MORNY GLORY FOR ARCANO

Purchased by Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum following his success in the G2 July S., **Arcano (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) provided an instant return on that investment with a battling success in yesterday's G1 Darley Prix Morny at Deauville. Sent off at 9-2, the bay needed a sharp reminder from Richard Hills inside the final quarter as the 4-5 favorite **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}) tackled the long-time leader **Special Duty (GB)** (Hennessy). Responding to driving, Arcano overhauled that pair in the final strides to record a short-neck success in a blanket finish, with Canford Cliffs a further neck behind in third. "It was the first time I've ridden the horse in a race today, although I had ridden him on the gallops," jockey Richard Hills commented. "They went quick on quick ground and, once I pulled him out, it was all over." **Cont. p2**

Sent off the 2-1 second choice in Sunday's GII Sky Classic S. at Woodbine, Eugene Melnyk's homebred **Marchfield** (A.P. Indy), champion older horse in Canada in 2008, rallied from last and asserted to beat **Champ Elysees (GB)** (Danahill) for a third success at graded level. "He showed me that he just wants to run down the lane," said winning jockey Patrick Husbands about race tactics. "I tried to get him as close as possible. He wanted no part of it. When I swung for home, he just took off."

Successful in the G2 Prix Corrida and runner-up in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, **Alpine Rose (Ire)** (Linamix {Fr}) put that experience of battle to full use when inching out **Lady Marian (Ger)** (Nayef) in yesterday's G1 Darley Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville. After a stretch-long tussle Godolphin's raider, the 13-10 favorite dug in for Gerald Mosse and had a short head to spare at the line. 'Can' Do Spirit...

Hindsight shows Arcano's head victory over Showcasing (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in a maiden at Newbury on debut June 11 was a pivotal moment in the story of the 2009 juvenile crop. Early signs that the race had unveiled something special came via a cluster of subsequent winners emerging from the also-rans, and Arcano duly carried the Sangster silks and the weight of favoritism to a fluent victory in the G2 July S. at Newmarket July 9. Just four days after Showcasing had underlined his debut conqueror's substance when capturing York's G2 Gimcrack S. in convincing style, Shadwell's acquisition was lining up against the current term's benchmark horse Canford Cliffs in this intriguing renewal. Keen early at the back of the quintet, he looked to be struggling briefly under the whip approaching the final furlong as the favorite battled with the front-running Special Duty and Stephane Pasquier up ahead. With Canford Cliffs failing to replicate the dash of his impressive G2 Coventry S. success against the stand's rail, it was left to Arcano to reel in Special Duty in the closing yards and record a track record in the process. "Martin Dwyer, who rode him in his last couple of runs, told me he was a good horse and was spot on," jockey Richard Hills added. "He told me to take my time, as he's got a good finish. He'll definitely get seven furlongs." For Angus Gold, racing manager to Sheikh Hamdan, the result was a satisfying justification of one of the rare purchases of the operation and he said, "All credit to Brian Meehan and his team, who have done a wonderful job with Arcano. I had only seen him once at Manton before today, and everyone around the horse had said he would be much better later on over seven furlongs. Richard [Hills] has just confirmed that and also said he was still a bit green and babyish, so considering that the G1 Dewhurst S. [at Newmarket Oct. 17] is the likely next option, but obviously that will be discussed with Sheikh Hamdan." Duty Almost Done...

Khalid Abdullah's Special Duty was again the speed of the race, as she had been when winning the July 26 G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte, and connections were left wondering what might have been had the filly enjoyed a lead. "She ran a blinder and was still a bit green early in the race, so it is a regret that another horse could not take her along," trainer Criquette Head-Maarek commented. "She is loaded with speed and is in the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 2], but she is also entered in the [Oct. 4] G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp." Canford Cliffs, who was unable to build on his Royal Ascot tour de force, finished alone against the fence in third, and connections were left feeling deflated afterwards. "That was disappointing really and, although it has been 10 weeks since Ascot, that is not an excuse," the trainer's son and assistant Richard Hannon Jr. said. "Maybe being isolated along the rail could be a factor."

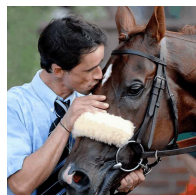

Alpine Rose, who hails from one of Jean-Luc Lagardere's better families, was third on her black-type bow for His Highness the Aga Khan and the Jean-Claude Rouget stable in the G3 Prix Minerve here last August. Let go at Arqana's December Sale after a subsequent third in the Listed Prix Joubert at Saint-Cloud in September and fifth in the G3 Prix Fille de l'Air at Toulouse in November, the gray made a winning debut for the Alain de Royer-Dupre yard in a conditions event at Saint-Cloud May 6.

It was a measure of the faith that her new trainer had in her that she was sent to that track's May 28 G2 Prix Corrida and, after recording a career-best success there, was runner-up to Spanish Moon (El Prado {Ire}) in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud a month later. Settled behind her pacemaker throughout the early stages, she was joined by Lady Marian and Frankie Dettori when in front at the top of the stretch. Digging in for Gerald Mosse, she refused to buckle despite the determined challenge of her only serious threat. "As well as the ground being too firm, she also came into season 48 hours beforehand, so Gerald was not too hard on her as a result," de Royer-Dupre added. "I am certain she wants a longer trip, so we might go for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4]. Whether she has a race or not beforehand remains to be seen, but I am not too keen to run her over a mile and a half in the G1 Prix Vermeille just three weeks before." Lady Marian's trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "Lady Marian has run a lot better today and only just missed out on success. The ground was probably a little bit too fast for her. We will try and find another Group 1 race and she may go for the Prix de l'Opera [at Longchamp Oct. 4], but we will see how she comes out of this race." **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#).**

