Paul Pompa Jr. stepped up to purchase **D'Funnybone** (D'wildcat) privately after the chestnut colt ran second in a black-type race. at Calder July 11, and was rewarded handsomely with a dominating performance in the GII Saratoga Special S. yesterday afternoon. GET BEHIND MI

Yesterday's G1 Darley Yorkshire Oaks was supposed to be all about the G1 Epsom and Irish Oaks heroine **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), but there was a twist in the tale as that 4-11 favorite was overturned by the street-wise **Dar Re Mi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}). Sent off the 11-2 second choice, Lord Lloyd-Webber's homebred got first run on the slow-starting crowd's choice inside the final three furlongs and made that count as she grimly clung on to score by 3/4 of a length. Adding to her latest G1 Pretty Polly S. success, the bay provided trainer John Gosden with his first trophy in this race. "They set a hell of a pace and Sariska got dead aim on us all the way down the straight, but it's the first time she has met older horses," Gosden noted. Cont. p2-3

So Very Special...

Bred in Florida by Harold Plumley, D'Funnybone aired by 7 1/4 lengths in his May 23 unveiling at Calder, racing for the partnership of Plumley and trainer Joseph Calascibetta. He made just one more start for them, finishing a valiant second to Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil) in the Frank Gomez Memorial S. at Calder July 11, and was brought to Pompa's attention soon afterwards, joining Dutrow's New York string.

D'Funnybone outbroke his rivals in the Special, but rider Edgar Prado elected to rein the youngster in as California invader Tiny Woods (Roman Ruler) dashed through a :21.42 opening quarter. The Florida-bred ranged up on the turn and poked his head in front as they straightened into the lane. Shaken up by Prado, the chestnut opened up stylishly to secure his first black-type trophy. "I was very impressed," Pompa confirmed. "I just like to win, but when they draw off like that at Saratoga, you have to be very satisfied. Edgar did a great job. We knew there was going to be a lot of speed, and that our intention was to sit off, and he executed. That's why Edgar's the best." Pompa indicated that D'Funnybone would make his next start in either the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. Sept. 7 at Saratoga or the GII Futurity S. at Belmont Sept. 19. Dar Re Mi earned **TDN Rising Star** status when recording an impressive maiden success at Sandown last April and encountered tough company at every step thereafter. After wins in Newmarket's Listed Aphrodite S. and Deauville's G3 Prix Minerve in July and August, she ran into Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) when second in this contest staged at Newmarket after heavy rain forced the abandonment of this fixture. She played the bridesmaid to the peerless Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) next time in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp the following month before dipping under that form when third in the G2 Prix de Royallieu back at that track on her final three-year-old outing in October. Back for the G3 Middleton S. over an extended 10 furlongs here May 14, she lost out to Crystal Capella (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) after a battle royal before going one better in the Pretty Polly at The Curragh last time June 27. Settled in fourth early by Jimmy Fortune, she tackled Roman Empress on the front end before the quarter pole and led soon after. As Sariska and Jamie Spencer dug in to her right, Dar Re Mi gave extra to hold her in a pulsating drive. "The plan was to stride on and make Sariska work and also stretch her stamina," Fortune commented. **Cont. p3**

