INTO MISCHIEF SPENDTHRIFT

RICHARD'S KID UPSETS PACIFIC CLASSIC

Bob Baffert, inducted into racing's Hall of Fame last month, sent out 24-1 shot **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid), owned by Arnold Zetzer, to upset the \$1-million GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar yesterday evening. "Bob said he was doing good," reported winning rider Mike Smith. "Then he said, 'I want you to give me one of those Hall of Fame rides.' He was just smooth as silk out there today." It was the second big win on the card for Baffert, who led over **Zensational** (Unbridled's Song) to secure the GI Pat O'Brien S. earlier in the day. Cont. p2-3

One day after Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) solidified her credentials for Horse of the Year, trainer Steve Asmussen saddled **Hot Dixie Chick** (Dixie Union) to take the GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga, establishing herself as the fastest juvenile filly in the east. "She was very professional and maintained her margin to the wire," Asmussen noted. "Obviously, today she reached a new level. I don't know if we look past this

AQLAAM POWERS TO MOULIN SUCCESS

Second to wonder filly Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in last month's G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois at Deauville, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's injury-plagued

Aqlaam (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) bounced back to register a deserved first top-level success in Sunday's G1 Prix de Moulin de Longchamp. Settled off the pace in second until inching closer in the straight, the 37-10 chance seized control approaching the final furlong and ran on strongly

in the latter stages to account for **Famous Name** (GB) (Dansili {GB}) by 1 1/2 lengths. "We came up against a great filly last time and she beat us soundly," admitted jockey Richard Hills. "Aqlaam ran a fantastic race that day, and today we've won a Group 1, which is very much deserved." Cont. p4

HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL

Two-year-old colts will get their first chance at Grade I glory on opposite coasts today in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga and, 2 1/2 hours later, the GI Del Mar Futurity. **Backtalk** (Smarty Jones) is 5-1 on the Hopeful's morning line despite coming off a pair of graded-stakes victories, but has drawn the far outside and must face several promising maiden winners. "We're coming up to this race great," said trainer Tom Amoss. "This is a big mature horse."

Bred in Maryland by the Meyerhoff family's Fitzhugh LLC operation, Richard's Kid showed signs of progression late in his three-year-old campaign for trainer Richard Small, stringing together three allowance-level victories at Laurel, the last of which came on Jan. 1. He ran a close third in an optional claimer at that track Jan. 21, then rallied five wide to defeat Bullsbay (Tiznow)--eventual winner of the GI Whitney H.--in the John Campbell H. at Laurel on Valentine's Day. Sixth in the GII New Orleans H. at Fair Grounds one month later, the bay wound up fifth to Bullsbay upon his return home in the Harrison E. Johnson Memorial H. Mar. 28, and closed out his tenure under Small with a fourth in the GIII William D. Schaefer H. at Pimlico May 16. Richard's Kid was subsequently purchased privately by Arnold Zetcher and shipped cross-country to Bob Baffert. He made an inauspicious local bow, finishing seventh in his turf bow in the GI Eddie Read H. July 25, but hinted at what might come with a nose second in the 12-furlong Cougar II on this Polytrack Aug. 5, and had trained strongly since that outing.

Mike Smith settled Richard's Kid near the back of the pack as Tres Borrachos (Ecton Park) made the running through splits of :47.42 and 1:12.53. Still unhurried as the field entered the far turn with Einstein about to take over the lead, Smith tipped his mount to the outside, and Richard's Kid advanced. He rallied in the eight path, came up alongside Parading (Storm Cat) and surged in the final strides to touch off the valiant Einstein. "He's a big, heavy-muscled horse; the kind that tend to tie up on you," said Smith, who dropped his stick nearing the wire. "But he was just doing great today. Every step he made along the way was a good one. He just was rolling all the way." Favored Rail Trip had an eponymous journey to finish third, while second choice Colonel John (Tiznow) turned for home behind a wall of horses and wound up fifth.

It was the second Grade I win on the year for owner Arnold Zetcher,

whose homebred Gabby's Golden Gal (Medaglia d'Oro) prevailed in the Acorn at Belmont in June. He recently teamed up with Baffert.

