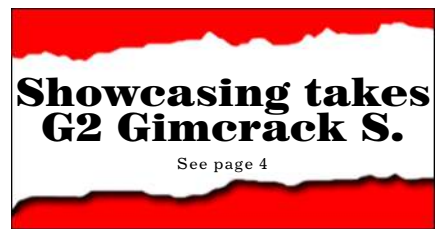

## 'WORST' PROVES BEST IN ADIRONDACK

**Worstcasescenario** (Forbidden Apple) was overlooked in the betting at 13-1 in yesterday's GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga, but she belied those inflated odds when she strode home an easy 4 1/4-length winner. Favorite **Dashing Debby** (Medaglia d'Oro) broke sharply and zipped through quick opening splits of :21.49 and :44.32 as Worstcasescenario was content to settle a length back in second. Ready to pounce at the top of the stretch, the Klaravich

## ISN'T THAT SPECIAL?

With the juvenile racing season already in full swing, the boys take center stage in this afternoon's GII Saratoga Special S. at Saratoga Race Course. A field of nine has been tabbed for the 6 1/2-furlong test, and among this year's participants is **Flatter Than Me** (Flatter), runner-up in his most recent start in the six-furlong GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill Downs July 3. The Merrill Scherer and Daniel Lynch-owned colt, who scored in his career bow over the Louisville oval Apr. 29, finished fourth in the mud following a problematic trip over that track June 11. The dark bay comes into this off a series of sharp works, including a five-panel move in :58 2/5, the fastest of 22 at the Spa Aug. 14.

A 7 1/4-length winner in his debut in a rain-soaked maiden at Calder May 23, the chestnut showed plenty of early speed, but came up a 1/2-length short of the victory in his final start for trainer Joe Calascibetta in the six-furlong Frank Gomez Memorial S. at the Miami-area oval July 11. Jockey Edgar Prado, aboard for the colt's latest start, returns here for new trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. Also likely to appreciate an off track is Churchill shipper **Thiskyhasnolimit** (Sky Mesa). Runner-up to subsequent GSW Backtalk (Smarty Jones) in a fove-furlong maiden at Churchill June 11, the dark bay romped by seven lengths most recently in a sloppy, six furlong test July 4.

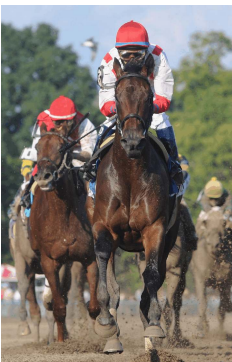

Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence, and trainer Rick Violette Jr.--retribution here after having to endure the nightmarish trip of their promising colt Bulls and Bears (Holy Bull), who had to settle for fifth in the Spa's opening week feature, the GII Sanford S. July 30. "It was the best case scenario, absolutely," quipped Violette Jr. "She broke so sharply--I thought we'd be three or four lengths back at the beginning of the race. The meet hasn't been really favorable to speed, so I didn't want to see her hooked

with anybody. [Jockey] Alan [Garcia] did the right thing and let the favorite (Dashing Debby) run up inside her. She just kept moving stronger and stronger, around the turn he kind of edged up, and then she just took off and opened up on everybody. She's obviously a pretty nice filly to have." As for what may lie ahead, McPeck added, "We'll point her toward the [GI] Spinaway S. [Sept. 6], the [GIII Arlington Washington] Lassie [S. Sept. 5], or something like that."

Showcasing shaped with much promise on debut when second to the subsequent G2 July S. winner Arcano (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) at Newbury June 11 before taking his maiden easily to earn **TDN Rising Star** status at Yarmouth July 2. Missing Goodwood because of the rain, the homebred was tardy from the gates here and raced in rear before finding his extra gears to inhale Taajub passing the furlong pole. Pushed out to assert from there, the bay stretched to a convincing success and dipped under the course record in the process. "He's a lovely horse who is going the right way about things," jockey Jimmy Fortune said. "He relaxed nicely today and that's the way you want these sprinters to be. I would say he'll definitely get an extra furlong." Trainer John Gosden told *PA Sport*, "He is a lot like his father Oasis Dream-- he is very laid back, the same build as him and certainly the best Oasis Dream I've had. He is very quick at home, yet he went to sleep a bit in the first half of the race. We will take the same route as his father and go for the G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 2] He is a proper speed horse. At this moment, this boy tells me he is a sprinter, that's what he says right now." Taajub is being aimed at the Weatherbys Insurance S., while Monsieur Chevalier is set to renew rivalry with the winner in the Middle Park.

