"We're stepping up to the plate and we just have to put them in the gate and see what happens."

## SEA THE STARS CHAMPION BID IN DOUBT

Heavy rainfall at Leopardstown has cast serious doubt on the participation of Christopher Tsui's dual Classic hero **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the G1 Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S. on Saturday. The Foxrock track is now described as yielding and trainer John Oxx has continually stated his stable star's race-course appearances hinge on suitable turf conditions. "It commenced raining here at about one o'clock [Wednesday]," Leopardstown's General Manager Tom Burke told *PA Sport*. "It has been raining heavily, though it did ease for a while, but it started again. By three o'clock we'd had six millimeters of rain and we've had more since. This morning we were good to yielding, but I'd say it's probably yielding now. For Thursday, we are forecast sunny spells, with showers about, and some drying conditions as it will be a breezy day. Friday will be similar, but with less of a risk of showers and Saturday is set to be dry. I've filled in the trainers on the ground and the forecast, and I'll be having further conversations with them. Obviously, John Oxx has a big call on it as the declarations are to be made Thursday morning."

**SIMILAR ‘SCENARIO’ FOR THE SPINAWAY?**

Trainer Rick Violette Jr. and jockey Alan Garcia teamed up for a 13-1 upset with Worstcasescenario (Forbidden Apple) in the GII Adirondack S. earlier in the

Saratoga meeting, and the duo will attempt to strike lightning again with a fresh face in Sunday’s GI Spinaway S.

Like Worstcasescenario, Broadway Blue Stable’s **Opus A** (Read The Footnotes) takes on graded-stakes company after getting her picture taken at first asking. Facing Empire-breds at the Spa

Aug. 12 ([Video](#)), Opus A was right with the early leaders after exiting from post three, but was steadied in traffic shortly thereafter, and quickly lost her position. Out of touch with the field approaching the far turn, the dark bay emerged from out of the clouds as she began to rally on the far outside, and came with a sustained run down the lane to graduate by a half-length at odds of 3-1. The final time for that 5 1/2-furlong contest was 1:05 3/5.

“She was being very polite, letting everybody go before her,” Violette offered. “Finally, Alan Garcia had enough around the three-eighths pole and demanded that she hold her ground and she got her act in gear and ran everybody down. I wasn’t shocked that she won, I was actually shocked at the way she won. I thought she’d be a little keener and have a little better position early on. I was a little disappointed at the way she backed out of there. I thought she’d be a little more aggressive on her own. She had shown some talent in the morning in her breezes and I thought she had a future.”

Bred in New York by Nan Cassidy, the dark bay prepped for the Spinaway with a pair of four-furlong moves at the Spa, including a :48 breeze Aug. 31.

“She galloped out in another :12 flat or :11 4/5 that day,” Violette noted of his charge’s latest workout. “She shaded a minute galloping out. I worked her with a colt that I think can run a little bit and she just was awesome. She hadn’t breezed really fast before this past race and she just looked like she wanted to keep on going. She breezed kind of as good as my colts [Bulls and Bears {Holy Bull} and Not Macho Anymore {Macho Uno}] did prepping for the Hopeful the same day. She’s training too good not to run [in the Spinaway].”

A compact field is shaping up for the seven-furlong Spinaway, headed by the one-two finishers from the opening-day GIII Schuylerville S., ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Hot Dixie Chick** (Dixie Union) and **Beautician** (Dehere).

“I think Hot Dixie Chick may be the best [two-year-old] filly in the country,” Violette said. “Because of that, the field looks like it could be coming up on the small side. Beautician is supposed to run, and I think she’ll be second choice. She’s gonna have to keep Hot Dixie Chick in her sight. We’ll be very happy to pick up whatever pieces are left, and if we can pick them all up, that’s fine. If we’re third in a Grade I, that’s something you’ll never be able to take away from the filly. The Spinaway is a very special race and she needs racing experience. There’s a New York-bred stakes a few weeks later at Belmont and this will certainly be a great education to move forward, win lose or draw.”

Violette also trained Opus A’s sire, who annexed the 2003 GII Remsen S. and the following year’s GII Fountain of Youth S.

