A MOMENT TO SAVOR

Sir Michael Stoute's long and distinguished career has seen many highlights, but all were surpassed yesterday as **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) led home a one-two-three for Freemason Lodge in Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. Last year's G1 St Leger and G1 Breeders' Cup Turf hero had shaped when third in the July 4 G1 Coral-Eclipse S. as if a return to a mile

and a half would help him to reach those heights once again. That was apparent as he swooped on **Tartan Bearer (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Despite a late drift across the path of that fellow Ballymacoll-bred, his superiority was clear, and the 13-8 favorite extended the winning margin to 1 3/4 lengths at the line. **Ask (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), just a head behind in third, filled out the stable trifecta. "This ranks very high and is a bit special," Stoute said. "I've always loved this race--it's a wonderful race and is very important in the calendar. It's a big thrill and hasn't quite sunk in yet. They've all run great races and I'm very proud of them."

Conduit was at Epsom on Derby day last year, but it was a 10-furlong handicap that offered a glimpse of his abundant talents, rather than the feature itself. Following his last-to-first rush that produced a six-length score there, the chestnut stepped into more exalted company, and wound up second in the G2 King Edward VII S. at the Royal meeting. He scrambled to a first black-type win in Goodwood's G3 Gordon S. in July, but made major strides to stamp his authority on the St Leger. His progression continued late into the fall, and Ryan Moore, who had opted to go elsewhere for the St Leger, was back on board for his Breeders' Cup victory, as well as his two starts so far this term. Runner-up by a nose to Cima de Triomphe (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) when attempting to give that rival seven pounds in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 28, Conduit was not ready to wage total war on the star sophomores Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Coral-Eclipse back over that course and distance three weeks ago, but he was sitting on ready this time. Held up by Moore early, he stayed on the heels of Tartan Bearer and Mick Kinane, and was perfectly poised as that rival passed Golden Sword (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) at the front with a quarter mile remaining. Rolling by his two stable companions 100 yards later, he was firmly on top at the post, which helped the stewards keep the enquiry into the late interference short. "It was a great thrill to see all three perform to such a high standard, and it doesn't often happen," Sir Michael Stoute continued. "In the spring, when Conduit should have been doing some good conditioning work, he was only walking, and he was getting a slightly better shape coming into this, so we were definitely more pleased with him. Ryan is a good judge and knows the horses well, so I'm pleased he won it, as he has contributed so much to the careers of Tartan Bearer and Ask also. All the world knows that this is not Ask's ideal ground, and when he gets that, he delivers." For Ballymacoll Stud, it was a red-letter day. The Stud's Manager Peter Reynolds told *PA Sport*, "That is our 50th Group 1 winner and Michael's 10th individual and 20th overall Group 1 for Ballymacoll, which isn't bad. Lord Weinstock bought the place in 1960 and we have kept it going, and we need days like today. He was nearly here for the last one when Golan won--he was only dead a week, God bless him. It is great to keep the firm up there. We are competing against some heavy hitters in Sheikh Mohammed and John Magnier's team, and it is nice to have something to take them on with." Ask's owner Patrick Fahey is looking long-term at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 4. Unheralded Global Hunter came after pacesetting **Monterey Jazz (Thunderello)** in upper stretch and had plenty in reserve to hold off the come-from-behinders to win the **Eddie Read**. Winner of the restricted **Lure S.** over the **Santa Anita turf Oct. 12**, the Argentine-bred was runner-up in the off-turf **Gill Thunder Road H.** in **Arcadia Feb. 7** and was fourth, beaten just 1 1/2 lengths, behind divisional heavy **Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat)** in the **GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H.** **Mar. 7**. Five wide into the stretch of the **GII Arcadia H.** at the Los Angeles area oval **Apr. 4**, **Global Hunter** was last seen finishing a non-threatening eighth in the **GI Hollywood Gold Cup** on **Cushion Track July 11**. **Thorn Song** was ridden away from the gate by **Mike Smith** and covered the opening quarter mile in a comfortable :24.02 before disaster struck. Just as they were about to turn out of the stretch, the grey bolted to the outside fence, eliminating him from competition. Just in behind was **Monterey Jazz**, the noted front-runner who was content to lay second, but jumped into the bit and pulled **Tyler Baze** through an internal half-mile in :46.09.

