GOOD ADVICE FOR THE SWAPS

Lexington S. at Keeneland Apr. 18, figures to appreciate the return to a synthetic surface in today's GII Swaps S. at Hollywood Park. A well-beaten 13th in the GI Kentucky Derby, the dark bay most recently placed an honest fourth in the grassy GII Jefferson Cup at Churchill Downs June 13. The

\$170,000 OBSFEB graduate has fired a pair of bullets beneath the Twin Spires since, including a best-of-47 four-furlong move in :47 3/5 July 13. Phipps homebred **Conservative** (Unbridled's Song), a good second behind Advice in the Lexington, makes his California debut for the Shug McGaughey barn. The gray has trained smartly over this course since finishing up the track in fourth in the off-the-turf GIII Hill Prince S. at Belmont June 5. **Misremembered** (Candy Ride {Arg}), bred, trained and co-owned by Bob Baffert, reeled off two straight wins in Inglewood prior to placing second in his black-type debut behind **Grazen** (Benchmark) in the GIII Affirmed H. June 20. "I thought he ran a real nice race last time, but the winner just kept going," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's a little green. He's a big, gangly horse. He hasn't come into himself yet. He needs a mile and an eighth. The farther the better for him." Field p3

CANDY RIDE TO LANE'S END

Candy Ride (Arg) (Ride the Rails--Candy Girl {Arg}, by Candy Stripes), a leading sophomore sire of GSWs Capt. Candyman Can, Chocolate Candy and Evita Argentina, has been relocated from Hill 'n' Dale Farms to Lane's End Farm, according to Hill 'n' Dale President John Sikura. "I was disappointed, we did a great job," Sikura told the *TDN*. "We foaled and raised Evita Argentina, Chocolate Candy, Misremembered and other leading offspring of Candy Ride. At the time that we syndicated Candy Ride, we were the only farm that believed in the horse, and his abilities to become an outstanding sire. I'll deal with this disappointment like I'll deal with all my disappointments and that is by redoubling my efforts to make Hill 'n' Dale one of the world's leading Thoroughbred nurseries." A champion miler in Argentina, Candy Ride was a perfect six-for-six in his career, including the 2003 GI Pacific Classic. He raced in colors of Sid and Jenny Craig. "I have not heard from Mrs. Craig, and calls to their office have gone unreturned," Sikura continued. "I have heard rumors that a complaint that they had was that I did not raise Candy Ride's stud fee for 2009. I specifically told Larry Poster, Mrs. Craig's accountant, that with the crash of the world economy and the aberrant year of 2009, that it would behoove us to show loyalty to our customers and respect for the challenges that this year brought by leaving the stud fee at the 2008 price, with the recognition that his stud fee would surely rise in 2010."

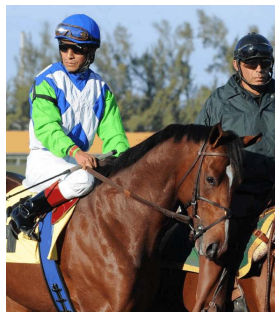

MORNING-LINE FAVORITE OUT OF VA DERBY

The GII Virginia Derby took a hit on Friday with the defection of Lael Stables's **Nicanor** (Dynaformer), the popular full-brother to GI Kentucky Derby hero Barbaro and 7-2 morning-line favorite. "We took him out of his stall to walk him and graze him, and he was very stiff in behind," trainer Michael Matz told *Daily Racing Form*. "I don't know if it's anything serious or long-term. Nothing turned up on X-rays, so we sent him to New Bolton to have a nuclear scintigraphy done on him to see if something can be found." The bay has thrived since switching to grass, graduating at Delaware by 15 1/4 lengths May 13, and adding an allowance last time June 17.

The first four finishers from the June 20 GII Colonial Turf Cup S.--**Battle of Hastings (GB)** (Royal Applause {GB}), **Straight Story** (Giant's Causeway), **Lime Rickey** (Lemon Drop Kid), and **Take the Points** (Even the Score)--line up again here. Battle of Hastings shot through an opening along the rail in the stretch en route to a head victory that day, while the runner-up was floated extremely wide on the turn for home. Lime Rickey rallied from eighth to finish only 1 1/4 lengths behind the victor. **Hold Me Back** (Giant's Causeway), winner of the GII Lane's End S. Mar. 21 and second-place finisher in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 11, switches to grass after finishing 12th in the GI Kentucky Derby.

CAMAS PARK AND ASHTOWN HOUSE STUDS TO SPONSOR PHOENIX S.

