### "KEN" DO KID

It could be a great weekend for Stonestreet Stables and trainer Steve Asmussen. The operation that brings you Rachel Alexandra in today's GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park started the celebration at the Spa after **Kensei** (Mr. Greeley), owned in partnership with breeder Gulf Coast Farms, drove to a professional win in the GII Jim Dandy S. yesterday. Just moments earlier, Asmussen watched as another trainee, Zayat Stables' **Soul Warrior** (Lion Heart), posted the upset in the GII West Virginia Derby. "It's been a good day--unbelievable," said Asmussen. Kensei's success came as less of a shock. The winner of the July 4 GII Dwyer S. after being stretched out past 7 1/2 furlongs for the first time, the bay collared front-running **Warrior's Reward** (Medaglia d'Oro) at the three-eighths pole and pulled away down the lane to take the nine-panel Jim Dandy by 2 1/4 lengths. ### MIDDAY MAGIC

There was no Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) to take on in yesterday's G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood, but Khalid Abdullah's **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) still had the elements to overcome before she could claim a first top-level success. Allowed to drift to a huge 11-2 after heavy rain turned the going against her, the homebred G1 Epsom Oaks runner-up went through the ground with her usual ruthless efficiency and, after grabbing the advantage inside the final quarter, stayed on under Tom Queally to secure a 2 1/4-length success from **Rainbow View** (Dynaformer). "She has worked well on good-to-soft ground and they were going through it in the earlier races, so I took a chance," commented trainer Henry Cecil, whose suggestion it had been to let her line up. "She didn't get the best of runs in the Oaks, but I thought that was her d-day and knew Sariska would improve a lot from there, so this is compensation."

Goodwood recorded good ground at the start of racing, but by the time she was due to be saddled it had turned soft with the rain, and connections took the plunge based on Henry Cecil's judgement. That proved well-founded as she tracked the early pace and had the speed to cross over to the stand's rail at the top of the straight. Swooping at the head of affairs as the runners vanished into the sea fret passing the quarter pole, she was firmly on top when reappearing and safely holding the wide challenge of **Rainbow View**. "She did it well and is back to her best," jockey Tom Queally said. "We didn't want to break her heart and disappoint her, but Henry stuck his neck out and said he wanted her to run, and she went through it better than I thought she would. English soft ground and Irish soft are two different things." Cecil added, "She couldn't go on the ground at all at The Curragh, but she is very consistent. Forever Together commenced her run at the Eclipse Award with a rallying score in the 2008 Diana. She came up short when third in the Sept. 7 GII Canadian S. over a yielding Woodbine turf, but followed up with victories in the Oct. 3 GI First Lady S. at Keeneland and Oct. 24 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. Put away for the winter, the Augustin colorbearer opened 2009 with a win in the Apr. 11 GII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland. Things did not go as planned in the GI Just a Game S. June 6 and, after having to wait for running room on the turn, Forever Together ended up second, but she enjoyed a perfect trip here. Ninth of 10 through the opening half, she gained ground on the turn and kept on coming in the lane, then throttled it down a bit after getting the lead to make it close. Soul Warrior was unsuccessful in two prior graded starts, running sixth in the Feb. 7 GIII Risen Star S. and fifth in the Mar. 14 GII Louisiana Derby. Given a break after those efforts, the chestnut colt came back in an allowance test at Churchill Downs June 4 and scored by 2 1/2 lengths. Let go at 13-1 in the June 26 Iowa Derby, he was second best behind today's GI Haskell Invitational S. contender Duke of Mischief (Graeme Hall), but that performance did little to convince the Mountaineer faithful. Soul Warrior bided his time in third as Big Drama dashed off to lead by as many as 10 lengths early. Still nine in front after six furlongs in 1:10.45, the pacesetter shortened stride when they hit the lane, but found a little more when Eibar Coa went to the whip. Kensei broke his maiden when making his debut over the Saratoga main track last August, but faltered after pressing the pace in the Sept. 13 GII Futurity S. at Belmont and finished sixth. Out of action for 6 1/2 months, he returned to take an Oaklawn allowance test Apr. 2. The colt ran into a couple of **"TDN Rising Stars"** in his next two outings, running second behind Hull (Holy Bull) in the Apr. 25 GIII Derby Trial and third to Munnings (Speightstown) in the June 6 GII Woody Stephens S. But things turned around when he was stretched to a route. Off at 6-1 in the GII Dwyer S. at 1 1/16 miles, Kensei closed from just off the pace to win by 3 1/4 lengths. He used similar tactics yesterday, tracking Warrior's Reward early, putting a head in front after six furlongs in 1:11.55 and pulling away down the lane as the pacesetter held off Charitable Man for second. "When the horse won the Dwyer in such an impressive fashion, this became a target for us," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "We're glad to be on his side. He's a beautiful horse; he was very composed with the crowd. For him to perform as he did on the highest stage speaks a great deal to his class." It has not yet been decided what's next, but Asmussen added it was unlikely that both Kensei and Rachel Alexandra would point for the GI Travers S. Aug. 29. She was the longest shot on the board, but Glitter Rox didn't let that stop her. The bay mare tracked the pace from fourth and rode the rail into the stretch, then angled outside and shot past Canadian Ballet in the final strides. It was her first victory in nearly a year, and her first start since November. The Ontario-bred annexed the restricted Belle Geste S. going seven panels on the Woodbine lawn last Aug. 24, but tired late to be fifth in the Sept. 27 Avowal S. over that course and trip.

