MORE THAN "ENUFF"

After going to \$550,000 to get **Justenuffhumor** (Distorted Humor) at the 2006 Keeneland September sale, Darley had to wait a bit before the colt came to hand, but he has proven worthy of their patience. The chestnut, a half to champion Dreaming of Anna (Rahy) out of a half to champion Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) and MGISW Precious Kitten (Catienuf), showed little after getting off to a slow start on the Keeneland Poly last October in his lone

start at three and took the rest of the year off. Switched to the turf at Gulfstream Park in January, he rallied to what would be the first of five straight wins on the spinach. He goes for number six in today's GII Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga. Justenuffhumor swept through his conditions before stepping up to the black-type ranks in the Aug. 2 GII Fourstardave H. at the Spa. Sent off the 7-2 second choice behind **Cowboy Cal** (Giant's Causeway), he swept to the front inside the eighth pole and easily held off **Mambo Meister** (King Cugat) to take it by 2 1/2 lengths. Cowboy Cal set the pace, but weakened to be third. In receipt of five pounds from the crowd's choice last time, Justenuffhumor gets only one here, and trainer Kieran McLaughlin cautions that the streak could be in jeopardy. "Each time you step up, it's tough," McLaughlin said. "Last time, he stepped up and handled it, but now he has a target on his back and is one of the ones to beat. It gets tougher."

SUNRIVER DEAD

According to a press release from Empire Stud, GISW **Sunriver** (Saint Ballado--Goulash, by Mari's Book) died Tuesday. The cause of death had not yet been determined, but a heart attack or aneurysm was suspected. A full-brother to champion Ashado, Sunriver began his career on the dirt, winning the GII Peter Pan S. and running third in both the GI Belmont S. and GI Florida Derby. The dark bay was moved to the grass for the last six starts of his career, where he captured the GII Bowling Green H. and, in his final outing, the GI Hollywood Turf Cup. After compiling a record of 17-6-3-3 and a bankroll of \$816,414 for owner/breeders Aaron and Marie Jones and trainer Todd Pletcher, he retired to Empire Stud, near Hudson, New York, in 2008, and had just completed his second season. The six-year-old reportedly covered 90 mares in 2008 and 81 this year. His 2009 stud fee was \$12,500. Empire Stud President Jamie LaMonica said in a statement, "It is a sad day for Empire Stud, a sad day for New York, and a sad day for all of the shareholders who so strongly supported the horse during his two years at stud."

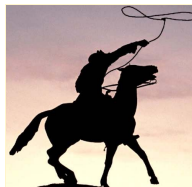

According to the New York Racing Association stable notes, the colt was energetic, but well-behaved. Warrior's Reward also was unfazed by the session. FEVER FORCES MIDSHIPS OUT OF DEL MAR H. GISW **Midships** (Mizzen Mast) will miss this Sunday's GII Del Mar H. after spiking a 102-degree fever yesterday. "I can't run him with a temperature," Humberto Ascanio, assistant to Bobby Frankel, told *Daily Racing Form*. According to Ascanio, the grey is unlikely to start again at the current Del Mar meeting, and will be targeted toward the upcoming Oak Tree meet, which begins Sept. 30. Midships recorded his latest work Monday, going six panels in 1:12 over Del Mar's main track. Earlier this season, the Juddmonte homebred scored in the GIII San Luis Rey H., followed by a win in the GII San Juan Capistrano H. After taking his first Grade I in the Charles Whittingham H. June 6, he came home a well-beaten ninth in his latest start in Belmont's GI Man o' War S. July 11.

KING'S APOSTLE RETIRED Bernard Kantor's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest winner **King's Apostle (Ire)** (King's Best--Politesse, by Baratheia {Ire}) has been

retired due to injury. Trainer William Haggas revealed the news to the *Racing Post*. "It's a great shame that we've had to retire King's Apostle, as the horse has come into his own this year," Haggas said. "I was delighted to win a Group 1 with him, and he's been a thoroughly genuine and consistent performer at the highest level." Formerly a high-class handicapper, the five-year-old broke through in black-type

company when taking the G2 Diadem S. at Ascot in September, and had returned this season to finish runner-up under a penalty in the G2 Duke of York S. at York in May. Also fifth in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 10, he registered a career best on what was to be his last start in Deauville's 6 1/2-furlong contest Aug. 9, beating Mariol (Fr) (Munir {GB}) by a half-length. In total, King's Apostle won seven of his 22 races and earned just over £300,000 in prize money. "The horse has a wonderful nature and is thoroughly genuine in every way," Haggas added. "I really hope that we can find a place at stud for him somewhere in the British Isles in the near future."