"[Dar Re Mi] is a good galloper with a lot of class and she never knows when she's beaten--we outbattled Sariska in the end," jockey Jimmy Fortune continued. "She ran some great races in defeat last year and she is never going to be flashy and win by three or four lengths--she just wears horses down." John Gosden is aiming for an international campaign from here and added, "We will run in the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 13], where we ran into Zarkava last year and, if she runs a big one there, we will think about something mad like the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4]. There is also [the £\$1.2-million G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 15], so that might make a difference." 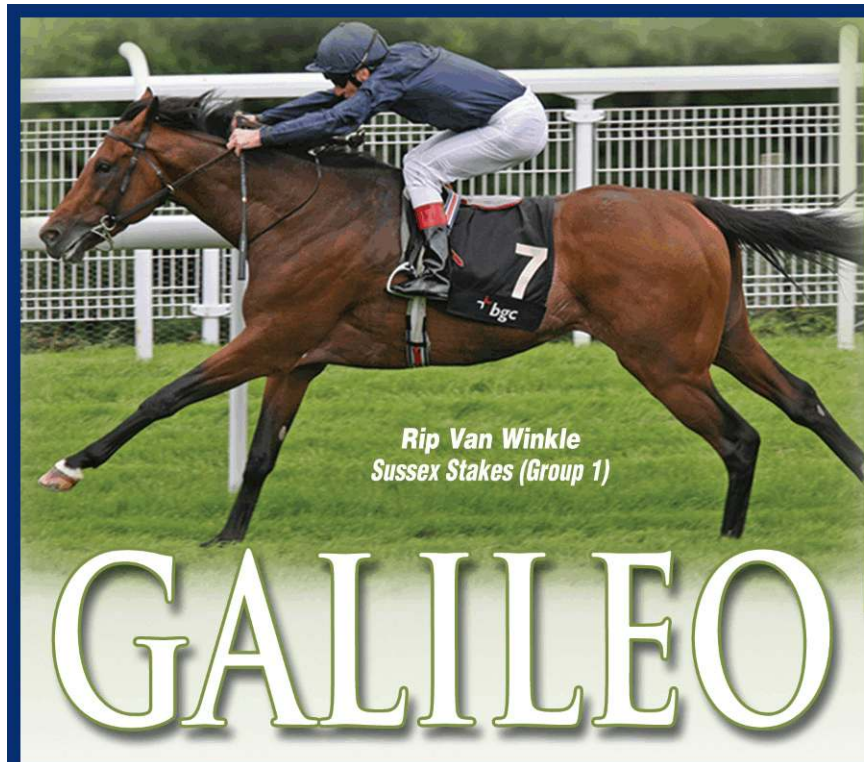

Valid Excuses...

Sariska's trainer Michael Bell later revealed that the dual Classic heroine had come into season. "There were three factors today," Bell explained. "Firstly, the winner is a high-class filly in her own right; secondly, the ground was probably faster than ideal for her and thirdly, she has come into season immediately after the race, and that is probably the most relevant and most significant factor. She showed no signs before the race and who knows whether it affected her performance or not, but I am presuming it did. She was still second, so it's not a disaster and we will take our time to decide what to do. I am still inclined to go for the Arc if it is soft ground, but we'll definitely keep her on her optimum surface from now on."

Lady of the Desert earned a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ tag with an impressive debut score at Leicester May 26, but was no match for **Jealous Again (Trippi)** when sixth in the June 17 G2 **Queen Mary S.** at Royal Ascot. Bouncing back from that defeat, she claimed a first black-type score in the July 25 **Princess Margaret S.** back at Ascot, and emulated her dam **Queen's Logic** by tearing up this for a career high in track-record time. Lady of the Desert was handily placed just behind the leaders along the stands' side rail after a smart break and cruised to the front before halfway. Still on the bridle as her rivals began to toil passing the two pole, she was coaxed clear inside the final furlong to win in impressive style. "To be honest, once I jumped out of the gates I thought I had the race won," boasted winning rider **Martin Dwyer**. "I just left it all to her because she's that good--she's a Group 1 filly racing against Group 2 horses. They went faster at Ascot last time so I was able to hold her up for longer there, but today I just sat still and didn't have to do a lot. She did it all for me." Of future plans, trainer **Brian Meehan** indicated Lady of the Desert will point straight to the **G1 Cheveley Park S.** at Newmarket Oct. 2. "There should be plenty of pace early on, the five furlongs is ideal and the ground should suit. The fact that he gets all the allowances is a further boost to his chance and his work in his build-up to this race suggests he is in great form. He's got the right temperament for the job and enjoys the game, so should take his shot." Kingsgate Native caused a stir when breaking his maiden in this test in 2007, and went on to prove that was no aberration with a win in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot last June. He was sent to stud at the end of his last campaign, but, after proving infertile was sent to Sir Michael Stoute by Cheveley Park Stud. After offering little on his return in the latest renewal of the Golden Jubilee June 20, he rebounded in style when turning Goodwood's G3 King George S. into a procession July 30. Connections are hoping he can add to his top-level tally. "He twisted a joint at Ascot; we couldn't believe he ran so badly there," Stoute commented. "I knew the race would bring him on though, as he had been out of training for such a long time. We felt he had a valid excuse there, but while he had been showing glimpses of real pace, he hadn't been very consistent in his homework. He was just readjusting to being a professional athlete again." Another Group 1 winner in the line-up is Richard Green's **Art Connoisseur**, who registered an impressive success in the Golden Jubilee before failing to fire when beating only one home in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 10. Conditioner Michael Bell commented, "I've been happy with the horse, he had a canter on Wednesday morning and looks happy and well--he's in great nick. I think the track will suit him--it's really a question of whether he is as effective over five furlongs as six. I think he will be and I'm not too worried about the drop back in trip." James Edgar and William Donaldson's **Borderlescott** bids for back-to-back renewals after recording a career-best in the race rescheduled to Newmarket 12 months ago. Fourth last time in the King George at Goodwood, the admirably consistent seven-year-old should not be far away at the finish.

