RARIFIED AIR: RACHEL DOMINATES AGAIN

When it comes to an off track at Monmouth Park, Jess Jackson approves. Two years ago, Curlin, co-owned by Jackson's Stonestreet Stables, splashed home to a convincing win in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Monmouth, a victory that earned him Horse of the Year honors. Yesterday, Stonestreet and Harold McCormick's **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) moved one step closer to that same title with an overwhelming, six-length victory facing males in the GI Haskell Invitational S., which came over a muddy Monmouth strip that had been battered by heavy rain earlier in the day. "Wow, she exceeds our expectations every time," Jackson said after the race. "That's what we want to do--we want to test the great ones." **Cont. p2**

GOLDIKOVA RAMPANT

Alain and Gerard Wertheimer's **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) rediscovered her zip in last month's G1 Fal-mouth S. at Newmarket, and dominated yesterday's G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville to claim second renewal--and a fifth top-level success--by 1 1/2 lengths from **Elusive Wave (Ire)** (Elusive City). Positioned in the wake of her pacesetter **Only Green (Ire)** (Green Desert) until seizing control from that wilting stablemate passing the two pole, the 9-10 favorite outclassed her rivals in the closing stages and was geared down late. "All being well, Goldikova will now go for the [Aug. 16] G1 Prix Jacques le Marois," said trainer Freddy Head. "We definitely want to take her back to Santa Anita for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile [Nov. 7]." **Cont. p3**

Road to Victory...

Entering the Haskell, Rachel Alexandra had already proved she was different class. She began the year with a tally in Oaklawn's Martha Washington S. Feb. 15. After easy wins in the Mar. 14 GII Fair Grounds Oaks and Apr. 5 GII Fantasy S., she decimated an over-matched GI Kentucky Oaks field by a record 20 1/4 lengths May 1. Jackson and McCormick privately bought Rachel Alexandra from her breeder Dolphus Morrison following that win, and immediately asked the super filly to tackle colts in the GI Preakness S. May 16 with new trainer Steve Asmussen. She handled the assignment with a superb effort, defeating the GI Kentucky Derby hero Mine That Bird (Birdstone) by a length. She returned to face her own sex with a near-20-length tally in the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont June 27, but was back facing males in the Haskell.

With Asmussen's assistant Scott Blasi at the end of the shank, Rachel Alexandra was led into Monmouth's paddock to the cheers of an appreciative crowd that had endured a wet afternoon waiting to see the champ. She calmly took it all in and was still a picture of poise entering post six, from which she broke alertly under regular jock Calvin Borel. The pair stayed well off the rail as Munnings, under a hard hold by John Velazquez, tugged his way to the front through a fast quarter split of :22 4/5.

'Rachel' stayed just off the flank of Munnings, in the two path, as Summer Bird came up to challenge along the rail after a half in :46 2/5. While her two rivals began to be ridden hard on the turn, Rachel cruised up without being asked and had hit the front after a blistering six furlongs in 1:09 4/5. Borel went to the whip soon after, and Rachel responded immediately, powering away to an emphatic score. "I was very comfortable," said Borel. "They were going pretty quick, but

she had her ears pricked, and when she does that, she is just so relaxed. Down the lane she was kinda looking, and I kept her going so she'd get something out of it. I was tapping on her a little bit, but that's because she was looking at the crowd. She's unbelievable."

The victory improved Rachel Alexandra's record to seven-for-seven in 2009, and gave her a second Grade I victory over males. She be-