Camas Park and Ashtown House Studs have jointly agreed to sponsor the G1 Phoenix S., which will be held next Sunday, July 26 at the Curragh, and which will be known as the Camas Park & Ashtown House Studs Phoenix S. Timmy Hyde of Camas Park Stud commented, "I am delighted to be associated with such a historic and prestigious race which has consistently attracted some of Europe's very best two year olds, including last year's winner Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). Racing has been good to us and now is the time to give something back to the business that supports us, as those behind the yearling bonus scheme are doing." Added Racecourse Manager Paul Hensey, "We are very grateful to Tim Hyde of Camas Park and Paul Shanahan of Ashtown House Studs for agreeing to support what is undoubtedly one of the top races for juveniles in Europe and look forward to the prospect of another great contest this year." Both studs have bred or sold numerous top-class horses that have made their mark on international racing, including Group 1 winners such as Mastercraftsman (Ire), Fame And Glory (GB), Dr Devious (Ire), Frozen Fire (Ger), Indian Skimmer, Red Evie (Ire), Soviet Star, Araafa (Ire), Alexandrova (Ire), Magical Romance (Ire), Authaal, Grandera (Ire), Al Bahathri and Landseer (GB). The Phoenix S. was first run in 1902 and has an illustrious list of previous winners, including recent victors Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) and Mastercraftsman (Ire). This year's edition figures to feature G2 Norfolk S. winner Radiohead (GB) (Johannesburg), whose sire won the Phoenix S. in 2001 and who was sold as a yearling by Hyde. "He worked very well this morning, he is in great shape since his Royal Ascot win and it is all systems go for him to run at the Curragh," said trainer Brian Meehan. Aidan O'Brien expects to be represented by two or three runners including recent G2 NetJets Railway S. winner Alfred Nobel (Ire) (Danheill Dancer {Ire}), while Jim Bolger, successful in the race three times, has entered Kitty Kiernan (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and Gold Bubbles (Street Cry {Ire}). Trainer Tommy Stack is considering running recent G3 Jebel Ali Racecourse Anglesey S. winner Walk on Bye (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). "A decision will not be made until Monday evening on whether we will supplement her into the race, but she is in very good form and has come out of the Curragh race in great shape," said assistant trainer Fozzy Stack. Joanna Morgan will attempt to become the first female trainer to win the race with G2 Coventry S. fourth Moran Gra (Rahy), while recent Navan winner Wealdmore Wave (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}) will hope to give Ger Lyons his first G1 success.

Op/Ed feedback

Contrary to what was written in a recent Op/Ed by Barry Irwin, the Kentucky Equine Education Project was not formed as a political action committee "with the sole purpose of promoting the introduction and proliferation of alternative gaming at Kentucky race tracks." In fact, KEEP was established to unify horse breeds across the state into one umbrella organization, and to educate our state about the importance of the entire horse industry. KEEP works for all horse breeds. Need proof? KEEP has privately raised and donated over \$600,000 to local horse shows, 4-H clubs and equine education programs in the last four years. What other organization has made such a commitment to our local horse economies and contributed more to non-race breeds?

Furthermore, KEEP fought to include pro-equine industry provisions in the bills introduced during this year's regular and special sessions that would have placed video lottery terminals (VLTs) at race tracks. The bill would have founded the Equine Breed Authority to promote non-racing breeds and created economic development opportunities within the equine industry by investing in show facilities, trails and equine health and welfare. Another provision would have provided sales tax relief for various purchases related to breeding, raising, training or transporting equines—a measure that would benefit all breeds. This bill would have been the most pro-horse industry expanded gaming bill to pass in any state. Let us also not forget that KEEP played an instrumental role in passing the Kentucky Breeders' Incentive Fund, which also includes funding for non-race breeds.

The Op/Ed writer further suggests that our overall strategy has not worked, but we must strongly disagree. Our strategy to better Kentucky's equine industry is working. In a recent statewide poll, 69 percent of Kentuckians support VLTs at race tracks. The gaming bill passed out of the House for the first time ever, and we had the votes on the Senate floor had the bill not been held hostage in the Senate Appropriations and Revenue Committee.

All horses in the *TDN* are bred in North America, unless otherwise indicated

We will continue to implement our strategy with the hope that our state legislators will recognize the need to allow us to compete on a level playing field with now 12 states in the region that supplement purses and breeders' incentive funds with expanded gaming revenue—thanks to Ohio Gov. Strickland's recent Executive Order.

The Op/Ed writer finally suggested that KEEP should support all politicians, regardless of whether those politicians support the horse industry. It makes no practical sense to help elect politicians who are going to vote against our industry, so KEEP will continue supporting only those elected officials and candidates who support the entire equine industry in Kentucky. To paraphrase Gov. Beshear, it is up to all of us to either change the minds of a few elected officials, or to change a few elected officials. KEEP is committed to doing just that.

