RACHEL TUNES UP FOR HASKELL

GI Preakness S. winner **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) tuned up for a start in Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park with a four-furlong breeze in :49.26 over the Oklahoma training track at Saratoga

yesterday. It was the sixth fastest of 23 at the distance. "She seems to be doing extremely well," trainer Steve Asmussen said after the work. "We want everything to go well, and we expect it to [go well]. We have a tall task for her this week. We want to show the respect that we think it deserves. We're excited about the opportunity."

Rachel Alexandra, trying to become just the second filly to win the Haskell, is expected to ship to the Jersey shore Friday morning. Also working towards the Haskell yesterday, GI Arkansas Derby winner **Papa Clem** (Smart Strike) worked six furlongs at Monmouth Park in 1:14.60. Jockey Elvis Trujillo has the mount in the Haskell. Iowa Derby winner **Duke of Mischief** (Graeme Hall) arrived at Monmouth yesterday morning after a 24-van ride from Calder. "He walked and got a bath," said trainer David Fawkes. "That's it. He'll go to the track tomorrow. He shipped great and everything is set with him." The Haskell field is also expected to include GI Belmont S. victor **Summer Bird** (Birdstone), **Munnings** (Speightstown), **Atomic Rain** (Smart Strike) and **Bunker Hill** (Trippi).

MINE THAT BIRD WORKS AT MOUNTAINEER

GI Kentucky Derby winner **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) recorded his first work at Mountaineer Racetrack in

West Virginia yesterday, going four furlongs in :49.80 as he prepares for a tilt at Saturday's GI West Virginia Derby. It was the fourth fastest of seven on the work tab at Mountaineer. "He was really sharp, we got just about exactly what we wanted out of him," trainer Chip Woolley said after the drill. "This

racetrack is going to fit him pretty well, we think. The track was as big a factor as anything in our decision to come to the West Virginia Derby." Local jockey John Perez was aboard for yesterday's work. "Mine That Bird was perfect this morning," Perez said. "He bounced right over the top of the track." Mine That Bird will be the first Kentucky Derby winner to compete in the state. Mike Smith, who rode Mine That Bird to a runner-up finish in the GI Preakness S., will be aboard the diminutive bay gelding in the West Virginia Derby. Also expected in Saturday's nine-furlong race is graded stakes winner **Big Drama** (Montbrook), **Awesome Rhythm** (Toccet), a multiple stakes winner at Woodbine, and **Sunday Sunrise** (Lemon Drop Kid), most recently seventh in the July 4 GI Dwyer S.

ALL-WEATHER GO-AHEAD AT CHANTILLY

Chantilly, which hosts the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, will install an all-weather track in time for the 2011 season. Work on the project, which has been driven by His Highness The Aga Khan and the town's mayor Eric Woerth, is due to begin next July following the running of the G1 Prix Jean Prat and will take six months, during which time

Main Aim sets the standard on his second in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket 18 days ago and proved he is effective at this trip when winning the G3 John of Gaunt S. at Haydock May 30. Sandwiched in between those two outings was a fine fourth in the G1 Queen Anne S. over a mile at Royal Ascot, so the Juddmonte homebred is proving to be a versatile performer.

J J the Jet Plane bids to improve on his latest third in the July Cup, and Mike de Kock has been suggesting for a while that a step up in trip will help. "He's as fit and well as he can be and, obviously, we have Main Aim as our main danger, as he has beaten us before," the trainer's assistant Juan Nel told *PA Sport*. "Hopefully, with luck we can turn the tables. I don't think the trip will be a problem for him, and it's just whether he's good enough on the day." Last year's G3 Molecomb S. winner and G1 Dewhurst S. third **Finjaan** and recent G3 Jersey S. scorer **Ouqba** represent Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum and Richard Hills has opted for the latter after his June 17 Royal Ascot success. "We have been very pleased with him since Ascot, and he seems to have done very well physically," said trainer Barry Hills's son and assistant Charlie. "He won't have to carry a penalty in the Betfair Cup, and the seven-furlong trip obviously suits him, although he may get further in time."

