#### 'RACHEL' IN 6 HOLE; INSTALLED 4-5 CHOICE

At yesterday's post position draw in the Garden Room at Monmouth Park, **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) drew the six hole and was installed the 4-5 morning-line choice for Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational. Owned by Stonestreet Stables and Harold McCormick, the dark bay is scheduled to arrive at the Oceanport oval this morning and will school in the paddock before the sixth race. The winner of the May 1 GI Kentucky Oaks joined Steve Asmussen's string prior to a victory in the May 16 GI Preakness S. "She hasn't changed a bit, which is good," said Asmussen, explaining the fillies' progress since he took over training duties. "She's just been very consistent." **Haskell Draw Cont. p2**

#### BACK IN BLUE

**Schiaparelli (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) is renowned in his native Germany with a trio of domestic Group 1 wins, and the Brits got a first real taste of his talent yesterday as he strode to G2 Goodwood Cup glory in the Godolphin livery. Warming up with a second, before being demoted to third, in the G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket three weeks ago, the giant chestnut had the race in safe keeping soon after Frankie Dettori let him loose at the top of the straight. Despite the late and persistent presence of his only challenger **Mourilyan (Ire)** (Desert Prince {Ire}), the 6-4 pick had a comfortable length to spare at the line. "This fellow is a good horse and stayed well for his first time over this trip," Dettori said. "He won like a nice stayer and is versatile, as he can go over a mile and a half on soft ground." **Cont. p4**

#### BACKTALK GETS LAST WORD IN SANFORD

**Backtalk** (Smarty Jones) justified his 3-2 favoritism when forging to the front in the final strides to land Thursday's GII Sanford S. at Saratoga. The \$250,000 KEESEP yearling, a half to GSW Bsharpsonata (Pulpit), settled in a stalking sixth as **Soundman** (Songandaprayer) rolled through an opening quarter mile in :21.99. With that foe struggling to keep up approaching the home stretch, Backtalk began to pick off horses while racing six wide turning for home and drew up alongside a host of rivals midstretch before forging ahead late to post a neck victory over **Enumerate** (Proud Accolade). **Louisville luminary** (Pulpit) was a neck back in third, while **Bulls and Bears** (Holy Bull), who missed the break, regrouped and appeared to have a shot, but could do no better than fifth. "I was a little nervous because this is my first meet at Saratoga, but I got a great horse with a bright future," said winning rider Miguel Mena. "He's learning race by race. He was so calm in the post parade. He felt good and had a good trip. A couple of horses got a little tough in the end, but he never quit. He fought through the end." **Cont. p3**

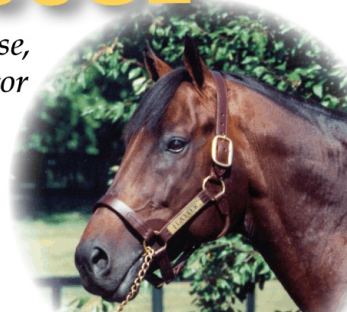

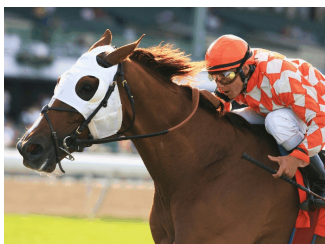

**FOUR LATE NOMS ADDED TO MILLION**

Four late nominations were added to the original list of 102 when the GI Arlington Millions late nominations closed Wednesday. Added to the 10-furlong marquee event are **Stotsfold (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}), a Group 3 winner in France; Grade III/Group 3 winner and Grade I-placed **Musketier (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}); GII Illinois Derby hero **Recapture the glory** (Cherokee Run); and **Presious Passion** (Royal Anthem), victorious in his latest outing in July 4 GI United Nations S.

