TERMINATED!

Ignored at 16-1 for yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S., **Termagant (Ire)** (Powerscourt {GB}) made a mockery of her inflated odds when registering a 16-1 upset at a rain-soaked Curragh. Earning **"TDN Rising Star"** status when scoring on debut at Leopardstown June 11, the bay was allowed to take her chance here despite trainer Kevin Prendergast's misgivings about the heavy ground. Traveling through the mud with elan,

she cruised from rear to pass the long-time leader **Famous (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) inside the final quarter before drawing away for a 2 1/2-length success under Declan McDonogh. "She has always shown us a great deal, and this race was always the plan after her maiden," her conditioner said. "She got through the

ground well and is a good filly, but hopefully she will be better when it's drier." **Cont. p2**

PROJECT RUNS AWAY

Icon Project (Empire Maker) must love New York. The four-year-old filly, who romped home by 13 1/4 lengths in the GIII New York S. in June at Belmont, took her

show upstate and powered home by 13 1/2 lengths in the GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga. "At the three-eighths pole, she just grabbed the bit from me and she kept on going," said winning rider Julien Leparoux. "She didn't get tired at all, she just kept on going the whole way." Winning trainer Marty Wolfson knew the competition was in trouble. "When she

was tugging at him at the three-eighths pole, it was just a question of how far she was going to win by," Wolfson admitted. "It was just like the New York S. Icon Project began her career in Europe with trainer Brian Meehan. She took a Gulfstream allowance Apr. 12 over the turf in her second outing for Wolfson and ran third over the green stuff in the Apr. 15 GII La Prevoyante. She made a smashing main-track debut in the off-the-turf New York S. and closed to be second in the July 19 GII Delaware H. last time out. "I had been wanting to run her on the dirt--she's by Empire Maker, and she trained great on dirt ever since I got her from overseas," Wolfson added. **Cont. p2**

Termagant Takes Moyglare Stud *(cont. from p1)*

Termagant exhibited a smart turn of acceleration when beating Cabaret (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) over this trip at Leopardstown, and that form was advertised when the runner-up took the G3 Silver Flash S. While she faced mainly more experienced rivals here, including two fillies in **Lillie Langtry (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) and fellow ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Long Lashes** (Rock Hard Ten) who are prominent in the early betting for next year's Classics, she traveled as well as any as she settled in rear throughout the early stages. Asked to close passing halfway as Ballydoyle's supposed second-string Famous maintained a relentless gallop, it was soon clear that she was the sole threat to that rival. Looming alongside with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, Termagant continued to work her way through the testing ground for the clear-cut win. Winning trainer Kevin Prendergast added, "She has done her job here and might not run again this season, but our main aim is to come back here for the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas in May." Termagant was produced by a full-sister to MGSW Kirkwall (GB); Lillie Langtry, who was sent off the 8-11 favorite, made ground from rear, but never looked like landing a blow on the front pair, while Godolphin's Long Lashes showed speed before fading to finish a further eight lengths behind in fourth. Jockey Declan McDonogh added of the winner, "She's such a good-moving filly, the heavy ground had to be a major worry, especially as it was quick when she won on her debut but she coped with it very well. The race went very well for me. She settled well, travelled well and battled when she needed to. She's just a very good filly and she doesn't do a whole lot at home, but she certainly saves it for the track." For Swiss-born Jorge Vasicek, owner of the Tipperary-based Kenilworth House Stud, this represented a first Group 1 success. "Kevin had trained a couple of horses for me before and we had been lucky together already," Vasicek said. "So when I saw this filly win in his wife's colours at Leopardstown during the summer, I enquired whether she might be for sale and she was." "For once she left the gate well, so I lay pretty close to the pace today," Julien Leparoux commented. Marty Wolfson made no commitment on Icon Project's next start. "We'll keep our options open," he said. Swift Temper, winner of the GII Delaware H., closed to be second, but was never a threat to Icon Project. "That filly ran a freaky race," Dale Romans, trainer of the runner-up, said of the winner. "It was very impressive. Of course, we are disappointed that we didn't win but we're still happy with the way our mare ran. She finished second in a Grade I race." Luna Vega, a maiden winner for a \$50,000 tag at Keeneland last October, took a Churchill allowance May 1 before adding a romping 6 3/4-length win in a Monmouth Park allowance June 25. She was coming off a sixth-place effort over a sloppy track in the Aug. 2 GI Go For Wand H. The chestnut filly, allowed to settle into stride early, swept to the outside for the stretch run, took charge at midstretch and drew clear for a confident victory. "There was a lot of speed in the race, so I just stayed behind everyone," said winning jockey Elvis Trujillo, who was winning his fifth race on the afternoon. Spring House, winner of this race a year ago, claimed a second renewal of the Gil San Luis Obispo H. in February, and also captured this year's May 30 Gill Golden Gate Fields Turf S. The dark bay gelding was coming off a solid runner-up effort in the July 19 Gil Sunset H. at Hollywood Park. Spring House was an unrushed eighth behind fast early splits. He angled out four wide into the lane and closed with a vengeance to just nail longshot Sir Dave on the line. "The old boy's still got it," said winning jockey Alex Solis. "I knew he was going to make his run and I wanted to be able to let him do it. Right at the end his head was down and I thought that made him a winner." Winning trainer Julio Canani added, "I lost them in the fog, and when I heard Trevor [Denman] say Spring House was coming, I was thinking he had to hurry because the wire was coming up. Jukebox Jury, who earned the **TDN Rising Star** tag with a debut victory at Goodwood last year, justified his billing with success in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot in September and closed his freshman campaign with a second in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster the following month. He came back to run seventh in the June 22 G3 Prix Daphnis at Longchamp before running sixth in the July 4 G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown and claimed the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. at Haydock in his penultimate start Aug. 8. The grey sophomore prepared for this contest with a fourth in the Aug. 18 G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York. Leading at a sedate pace until relegated to second by Kasbah Bliss at halfway, the eventual winner came under pressure rounding the home turn. He rallied to reclaim the lead approaching the final furlong and refused to surrender under a vigorous drive to just withstand the ominous threat of Pouvoir Absolu. "He didn't seem to be enjoying himself when he was on the front early, but got a good lead and traveled much better into the race," said winning trainer Mark Johnston. "When Pouvoir Absolu quickened up to challenge in the center of the track, I thought he'd win, but my horse is a fighter and was able to hold on. He's very unlikely to go for the [G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4]. The [G1] Canadian International [at Woodbine Oct. 17] is a more likely target for him now, although I would like to win a Group 1 race in Europe with him." **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#).**

