## NO TELLING AT GRAVEYARD OF FAVORITES

The expression "it's anybody's race" is trotted out from time to time, but it would have been tough to back **Telling** (A.P. Indy) in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational yesterday at Saratoga. Dismissed at 33-1, the Chicago shipper shrugged off a 10-race losing streak and rallied boldly up the center of the course to claim the trophy. "The owner [Alex Lieblong] picked it out," said winning trainer Steve Hobby, who was making his first trip to

Saratoga. "We [entered] a small stake in Chicago and we scratched to run in this. I figured it was the time to try now. For me, it's a great thrill. He was training so well and he really moves up in the mile and a half. We figured if he can't do it now, he'll never do it." Lieblong added, "We knew we were in tough. We didn't think we were over our heads. I thought coming up here with the jockey colony you have, it wasn't going to be a problem [getting a rider]. It's fun having a horse like this, but it's hard to find mile-and-a-half races. Steve does such a wonderful job with the horses." **Cont. p6**

home in today's Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville. The lackluster seasonal return of the Wertheimers' homebred in the May 17 G1 Prix d'Ispahan seems a distant memory after her latest rout of overmatched rivals over this track and trip. "She has done very well since her last run and I couldn't have her better," said trainer Freddy Head. "She is a fantastic filly who is very easy to ride and

does what you want. She was very impressive last time and is something special, but no horse is invincible, and sometimes they can have an off-day. I'm going to be very disappointed if she gets beaten." **Cont. p10**

## PIVOTAL FILLY TOPS DAY TWO

Arqana's August Yearling Sale continued its forward momentum yesterday when a daughter of Pivotal (GB) topped proceedings at €300,000. As he had on the first day, Darley representative John Ferguson made an early impact when outlasting the opposition for the February-foaled chestnut, who is out of the listed-winning and G1 Oaks d'Italia fourth Relais d'Aumale (GB) (Rainbow Quest). The previous day's topper, the son of Storm Cat, had failed to meet his reserve as a weanling, and that was the case again with Haras des Capucines' **hip 121**, who had been led out unsold at 85,000 guineas at Tattersalls December. "This filly is an excellent mover, and her sire Pivotal gives more than his share of top fillies," Ferguson said. "She was indeed an attractive package." The agent also struck late in the session for Haras de la Louviere's **hip 228**, an April-foaled colt by Invincible Spirit (Ire). Out of the listed-placed Priere (GB) (Machiavellian), he was purchased for €260,000. **Arqana cont. p2-5**

**Love for Louviere...**

Lord and Lady O'Reilly's Haras de la Louviere were among the most successful vendors during the second day, and enjoyed a strong start as well as the finish which saw the sale of the abovementioned Invincible Spirit (Ire) colt. Just minutes into the session, Anthony Stroud paid €280,000 for their son of Cape Cross (Ire), [hip 127](#), whose dam is the listed-winning and group-placed Seralia (GB) (Royal Academy) and who has produced the 2002 G3 Prix de Psyche winner Serisia (Fr) (Exit to Nowhere). "This colt is a very good mover by a solid sire, and Lady O'Reilly's breeding operation is top class," Stroud commented. "There is every chance that he will remain in training in France, but we shall decide that later." The operation's [hip 204](#), a Red Ransom half-brother to this year's G3 Prix Penelope scorer and G1 Prix de Diane fourth Celimene (Ire) (Dr Fong) was snapped up by Gerard Laboureau for €220,000.

Shadwell France, who are one of this sale's leading buyers, were prominent again on day two and paid €280,000 apiece for a pair of well-connected colts. [Hip 208](#) is a son of Redoute's Choice (Aus), sire of

Shadwell's recent G1 Blue Diamond S. winner Nadeem (Aus). The January-foaled bay, from the draft of Haras d'Etream, is out of a half to the 2006 GI Del Mar Debutante S. winner Point Ashley (Point Given) and dual stakes scorer Raw Gold (Rahy). Seven lots later, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's operation secured Haras des Capucines' Oasis Dream (GB)

offering ([hip 215](#)), whose pedigree includes the dual group winner War Declaration (Ire) (Persian Bold {Ire}). Earlier, Shadwell paid €230,000 for Newsells Park Stud's [hip 195](#), a Medicean (GB) colt from the family of sires Laveron (GB) and Laveron (GB). Lomitas (GB) features on this page, alongside last year's G1 Prix de l'Opera heroine Lady Marian (Ger) (Nayef).