Askar Tau bagged five straight handicaps before closing his sophomore season with a fourth in the stamina-sapping Cesarewitch H. at Newmarket Oct. 18. His reappearance this term was delayed by trainer Marcus Tregoning's self-imposed shutdown, and he eventually came back to finish eighth in the July 30 G2 Goodwood Cup last time. Fitted with a first time visor for this, he responded to stretch-long urging to register a career high in determined fashion. Askar Tau was positioned last of the five runners, but came under pressure with six furlongs to run and turned for home in fourth. Responding to continued pressure in the straight to challenge Royal and Regal--who had cruised to the front at the two pole--with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, he soon had that rival's measure and was driven out to hold the rallying effort of Drill Sergeant. "I think he quite enjoyed picking them up in the straight and I knew he had the measure of Royal and Regal," commented jockey Ryan Moore. "I haven't ridden him before, but I know he generally races on and off the bridle. Maybe the visor helped him concentrate, but I'm not sure for certain if it helped or not."

## NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



### TOWN HALL MEETINGS INFLUENCE LEGISLATORS

The health care reform debate continues to rage as passionate constituents overrun town hall meetings hosted by members of Congress. Democratic House leaders originally pushed to have a reform bill passed before lawmakers went home for the August recess, but those plans changed when conservative Democrats hesitated and wanted feedback from constituents.

Lawmakers now say they are working toward an end-of-September vote, with more debate scheduled when the House reconvenes the day after Labor Day.

At the center of issue is the so-called public option. It calls for a government-run insurance plan to compete with private companies. Some influential House members are opposed to any bill that does not include a public option and are prepared to stand firm. However, there is evidence that the administration is backing off its position on this being included in the overhaul. Both Department of Health and Human Services Secretary Kathleen Sebelius and President Obama publicly made such comments in the past week.

At three, he won the G2 Clasico Coronel Miguel F. Martinez and was fourth in the Argentine classic G1 Gran Premio Polla de Potrillos. He was third in this year's G1 Estrellas Mile and came here off a fourth in the July 24 G2 Clasico Peru. The winner, campaigned by breeder Jorge Cardemil's Haras Futuro, was imported to Argentina in utero. His dam is a half-sister to Grade I winner Danger's Hour (Coastal). Heading the opposition to Sariska is Lord Lloyd-Webber's **Dar Re Mi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}), who was runner-up to Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in this race rescheduled to Newmarket 12 months ago. Admirably consistent, the homebred was also runner-up in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September and third in the G2 Prix de Royallieu back there the following month. Beaten a short head by Crystal Capella (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) on her return in the G3 Middleton S. over an extended 10 furlongs here May 14, she was on the right end of the photo in The Curragh's G1 Pretty Polly S. last time June 27. "Obviously, Sariska is a very good filly, but hopefully, she will run well," the Lloyd-Webbers' Racing Manager Simon Marsh told *PA Sport*. "Sariska was absolutely incredible in the Irish Oaks. We give her the utmost respect, but you shouldn't duck one opponent. One thing is that she has yet to run over her optimum trip of a mile and a half this season--she has run twice over a mile and a quarter so far." Jeff Smith's one-eyed **Barshiba (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) has improved since stepping up to this trip and rattled off a brace of wins in the July 4 G2 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock and Listed Plantation Stud S. at Newmarket a fortnight later before finishing fourth back over 10 furlongs in Goodwood's G1 Nassau S. last time Aug. 1. Aidan O'Brien's representatives are always to be feared and Susan Magnier and Diane Nagle's **Tamarind (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) leapfrogged to the top of the pile with a 20-1 success in the G3 Give Thanks S. at Cork on her latest start Aug. 3.