"When I decided to make a change, I thought about other trainers, and Bob Baffert was the one I thought would work best for us," Zetcher explained. "We were acquainted through mornings on the backside and we always got along fine. And when I decided to change my stable's emphasis to younger horses, Bob was the one for me."

Second to subsequent GSW Decelerator (Dehere) in her May 14 bow at Churchill, Hot Dixie Chick set a track record of :56 2/5 when graduating by 5 3/4 lengths under the Twin Spires June 13, and was tabbed as a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆. She lived up to that billing with an emphatic score in the gloaming on opening day in the Gill Schuylerville S., and was widely expected to extend her record here. The dark bay settled along the fence just off Bickersons, who put up splits of :22.77 and :45.19. Hot Dixie Chick took back a bit for a few strides on the turn, but put her head down once in the lane and finished up determinedly to take her first Grade I event. "She's got a mind that's spooky--she's extremely laid back," said winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "[Assistant trainer] Scott [Blasi] said she was laying down in the holding barn. Her demeanor is why she's stabled next to Rachel--you can't have a better demeanor than that." Her yearling half-sister by Speightstown is catalogued as [hip 540](#) at KEESEP. He didn't have much to beat, but Zensational did what he had to do to earn his third Grade I win in the arguably weak West Coast sprint division. The roan ridgling went gate to wire in the July 5 GI Triple Bend H. at Hollywood and Aug. 8 GI Bing Crosby S. at Del Mar. Off a stride slowly yesterday, the headstrong sophomore pulled his way to the lead in a matter of strides. He led them along through unassuming fractions of :23.10 and :45.37 and was not threatened as Noble Court closed some ground late. "It's nerve-wracking to have a horse this good," trainer Bob Baffert said. "He's an incredible animal; so fast. You have to be careful with him. If you move on him, he takes off." Baffert added, "This is all the racing for him for now. I want to keep him real sharp for the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Sprint, Nov. 7]." Aqlaam was restricted to just seven prior starts by a catalogue of injuries, but announced his class in last season's G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot. He came back this year to run 10th in the May 16 G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury, and improved to hit the board in the June 16 G1 Queen Anne S. Getting better yet to garner the July 11 G2 Summer Mile at Ascot, he was far from disgraced when second in the Aug. 16 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois, and reached his pinnacle here. Aqlaam broke swiftly, but was settled five lengths off the pace as Gladiatorus (Silic {Fr}) set solid fractions. Inching ever closer in the stretch, he was ridden to lead approaching the final furlong and ran on strongly. "It's been a very big team effort, all the way from [Racing Manager] Angus Gold and everyone at Shadwell Stud to [trainer] William Haggas' yard," said jockey Richard Hills. "Everybody's had a little bit of involvement, so it's somewhat special." Reflecting on the winner's injury woes, and looking ahead to future plans, Angus Gold added, "Last year he had a hairline fracture in his pelvis, and it has taken time to come back to his best. He didn't run well in the Lockinge, but his trainer suggested we run him in the Queen Anne because he felt the horse had never been better. From there he's not stopped improving. With a Group 1 win, and being by the hot sire of the moment, he now has a future as a stallion. The [G1] Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Sept. 26] is the logical step, but we'll discuss everything with Sheikh Hamdan first." Aqlaam's task was made easier when Elusive Wave (Elusive City) refused to race. The crowd's 6-4 choice planted herself as the gates opened and took no part in the contest after dislodging jockey Christophe Lemaire at the stalls. "Elusive Wave just showed a bad attitude today," said Lemaire. "When she finally exited the gate she clearly showed she didn't want to run and tried to unship me." Getaway, labeled a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ back in 2006, was lightly raced as he entered the