In his career bow, Backtalk came from off the pace to graduate in a five-furlong test at Churchill Downs June 11. Favored in his latest start in the GIII Bashford Manor S. July 3, the \$250,000 KEESEP yearling purchase stumbled at the start, but recovered well to settle just off the early pace. Despite the tough start that day, the Florida-bred rallied late to win by a length and was well-supported to give his sophomore sire another victory at this level here. "These don't come around in my barn often, and I'm certainly grateful to Goldmark Farm for the opportunity," said winning trainer Tom Amoss. "I think the ability to come from that far off the pace on a day like today when it looked, to me, as the day went on that speed was a good commodity [and] the wide trip he had..I think those things were very exciting. And, I would say, a will to win. The race was not decided until very late." Jockey Edgar Prado, who was aboard the runner-up Enumerate, added, "Everything was looking good at the top of the stretch, just two, three horses that kind of died in front of me, and I had to wait a little bit and take [Enumerate] outside and split horses. He still fired real hard, and it came out to be a bob of the head at the end of the race--pretty close."

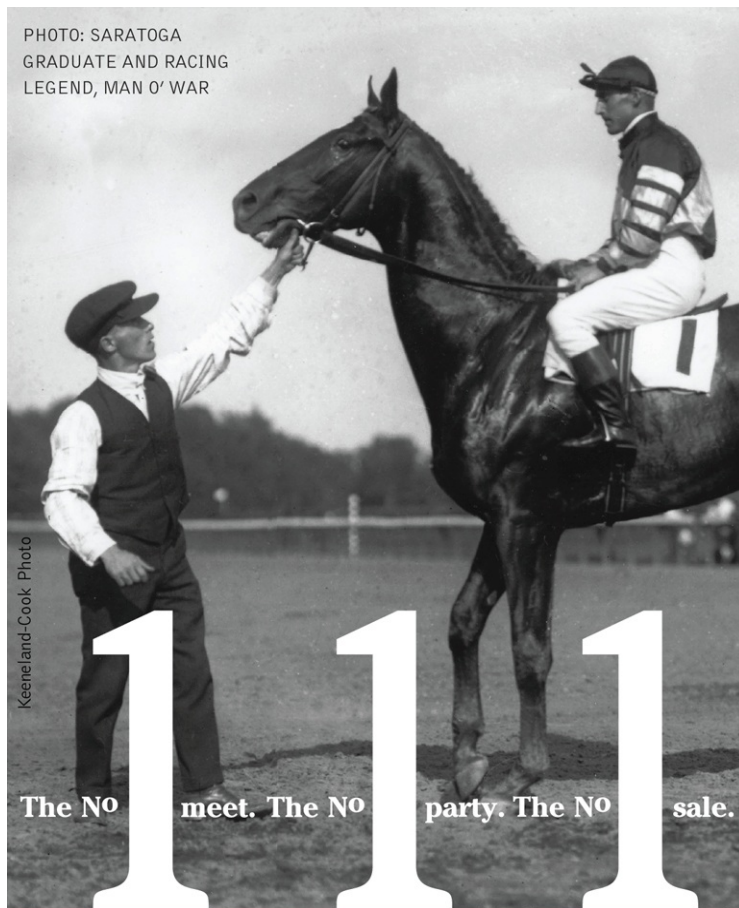

Schiaparelli became the second G1 Deutsches Derby winner bred from his high-class dam in 2006 and was only able to build on that Classic victory a year on when capturing the G1 Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf. His next two outings garnered Cologne's G1 Preis von Europa and the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club at the San Siro before leaving Peter Schiergen. Making his debut for new connections when second in the G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp in September, he was only 13th in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe back there the following month and was disregarded in the betting before the Princess of Wales's. Belying that lack of expectation, he bounded ahead and was only caught in the final furlong where he wandered across Alwaary (Dynaformer) and subsequently lost second place in the stewards' room. Sharper for that experience, he tracked the generous early pace in a distant third before lobbing to the front inside the final half-mile. Soon clear, he galloped relentlessly as Mourilyan and Ryan Moore worked hard to bridge the gap and was always holding that rival. "He ran a really big race today over a distance that suits him," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He needed the race at Newmarket and had worked really well afterwards. The ground was suitable for him today, and I told Frankie not to fight him and keep him where he was happy. **G3 King George S. cont.**