How--and why--did you get into racing?

What is the most exciting sporting event you've attended that didn't involve one of your own horses? Being on the sidelines of a College Football game last year when Texas Tech upset Texas on a last second touchdown pass. The crowd went nuts.

What is your favorite Saratoga restaurant? Pizza and darts at the Parting Glass or a sit down at Chianti.

What's the longest trip you've ever taken? Traveled to Edinburgh, Scotland for a New Year's Eve party with my wife Michelle. We were dating at the time, so I passed the test.

Named Scarlet Starlet, the March foal is out of a winning daughter of MSW Airstar (Prospective Star). She was consigned by Abbie Road Farm (Lisa McGreevy), Agent IV, and purchased by Vinery Stables. The three open sessions of the sale saw the average drop 30 percent, from \$10,098 to \$7,067; the median was off 27 percent, decreasing from \$5,500 in 2008 to \$4,000 this year. ILLINOIS APPRENTICE SERIOUSLY INJURED

Apprentice jockey Michael Straight, who was injured in a spill during the eighth race at Arlington Park Wednesday, suffered four fractured vertebrae. Straight was scheduled to undergo spinal surgery yesterday at Lutheran General Hospital in Park Ridge, Illinois. The 24-year-old was riding Im No Gentleman (Whadjathink) in the final race on the card, a 1 1/16-mile test for \$10,000 maiden claimers, when his mount went down suddenly. The two-year-old died on the track, possibly from a heart attack. Straight, a graduate of the North American Racing Academy, began riding at Tampa Bay in March. To date, he has 39 wins from 372 starts. His twin brother Matthew also attended the NARA, and has been competing at Ellis Park. While a *Daily Racing Form* report indicated Straight could be paralyzed, and quoted a family friend as saying that his prospects of walking again were "very grim," a statement from Matthew Straight issued midday Thursday said simply, "Mike is stable and is scheduled to undergo surgery later this afternoon. The surgery is expected to last several hours. We will issue a further update [Friday morning]." Jockey Rene Douglas suffered a severe spinal injury in a spill at Arlington earlier this meet. The start of Thursday's card was pushed back a half-hour as jockeys and trainers met with track management.

"I always liked her," Sonbol explained. "She just looked like a fast racehorse, and that's exactly what I want. Everyone looks at the pedigree, but she moved great and was a very pretty filly."

Turned over to be broken by the McKathan brothers in Florida, it did not take long for her to impress her connections.

"She was a beautiful mover while she was being broken," Sonbol stated. "Everyone was a little bit skeptical because of her pedigree, but she was just one of those horses that kept getting better and kept going forward. She convinced us that she could compete at this level."

J Z's Revenge was 24-1 for her Aug. 2 debut, and it seems she ran to her odds. But there was an explanation for the seventh-place effort.

"She blew a shoe right out of the gate that day," Sonbol commented. "She was very fast early on, but she gave way."

Connections could easily have dropped the filly in class, but their faith was rewarded yesterday afternoon. Sonbol will take some time before deciding what's next.

"I am going to enjoy this one first," he said. "That's the good thing when you have a fast horse. We have plenty of time and plenty of races to choose from."

Illinois Legalizes Internet Wagering:

A bill that legalizes internet wagering on horse racing in Illinois has been signed into law by Gov. Pat Quinn. Residents of the state will now be able to open accounts with advance deposit wagering companies including TVG, Youbet and Twin Spires. Those companies will have to go through an application process, but the Illinois Racing Board is likely to be working under emergency rules, which is expected to shorten the normal three-to-four month period required to approve the applications. "We're getting everything in the pipeline to get it up and going," said IRB spokesman Mickey Izzo.

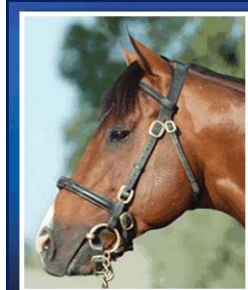
