earned the right at stakes competition. **Cont. p8**

Stauffer Back Doing Double Duty:

Hollywood track announcer Vic Stauffer, who missed Sunday's live race card at Hollywood Park after suffering what doctors have called a minor stroke, was back at the microphone Wednesday afternoon. Earlier in the day, he was combing the backstretch booking mounts for Joel Rosario, who is poised to land his first riding title in Southern California when Hollywood closes this Sunday. "Eight up, four days to go; I think we're in pretty good shape," said Stauffer. "The mathematics are rather compelling at this point." Stauffer, who was replaced by Los Alamitos track announcer Ed Burgart Sunday afternoon, explained how he was stricken Saturday evening. "My fiancée, Tina, and I were attending a concert--a tribute to Henry Mancini--at the Hollywood Bowl when my arm went numb and my speech was slurred," said Stauffer. "I went to first aid and was taken to St. Joseph's Hospital in Burbank, where they termed it a mini-stroke. I had all kinds of tests--CATSCANS, MRIs, EKGs--and they revealed that they didn't know how it happened," added Stauffer. "But my theory is stress." Stauffer will yield racecalling duties to his colleague Trevor Denman at Del Mar, but that doesn't mean he won't be busy. "I have 80 calls in the first book," he said.

Rosecroft Owner Denied Injunctive Relief:

A United States Bankruptcy Court judge has denied a motion filed by Cloverleaf Enterprises, Inc., the bankrupt owner of Rosecroft Raceway, that would have forced Track Net Media Group and 15 other racetracks to send Thoroughbred simulcast signals to Rosecroft. In April, Cloverleaf had announced that it would not honor the Cross-Breed Simulcasting Agreement that it signed with various segments of the Maryland racing industry in 2006 and refused to pay any monies it owed the Thoroughbred industry in lieu of a better deal. Track Net and several other tracks and organizations agreed to pull its signal from Rosecroft, and on July 6, Cloverleaf filed a \$20 million lawsuit alleging breach of contract and sought injunctive relief. After three days of testimony, Judge Paul Mannes ruled Wednesday against Cloverleaf's claims.