SILVER FROST RETIRED G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner **Silver Frost (Ire)** (Verglas {Ire}--Hidden Silver {GB}, by Anabaa) has been retired after he sustained a fracture in his near hind. Only sixth behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville a fortnight ago, the John Cotton-owned grey becomes the second French Classic hero to be rushed off to stud through injury after the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Le Havre (Ire) (Noverre) met with the same fate earlier this summer. It was that rival who finished runner-up as Silver Frost captured the May 10 Longchamp mile Classic, just four weeks after he had annexed the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau. Also the winner of the G3 Prix de Cabourg and G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud, as well as finishing third in that track's G1 Criterium International as a juvenile, he was sixth in the Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 7 before his final outing in the Jacques le Marois. He retires with six successes from his 11 starts and over €400,000 in prize money. "He has sustained a hairline fracture to his near hind and he will not run again," trainer Yves de Nicolay told the *Racing Post* yesterday. "It has not been decided which stud he will stand at next year."

War Artist, who was successful in the 2007 G1 Mercury Sprint in his adopted South Africa, hit the board in last season's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot and G1 July Cup at Newmarket, but was on the shelf for over a year since the latter run. Making his comeback with a fourth in the G3 Hackwood S. at Newbury July 18, he occupied the same berth in a Doncaster conditions event last time Aug. 1 and prevailed here to register a European best. Handily placed in a close-up sixth until the turn, he made smooth progress in the straight to challenge approaching the final eighth and was ridden out late to assert superiority. "My instructions were to wait as long as possible, and I kept an eye on Smooth Operator, who I assumed to be my biggest danger," explained jockey Andreas Suborics. SUMMER BIRD FINE AFTER TRAVERS WIN

Summer Bird (Birdstone) exited his authoritative win in Saturday's GI Travers S. in fine shape, according to trainer Tim Ice. "He walked great this morning, he ate up last night, so today everything is looking up," Ice said. Summer Bird's next start remains something of a question mark, with three options looming. "[Louisiana Downs] has the [Sept. 19 GII] Super Derby in three weeks, which is a little close--that's the longshot," Ice commented. "[Belmont Park] has the [GI] Jockey Club Gold Cup on Oct. 3, then on Oct. 10, Santa Anita has the [GI] Goodwood." The Goodwood would give Summer Bird a start over the track which will host the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, but his trainer isn't convinced the colt needs that experience. "What if he goes out there and he runs bad in the Goodwood? Then we passed up the Jockey Club Gold Cup on a racetrack that he loves. I'm not saying that he would or he wouldn't like the [synthetic], he was out there for three months last year from October to January and he seemed to work well over it. He seems to adapt well everywhere he goes, whether it takes him a week to get used to it, but eventually he handles it. Overall, I think that if we get him out there in enough time, he'll be used to the track and it won't be an issue."

Trainer Todd Pletcher said that Travers favorite **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) was "excellent" after his third-place effort Saturday. "I thought he ran very well," Pletcher said. "He didn't exactly get the kind of trip we were hoping to get. The mile and a quarter had nothing to do with it. And he handled the [wet track] fine. I think the biggest thing is he wasn't able to get into a high cruising speed." Pletcher added Quality Road will make his next start in the Jockey Club Gold Cup. Fellow Pletcher trainee **Munnings** (Speightstown) did not appear to handle the off going Saturday when he finished third as the favorite in the GI NetJets King's Bishop S. "Everything that could have happened did happen in the race," Pletcher explained. "He was slipping and sliding throughout." Munnings will not be pointed towards the Breeders' Cup, but could head towards the Oct. GI Vosburgh S. and Nov. 28 GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile. Pletcher has taken over the training duties for Saturday's GII Ballston Spa winner **Salve Germania** (Ire) (Peintre Celebre).

"I was contacted about a month ago by her connections," Pletcher said. "She shipped in Tuesday from quarantine and, basically, I helped them get organized and familiar with her surroundings. She'll stay here. We'll see how she settles in and go from there." Salve Germania was making her U.S. bow in the Ballston Spa for owner Manfred Hellwig and trainer Waldemar Hickst.

Kensei Named Best Turned Out

Kensei (Mr. Greeley) was named the Shadwell Farms Best Turned Out Horse in Saturday's GI Shadwell Travers S. at Saratoga. The colt's groom was awarded \$500. "Shadwell would like to express our congratulations to Filipe Gutierrez for presenting such a well-cared-for Thoroughbred to participate in the Travers," said Rick Nichols, vice-president and general manager for Shadwell. "We all deeply appreciate all the grooms that take the welfare of our horses so seriously. As always, the horse industry could not be what it is without them."