comes the first filly to achieve such a feat on the main track since Winning Colors beat colts in the 1988 Santa Anita and Kentucky Derbies. And, according to connections, she might not be done terrorizing the boys. Asked if Saratoga's GI Woodward S., against older horses Sept. 5, was a possibility, Jackson commented, "I'd have to look at that opportunity if she tells me she's ready for that. I don't know what frontiers she's going to conquer next. She does so well when we raise the bar that we have to consider all options. But she's going to tell us what's next." Rachel's win capped a big weekend for Asmussen, who won the GII Jim Dandy S. with Jackson's Kensei (Mr. Greeley) and upset the GII West Virginia Derby with Soul Warrior (Lion Heart). **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#), the [brisnet.com PPs](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#). It didn't come easy, but Seventh Street picked up a second Grade I score with this determined effort. The chestnut, a troubled second in the Feb. 14 GI Barbara Fritchie H. at Laurel, rebounded with a break-out score in the Apr. 4 GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn, but she ran into a buzzsaw in Seattle Smooth (Quiet American) in the June 13 GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont last time out and had to be satisfied with second once again. Seventh Street was the second choice to get back to the winner's circle here. Sent up to press longshot Color Me Up (Aptitude) through the early splits, she drifted wide when taking the lead at the top of the lane, giving Spritely room to motor on the rail. That rival shot through and opened some daylight, but Seventh Street found another gear, catching Spritely in the waning yards before edging clear. Favored Miss Isella closed late to be second. Placed in two Classics last term, Goldikova bagged a first top-level triumph in last year's renewal of this event before winning the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp in September and the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita the following month. She was compromised by testing conditions when seventh, her only off-the-board effort, in the May 17 G1 Prix d'Ispahan back at Longchamp on seasonal return, but regained the winning habit in the July 8 G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket. Positioned directly behind stablemate and pacemaker Only Green (Ire) (Green Desert), the bay homebred enjoyed a windbreak until cruising past her fading rabbit on the run to the final quarter mile. She passed the eighth pole clear, and in total command, was afforded the luxury of gearing down late to allow Elusive Wave to be flattered by proximity. Night Magic turned this seemingly open affair into a procession with a dominating front-running display under Karoly Kerekes. Third in the Junioren-Preis over a mile here at the end of her juvenile campaign in September, the dark bay returned to be third when taking on colts in the G3 Albert von Metzler-Rennen at Frankfurt May 3. She filled that spot again in Hoppegarten's G2 Diana-Trial May 31 before finally gaining black-type success in the G3 Grosser Preis der Jungheinrich Gabelstapler at Hamburg last time July 3. Sent straight to the head of affairs here, she steadily built a sizeable advantage and had her immediate chasers in trouble by the turn into the straight. Maintaining a fierce gallop all the way to the line, she was beyond recall as **TDN Rising Star** Soberania emerged from the pack to claim the silver medal. While reigning G1 Dubai World Cup hero Well Armed took the lion's share of the crowd's money, it was another son of Tiznow, former claimer Informed, who stole the show here. A well-beaten seventh on the World Cup undercard in the G2 Godolphin Mile Mar. 28, Informed was a solid fourth in the GIII Alysheba S. in his return to the U.S. Sent off a big 14-1 outsider in the GII Californian H. at Hollywood June 13, Informed defeated Rail Trip (Jump Start) by 3/4 lengths, but could do no better than sixth to that foe in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 11. The distant second choice to 3-5 pick Well Armed, Informed was smartly placed in the slipstream of pacesetter Mast Track in the early going. After a half in :47 and three-quarters in 1:10 4/5, Informed was switched to the outside and, put to a drive, chased down Mast Track. "He'd been training really good down here and he loves this racetrack," said trainer Doug O'Neill, who haltered Informed for his current connections for just \$25,000 at Hollywood in June of 2008. O'Neill added that the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Sept. 6 would be the next target. Well Armed was making his first start since his record triumph in the World Cup in March and struggled home last of eight under Aaron Gryder. "I don't think it was the 'Dubai bounce,'" said Gryder. "On the backside I asked him to move a little bit and he just never grabbed the bridle. By the top of the stretch, the race was away from him. He'll be back."

Justenuffhumor, off the board on the Keeneland Poly in his lone start at two, switched to the turf for his sophomore bow at Gulfstream Jan. 14 and graduated by 1 1/2 lengths. He added an allowance win at the Hallandale oval Mar. 28 before shipping north and taking optional claimers at the Big A Apr. 25 and at Belmont June 17, and the bay was bidding to make it a perfect five-for-five on the spinach in his stakes bow here. Justenuffhumor reared just before the break, but was ready for the start and was content to sit off the pace as Cowboy Cal cut out sensible fractions. He loomed boldly while tucked in at the rail on the turn and dove through a gap between the pacesetter and Mambo Meister at the eighth pole, drawing off in the final 70 yards to win handily. She's just a racing machine."

He started out easy and he didn't need a whole lot." Einstein recorded early splits of :12.80, :25.60, :38.20 and :50 Saturday before galloping out three-quarters of 1:16.20.

Winner of the last two renewals of Churchill's GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic and hero of the GI Santa Anita H. in March, Einstein ran fifth in last year's Million after a stumbling start, and Pitts-Blasi knows he can't afford any miscues this time around. "It's going to be very tough," she said. "There are a lot of nice horses in there, and it's probably a lot tougher than it was last year, I think." She added, "It would mean a lot to win the Million. There's a lot of prestige to the Arlington Million. With what happened last year and as hard as he tries, you always want the best for him." He has been tabbed at 4-1 in the early Million line, behind 5-2 choice Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat), he comes into the race off a tally in the GI Man o'War S. at Belmont July 11.