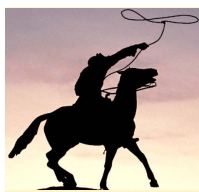

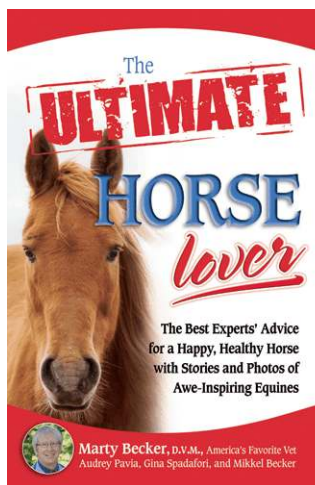

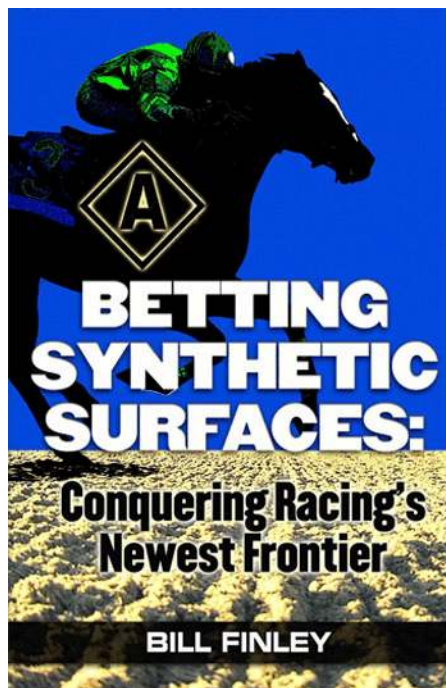

When Kieran McLaughlin received a Medaglia d'Oro--Queen's Lady colt named Iqbaal to train for Shadwell, he did so with some familiarity with the colt's female family. McLaughlin had previously trained his half-brother White Tie (Unbridled's Song), a \$1.3-million Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling who had shown plenty of ability for Darley. "He was very well meant," said McLaughlin. "He had some issues and problems and didn't win, but he was a nice horse. I remember he had a really troubled trip on Belmont Stakes day a year ago [in his debut]."

White Tie didn't factor in two more starts later in the summer. And while that one failed to live up to expectations, perhaps his brother can make amends for the family.

"He's a really nice colt," said McLaughlin after yesterday's race. "Obviously, it took us some time to get him to the races. We had to do throat surgery in February or March because he was having trouble breathing. We thought, coming off the surgery, that we'd start him at Monmouth, because we weren't sure that he was up to facing the quality he would have at Saratoga. But I don't think it would have mattered where we started him, the way he raced today. I think he would have been just about any group of maidens today. I'm glad he ran so well; he's a big, stout, gorgeous horse, and Medaglia d'Oro needs a good colt."

Asked if he was surprised to see the colt run so well at six furlongs, McLaughlin said, "Well, we actually considered running him at a mile before deciding just to drop him in this spot at six furlongs, but he definitely wants to go further. The main issue with that was the breathing, but hopefully that's not an issue. We'll look to run him back in a one-turn mile at Belmont sometime in September."

McLaughlin might well have yet another member of the family in his barn before long. Shadwell's Rick Nichols recently went to \$650,000 to land an Unbridled's Song half-brother to Iqbaal at the Saratoga Sale just over a week ago.

That transaction, along with the sale of Iqbaal for the same amount two years ago, means breeder Dell Ridge Farm has made out fine with dam Queen's Lady. The operation went to \$750,000 for her, with Iqbaal in utero, at the 2005 Fasig-Tipton November Sale, and have sold two of her offspring for a combined \$1.3 million. Queen's Lady did not produce a foal in 2007; brisnet.com does not report a 2009 foal. The 10-year-old mare is a daughter of MGSW Jeano (Fappiano), making her a half-sister to Contrive (Storm Cat), dam of champion Folklore (Tiznow). -L Marquardt

This prestigious and valuable mid-summer jewel among Britain's heritage handicaps witnessed one of the shortest-priced favorites in its long history in Ballydoyle's Changingoftheguard, but it was the dual-purpose mare Sesenta who denied the gamble in a thrilling finish. Settled towards the rear early by rookie rider Gary Carroll, the outsider crept closer out wide as Changingoftheguard and Johnny Murtagh stayed tight on the inside. Getting first run on that rival, who had encountered trouble in running towards the fence, she dug in after garnering the lead in the final 50 yards and had enough in reserve to hold his challenge. "She's only a small filly and so I got shuffled back a little further than I wanted to be, but she's all heart and galloped to the line," Carroll said. "When she got to the front, she was only doing enough until Johnny [Murtagh] came and pushed me a bit further. I tried to ride it like any normal race and things work out if you are on the best horse--I knew the ground was going to be quick and there was a great tailwind which is great for horses picking up." Mullins revealed that Sesenta will be tackling black-type races now and will not return to hurdles, while the runner-up's trainer Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*, "He ran a great race, we will see where we go now, he'll have plenty of options.