With successes in York's G1 Nunthorpe S. as a juvenile and last year's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot on his resume, Kingsgate Native was an exciting addition to the Cheveley Park Stud stallion ranks last fall. After none of the mares covered ended up in foal, it was a case of back to the drawing board--and to the Sir Michael Stoute academy--for the imposing bay. He offered little promise when trailing on his racecourse return in the latest renewal of the Golden Jubilee last time June 20, but, cutting a different shape entirely here, he sat in the slipstream of the leaders on the stand's side, surged through a gap on the fence to lead with a furlong remaining and quickly asserted. "He traveled real well and when half a gap appeared, he quickened up well and, put the race to bed very quickly," jockey Ryan Moore explained. "He's always been a highly strung horse and covering mares wouldn't have quieted him down, so the team have done a really good job to get him back to win a race like this." Cheveley Park's Managing Director Chris Richardson added, "Mr. and Mrs. Thompson were extremely disappointed he was unable to fulfil his commitments at stud, but we did everything we could, and it was one of those things. We're thrilled that he has come back, as he had a long time off doing another job, and we are concentrating on making him successful in the sprinting world. We have the opportunity to review the stud situation now that he is a four-year-old, but from what we have been told it is highly unlikely. Today was a Group 1 in quality, and it has been quite a challenge for Sir Michael and his team, so we'd like to have another go at the [Aug. 21] Nunthorpe." **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#). Sevenna had been kept to handicap company after breaking her maiden at Newbury last June and had failed to add to that win despite a string of consistent efforts. Runner-up over this track and trip last time June 19, the bay took a leap forward after the heavens had opened in the preceding moments. Fourth early, she was committed by Tom Queally before the final quarter and duly drove her rivals into submission. "She loves that ground and really tried," her rider said. "She has guts and determination and showed a willing attitude. She has improved and the plan was to go and make it, but I had to sit and suffer and she made up ground going downhill which made it easier. 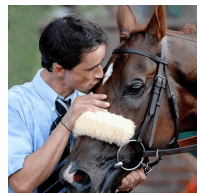

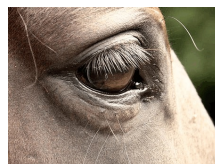

### 'Dixie Chick' in Fine Fettle After Schuylerville Romp..

Hot Dixie Chick (Dixie Union) exited an eye-catching 6 1/4-length victory in Wednesday's GII Schuylerville S. in excellent form, according to trainer Steve Asmussen yesterday. Also the conditioner of star sophomore filly

Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro), Asmussen indicated that the \$435,000 F-T Calder Sale graduate may make her next appearance in the GI Spinaway S. Sept. 6. Also possible for the Spinaway is Schuylerville runner-up **Beautician** (Dehere). "She came out of the race great; I was proud of her," said trainer Ken McPeek. "But I'd really like to win

a race up here for her owner, Peter Callahan, because he's a New Yorke owner and he's one of the good guys." McPeek added that the Aug. 19 GII Adirondack S. will also be under consideration for the gray, who broke her maiden in her career debut at Churchill Downs June 5.

Also a winner on Saratoga's opening day was **Westover Wildcat** (Forest Wildcat). A two-length winner going 5 1/2 furlongs against maidens, the Samuel Bayard-owned colt is conditioned by Tony Dutrow. "We knew we had a horse on our hands," stated Dutrow. "He's smart. He's got experience. He's got talent. We're hoping for something like we saw [Wednesday]." Dutrow indicated that the Sept. 7 GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. might be in the cards for the dark bay. "I wouldn't waste an allowance race on him," added Dutrow. "We will be looking at the Hopeful at this point, but he's going to have most to say in that." Also hailing from the Dutrow barn is recent GI Prioress S. winner **Cat Moves** (Tale of the Cat), who appears on track for an upcoming start in the GI Test S. Aug. 8. "I have every reason to think she's excellent," offered Dutrow. "To go from a maiden race to a Grade I in three months is an attribute to her quality. She showed a great deal of talent as a two-year-old, but her maturity in a short period of time has been the most impressive thing to us."



## SECOND CHANCES

### TDN takes a closer look at the also-rans in hot races...

It's no secret that Saratoga maiden races showcase some of the best juveniles in training. Samuel Bayard's

**Westover Wildcat** (Forest Wildcat), second behind subsequent Tyro S. runner-up El Rocco (Vicar) in his Philly Park debut July 7, got the meet off on the right foot Wednesday, drawing off to a sharp two-length tally as the lukewarm 2-1 favorite. While that one enjoyed the spot-

light at the wire, there were several also-rans who showed promise in defeat.

