## MIDSHIPMAN TRIUMPHANT IN RETURN

It wasn't a Grade I test, but Godolphin's **Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song) added to the stable's current run of success yesterday at Belmont, coming from just off the pace to score after an extended layoff. The Eclipse winner was making his first start since clinching the championship in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita Oct. 25, and his first on conventional dirt. The joint-second choice behind **Storm Play** (Smart Strike),

Midshipman raced freely as he tracked **Just Ben** (Speightstown) through a quarter in :22.46 and a half in :44.72. Head and head with the pacesetter into the lane, he drifted noticeably in the final furlong, but drew away to win by 3 1/4 lengths. The time for the 6 1/2-furlong allowance test was 1:15 4/5. "That's a pretty good horse he stalked all the way around," said Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "The staff did a great job in getting him ready." Added jockey Richie Migliore, "As good as he was on synthetic, maybe he's even better on conventional dirt. He couldn't have moved any better and couldn't have come back any better." Midshipman followed his debut score at Del Mar last summer with a narrow victory in the GI Del Mar Futurity. He was beaten by Street Hero (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Norfolk S. at Oak Tree Sept. 28, but turned the tables in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, with Street Hero third. Shipped to Dubai for the winter, the colt was sidelined by a soft-tissue injury, and returned to steady training about two months ago. Looking ahead, Mettee said, "This win gives us a lot of options. ## LAST LAUGH FOR D'FUNNYBONE?

An impressive winner at Calder in his career opener in May, **D'Funnybone** (D'wildcat) was caught late in the July 11 Frank Gomez Memorial S. and finished second, but had done enough to get the attention of owner Paul Pompa Jr. Pompa purchased the colt privately, and had him shipped north to the barn of trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. D'Funnybone made his first start under new colors in the Aug. 20 GI Saratoga Special S., romping to a 10 1/2-length victory, and he bids to make it two in a row in today's GI Futurity S. at Belmont Park. Can he take his connections all the way to the West Coast for the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile? "We'll find out more about the horse on Saturday," said Dutrow. "We're stretching him out a little further, and we'll let him dictate things and see how far he can take us." **Cont. p2**

Successful in the May 7 G3 Huxley S. at Chester, Doctor Fremantle dropped to seventh place in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 20, but regained the winning thread in the July 9 G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket last time. He was anchored in rear for most of this contest until inching ever closer once into the long home straight. On course to find a pocket inside the final quarter mile, the bay homebred was angled outside for a clear run with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and made an irresistible surge under a power drive in the closing stages to nail last term's G1 Epsom Oaks victress Look Here on the line. With the victory, Doctor Fremantle gained belated revenge on the runner-up, who beat him when the pair met in a 2007 juvenile maiden at Salisbury. "I wanted to get as much cover as possible and hoped he'd get the run," jockey Ryan Moore told *PA Sport*. "He's put his head down and done it quite nicely." Reflecting on the runner-up's close call, Look Here, trainer Ralph Beckett added, "That's life and I'm not quite sure what we will do next. We'll have to take the positives out of it, although just getting done on the nod was not quite what I envisaged."

## On Dark Day at KEESEP, Time Out for Good Cause...

On the morning of this year's GI Arlington Million, the owner of favorite Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat), Castleton Lyons' Shane Ryan read a story about Rene Douglas, who had been paralyzed in a spill. The story had an immediate impact on Ryan, who informed Arlington Park Chairman Richard Duchossois that if Gio Ponti lived up to advanced billing and indeed won the race, he would donate five percent of the winnings to the Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund (PDJF).

Gio Ponti won, and yesterday, during a break in the action at Keeneland September, Castleton Lyons presented a check to the PDJF in the amount of \$29,400. On hand to accept the check were retired Hall of Famer Chris McCarron, PDJF Board Vice President Jon Court, and Gary Birzer, who was paralyzed from the waist down in July of 2004 in a spill at Mountaineer. Stuart Fitzgibbons, commercial manager at Castleton Lyons, and farm manager Tobias Incollingo presented the check.

Formed in the spring of 2006, the PDJF is a non-profit charity that provides financial assistance to some 60 former jockeys who have suffered catastrophic on-track injuries.