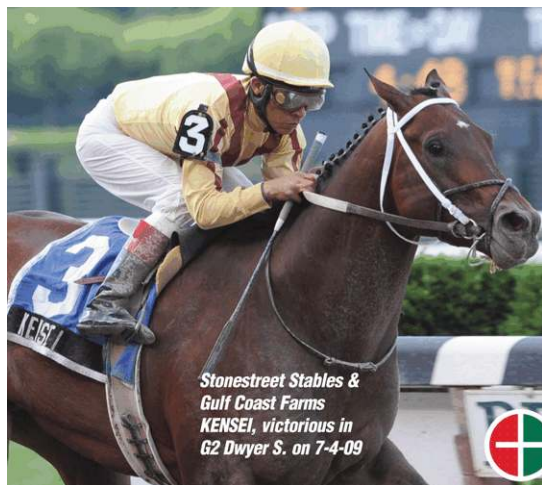

Harbinger has not been seen since beating the dual subsequent winner Changingoftheguard (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) at Chester May 6. "He's reported to in very good shape, but he's been off a while as he pulled a muscle in his quarters after Chester," owner Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's Manager Harry Herbert told *PA Sport*. "It took a while to come right and Sir Michael [Stoute] didn't have the time to do the work with him for the King Edward VII at Ascot. This looks a sensible target and he has really been trained for the race--although we think he will improve significantly for the run. He's a nice horse, a very relaxed worker. He finished full of running at Chester, so the step up in trip should hopefully suit--and he goes on all ground."

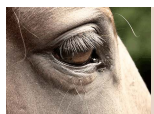

Two of the weekend's top events, on either side of the Atlantic, provided welcome confirmation that it is still possible in today's ultra-competitive industry for a stallion to rise through the ranks.

In Ireland, Danehill Dancer could be said to have started his career as a comparatively humble Corporal, at an initial fee of Ir4,000gns. His fee reflected the fact that his racing career, which had started out so well with a pair of Group 1 juvenile victories, had tapered off to such an extent that his price ranked him joint-26th of the 29 stallions standing under the Coolmore banner in 1998.

Now, 11 years later, he has developed into one of the Generals of the European industry and--for the second time in eight days--he supplied the trifecta in an Irish stakes race when Alfred Nobel cut down Air Chief Marshal and Walk On Bye to take the G1 Phoenix S.

Danehill Dancer also completed a rare Irish Classic double with Mastercraftsman and Again this year, achieving this double with progeny sired at a fee of €40,000.

The first three in the Phoenix S. were sired when Danehill Dancer's fee had risen to €75,000, which suggests that he could eventually challenge his stud-mate Galileo for the rank of Field Marshal, or Five Star General, as his 2009 yearlings and foals are off a fee of €115,000.

By the way, Alfred Nobel and Walk On Bye, along with Danehill Dancer's Classic-placed daughter Tamazirte, are all inbred 3x4 to Danzig through Danehill and Green Desert. I mentioned the likelihood that this type of inbreeding was set to proliferate 11 months ago, after Bushranger followed up his third to Mastercraftsman in the 2008 Phoenix S. with victory in the Prix Morny. Over in the States, you could argue that the then-three-year-old Malibu Moon started his stallion career in 2000 with the rank of Private. He had been forced onto the sidelines by injury before he had had the chance to prove himself at stakes level. The only races he had contested were a 4½-furlong maiden at Hollywood Park Apr. 30, 1999, when he finished second at odds-on, and a five-furlong maiden race at the end of May, which he took in a time of :57.41. That performance looked all the more promising because Malibu Moon is a son of A.P. Indy, a stallion not noted for siring precociously fast juveniles.

As might be expected of a son of A.P. Indy, Malibu Moon had a splendidly strong bottom half to his pedigree, as can be judged from the fact that his dam Macoumba had cost B. Wayne Hughes \$2 million while she was carrying her A.P. Indy colt. Even so, Malibu Moon was likely to struggle as a small fish in the big pool of Kentucky's breeding industry, and Hughes formed a partnership with Country Life Farm in Maryland to stand the colt at a fee of \$3,000.

This proved a very shrewd move and Malibu Moon wasted little time in proving himself Officer material. His four Maryland crops, which numbered 211 named foals, produced 24 stakes winners. You could be forgiven for thinking that this impressive total must have been achieved largely in stakes restricted to Maryland-breds, but the reality was that Malibu Moon hit the Grade I target with the champion 2004 juvenile Declan's Moon and Malibu Mint. He also sired the Grade II winners Perfect Moon and Moon Catcher.

Although the success of his first juveniles brought an instant move to Kentucky, to Castleton Lyons, Malibu Moon's fee was no higher than \$10,000 in 2004 and \$17,500 in 2005. Needless to say, there was substantial demand for his services, and these larger crops have provided further evidence that Malibu Moon was worthy of promotion to a much higher rank.