“She’s easy-going in her stall,” Violette said when asked to compare the two. “She has a big hip and shoulder like he had. She really still doesn’t have that much of a clue of what she’s supposed to do out there. She’s a little bit unfocused, and he was very focused. There are some physical attributes, but talent is probably the biggest common denominator.” --S. *Sherack*

## NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



### WRITE OFF YOUR YEARLING FASTER

Yearling buyers are presented with a significant tax benefit starting this year. With passage of the Farm Bill, all racehorses are now depreciated over three years (four tax years). Yearlings are included and can be written off much faster than in the past. Prior to 2009, yearlings had to be depreciated on a seven year schedule (eight tax years). The new schedule better reflects the length of the typical career of a racehorse and is applicable through 2013.

To illustrate the impact of the new schedule, consider the example of a \$100,000 yearling purchase. The first year deduction is now 2.5 times better than it was before (\$25,000 vs. \$10,720). And after two years, taxpayers can write off \$62,500 of the original purchase price compared to \$29,500 under the previous tax law. [Click here](#) for the complete schedule.

Note that buyers who only race, and do not race and breed or just breed, can write off their yearling purchase even quicker. Please consult your tax advisor for more information on this nuance of the tax law.

**MILO VALENZUELA DIES** Hall of Fame jockey Ismael "Milo" Valenzuela, the regular rider of Turf legend Kelso, passed away yesterday morning at his home in Arcadia, California, after a long illness. He was 74. Born in McNary, Texas, Valenzuela started off riding Quarter Horses before moving on to Thoroughbreds, and won his first official race at Rillito Park Apr. 8, 1951. He partnered with Allaire duPont's Kelso to win 22 of 35 starts, including 19 stakes races. Valenzuela also piloted Tim Tam to victory in the 1958 Kentucky Derby and Preakness S., and won the same races 10 years later for another Calumet Farm colorbearer Forward Pass. His other Hall of Fame mounts include Affectionately, Cicada, Native Diver, Round Table and Searching. Valenzuela hung up his tack in 1980, and was elected to the Hall of Fame himself in 2008. He is survived by his wife, Rosa, five children, 14 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. A special ceremony for his induction was held at Santa Anita when the reinsman was unable to travel to the Hall of Fame in Saratoga Springs, New York. Funeral arrangements have not been finalized.

**NYCOTB CLEARED FOR BANKRUPTCY** Monday, New York Gov. David Paterson signed an executive order that will pave the way for New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation to file for Chapter 9 bankruptcy. According to a study done by the New York State Comptroller's Office, the financially troubled company will need to undergo extensive restructuring to put it on solid economic ground, but, as stated in the report, is "too important to fail." Since off-track betting was legalized in New York in 1970, it has produced more than \$4.5 billion in revenue for state and local governments and for the horse racing industry. NYCOTB has two months to file a plan for the reorganization with the Governor's Office. "This Executive Order will provide necessary flexibility to help restore NYCOTB to financial viability without any investment of State resources," said Gov. Paterson in a press release. "When we assumed responsibility for the struggling NYCOTB from New York City, we acted decisively to protect approximately 40,000 jobs statewide, which are maintained by the horseracing and breeding industries and depend on OTB revenue. After a year of study and intense effort at reorganization, we have determined that Chairman [Meyer] Frucher and the NYCOTB board need the tool of a Chapter 9 restructuring to keep NYCOTB in operation." According to the press release, NYCOTB is losing about \$600,000 a month, and also has more than \$500 million in unsecured debts, a majority of which funds employee benefits and retirement plans. "NYCOTB will likely be unable to fund operations beyond March 31, 2010. "We are considering a range of options aimed at restoring fiscal equilibrium to NYCOTB," added Frucher who was appointed to the post last June. "Our goal is to make NYCOTB a modern wagering operation that can operate lean and maximize revenue for State and local governments as well as the horseracing and breeding industries. In this process, we are committed to treating the NYCOTB workforce in a fair and equitable manner. And to the fullest extent possible, the NYCOTB Board intends to achieve consensus among all of the Corporation's racing industry stakeholders, its employee representative organizations and other creditors during this reorganization process." Charles Hayward, president and CEO of the New York Racing Association, was in support of the Governor's plan. "NYRA applauds the bold initiatives that Governor Paterson and Chairman Frucher are undertaking to reorganize NYCOTB, which plays a critical role in the horseracing industry and the economy of New York State," Hayward said in the statement. "We pledge to work with them in advancing the interests of racing industry stakeholders and the citizens of New York."

The doctors say the head injury will heal on its own in time. He still has no feeling in his lower body, but until the swelling around the spine goes down, we are keeping positive thoughts. He is responding to commands and shakes his head 'Yes' and 'No' when responding to questions and holding up fingers when asked."