"We're conscious of the human side of the business," said Fitzgibbons. "There are a lot of people who need help in this business. There have been a lot of accidents this year, unfortunately, and a lot of guys are getting badly hurt. There is a need for people, if they can, to step up to the plate and try to help out these guys. The jockeys risk their lives every day for us."

Added Court, "On behalf of the PDJF, we're incredibly grateful and appreciative of the efforts of Castleton Lyons, and for making this donation."

"We're less than half a decade young, and we've made enormous progress increasing the benefits and improving the quality of life of some of these riders who have suffered these catastrophic injuries," he added. "We hope that we can continue this diligent effort with other racing interests throughout the industry, and make people aware of how big of a need that there is for these permanently disable riders. We've come a long way, but we have a significant way to go."

Birzer made the two-hour trip down from his home near Cincinnati, Ohio, to attend the presentation. Asked what it meant to have an organization like the PDJF behind him, he commented, "Everything--because I wouldn't be able to live. I mean, their donation checks helps me with the nurse bills, it helps me to hire people so I can have my kids. It helps to pay everyday bills. Really, it means everything. Without the organization, I don't know what I'd be doing right now."

**Blame** put in a determined run to collect a first-level allowance at Churchill under the lights July 2 ([video](#)), then rallied up the rail to deny subsequent GII Pennsylvania Derby hero **Gone Astray** (Dixie Union) in the restricted **Curlin S.** at Saratoga Aug. 2. "That race at a mile and an eighth on a wet track at Saratoga is a tough race on a horse," trainer **Al Stall Jr.** told *Daily Racing Form*. "He handled that well and acts like he wants to keep going." Stall added, "What happened in the Penn Derby made it a pretty legit race." The bay is a homebred for Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider, who teamed up to win the 1998 Super Derby with the colt's sire **Arch**. **Godolphin's Regal Ransom** outgutted stablemate **Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}) in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba Mar. 28. Forwardly placed in the GI Kentucky Derby next out May 2, the bay colt faded in the Churchill slop to finish eighth, and has been sidelined since then after popping a curb. He could be ready to fire for the boys in blue after a pair of solid recent works, going six panels in 1:11 4/5 Sept. 4 at the Spa and a five-eighths drill in :59 2/5 at Belmont 10 days later. "We thought about the Pennsylvania Derby [Sept. 7], but he wasn't quite ready for that," assistant trainer **Rick Mettee** told *DRF*. "After that three-quarter work, we felt we've got a horse ready to run a pretty good race."

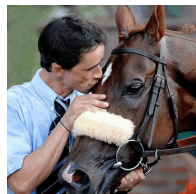

He was at the short end of a three horse photo in the local prep for this, but Thoro-Graph figures factor in weight carried and ground loss, and he earned clearly the best figure in the race (*note 4w3w, upper left*). With five weeks rest since, there's no reason for him to take a step backward now, and this gelding could easily run a new top. Very live at a price.

**2 Soul Warrior [Lion Heart](#) Asmussen 2-1**

Will get a lot of attention at the windows after beating Big Drama and Mine That Bird last time, but it should be noted he was getting a lot of weight that day, and got an inside trip. He ran a new top, but didn't earn as good a figure as the other two did and, even if he manages to avoid a bounce, a repeat would make him just one of the contenders here.

**3 Massone Menifee McAnally 4-1**

Hasn't run too fast and hasn't gotten back to his best effort, which came back in February at Golden Gate. This, however, will be his first try on dirt, and sire Menifee throws runners that are usually better on that surface than on grass or synthetic (*see sire profile*). That makes this one dangerous—he definitely could jump forward.

**4 Regal Ransom [Distorted Humor](#) bin Suroor 5-2**

Ran huge in his debut last year, and came back to that effort to win the G2 UAE Derby before stopping in the G1 Kentucky Derby slop. The barn is on fire (*see "Last 90 Days"*), does well fresh and wouldn't be putting this colt on a plane just to give him a race—he figures to run his race, or a new top.