Keertana ships to Saratoga on the strength of a three-race streak, including the GIII Regret S. at Churchill June 13 and the Indiana Distaff S. July 6 in her most recent appearance. **Shared Account** looked like a winner last out in the GIII Virginia Oaks over a soft Colonial Downs course July 18, but wound up second by a head. Fresh off the boat is Miss Keller, a private purchase by Three Chimneys Racing. The bay filly captured a handicap at Down Royal June 21 and, in her final start for trainer John Oxx, ran fourth in the Listed Kilboy Estate S. at The Curragh July 12. She will compete with Lasix in her first start for trainer Roger Attfield. "We were running her off the plane when the [GIII] Lake George [S.] came off the turf [at Saratoga July 31]," Attfield revealed. "I've seen videos of her races, and John Oxx has talked to me about her. She's a small filly, very compact. I know very little about her."

NEW SOVEREIGN AWARD ADDED The Jockey Club of Canada announced that it has added a Sovereign Award for the nation's champion female sprinter. In order to be eligible for a Sovereign Award, horses aged three or older must make at least three starts in Canada prior to Dec. 31; juveniles are required to start at least twice. A reception for the 35th annual Sovereign Awards will be held Jan. 29, 2010 at Roy Thomson Hall in Toronto, Ontario.

OHIO DERBY BACK IN PLAY The GII Ohio Derby, cancelled earlier this year in an effort to maintain purse levels at Thistledown, will likely be contested Oct. 3, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The Ohio State Racing Commission brought about the race's return by dropping five live racing days at Thistledown. Officials at that track and the Ohio Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association had earlier failed to come to a decision about the Ohio Derby, which would require a minimum \$150,000 purse to maintain its Grade II status. "I believe this is a best-interests-of-Ohio-horse-racing issue," OSRC Deputy Director John Izzo told *The Blood-Horse*. "I believe we have it on the record that the horsemen promised the commission the Ohio Derby would be run. I don't think the commission believed Magna would be eating \$150,000 to make this happen."



RACING Round-Up

Mine That Bird Back on Track?

GI Kentucky Derby hero **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone), who had surgery Tuesday to correct an entrapped epiglottis, could head back to the track Friday. "We'll scope him first thing in the morning [6:30 a.m. Friday], and if he's good we'll go to the racetrack [at 7:15 a.m.] and jog him a couple rounds," trainer Chip Woolley said. The gelding breezed Monday, and a post-work scope revealed his condition. He is still scheduled to start in the GI Shadwell Travers S. Aug. 29 at Saratoga, and Woolley indicated that he wanted to be forthright about his charge's wellbeing. "People deserve to know," he said.