following year's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in place of the injured Manduro (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}), but he emerged with an enhanced reputation after finishing fourth in the autumn highlight. When he cruised to a facile success on his next outing in the 2008 G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket the next spring, the homebred looked to have the world at his feet, but he failed to follow the script and was off the board in four of his next five starts. All failures came at this level, and his only subsequent win before being transferred from Andre Fabre to Jens Hirschberger at the end of the season was the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville in August. Starting out for his new stable with a second in the G2 Hansa-Preis at Hamburg June 28, the bay stepped up off that effort to annex the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf July 19 before being outgamed by G1 Deutsches Derby hero Wiener Walzer (Ger) (Dynaformer) in the G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne last time Aug. 16. Exacting his revenge in this highlight of the Baden-Baden racing and sales festival, he moved ominously well in third as Wiener Walzer took the field along and, after looming alongside that rival at the top of the stretch, soon quickened into a decisive lead before being kept up to his work by Adrie de Vries. De Vries commented, "It felt good all the way. Getaway settled down quickly and was traveling great. I only had to watch out not to hit the front too early, but everything just worked out great." Trainer Jens Hirschberger added, "Getaway is feeling absolutely great at the moment, both at home and on the track, and today he left a great impression. Improving off a debut second at Windsor June 27, Buzzword shed maiden status back there July 13 before running second in the July 31 G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood. He occupied the same berth in the Aug. 22 G3 Solario S. at Sandown last time, and dented some lofty reputations with a decisive victory in this. Breaking well to lead early, the eventual winner was headed by ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Eightfold Path after a furlong and stalked that keen-running rival until the home straight. Buzzword reclaimed the initiative when quickening to the front approaching the final quarter mile and ran on strongly in the closing stages to easily hold the vain bid of another ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ in Siyouni. "It's not a surprise to me, as he has a lot of class and has shown good form already," said trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "I instructed [jockey] Ahmed [Ajtebi] to keep him up front; he liked being there and has run very well. Buzzword showed speed and a good turn of foot, and handled the distance and the ground very well, too." Rendezvous broke his maiden for a \$40,000 tag at Calder last November before he was acquired privately by his current connections. After rattling off consecutive wins at Golden Gate this winter, the chestnut reported home third in that track's GIII El Camino Real Derby Feb. 14. He raced evenly to finish fourth in the GIII Derby Trial S. at Churchill Apr. 25, then was third in an optional claimer over the Belmont turf May 14. After beating one home when fifth in an off-the-turf renewal of the GIII Hill Prince S. at Big Sandy June 5, Rendezvous rebounded to complete the trifecta when back on the spinach in the restricted Oceanside S. at Del Mar July 22. The chestnut took the overland route to grab the lead at the top of the stretch of the Aug. 15 GII La Jolla H., but was forced to settle for second by 1 1/2 lengths after he failed to hold off the late charge of **Meteore (Pulpit)**. Rendezvous, dismissed in the wagering here, clipped heels with **Midnight Mischief** on the chute before he settled in eighth through the early exchanges. Jockey Joel Rosario waited until he was inside the quarter pole to push the button, and Rendezvous made a determined run in the stretch to nip **Battle of Hastings** on the wire. "Joel was in a zone today, so I just told him to ride his race, and he surely did," said winning trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. Rendezvous will now be pointed towards the GII Oak Tree Derby on Breeders' Cup day, Nov. 7.