 Has been inching forward, and a little more development would make him a contender here. Still, he's already come pretty far from last year, and he's not that fast with these. He's an underlay as one of the favorites.

**6 Uno Mas Macho Uno Asmussen 8-1**  
 Didn't run very fast to win the local prep, but got the best of the trips that day. He hasn't developed at all from the figure he ran last December, and would need to jump forward to contend here.

**7 Electric Alphabet Alphabet Soup Borel 15-1**  
 Also comes out of the local prep. This one has been moving forward, but would still need a pretty big new top to get involved.  
 All carry 124 lbs.

**BOTTOM LINE:** Several of these are shipping into Louisiana, which is never a picnic, especially for those going north/south. Red Lead doesn't have that problem, and has the additional advantages of the rail and tactical speed. He's a solid key at the price, with Massone and Regal Ransom the ones to protect under in exotics.

**BOOK 2 REVIEW: THE NEW REALITIES**

In several key areas, Book 2, which is now twice as big as Book 1 anyway, did considerably better than the sale's formerly much-storied first two days. Sixty-seven percent of the yearlings sent through the ring on Wednesday and Thursday were reported sold, versus 62 percent on Monday and Tuesday, and 61 percent of those catalogued in Book 2 were reported sold, versus just 53 percent in Book 1. The Book 2 gross was down 37 percent, which is maybe the sale's key figure to date, since the number catalogued to Book 2 (794) was only one percent fewer than last year (801). The Book 2 gross (\$58,903,500) narrowly exceeded the gross in Book 1 (\$58,756,000), whereas last year Book 2 was \$20 million under Book 1. Interestingly, too, the Book 2 average was down 30 percent--the same as Book 1. Going into today's Book 3, you'd say the barometer readings for the sale so far are: off around 35 percent in gross, 30 percent in average. Call it down a third (after Book 1).

Besides the collapse in demand for anything that doesn't hit 'the bar,' maybe the big news to come out of Book 2 is that there is still demand for 'nice' (however that is defined) horses. We analyzed the numbers for 38 stallions that had nine or more catalogued in Book 2 (so not including Storm Cat's \$675,000 filly, or the two Candy Ride colts for \$630,000 and \$340,000). These 38 stallions (see accompanying table, p12) accounted for over three-quarters of the yearlings sent through the ring and sold in Book 2. In total, these 38 sires accounted for 548 yearlings sent through the ring, and 368 of those sold. The week's good news was that over a third (191) of the yearlings sent through the ring --and over half of those that sold by these 38 sires-- sold for \$100,000 or more. Of those, 77, or a little better than one in five of those sold, brought final bids of \$200,000 or more. It is not an inconsequential number that 191 yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more: if the horse business had only started up this week, and there were no history to reflect upon, we'd all think that was a lot of money.

Of course, the fly in the ointment here is stud fees. The average price paid for the 368 yearlings sold by the 38 sires covered here in Book 2 was \$128,723 (average for the Book was \$122,460). But the average 'retail' stud fee paid to produce those 368 yearlings was \$74,995--call it \$75,000. Deduct the commissions and the cost of insuring and raising the yearling and, on average, you should just about have enough left over for a ham sandwich and a cup of coffee. Cut the stud fees in half, and at these prices you might just make a little money, or at least be able to amortize some of the cost of your mare. One thing that should be useful for breeders to know, when considering the cost of 2010 stud fees, is that Book 2 yearlings this year averaged a little under \$125,000--about 30 percent below 2008 Book 2 yearlings, which averaged just at \$170,000.

A few notes about stallions, hot and cold. Hot, of course, were the horses favored by Sheikh Mohammed and entourage, especially **Bernardini** (A.P. Indy) (25 averaged \$280,600, including both Books 1-2) and **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) (33 averaged \$240,061, again including both books). **Street Cry** averaged \$344,167 for six sold in Book 1 (all bought by John Ferguson or Blandford), but only \$99,900 for 10 in Book 2--so \$191,500 for 16 sold in the first two books, which looks hot, but isn't maybe quite as hot as it looks. **Unbridled's Song**, who averaged \$342,273 across both books, including purchases by both the Maktoums and Coolmore, was really the first two books' leading sire if you discount **Storm Cat**, who did average \$442,895 for 19 sold, but, since he stood for \$500,000 in 2007, he has to go on the cold list. So does **A.P. Indy**, whose sole Book 2 sale brought his average down to \$299,231--marginally below his 2007 stud fee of \$300,000--even though he, too, was patronized by both the Maktoums and Coolmore.

