Coming Out Party for Lillie...

Starting out over six furlongs at Naas May 13, Lillie Langtry deserved credit when a troubled second to Kitty Kiernan (GB) (Pivotal {GB}). She met that rival again in the June 1 G3 Coolmore Stud Fillies' Sprint S. back over the same track and trip and turned around the 2 1/2-length deficit with a convincing win by the same margin. Heavily backed at the Royal meeting, she joined the list of juveniles to sacrifice their chances by chasing the U.S. contender--after trying to stay close to Aegean (Northern Afleet), she let eventual G3 Albany S. winner Habaayib (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}) through to land the spoils. That effort did not deter the bettors, who backed her down to odds-on here. Settled at the back by Johnny Murtagh after breaking well, she slipped between rivals in early stretch to arrive on the tail of Devoted to You inside the final quarter. Taken wide around that rival, Lille Langtry required just two slaps with the whip to settle the result in the final 125 yards. She was hand ridden thereafter and firmly on top at the line. "We gave her a little rest after Ascot and Johnny gave her a lovely confident ride, switching her off and letting her enjoy herself," Aidan O'Brien said. "She has a great turn of gear and has always shown that, but she also relaxes very well, and hopefully, will get a mile. The G1 Moyglare Stud S. [The Curragh Aug. 30] is the plan if all goes well." O'Brien added, "We are delighted with Devoted to You, who was coming back a little bit quick here after Galway. She won't mind going a bit further."

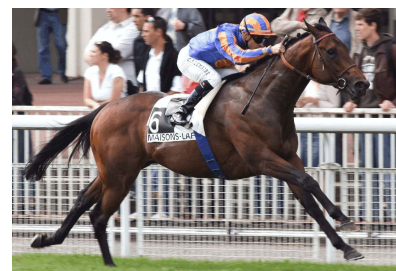
Naaqoos on Course for Sunday...

Trainer Freddy Head yesterday confirmed **Naaqoos (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) would head to Deauville's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest Sunday. Successful in the last three renewals of the 6 1/2-furlong contest with Marchand d'Or (Fr) (Marchand de Sable), the Chantilly-based conditioner said of Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner, "Naaqoos is on target for the Prix Maurice de Gheest and he is very well in himself at the moment. I don't think that dropping down to 6 1/2 furlongs will be a problem--he has a lot of speed and it could turn out to be a good distance for him. I have always thought highly of Naaqoos, and he could turn out to be a real top-class colt. We will certainly consider the Breeders' Cup for him if he runs well at Deauville--the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint could be an option for him--but it's obviously some way off at the moment. We will see how he gets on Sunday before deciding where to go next with him."

From three seasons to race in Europe, the bay, who was rated the top-weight on the Irish Free Handicap at 5-7 furlongs at three and four, won five times and finished in the money in five additional starts, including the G1 Prix de la Foret, G1 July Cup S., G3 Jersey S. and G3 Gladness S. Brought stateside for his five-year-old season, U S Ranger made three starts and was a close-up third in the 1 1/16-mile GIII Inglewood H. at Hollywood Park Apr. 18. He retires with five wins and two seconds and earnings of \$483,607.

Earned a big figure over this track as a two year old, and finally broke through that level in her seasonal debut, winning an allowance at Churchill. Her last was another slight new top, and with only two points of development from her two year old best, she could be ready now for the race of her life. Trainer James Baker is hot (see "Last 90 days"), and this filly is very usable at a price.

2 Cat Moves [Tale of the Cat](#) Velazquez 122

Ran well in her debut, earned a stakes-level figure to win an allowance at Delaware, then exploded with a big one to win the GI Prioress S. Anthony Dutrow is on fire recently (see "Last 90 days"), and if this filly pairs up that figure, she'll be right in the thick of things. However, a slight bounce is more likely, and at the weights that would bounce her right out of the exacta.

3 Olde Glamour Kelly Kip Luzzi 116

Has done a lot of developing this year, and ran her best race yet to win an overnight stakes last time out. But that effort isn't nearly fast enough to make an impact here, and as George Gilmore sings, "This is as far as I go," at least for a while.