**Trappe Shot** (Tapit), who topped EASMAY at \$850,000 earlier this spring, was backed at 5-2 after compiling a smart worktab for trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. The half-brother to GISW Miss Shop (Deputy Minister) drilled a bullet half-mile in :47 2/5 at the Spa July 19, and was equipped with Lasix for his unveiling. With Saratoga reigning leading rider Alan Garcia aboard, the chestnut stumbled badly shortly after exiting from the eight stall and trailed the field of 11. Quick to recover, he made an eye-catching move along the inside to race in eighth through a sharp opening quarter of :21.94. Still with plenty to do in the stretch while caught in traffic, the Mill House colorbearer altered course multiple times before finishing with interest once clear to get up by a nose for fifth, beaten 7 1/2 lengths.

"He stumbled real bad and basically lost all chance," McLaughlin offered. "We will regroup and run back in three or four weeks and see a different horse. He was just real unlucky [Wednesday]. I did [like how he finished up]. He's a very nice colt, just unlucky. The break cost us the race. We'll regroup and he'll be very tough to beat next time. We'll run back at six furlongs, possibly on Travers day [Aug. 29]."

WinStar Farm homebred **Antenna** (Tale of the Cat) also looks like one to follow down the road. Drawn the widest in post 11, the dark bay settled toward the back of the pack. **Cont. p12**

With Kent Desormeaux in the irons, the son of the stakes-placed mare Miss Moonwaki (Miswaki) began to launch a bid while racing very wide on the turn for home and came with a sustained rally down the center of the course to complete the trifecta, 4 1/2 lengths behind the victor. He is trained by Bill Mott.

"I was very pleased," WinStar Vice President and Racing Manager Elliott Walden commented. "He didn't break that great. Kent said he kind of was running along down the backside just a little green, started to squeeze him turning for home, and he really started giving him a nice feeling. What I liked the most is that he got real competitive with that horse that was running with him [fourth-place finisher Devonshire {Royal Academy}]. He got his head in front for third and was fighting it out hard."

Antenna showed a steady series of works, which began at Keeneland in April. He most recently breezed five furlongs around the "dogs" on the Oklahoma turf course in an easy 1:04 July 22.

"We were looking for an okay effort," Walden continued. "Neither one of the two colts we ran [Wednesday] [Doubles Partner {Rock Hard Ten}, last of 11] were horses that we felt like would crank first time out. That's really not the kind of horses we have, typically. Most of our two year olds are geared to go a mile, a mile and a sixteenth or a mile and an eighth. They don't show you the half-miles in :46 when they work."

As for what's next for Antenna, Walden added, "We'll run him back on dirt. Probably something going a little longer, like six or six-and-a-half furlongs in the second book." --S. Sherack

**TIMEFORM RAISES STARS' RATING**

P. Indy). "He's certainly a very green horse who has burst onto the scene from nothing, and we couldn't see that he had that sort of ability. None of us realised he was that good, so we'll have to talk about where he goes now."

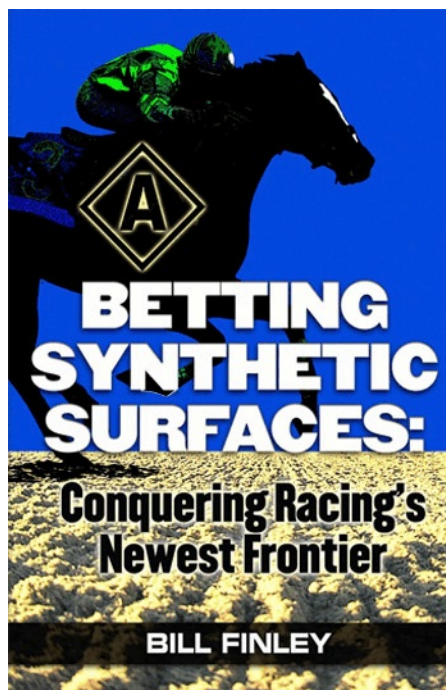