"Certainly, there are less good horses than on the first day, but still enough left to choose potentially good animals," Shadwell racing manager Angus Gold explained. "We really liked the Redoute's Choice. Obviously, Shadwell had some luck with that same sire in Australia, and he is out of a Kingmambo mare. He had a good walk and a lovely head and, hopefully, he will be a two-year-old. Of the Medicean, we know that he can sire good horses. He might take plenty of time to mature, but will become a lovely three-year-old, and he's from a good German family. We will now take all our buys to England and will have another look at them after the Newmarket sales and decide where they will go to be trained."

Marc-Antoine Berghgracht was in action to secure Haras du Mezeray's [hip 150](#), a daughter of Galileo (Ire) whose second dam is the triple Group 1 winner Hatoof (Irish River {Fr}). From the extended family of Mrs. Penny and her descendant Mrs. Lindsay (Theatrical {Ire}), the April-foaled bay cost €240,000. "Galileo is an exceptional sire, and this filly hails from a very good family," Berghgracht said. "She will be trained in Chantilly by Richard Gibson for a Russian client, Mr. Valentin Bukhtoyarov, and we

feel that considering the market, we didn't overpay for her."

Early signs are that Hurricane Run (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) will be making an impact during the yearling sales season and Peter Doyle became one of his latest admirers when purchasing [hip 144](#), a Capucines-consigned son of the 1997 G3 Premio Umbria scorer Uruk (GB) (Efisio {GB}). She has produced the smart graded stakes place-getter Urban King (Ire) (Desert King {Ire}) and cost the agent €210,000. That price was matched by FIPS for Haras de la Reboursiere et de Montaignu's [hip 207](#), an April-foaled Montjeu (Ire) colt out of the listed winner Maid of Dawkins (Ire) (Kendor {Fr}) from the extended family of Grey Swallow (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}). FIPS's agent Gilles Forien said, "The Marquesa [Sol de Moratalla] did not buy two years ago, but was back last season and again today. The market is good for buyers at the moment. All these lots will be shared between her two main trainers in Chantilly, Alain de Royer-Dupre and Mikel Delzangles, and also other trainers in the Southwest, as she does usually." The last of the Dansilis to sell this week and the only representative of Juddmonte's proven sire during today's session, this filly is out of a half to the sire Zayyani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}). Under the third dam Zahra (Ire) is the now legendary Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar).

Diyawara has produced the 2007 G1 Prix de Diane third Diyakalanie (Fr) (Ashkalani {Ire}) and group scorer Dilek (Fr) (Sendawar {Ire}), who after being sold by the Aga Khan has made an impact in Hong Kong as Viva Macau. The page includes some top-class middle-distance performers and stayers from a proven Aga Khan family, including the 1997 G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Prix Royal-Oak heroine Ebadiyla (Ire) (Sadler's Wells).

**330, c, Hurricane Run (Ire)--Mare Aux Fees (GB),

A colt from the first crop of the 2005 Arc hero sold for €520,000 on Friday and this is a well-connected offering who should command attention. His half-siblings include last year's G3 Prix Vanteaux winner Belle Allure (Ire) (Numerous), while his close relation is Jukebox Jury (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}). The latter added last Saturday's G3 Rose of Lancaster S. to his G2 Royal Lodge S. success to prove a timely and significant update.

### PRIVATE SALES IMPACT FTSAUG FINAL FIGS

In an effort to further increase transparency at their sales, officials at Fasig-Tipton began publicizing private sales of horses originally bought back and including those sales in their final sales summaries. It is a decision which has a predominantly negative statistical impact on the average and median, the chief barometers of success, while adding to the overall turnover. The final sheets issued after Tuesday night's second and final session of the Saratoga Selected Yearling Sale included revised stats and reflected the private sale of nine horses that were originally led out of the ring unsold Monday evening. Those sales increased the numbers to 85 horses sold for gross receipts of \$26,789,000, an increase of 5.1 percent. The re-computed average of \$315,171 and median of \$230,000 represented decreases of six and eight percent, respectively, from the original figures. The most expensive of the horses sold privately and reported by Tuesday was [hip 117](#), a Bernardini (A.P. Indy) half-brother to champion Spain (Thunder Gulch), which was purchased for \$300,000 by Donald Dizney. He failed to meet his reserve on a bid of \$350,000 Monday evening.