The really hot horse, throughout both books, has been **Dynaformer**. Twelve yearlings by him averaged \$304,582 in Book 1, and another seven averaged \$274,286 in Book 2, combining for an overall Book 1-2 average of \$293,421 for 19 sold, off a 2007 stud fee of \$150,000. I thought **Distorted Humor** sold very well in Book 1, though with Book 2 added in he's had 20 sell for an average of \$251,750; there have been 34 offered, and I show his 2007 stud fee as \$225,000. He could be in trouble next year, off a \$300,000 stud fee in 2008, though to be fair, it did drop back to \$150,000 this year. They might not be especially profitable this year, but I still maintain we saw a lot of nice yearlings by him.

Bernardini is safely the leader among the sires with their first yearlings selling, but **First Samurai** put up a mighty performance to average \$186,154 with 13 selling, of 14 offered, in Book 2, which ranked him fourth among these 38 sires strictly on Book 2 average. His first two books' average is \$209,937, carrying him well in front of his two serious competitors for the second spot among first-crop sires, ahead of **Henny Hughes** (\$134,833 for 12 sold, from 25 offered, in the first two books) and **Bluegrass Cat**, who averaged just \$72,700 in Book 2, and \$85,500 for 14 sold (of 28 offered) in the first two books combined. First-year sires have gone from heroes to zeroes in the last 12 months, so First Samurai's performance, in particular, is noteworthy.

Other sires which sold well in Book 2 included: **Indian Charlie** (10 sold/16 offered), averaged \$181,700 off a 2007 stud fee of \$40,000, though that shot up to \$75,000 this year; and two-time leading sire **Smart Strike**, with 11 averaging \$180,909 in Book 2--though that was from 22 offered and, when you add in Book 1, he had only 13 sell, of 33 offered. They've always said he wasn't much of a sales sire, which is one reason why he's still one of the most underrated sires (of actual racehorses, not sales horses) in the business. **Tapit**, one of five really hot second-crop sires, had nine yearlings sell in Book 2 (of 12 offered), for an average of \$165,556 and a median of \$140,000, off a 2007 stud fee of \$12,500. This group of 'second-crop' sires (first three-year-olds) also includes Medaglia d'Oro; **Speightstown**, who has averaged over \$160,000 in the first two books (17 sold, from 28 offered), off a \$40,000 fee; **Candy Ride**, who had two colts sell in Book 2, for \$630,000 and \$340,000, respectively; and **Birdstone** (Grindstone), who's only had one sell so far (for \$130,000), but, like all of these five, is sure to prove popular as we kick off Week Two.