NYRA TO OFFER FIELD SIZE PURSE INCENTIVES AT SPA Larger fields in distance races will mean larger purses at the upcoming Saratoga meet, NYRA announced Friday. Maiden special weight, maiden claiming and claiming races on dirt with more than eight betting interests when the field leaves the paddock will receive a 10-percent increase, while main-track allowance races and overnight stakes will receive a 15-percent boost. For dirt races at nine furlongs and longer, NYRA will also increase the purse for every additional betting interest beyond six. Maiden races that fit the criteria will offer an additional \$4,000/horse above six, allowance races \$6,000/horse above six, and money allowance races and overnight stakes \$8,000/horse above six. The same values apply for turf races longer than nine furlongs, except the bonuses will kick in with every additional interest above eight. If a carded race is taken off the turf and leaves the paddock with eight or more betting interests, NYRA will offer a 20-percent increase to the total purse. A similar incentive program was used last year. "2008 was the first year we opted to incentivize distance races, and we were very pleased with the response from owners and trainers," said P.J. Campo, NYRA vice president and director of racing. "This year, we've decided to take it a step further and provide purse increases for all dirt races with more than eight betting interests. Higher purses attract quality horses and the additional wagering opportunities available in larger fields drive handle."

STARLIGHT GRANTED INJUNCTION IN SAM P. CASE A Bourbon County (Kentucky) judge has ruled in favor of Starlight Stables and has awarded a permanent injunction forbidding the purchaser of former Starlight runner Sam P. From pursuing a return to the races. The son of Cat Thief was retired from racing last November after sustaining a serious and career-ending tendon injury. The colt was offered for breeding purposes only through Taylor Made and was purchased by Triton Farm, an entity controlled by George Hofmeister, former owner of Vinery. In April of this year, officials at Starlight learned that Sam P. Was in fact back in training, at which time it was demanded that the horse be removed from training. When that request was not met, Starlight filed suit. "We are pleased that judge Isaacs supported our original intentions of Sam P continuing his career as a stallion," said Jack Wolf, managing partner of Starlight Stables. "It is of the utmost importance to us that our retired race horses are taken care of properly and their health and best interests are being looked out for." In his written opinion, Bourbon Circuit Judge Paul Isaacs stated that the contract language restricting the horse to use for breeding purposes was clear and unambiguous and that Triton had no right to ignore those provisions. The court permanently prohibited Triton from training or racing the horse.

"Her victory is a testament to the team effort," Blum said Friday evening.

Blum acquired Platinum's dam Nataliano (Fappiano) early in the racing career of her fifth foal, who had sold for \$425,000 as a FTFFEB juvenile. The move quickly paid off when that filly, a daughter of A.P. Indy named A. P. Adventure, won the GI Las Virgenes S. in her third start.

Blum tried breeding Nataliano back to A.P. Indy in 2004, but the mare came up barren. So he did the next best thing and sent her to A.P. Indy's son Mineshaft the following year, and the mating resulted in Platinum.

"If something works, I don't try to go away from it," Blum explained.

Even though Blum tries "to sell the best horses we raise," he opted not to send Platinum through the ring.

"I thought they'd criticize her conformation, even though I never thought it'd affect her racing career," Blum said. "Mineshaft wasn't the most popular sire at the time. I sent her to David Scanlon, and they liked her very much."

An injury early in her training delayed Platinum's career, and she was returned to Dromoland Farm, where she had been raised, for rehabilitation. Once she had recovered, she trained with Jose Fernandez in Kentucky, and he was the trainer of record when she debuted at Churchill Downs May 29.

Surgery for Jockey Glen Murphy:

Jockey Glen Murphy, who injured his left elbow and right hand when tossed from his mount Clever Call at Lone Star Sunday, underwent surgery at Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas Monday. He was released from the hospital on Tuesday. "I'm feeling much, much better," Murphy said. "I had surgery on my left elbow, but was very lucky because the break wasn't in the joint. They put in some plates and screws, 12 small ones I think, and that should heal really well. I also dislocated my first two knuckles and broke the index finger on my right hand. The doctors decided to just clean it out and didn't have to put in any pins, thank goodness. Everything should heal up so that nothing else has to be done." Murphy also had surgery on his right leg. "When I fell on the turf course in 2005, it broke some of the screws that were in my [right] leg from an injury that happened in 2003," Murphy continued. "They had to put in new screws then, and one of those replacement screws was backing out. It's just natural after everything heals. I wanted to get it taken care of this year, but haven't had the time. So they took that screw out too. I feel like I have a brand new leg." Murphy expects his right hand to heal in about four weeks, and said that his elbow will be reevaluated after six weeks.