Global Hunter, in the meantime, sat second behind the heavy favorite and began to take closer order approaching the stretch. **Monterey Jazz** had little to offer once collared and **Global Hunter** was on to a relatively easy score. 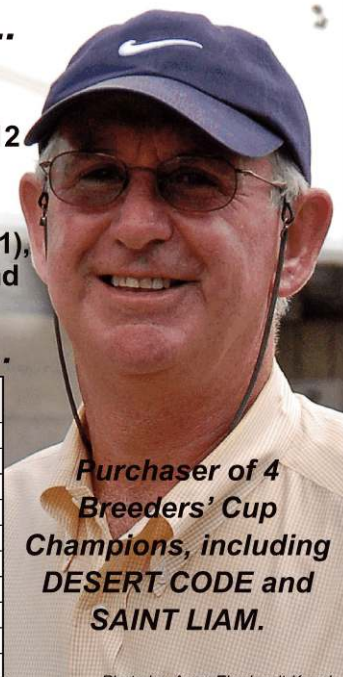

Funny Moon made a pair of starts at Gulfstream over the winter, rallying from 10th to finish runner-up in her seven-furlong debut Feb. 15 before graduating over an extra panel Mar. 18. The chestnut remained perfect at that trip May 7, taking a Belmont allowance by three

lengths and earning a first crack at Grade I company in the June 6 Acorn S. She was sent off at 4-1 that afternoon, very little went according to plan and she trailed in eighth. "I was very disappointed in her performance in the Acorn," admitted trainer Christophe Clement. "We loved the filly beforehand and it's still a bit of a puzzle

why she ran so badly that day." A drop back into allowance company proved the right tonic in her latest, an 8 1/4-length score at Belmont July 3, but she was lightly regarded in her first try beyond a mile. Last of eight as Devotee (Elusive Quality) raced far too freely up front, Funny Moon travelled well off the rail and began to advance on the turn. She seemed to be going more sideways than forward at the quarter pole, but responded when set down by Alan Garcia and was along late for the victory. Don't Forget Gil raced in traffic and was blocked in the stretch before rallying once clear into second.

FUNNY MOON (Malibu Moon)

Bloodstock agent Debbie Easter signed the ticket on Funny Moon at \$175,000 at the 2007 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale. She could barely contain herself when reached on the Belmont backstretch following the CCA Oaks

"It really has not sunk in yet. This is so exciting," said Easter, who was represented by her first Grade I winner as a bloodstock agent. "I've had a few run in Grade Is, but I've never won one. This is what you work so hard for. We're having some fun."

Easter explained what caught her eye two summers ago.

"She was just a beautiful, long-legged, pretty Malibu Moon filly," she explained. "I thought she looked like a filly that might run. I loved the sire, too. The mare had been producing nice looking foals and I knew that she was throwing horses that could run."

"Randy Miles broke the filly for us, and we knew last spring she was very good," she continued. "Everyone that dealt with her thought she could be something special."

What once was a dream became reality yesterday.

Kirklees apparently found 12 furlongs beyond him when 10th in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 28. But, out of action for three months after that effort, he strolled home in the Listed Gala S. over Sandown's 10-furlong course last time out July 3, and was the heavy chalk here. Reined back to stalk the pace in second having led through the first furlong, the bay was travelling best of all as he eased to the front before the quarter pole. He was kept up to his work on the run to the line, and was not fully extended to notch his most important victory since taking the G1 Gran Criterium at Milan as a juvenile. "I decided to take a lead today and they went a touch slowly, so I was in front from 2 1/2 to the winning post, and it was a long way," jockey Frankie Dettori explained. "But he's a class horse and he won like we thought. We gave him time to develop and he's turned out to be a real nice horse. If we campaign him abroad, I think he can win a Group 1." After an impressive debut success at Leicester that earned her ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status May 26, Lady of the Desert was found wanting when only sixth in the G2 Queen Mary S. at the Royal meeting here last time June 17. She paid the price for chasing the eventual winner Jealous Again (Trippi) on that occasion, but Martin Dwyer played it cool this time and restrained the chestnut behind the leaders early. Making ground easily approaching the final quarter, the homebred put her seal on the race soon after, and comfortably held Full Mandate in the run to the line. "That was an armchair ride, and she did everything great for me," Dwyer said. "She took me there so smoothly and, when I pressed the button, she quickened away. She is a nice filly and probably would have won the Queen Mary if it wasn't for the American filly being there. Her speed just killed her off in the end, so I'm pleased she's come back and won." Trainer Brian Meehan added, "I said to Martin to go out and follow the American filly at Royal Ascot, so I got it wrong, but she came back very well. She has a wonderful attitude and is very progressive, with the pedigree to stack it up. She looked, going over the line, as if she would get seven furlongs easily now."

The chestnut colt took an off-turf allowance at Calder by 11 3/4 lengths May 30 before upsetting the June 26 Iowa Derby at 13-1, scoring by five lengths. "The decision came down to a lot of things," Fawkes told *Daily Racing Form*. "Finishing second in the Haskell adds a lot more to his value versus running in a Grade II at Saratoga. This is a nice little horse. Either race would be a big step forward. We are asking a lot from the horse."