Bred by Darley, Telling debuted with a third-place finish for trainer Eoin Harty in an Arlington maiden in June 2007. The runner-up that day, Mountain Stag (Running Stag), was owned by the Lieblongs and trained by Steve Hobby, and they must have seen something they liked. The Arkansas-based couple acquired Telling privately and the bay ran second for them next time out at Hawthorne in November. Sent to Oaklawn, the regally bred colt rattled off three straight wins, then made a successful return to Arlington in a turf allowance last May in what would be his most recent trip to the winner's circle. Telling notched a second in the GIII Stars and Stripes H. last July and later ran third in both the GIII Sycamore S. at Keeneland Oct. 18 and GIII River City H. at Churchill Nov. 22. Second in a Keeneland allowance in his 2009 opener Apr. 9, he completed the exacta in the Chester House S. a month later at Arlington. He ran sixth in The Tin Man S. June 6 over the same course, and most recently finished a close fifth to Just as Well (A.P. Indy) in the GIII Arlington H. July 11. Never too far from the swift splits of :23.48 and :46.80, Telling skimmed the rail under rider Javier Castellano. He began to edge forward after a mile in 1:36.02 and came off the rail to deliver his challenge. The five-year-old hit the front approaching the eighth marker and held sway over grizzled veterans Better Talk Now and Brass Hat."

Meteore put in several good tries in a trio of turf outings, interspersed with a pair of desultory efforts on the main tracks at Del Mar and Santa Anita. After two close third-place finishes at Arcadia Feb. 20 and Mar. 13, the chestnut finally broke through in a one-mile maiden on the Santa Anita spinach Apr. 9. He was given a brief break, but wasted no time clearing his first condition with a rallying win on the Hollywood sod June 11. Sent off as the 9-5 favorite in Del Mar's traditional opening day feature, the Oceanside S. July 22, the well-bred colt got caught a bit wide and wound up fifth, but was ready to make amends this time. Alex Solis allowed his mount to caboose the field for the opening six furlongs as New Bay (Cuvee) attempted to take it all the way on the front end. Meteore advanced between rivals on the far turn, angled out in the lane and finished up strongly to secure his first black-type success. "We thought he was too close to the pace in the Oceanside, and so we wanted to take farther back today," reported winning trainer Richard Mandella. "I guess it worked. He came out of that race with a bruised foot, also, and I wasn't sure we were going to be able to run in this race. We took his shoes off and poulticed the foot for a while, and he responded real quickly. He sort of pushed us to run here." The Wertheimers acquired Meteor Miracle with this colt in utero for \$740,000 at KEENOV in 2006.

Having perched himself on top of the World Rankings with an emphatic success in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 28, Godolphin's **Gladiatorus** (Silic {Fr}) was displaced after a disappointing latest effort when sixth in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 16. He deserves another chance to shine, and the team could not be in better form at present. "We were disappointed with him the first time he ran in England at Ascot, but he has had some time since then and now we think he is doing good," Saeed bin Suroor commented. "His work has been good, he's in good form and we are expecting a good run. The ground should be fine for him." Having taken the Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp in which Goldikova flopped, Daniel-Yves Treves's **Never on Sunday (Fr)** (Sunday Break {Jpn}) was third behind Vision d'Etat (Fr) (Chichicastenango {Fr}) and Tartan Bearer (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}) in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. York remained dry over the first part of the weekend despite earlier forecasts, which is almost certain to ensure the participation of Christopher Tsui's **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in Tuesday's G1 Juddmonte International. Clerk of the Course William Derby revealed yesterday morning that the expected heavy rainfall did not materialise and was encouraged by the outlook over the days leading up to the Ebor festival's highlight. "It's a bright, sunny day on the Knavesmire, and the current ground is currently good-to-firm, with no overnight rain," Derby said. "The rain stayed to the north of us and, although there are a few showers about over the weekend, it looks a promising picture for next week."