4 Heart Ashley [Lion Heart](#) Asmussen 118

Jumped to a big one back in March and the effort took its toll, with her next two not nearly as good. In the Prioress, however, she was pushed to a :21 2/5 quarter, and the pace here figures to be much softer. With five months since the big effort, Heart Ashley should be ready to start heading forward again, and that makes her a threat here.

5 First Passage [Giant's Causeway](#) Garcia 118

Started moving forward as soon as she left Gulfstream, which happens a lot with Marty Wolfson trainees. She earned an almost Rachelesque figure last time out while racing wide in a very fast race, and is almost sure to bounce now. However, a) she can bounce four points and still have a good shot to win here, and b) when Wolfson leaves Florida his horses almost always run well. Strong contender.

6 Flashing [A.P. Indy](#) Migliore 118

Ran a couple of good ones this spring for Tom Albertrani, then not nearly as well for Saeed bin Suroor, which has been true of several that have made that transition. This filly will have to show us she's still capable of those good figures, and even if she is, it only makes her a borderline contender.

7 Reforestation [Forestry](#) Coa 116

Improved four starts back and has stayed at that level since. This is a very healthy filly with a chance for a minor award just by doing what she has been, but the amount she has developed already makes further short-term development unlikely.

8 All of Her Twist [Forest Wildcat](#) Maragh 116

Wasn't much as a juvenile, got better this spring, then ran stakes-level figures in her last two. This filly, Pretty Prolific and Reforestation are similar in recent ability, but this one is the least likely to make the necessary forward move because she's developed the most already.

Bottom Line: This race is very bettable if you are willing to take a stand against Cat Moves as the favorite, and we are. Heart Ashley and First Passage are very fast on their good ones, and Pretty Prolific is a very live longshot.

PARAGALLO INDICTED Owner Ernie Paragallo has been indicted on 35 misdemeanor counts of animal cruelty, 13 more than he was charged with when arrested in April, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Each count carries a maximum penalty of a \$1,000 fine and one year in jail, but the maximum jail sentence can't exceed two years. The 51-year-old is scheduled to be arraigned in Greene County Court in New York Aug. 18. District Attorney Terry Wilhelm explained to *DRF* the reason for presenting these misdemeanors to a grand jury for indictment, which is not common. "It was our opinion that the proper venue was county court because of the seriousness of the charges and the likelihood that this will lead to litigation," Wilhelm told the publication.

TRF Appoints Williams and Ludt:

The Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation announced yesterday the unanimous election of Robin Traywick Williams as president and Tom Ludt as chairman. Williams, formerly chairperson of the National Racing Compact and director of the Association of Racing Commissioners International, succeeds Johnathan Miller, who stepped down as president after a three-year term. Ludt is president of Vinery, a member of the Breeders' Cup's board of directors, and a member of the TRF's executive committee. "I am pleased and honored to be named the next president of the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation," Williams said. "Johnathan led the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation through a period of transition and I'm looking forward to working with the Board of Directors in continuing to move this great organization to the next level." Williams, a native of Lynchburg, Virginia and graduate of Hollins University, served for 10 years on the Virginia Racing Commission where she helped oversee the advent of horse racing. During that time she also was elected as director of the board of the Association of Racing Commissioners International and to the board of the North American Pari-Mutuel Regulators Association. Williams is credited with initiating the national racing license project and served for four years as chairperson of the National Racing Compact, which issued the first national license in 2000. Her involvement with the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation dates back several years. In 2007 she organized the James River chapter of the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation, where inmates at the James River Work Center care for retired Thoroughbreds while learning life and vocational skills.

Williams's election as president follows in the footsteps of the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation's new working relationships with the New York Racing Association (NYRA), Jockeys' Guild, New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association (NYTHA) and The Jockey Club. "It is a new era for horse retirement," said TRF's executive director Diana Pikulski. "TRF's success over the last 30 years is now front and center in racing, and this new executive team is perfect to establish the funding and infrastructure we need to fulfill our mission going forward." Ludt was named GM of Vinery in 2005 before being named president in 2008. He's currently a member of the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority and was chairman of the Blue Ribbon Panel of the Jockey's Workers' Compensation Insurance Committee. He's also currently a board member of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association.

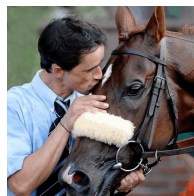