Switched to the all-weather for an allowance Oct. 13, she finished a close-up second, but ended the season with off-the-board efforts in the Nov. 2 Ontario Fashion S. and Nov. 23 Bessarabian S. Glitter Rox was overlooked while making her return off the eight-month layoff, but proved ready for her comeback. Explaining that the mare had been sidelined by a splint, trainer Ian Black added, "To be honest, I was prepping her for the Belle Geste [Aug. 23]. I had to start her somewhere."

Successful in an Apr. 5 Longchamp conditions event on her seasonal return, Board Meeting ran second in the May 1 G3 Prix Cleopatre at Saint-Cloud and was a last-out fifth in the June 14 G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly, a race won by her half-sister Bright Sky in 2002. Restrained in fourth until turning for home in third here, she was shaken up to challenge with 300 meters remaining and stayed on in determined fashion under vigorous urging to just hold the vain bid of Proportional. "Board Meeting is a nice filly who ran a good race in the Prix de Diane last time," said trainer Elie Lellouche. "She needs to settle in her races to give her best, so I was pleased there was a pacemaker present today. She deserved to win a group race and I'm convinced she will stay further, so I will now take her straight to the [G1] Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 13]."

The chestnut colt has earned triple-digit Beyers in each of his three starts this season, including a 110 for his victory in the June 6 Gil Woody Stephens S. and a 111 over a less-than-stellar field of older horses in the July 5 Gil Tom Fool H. But both those races came at seven

panels. In two tries beyond that trip last year, Munnings was second, beaten 5 3/4 lengths by Vineyard Haven (Lido Palace {Chi}), in the GI Champagne S. at a mile, and 10th, though just 4 3/4 lengths behind champion Midshipman (Unbridled's Song), in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "I'm confident he'll run to the best of his capabilities," trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm just not sure if a mile and an eighth is his best distance. He's got a good foundation to him, he's in great form, and it certainly seems like the right time to step up and find out. Obviously, he is going to have to run a superior race to compete with the filly." Respect for Rachel Alexandra is universal, but trainer Tim Ice has faith his **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) can make a horse race out of the Haskell. "I look forward to running against the filly and finding out what my colt can do," Ice told *DRF*.

**Goldikova** bids to become the first to record back-to-back successes in this contest, which was previously known as the Prix d'Astarte and has been run as a Group 1 since 2004. Following a stellar campaign in 2008, which resulted in a trio of wins at the highest level culminating in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, the homebred raised concerns that she was past her best when trailing in the G1 Prix d'Isphahan at Longchamp on her seasonal bow May 17. Back to her reliable best in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket last time July 8, she accounted for Heaven Sent (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and Spacious (GB) (Nayef) without being hard pressed there and sets a lofty standard. **Elusive Wave** captured the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 10 before finding the competition too hot in the G1 Coronation S. Only fourth behind Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway), **Reggane** and Saturday's G1 Nassau S. runner-up Rainbow View (Dynaformer) in that June 19 Royal Ascot contest, she may need to be able to dominate to make her presence felt again. Reggane improved markedly off her second to **Homebound** in the May 31 G2 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly at the Royal meeting and warrants respect, as does last year's G1 Prix de l'Opera winner **Lady Marian**. Purchased by Godolphin after that career-best on Longchamp's Arc card, she put in a lackluster effort on her first start in the royal blue when last in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad Al Sheba.

He added, "We don't think [Well Armed] has lost a step." The WinStar homebred will need to be on top of his game, as he gives his rivals from seven to 15 pounds.

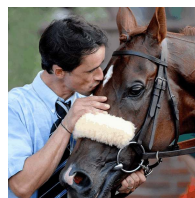

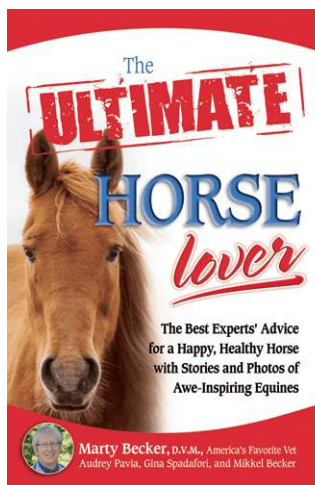