**Summer Bird Breezes on Dirt...**

G1 Belmont S. hero **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) drilled five furlongs in 1:01.97 over Saratoga's main track yesterday morning. He galloped out in 1:14.67. Jockey Kent Desormeaux was in the irons aboard the chestnut, who most recently ran second to Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the Aug. 2 G1 Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park. "I wasn't looking for a whole lot," trainer Tim Ice said. "If he went slower or faster...as long as he was doing it on his own, that's all that matters." Summer Bird has become accustomed to the attention associated with a Classic victory. "He thinks he's a movie star," said Ice. "That's what's so great about a horse like him. He enjoys shipping, he enjoys people, nothing bothers him. That's one of the advantages I have with this colt. Nothing gets to him." As for the three-year-old's condition following his trip to the Jersey Shore, Ice offered, "He lost a little bit of weight coming out of the Haskell, which I thought he would, running as hard as he did. He's putting weight back on. I'm not at all disappointed in the way he looks."

for the race," trainer Christophe Clement noted. "She has been training well for the race. She went out to the paddock after training [Saturday]." Clement added, "I don't know if I plan to breeze her. I may just have her gallop into the race. I have to think about it. If I do give her a workout, it will be an easy one." Among her possible ri-

vals in the Alabama is **Gossip Girl** (Dynaformer), but the connections of that GI American Oaks winner are unsure about sending their star on dirt. "I don't want to take a step back; she's got a lot of confidence in herself," trainer Tom Albertrani said. "Outside of Rachel Alexandra...we've seen she's one of the top fillies on grass, but on the dirt, we don't know that. If she were to run well [on dirt], it opens up [things] for her as a broodmare prospect." Prior to her win over the Hollywood turf course in the American Oaks, the dark bay captured the GII Sands Point S. on the Belmont sod, and was also narrowly beaten in the GI Ashland S. on Keeneland's Polytrack. "We're nominated for the GII Lake Placid [Aug. 21], the Alabama and the [GI] Garden City [at Belmont Sept. 12]," Albertrani commented. "We're looking at all three of these races. She's still a little light [after the hard run in California]. I want to give her some time before [her next] race."

**Blame Bound for Super Derby...**

Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Blame** (Arch), who made it two straight in the Curlin S. at Saratoga Aug. 2, will make his next appearance in the GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs Sept. 19, according to *Daily Racing Form*. His connections had been considering the GI Shadwell Travers S. Aug. 29. "We're going to follow along the same lines as his dad," trainer Al Stall Jr. told *DRF*. Arch captured the Super Derby, then a Grade I,

in Claiborne's colors in 1998. Prior to his Curlin success, Blame took a first-level allowance on a night card at Churchill July 2.

**Gayego Set for Allowance Return...**

**Gayego** (Gilded Time), unraced since a runner-up effort to Godolphin stablemate Two Step Salsa (Petionville) in the G2 Godolphin Mile Mar. 28, is scheduled to make his return to the races in a six-furlong allowance Monday afternoon with the option to enter for a claiming price of \$100,000. The 2008 winner of the GII Arkansas Derby, Gayego was purchased privately at the tail end of last year before being sent to Dubai. In his first start under new management, the dark bay annexed the Mar. 5 G3 Mahab al Shimaal S., a prep for the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, but ran in the Mile instead, finishing 2 1/4 lengths adrift of his stable companion. "He could probably use another work or two, but the other race for him up here is the [seven-furlong GI] Forego [S. Sept. 5], and we've got **Pyro** (Pulpit) for that and Darley has **Past the Point** (Indian Charlie)," said Rick Mettee, Godolphin's North American racing manager and assistant to Suroor. "So why have three in that?" Mettee is especially impressed by the colt's versatility. "He can do so many things; he does six to nine [furlongs], dirt or Poly," he commented. "It can get a little tricky, but the good thing is he's got Poly form, too, and he acts like a horse that could go on the grass, too." Chief among the opposition Monday is **Lantana Mob** (Posse), a dual Grade III winner in 2008 who makes his seasonal debut.

In other developments from the Godolphin stable, both **Cocoa Beach (Chi)** (Doneraile Court) and Pyro had works Saturday morning. Prepping for the GII Ballston Spa H. on the Shadwell Travers Day undercard, Cocoa Beach went a half-mile in :48.97 beneath jockey Ramon Dominguez. The five-year-old took the De La Rose S. Aug. 5 in her most recent appearance. With Hall of Fame jockey Angel Cordero up, Pyro went four furlongs in a more leisurely :50.14. "He's not a great work horse, but I was still happy with it," Mettee said. "Angel was pleased with him. He'll probably have two more works before the Forego." In his first start of 2009 and first in Godolphin blue, Pyro was runner-up in the July 29 James Marvin S. **Atomic Rain** (Smart Strike), a recent addition to the Godolphin team, is training every day at the Spa, but is not certain to face the starter again this season. "We may or may not run him at Belmont in the fall before he goes to Dubai. We'll see what happens," Mettee said. Atomic Rain was last seen finishing a distant sixth behind Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI Haskell Invitational S. Aug. 2.