His first Kentucky crop, born in 2005, includes two graded-winning fillies in Raw Silk (Gil Sands Point S. on turf) and Sweet August Moon (Gill Las Flores H. on all-weather). By the Light, runner-up in the GI Prioress S., and Solar Miss are graded-placed fillies from this \$10,000 crop, which also includes Moon de French, a filly who gained ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status when she recently returned to action at Hollywood Park. This crop also includes the Grade II runner-up Malibu Kid.

The signs are that Malibu Moon's 2006 crop is destined to become one of his most productive. Once again it has been his fillies which have been leading the way, with Sara Louise, Bon Jovi Girl, Pinkarella, Malibu Prayer and Funny Moon all winning or placing at graded level. The colts Au Moon and Ninth Client have also been placed in graded company, while Phoenician Girl and Essenceofthemoon have won stakes races. The strength of this crop suggests that Malibu Moon will rise further through the ranks with the help of his next four crops, all sired at fees of \$30,000 or \$40,000. The \$30,000 crop has already produced three juvenile winners.

Pride of place in his 2006 crop must go to Funny Moon, who became her sire's third Grade I winner when she came out on top in a tight finish to the Coaching Club American Oaks over a mile and a quarter.

The distance of the CCA Oaks represented something of a trip into the unknown, as a mile and an eighth was the farthest that any of Malibu Moon's previous winners had won over at graded level. There was some reassurance to be had from the fact that Malibu Moon's sire A.P. Indy had been responsible for two winners of this famous race in Music Note and Jilbab (who won when the Oaks was over a mile and a half).

There is also plenty of stamina in the bottom half of Funny Moon's pedigree, her broodmare sire being Easy Goer, who demonstrated his prowess over a mile and a half with victories in the Belmont S. and Jockey Club Gold Cup.

RACING AND BREEDING IN KENTUCKY: IT'S A WIN-WIN PROPOSITION.

The Jockey Club Gold Cup also figured on the resume of Vanlandingham, a top-class half-brother to Funny Moon's dam Fun Crowd. The unraced Fun Crowd was sold for 120,000gns by Juddmonte, who paid as much as \$2 million for Fun Crowd's dam Populi at Keeneland in 1983.

Two of Populi's other daughters produced group winners for Juddmonte, the most notable being her Nijinsky filly Musicanti, who produced the G1 Dewhurst S. winner Distant Music. Musicanti's daughter New Orchid has also supplied Juddmonte with a Group 1 winner in African Rose, winner of last year's Sprint Cup.

Populi was herself a half-sister to Temperance Hill, a champion three-year-old who numbered the Belmont S. and Jockey Club Gold Cup among his successes, so there is an unusual amount of stamina, by today's standards, in Funny Moon's family.

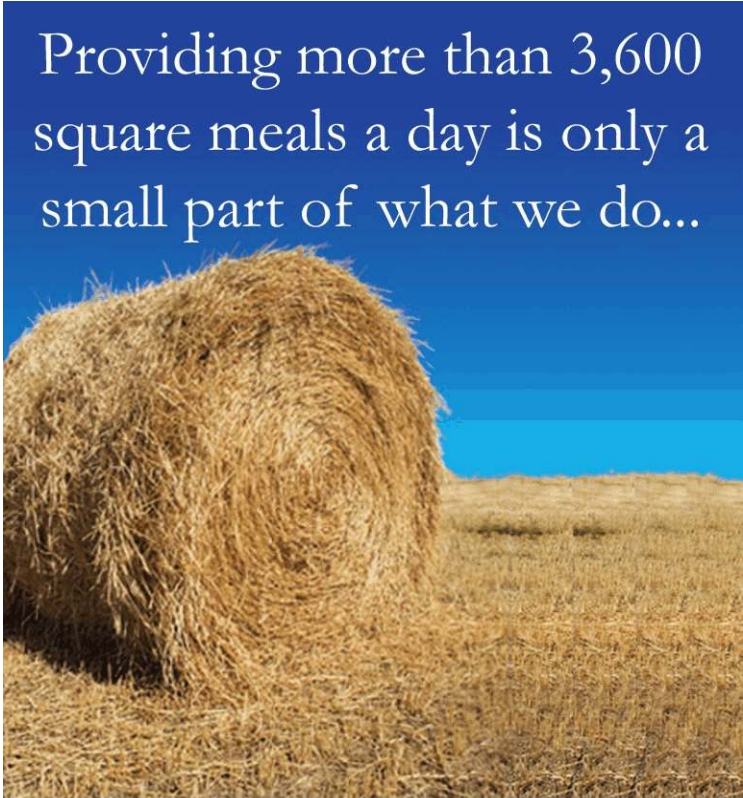