"Those people [fans] put on the show. If I lead him over for the Travers, people are going to bet \$300,000, \$400,000 on him. I wanted everybody to know this is what we're dealing with." Other Travers hopefuls include **Summer Bird** (Birdstone), **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality), **Our Edge** (The Cliff's Edge) and **Warrior's Reward** (Medaglia d'Oro). The possibilities for the Mid-Summer Derby include **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro), **Kensei** (Mr. Greeley) and **Hold Me Back** (Giant's Causeway).

Charitable Man Likely for Travers...

Trainer Kieran McLaughlin said yesterday that **Charitable Man** (Lemon Drop Kid) would most likely make his next start in the GI Shadwell Travers Aug. 29 at the Spa, but that could change if Rachel Alexandra makes the field. Mr. and Mrs. William K. Warren Jr.'s colorbearer captured the GII Peter Pan S. in May prior to running fourth in the GI Belmont S. June 6, and is coming off a third in the GII Jim Dandy S. Aug. 1. "We had always been pointing towards the Travers, having prepped in the Jim Dandy, but it's an extremely tough field, everyone's going," McLaughlin said. "Now, if Rachel Alexandra does decide to enter, then we'll look at other options." One of those options is the \$1-million GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 7, but McLaughlin would rather run out of his own barn. "The [Travers] is coming up extremely tough," he said. "We talked about the Pennsylvania Derby, but if we can win the Travers or run well in it, it will be a big deal for the horse."

Indy). Informed Decision, campaigned by Augustin Stables, is riding a five-race winning streak, all at the Ballerina's seven-furlong distance. Indian Bless-

Second to the boys in the G1 Golden Shaheen in March at Nad al Sheba, the dark bay hasn't faced the starter since finishing fourth as the 1-2 chalk in the Desert Stormer H. at Hollywood Park June 14. Godolphin's Music Note, a three-time Grade I winner in 2008, has made just one appearance this year, finishing fifth in the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont June 13.

Talking About the Future...

Bushwood Stable's multi-millionaire **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) may make just one more start before being retired, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Hero of the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Turf and four other top-level races, the 10-year-old settled for second in the

GI Sword Dancer Invitational last Saturday at the Spa. "I questioned myself a little as to whether that it was age that he didn't get there," trainer Graham Motion revealed to *DRF*. "I just question whether he would have got there three years ago. It's in the back of my mind. It's

got me thinking." Motion continued, "We'll point him for one race in the fall, possibly the [GI] Joe Hirsch [Turf Classic at Belmont Oct. 3], then we'll say that will be his swan song. I think it's unrealistic to think we'll bring him back as an 11-year-old. It's a tough decision to make emotionally. When you have a horse that runs like that, when you see him every day and he's doing well and he enjoys it, it's hard to say he shouldn't be doing it." Better Talk Now hasn't actually had his picture taken since winning the 2007 GI Manhattan H., but has hit the board in two of three starts this season, including a third to divisional leader Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in this year's Manhattan June 6. In all, the nearly black gelding has amassed \$4,356,664 while compiling a record of 51-14-8-5.

Tiago to Return on Turf...

Multiple Grade I winner **Tiago** (Pleasant Tap) will return from a six-month hiatus in the Harry Brubaker S., an 8 1/2-furlong turf race at Del Mar Aug. 26, according to *Daily Racing Form*.

The five-year-old has seen action just once in 2009, finishing third in the GII San Antonio H. at Santa Anita Feb. 8. Trainer John Shirreffs is hoping the Jerry and Ann Moss homebred will return to form in time for a tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 7; he finished third in the \$5-million race last year. "I'm hoping to make the Classic," Shirreffs told *DRF*. "He's doing fine now. He had an intestinal problem earlier in the year. It wasn't quite colic, but he had to go to the clinic for a couple of weeks. No surgery. We managed it with different medicines." Tiago has three drills on the oceanside lawn, including a five-panel move in 1:01.60 Aug. 16. "I couldn't work him on the main track," Shirreffs told *DRF*. "He can't stand up on this track."