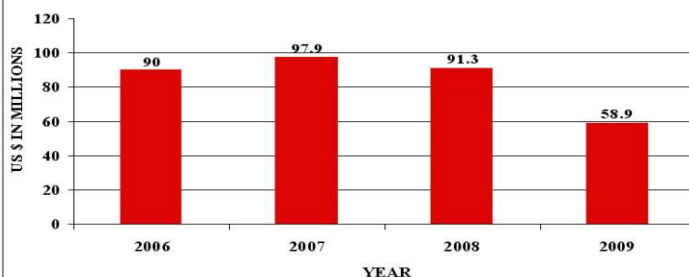

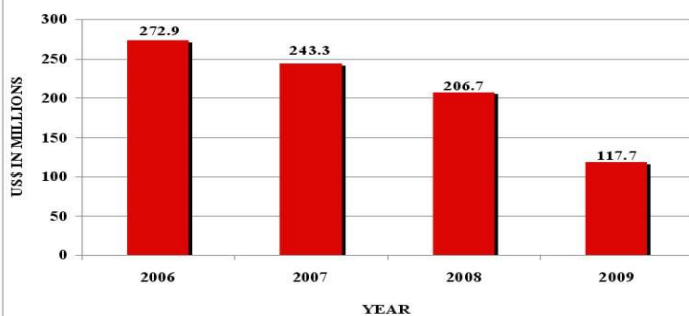

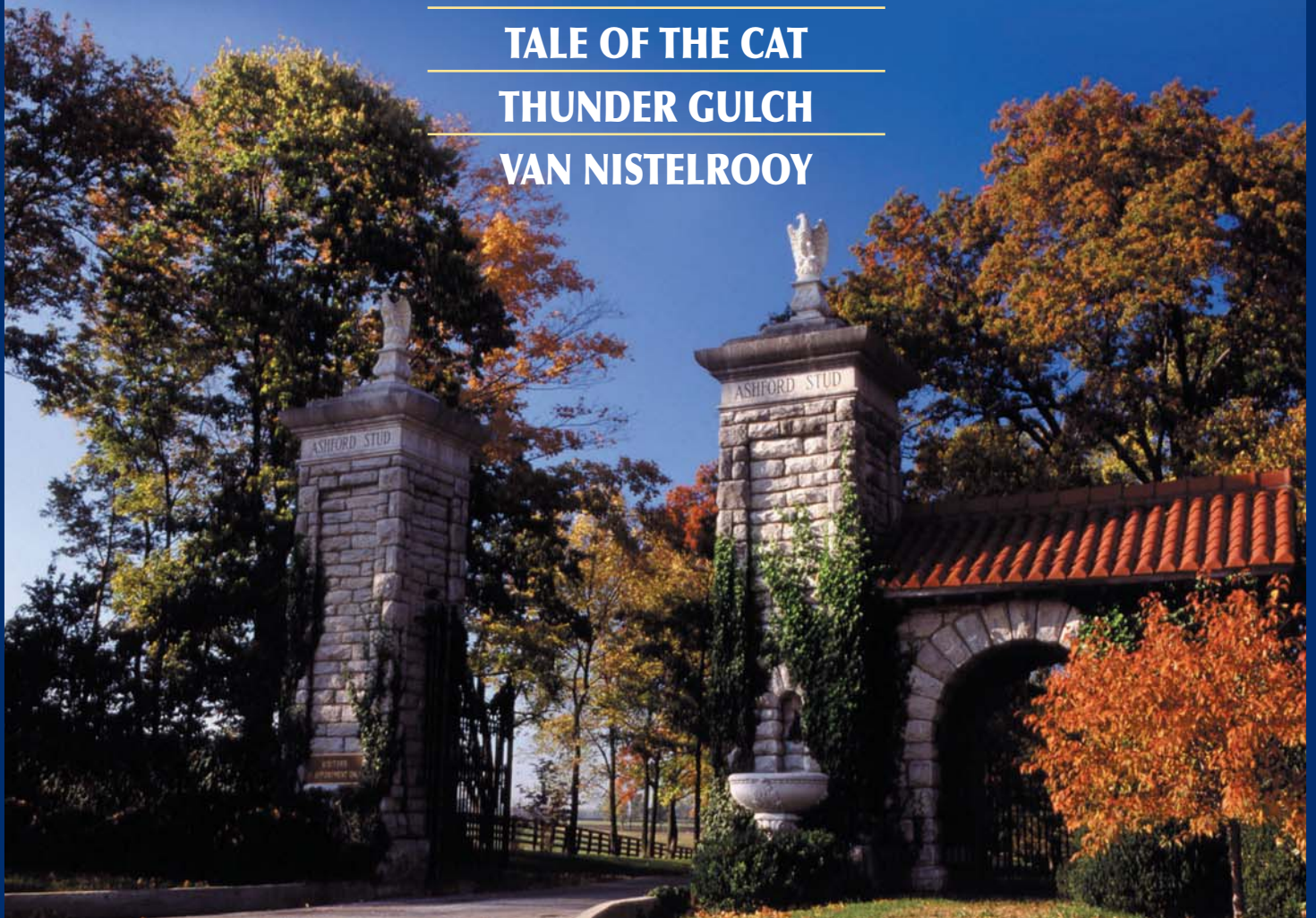

**JUDDMONTE BC TEAM TAKES SHAPE** Khalid Abdullah's European Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe yesterday unveiled Juddmonte's likely runners at this year's Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita. Headed by the G1 Nassau S. winner and G1 Epsom Oaks runner-up **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), who is bound for the \$2-million G1 Emirates Airline Filly & Mare Turf, the list also includes the June 28 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and G2 Prix Foy winner **Spanish Moon** (El Prado {Ire}). "Midday may go for the Filly & Mare Turf and we will make a final decision after she has run in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Oct. 4," Grimthorpe commented. "Her victory in the Nassau Stakes was especially sweet, particularly on that ground, but she's acted on a faster surface earlier in the season and going to Santa Anita wouldn't be a problem. **Father Time (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) could go for the Breeders' Cup Marathon. He stayed most of the St Leger trip and I would be hopeful that he could get a mile and six furlongs around Santa