Al Khali, who's changed hands several times and even crossed the Equator in his young life, became the first male by his esteemed young sire to capture a black-type event with a sustained rally. The \$15,000 KEESEP yearling began his career in Peru, graduating in his second start last September and adding a seven-length allowance tally the following month at Hippodromo de Monterrico near Lima. That win caught the attention of WinStar Farm, which purchased the bay privately and turned him over to Todd Pletcher. After landing a nine-furlong allowance on Gulfstream's dirt Mar. 6 ([video](#)), he was beaten 15 lengths in both the GII Illinois Derby Apr. 4 and GII Peter Pan S. May 9, and made the move to the infield for the GII Colonial Turf Cup June 20. He was fifth that day, then improved to be a narrow second to Courageous Cat (Storm Cat) in the A Gift S. at Belmont July 19, in what would be his final appearance in Pletcher's white bridle.

In his first start for Brous and Wachtel and trainer Bill Mott, the ridgling settled for third behind Courageous Cat in the GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. going nine furlongs over this course Aug. 14, and was the second choice in this slightly longer affair. Al Khali settled in fifth and was always traveling smoothly as favored Sal the Barber (Alphabet Soup) went up to set the pace. Kent Desormeaux shook him up on the far turn and Al Khali responded, bounding up to take command inside the final furlong on his way to a confident score. Mott had also entered the sophomore in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S. yesterday at Delaware, but opted to lead his charge over instead. "We love New York," said Mott. "We didn't have to ship. He's coming off only three weeks rest and I didn't want to van him down [to Delaware Park]. I knew he ran well over this course. The weather was pretty good, and I wanted to take a chance here." Backtalk, a half-brother to MGSW Bsharpsonata (Pulpit), went five wide to land his June 11 career opener at Churchill Downs. The next three finishers that day all went on to graduate next time out, including **Dublin**, and Backtalk himself overcame trouble to collect the GIII Bashford Manor S. by a length over **Flatter Than Me** July 3 under the Twin Spires. He came running six wide over this surface to prevail by a neck over **Enumerate** in the GII Sanford S. July 30, and trainer Tom Amoss is confident there's more to come. "The seven-eighths is a benefit to him," said Amoss, noting the Hopeful's distance, "but not where he wants to be. You won't see the best of Backtalk until he goes two turns." **Prince Rooney**, a grandson of Hall of Famer Princess Rooney (Verbatim), wired the field when unveiled in a 4 1/2-furlong test on Arlington's Polytrack July 5. The bay colt turned the Mountaineer Juvenile S. into a runaway when winning by 15 lengths Aug. 1, and looks primed to continue trainer Steve Asmussen's strong summer. "Prince Rooney worked extremely well up here," said assistant trainer Scott Blasi. "His race at Mountaineer was dominating, and he deserves a chance on this stage." The Hopeful wouldn't be the Hopeful without colts stepping up from Spa maiden wins. The aforementioned Dublin covered six furlongs in 1:09 2/5 when he broke through Aug. 1 ([video](#)), while **Liston**, a half-brother to MGSW Country Star (Empire Maker), delivered his punch at first asking Aug. 15 ([video](#)).

RACHEL WRAP-UP

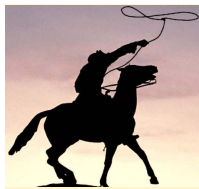
Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) will spend a couple of days in the barn following her gritty victory in the GI Woodward S. Saturday at Saratoga. "She ran," trainer Steve Asmussen remarked. "She's very physical. She ran hard, cooled out, drank plenty of water...she's a professional. She doesn't rest on her laurels. She puts in the work. That's what gives you so much confidence about her. She doesn't just take the day off." There had been speculation prior to the Woodward--her fifth straight Grade I victory--that the filly would wrap up her 2009 campaign at this point, and it has yet to be decided if she will face the starter again this year. "I honestly don't know [what her next race will be]," said Asmussen. "I heard [co-owner] Jess [Jackson] say [she might not run again

this year] at the press conference [Saturday]. We'll just worry about her health, and take her back to the track on Wednesday." Asmussen added, "I'm just extremely proud of her and proud of everybody, and happy for [owners] Barbara [Banke] and Jess. He steps up and puts it out there. People like to talk about what could have happened--he sees what will happen." The Woodward was Rachel Alexandra's eighth start of 2009, adding to her trophy case that already included the GI Preakness S., GI Haskell Invitational S., GI Kentucky Oaks, GI Mother Goose S., GII Fantasy S. and GII Fair Grounds Oaks. Her triumph in the Woodward, accomplished before a crowd of 31,171, was the first by a three-year-old in the race since Holy Bull in 1994. Coincidentally, that was the final start of his Horse of the Year campaign.

Pyro's Forego Marks 150th Grade/Group 1 for Godolphin...

When **Pyro** (Pulpit) got up to win the GI Forego S. Saturday, it not only was the fourth Grade I win this summer at Saratoga for Godolphin, but also the 150th victory at the top level for the operation, which was established in

1994. Pyro, acquired privately from breeder Winchell Thoroughbreds in 2008, closed out his sophomore campaign with a sixth-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, contested on Santa Anita's Pro-Ride surface Oct. 25. The handsome colt underwent surgery with Dr. Larry Bramlage to remove a chip in his knee, and was out of action for nine months. "[Darley] just felt that, with the economy last year, they had nothing to lose by keeping him in training and trying to win a Grade 1," said Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "But when you start doing that fast speed work, that's when you find out if they even want to run." Pyro's first start back was a fast-finishing second in the James Marvin S. on Saratoga's opening day, and he went one better on a bigger stage this past weekend. "We were convinced off the James Marvin he would run a whole lot better," Mettee added. "There's a lot of gratification."

