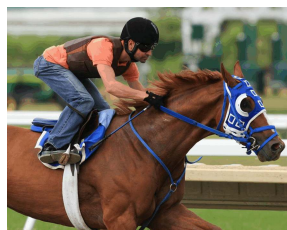

Classic Winners Converge on Jersey Shore..

Desormeaux, who rode Summer Bird for the first time in the June 6 Belmont, won last year's Haskell with GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. hero Big Brown (Boundary). "The track was a little slick and I got him coming home in 11 and change," Desormeaux said. "I tried to get him over the best part of the racetrack. He knows the game and knows how to prepare himself. He's ready." Summer Bird, who arrived from Louisiana in early July, will face GI Preakness S. heroine **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia

d'Oro) in the nine-furlong Monmouth feature. The Jess Jackson-owned filly is slated to ship to Monmouth from Saratoga Friday morning and school in the paddock with runners from that day's sixth race.

Also scheduled to contest the Haskell is Iowa Derby winner **Duke of Mischief** (Graeme Hall). The colt, who turned in a bullet half-mile in :48 flat at Calder Saturday morning, was placed on a van heading north yesterday and is expected to arrive at the Oceanport oval this morning. "We'll probably school him later in the week," said trainer David Fawkes. "Maybe we'll do it in the morning, but perhaps the afternoon. It wouldn't hurt to send him to the paddock and let him bounce around over there for a little bit." Eibar Coa, who was aboard when Duke of Mischief won the Iowa Derby by five lengths June 26, will have the mount in the Haskell.

Second on debut over five furlongs at Naas Apr. 18, Alfred Nobel finished third over this course and distance May 4 before opening his account stepped up to seven furlongs at Leopardstown May 28. He did not enamor

all with his workmanlike success in the Railway back at this venue last time, but neither had the stable's past winners George Washington (Ire) (Danehill) and Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire})

before they produced their tours de force here. Despite Johnny Murtagh's intentions beforehand to leave it late, he was anchored in rear longer than he would have wanted as tiring rivals stacked up in front of him inside the final quarter mile. Air Chief Marshal, who had taken over from the stable rabbits who had dictated the action throughout the first half mile, looked for most of the remainder of the race to have got away from his favored stable companion. In the end, it was Alfred Nobel's superior acceleration when circling the field which proved decisive. "He was very green on his first couple of runs and got a bit lonely in front the last day, so Johnny [Murtagh] said today he was going to wait," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "He's one of those horses that can really change gears, and so I was worried about the heavy ground, as he is such a good mover. Obviously he's a very good horse and may run in the G1 Prix Morny [at Deauville Aug. 23]. We're delighted with Air Chief Marshal, as we thought he was a very smart horse on his first few runs, but he had just lost his form."

Well supported to make it two straight, the bay stalked early leader French Beret (Broad Brush) through a pedestrian opening quarter in :26.26, took over from that rival and sauntered through splits of :51.74 and 1:18.06, and had enough left late to hold off Marchfield. "My main job was to get my horse to relax today," said winning rider Slade Callaghan. "He ran really good over a soft turf. I wouldn't necessarily say that might be his best going. He has a heart like no other. You can't ask for anything more than that in a racehorse." 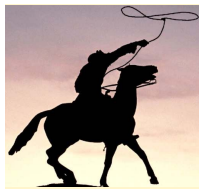

A major study recently proved Lasix to be effective. It also suggested that, due to improved testing techniques, it is unlikely to mask the presence of other drugs. Does this change the way you feel about the medication, and, as it is currently only in use in the Americas, how will it affect its usage in racing countries worldwide?

I wonder if anyone has done a study on whether Lasix/Salix use has an effect on the horse's skeletal soundness? I have no scientific basis for this question, however, if the animal is repeatedly dehydrated by the use of it for races and works, wouldn't it leach the minerals out of the bone marrow? I don't think administering a jug post race would put back all that had been depleted. Could this have something to do with the fragility of today's American racehorses?

It is very telling, in my view, that American-bred horses continue to race in countries where Lasix/Salix is not used on race day and they run much more frequently and seem to stay sounder. So, if they were genetically fragile, they wouldn't hold up anywhere else either. The difference between the U.S. and the rest of the world is the Lasix/Salix use here.--*Elizabeth Blythe*

So, that could have been seven-for-seven. It was obviously great to be able to win five, and to win three stakes on one day, that's definitely something I won't forget.

One of those wins was with Just as Well, who is slated to make his next start in the GI Arlington Million. The Million is a race I've

obviously watched over the years, but have never been able to participate in it. It would be very special to ride in that race.

Favorite racetrack? Gosh, I've ridden at so many of them, but Arlington Park is home for me. Each has its own identity, but I've ridden my whole career in Chicago. Arlington is just a beautiful track.

Favorite horse? I would have to say Nicole's Dream. She really loved to run and run fast. It was always just a thrill to ride her because she always showed up. She didn't make too many mistakes.

Who was your idol in life? My father. I had a lot of respect for him. He had to overcome a lot in life.

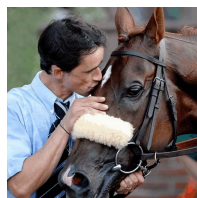