Anita. Spanish Moon also has the Breeders' Cup as an option. We are thinking about the [Oct. 4] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at the moment and there's also the [Oct. 17] G1 Pattinson Canadian International, which could lead to the Breeders' Cup Turf. There is also Hong Kong to think about. The idea is to have him on song for the top international races and the Breeders' Cup obviously comes into the equation. I thought he ran really well in the Prix Foy, considering that was his first appearance since the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, and he was a bit rusty--that run should bring him on a ton." Grimthorpe also revealed that the recent G2 Celebration Mile runner-up **Zacinto (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) is another possible representative. "We haven't decided whether Zacinto is going to Ascot [for the Sept. 26 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S.] or Newmarket [for the Oct. 17 G1 Emirates Airline Champion S.] at the moment," he added. "They are both part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge, but we would see how he goes in either race before deciding whether to let him run at Santa Anita. It's doubtful at the moment that he will go."

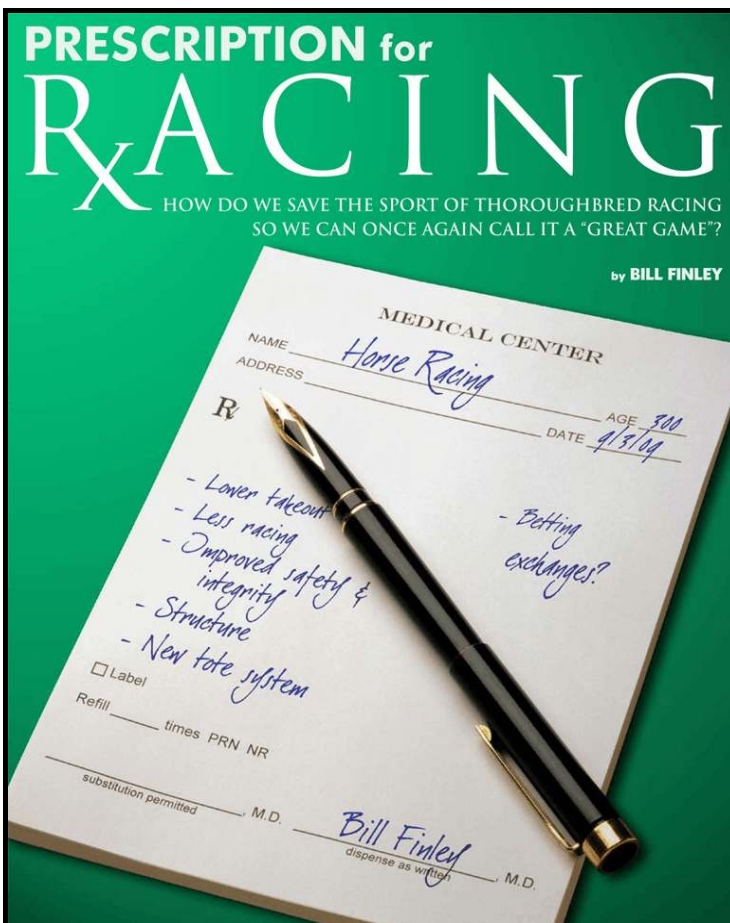