Mapping It Out for Beautician...

Peter Callahan's **Beautician** (Dehere) kicked off Saratoga with a second-place finish to Hot Dixie Chick (Dixie Union) in the GIII Schuylerville S. July 29, and mirrored that effort in yesterday's GI Spinaway S. The grey filly put in another solid late run, and has trainer Ken McPeck savoring her autumn campaign. "We're exactly where we want to be," McPeck revealed. "We have a couple of big races coming up: the [GI Darley] Alcibiades [Oct. 9 at Keeneland] and the [GI] Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies [Nov. 6 at Santa Anita]. We want to get her at two turns. To be top two-year-old filly, you have to win the big ones. I didn't want to overdo it today--I wanted to keep her fresh. She's a good filly. She's special to us. We needed a race over the track the last time. So, this was an improvement."

Maram on Fence for Garden City...

Unbeaten **Maram** (Sahm) may not make her intended start in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup S. at Belmont Saturday after shedding a frog, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "It looks like I'm going to miss my breeze," trainer Chad Brown told *DRF*. "If she's not 100 percent and I can't breeze her, then I'm not going to run her. I'd say she's unlikely." The three-year-old, who capped 2008 with a win in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, captured her lone outing this season, the James Hettinger S. at Saratoga Aug. 8. Brown also revealed that MGSW **Smooth Air** (Smooth Jazz) has been shipped to a farm in Ocala, Florida, to recuperate from some foot problems. The Mount Joy homebred most recently finished sixth as the 2-1 favorite in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 8. "We got the foot cleared up, but then a week later you could see something was bothering this horse," Brown told *DRF*. "He kept wanting to drift." A scan then revealed "some hot spots here and there." Brown added, "The good news is it's nothing major. He just had some spots where you'd want to give him a bit of time."

Having a number of fillies of my own, my instruction to the riders is always the same: "Do not hit this filly." To me, it does not matter the race or the situation: do not hit the filly, not even once. It was therefore sad to have to watch Rachel Alexandra winning the Woodward last night under almost continual striking in the final eighth of a mile from her manic (or is it manic?) rider. Was it so important to the rider (or indeed her connections) that she be treated in this way? Mr. Jackson had always appeared to me (albeit in the media) to be a decent person, but I have yet to read a word of regret from him about the treatment his filly received. If neither he nor the trainer (nor indeed the *TDN* editorial staff, I might add) say nothing, can we assume that they condone this win-at-all-costs behavior from the rider? Some horses are lazy and need some kind of encouragement, but Rachel Alexandra? Would she have won without the rider's whacking? We'll never know, but the picture of a wonderful filly being hit that many times to win a horse race is not going to encourage younger people to take an interest in the sport.

I wonder how many other viewers reacted in the same way as this one, and how many will write in to air their comments.

MAN BAILED AFTER BLAZE ARREST Police investigating the arson attack that claimed the life of two apprentice jockeys on Saturday have released on bail the man they had held in connection with the incident. While the jockeys have yet to be named officially by the authorities as the post-mortem is pending, it was revealed that Jamie Kyne, 18, and Jan Wilson, 19, died in the fire that broke out at a block of flats in Norton, near Malton, North Yorkshire. 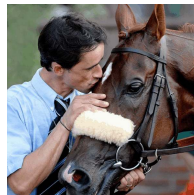

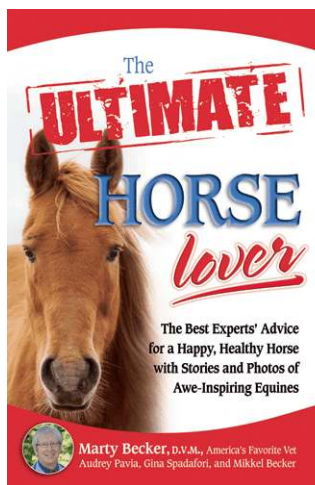