The versatile Marchfield won the GII Autumn S. over Woodbine's main track last October and, more recently, took the GIII Dominion Day H. on the Poly July 1. A good runner-up to Rahy's Attorney (Rahy) in the grassy GII Nijinsky II S. July 26, he was looking for his first turf stakes win since capturing the Breeders' S. here as a sophomore. Last of eight in the early going and no better than seventh around the far turn, he began to move in tandem with Champ Elysees and, after a stretch-long duel, outgamed that foe to the wire. "It's a great delight to see this horse show his pedigree," said owner Eugene Melnyk. "He's an A.P. Indy horse, out of a wonderful mare that I raised. Coming to Woodbine is an emotional thing because I won the Queen's Plate here [with Archers Bay in 1998]. Winning a race of that stature is a huge thrill. I'm looking forward to racing Marchfield back here again." Trainer Mark Casse said the plan is to run the Ontario-bred next in the \$750,000, GI Northern Dancer S. Sept. 20.

Schiaparelli debuted for current connections with a second in last September's G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp and ran 13th in the following month's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe on his return to the Bois de Boulogne track. Second, but demoted to third, in a messy renewal of the July 9 G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket, the 2006 G1 Deutsches Derby hero came back to plunder the July 30 G2 Goodwood Cup last time and justified prohibitive odds with ease in this. Leading his two rivals throughout, he was shaken up rounding the home turn and stretched ever clear in the straight before gearing down late to register an unchallenged win. "Schiaparelli is doing very well presently and we're very happy with the result," said winning trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "He didn't have his favored ground conditions, as he likes it much softer than that [good-to-firm going]. We'll keep all our options open, but his next start is likely to be the [G2] Prix Foy [at Longchamp Sept. 13] or the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden [at Baden-Baden Sept. 6]." Jockey Calvin Borel was aboard. "I've been watching him and I thought he needed the workout today," Wilkes said. "If I waited another day, who knows what the track [condition] would be tomorrow. He had no problems in handling the track. Even though he's a big horse, he always handles the track well."

The Steve Asmussen-trained duo of **Kensei** (Mr. Greeley) and **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro), both nominated to the Travers, are scheduled to work this morning at their usual times of 5:30 and 5:50 a.m., respectively.

On Tuesday morning, GI Kentucky Derby winner **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) is scheduled to hit Saratoga's main track at 8:45 a.m. for his final Travers drill. The gelding has been galloping regularly for the last three days following the completion of a minor surgical procedure to repair an entrapped epiglottis Tuesday morning.

ROUND TABLE FOCUSES ON MEDICATION ISSUES

The broken beast that represents conflicting medication policies throughout the United States needs fixing, participants agreed Sunday at the 57th annual Round Table Conference of The Jockey Club.

Yet the debate over how to make repairs reminded all that this will not be an easy problem to fix. Conference presenters at the Gideon Putnam Resort in Saratoga Springs, NY, produced a range of possible solutions at this meeting styled on the theme of "Medication: Where We Stand Today (Here and Abroad)."

Keynote speaker Louis Romanet of France received enthusiastic applause and a few expressions of "bravo" after stating he would like to see anti-bleeder medication banned by 2012 in all North American stakes races.

"Make no mistake, the medication issue is the most important issue for the Thoroughbred industry around the world," said Romanet. The Frenchman is chairman of the International Federation of Horse racing Authorities through 2012.

Romanet praised The Jockey Club's leadership in spearheading a number of changes to the sport following the furor that rose after the filly Eight Belles broke both front ankles after running second in the 2008 GI Kentucky Derby. "You have done more in the last 12 months than in the past 25 years," Romanet said about changes that have included action on the part of a large number of racing authorities to ban anabolic steroids for competition purposes.

But Romanet also plucked at the conscience of The Jockey Club, asking that body to extend its influence further in encouraging state regulators to ban race-day medications, including anti-inflammatory drugs. He asked, "How can we still recognize world champion horses that run on medications?" Romanet pointed out that the average number of annual starts per horse continues to decline despite the use of therapeutic medication. "I have one question," he said: "When do you intend to stop?"

Dr. Scott Palmer presented another side to this complex issue. Speaking as chairman of the racing committee of the American Association of Equine Practitioners, Palmer referred to a recently published research paper in which the evidence argued that treating horses with Salix on race day was in the best interests of the animals.

Palmer also pleaded for support of an interstate compact which could streamline passage of racing rules across state lines--an umbrella organization that would operate without waiting for individual state legislatures to act. "This would be our opportunity to make landmark reform," he said, describing the present system as "broken."

Steve Crist, chairman and publisher of the *Daily Racing Form*, gave the view from bettors, the public, and the media on medication. He told how e-mail response to his request for readers to frame the issues facing racing were that "drugs are out of control," that the need exists for "harsh penalties" and "it's time for horse owners to take responsibility."

Joe Gorajec, executive director of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission, urged that adjunct bleeder medications be banned. He also explained how Indiana's racing authority receives \$1 million annually from a legislative-mandated share of casino money to add to an administrative fund used for financing equine drug-testing and other initiatives. Gorajec suggested this "Indiana model" as a solution to state racing authorities strapped for funds.

Stuart S. Janney III, chairman of The Jockey Club's Thoroughbred Safety Committee, said state veterinarians are questioning the use of non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs within 48 hours of race day "to ensure uncompromised pre-race exams."

William S. Farish, vice chairman of The Jockey Club who stood in for the absent Ogden Mills Phipps, Jockey Club chairman, also delineated the complexity of the medication issue.

"Seeking balance between therapeutic medication and a level playing field should always be a priority for this industry," Farish said.
