BELMONT HOSTS SUPER SATURDAY

The five Grade I events on today's Super Saturday program at Belmont Park failed to produce a winner of any of last year's Breeders' Cup races, but that fact may be an aberration. In the history of racing's championship day, no fewer than 23 times has a winner of one of the races gone on to Breeders' Cup glory.

The centerpiece of the program is the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, which features leading three-year-olds **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) and **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) taking on the hard-knocking **Macho Again** (Macho Uno). Castleton Lyons's **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) looks to add a fifth consecutive Grade I in the Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, though his Breeders' Cup future may reside on the Pro Ride. Overnight rains in the forecast could greatly aid the chances of Dr. John Chandler's **Dynaforce** (Dynaformer), as she looks to become just the second repeat winner of the GI Flower Bowl Invitational. Walter Downey's **Fabulous Strike** (Smart Strike) failed by a head in attempting to take the GI Vosburgh S. last year, and faces a compact, but talented bunch in what may or may not be a prep for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. **Music Note** (A.P. Indy) romped by 5 1/4 lengths in the GI Ballerina S. over seven panels at Saratoga Aug. 29, but stretches back out to a route of ground as she seeks to give Godolphin a second straight renewal of the GI Beldame S. **Fields p7-10**

ARC FIELD WILL SEE STARS

Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) received a favorable draw in six ahead of his latest test in tomorrow's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. His stall, from which the 2005 and 2007 heroes Hurricane Run (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Daneshill) emerged, was the almost perfect scenario for connections who had been hoping not to be drawn too far down on the rail. With Aidan O'Brien withdrawing Johann Zoffany (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) at the final declaration stage yesterday, a field of 19 will head to post for the 88th renewal of the richest turf race in the world. **Cont. p6**

AWZOME

Awzaan (GB) (Alhaarth {Ire}) justified his **"TDN Rising Star"** tag with a victory in the Sept. 19 G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury and took another leap forward with a determined win in yesterday's G1 Shadwell Middle Park S. at Newmarket. Handily placed throughout the six-furlong test, the 4-1 chance made his bid inside the final quarter mile and kept on strongly under a drive, despite drifting left, to comfortably hold the late rush of **Radiohead** (GB) (Johannesburg) by 3/4-of-a-length. "He's quite a special horse because he's got a good cruising speed and he can really quicken," said rider Richard Hills. "The pace was pretty full on from the start and he got the trip really well." **Cont. p2**

CALL OF DUTY

Special Duty (GB) (Hennessy) was ousted in the dying embers of the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 26, but rebounded to gain compensation in yesterday's G1 Electrolux Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket. Leading after the early strides, the 3-1 second favorite looked vulnerable to the threat of **Lady of the Desert** (Rahy) approaching the final furlong, but found abundant reserves and drew away up the hill to score by 2 3/4 lengths from **Misheer** (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}). "She's a very fast filly," claimed jockey Stephane Pasquier. "I was disappointed by her defeat in the Morny because she did everything by herself and was beaten just a [short] neck. She did much the same today, but she won and won easily." **Cont. p3**

Awzaan opened his account in a low-key maiden at Hamilton June 17 and earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status following an impressive five-length score at Newmarket's other course July 9. That promise was confirmed with victory in the Sept. 19 G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury and he continued on an upward curve with a decisive win in this to stay perfect. Racing in a close fourth, but without the benefit of cover for most of the contest, he was shaken up to challenge at the quarter mile marker and stayed on resolutely under vigorous urging, despite drifting left, to safely hold Radiohead's late surge along the stands' side rail. "At one point I thought he wasn't going to pick up, but when he goes, he goes," said winning trainer Mark Johnston. "He got a little buzzed up on the July course and it was Sheikh Hamdan's idea to give him a break. It has worked out perfect. He's very relaxed and so laid back at home that he doesn't stand out from the crowd. He doesn't get excited, he doesn't sweat up and he's the perfect race-horse. All he wants to do is eat, sleep and gallop--and only gallop when he's asked to."

"We'll take him back home and see how he is, but I'm very pleased with his run today." Part-owner Peter Burrell added, "I'm very happy and this horse has never disappointed us. He's been a wonderful horse through the year. That was run number six and maybe he has one more run in him." John Gosden, trainer of third placegetter and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Showcasing, said, "He ran a good race and the form is solid, but he just looked a little unbalanced running into the dip. That can happen here, but he is probably a better horse on a flat track. Cheveley Park Stud S. cont.

Second in the July 4 Listed Prix Yacowlef at Deauville, Special Duty was victorious in the July 26 G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte before just getting collared in the final strides when attempting to make all in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 26. British bookmakers have promoted Special Duty to 5-1 favorite for next term's G1 1000 Guineas, a race trainer Criquette Head-Maarek garnered with Ma Biche and Ravinella. Special Duty broke well from the gate, came under pressure when tackled by Lady of the Desert approaching the final eighth, but found plenty when asked up the climb to draw clear of that rival who was nailed by Misheer on the line for second. "Stephane Pasquier rode a beautiful race," enthused the winning trainer. "We went too fast at Deauville so I told him to ride her the same way, but to wait as long as possible. She looks like she could get a mile because she was going away at the end, and I hope we come back here next year [for the 1000 Guineas]." Brian Meehan cited Newmarket's undulations as a contributory factor in the defeat of Lady of the Desert. He added, "The ground was fine, but I don't think she handled the track. She came there with her usual turn of foot, but became very unbalanced coming down the hill into the dip. I imagine that will be it for this year and we'll look at the French Guineas now."

Confront had turned potential into achievement on his last two outings, forcing a dead heat in the Listed City of York S. on York's Knavesmire Aug. 21 before taking the Listed Superior Mile at Haydock with something to spare Sept. 5. "I'm delighted and he handled the surface really well," Aidan O'Brien said. "He showed the class he has by the way he was able to make up the ground when Johnny [Murtagh] asked. He cruised home and I'd imagine if both are well, Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and him will both run in the Breeders' Cup Classic."

Tabassum broke through first time out at Newmarket's July course Aug. 8 and retained her unbeaten record with an impressive score at this Rowley Mile venue. The diminutive bay homebred raced prominently from the outset. Seizing control with three furlongs remaining, she was pushed along approaching the final eighth and stretched clear under urging in the closing stages to easily defeat Electric Feel. "She's small, but is very brave and has a really good gallop," commented winning jockey Richard Hills. "She can go a good pace and can keep it going. She's tricky and is quite highly strung, but is going the right way. A Cosmopolitan Arc...

Brazil will be represented by Estrela Energia Stables' G1 Gran Premio Asociacion Latinoamericana de Jockey Clubes e Hipodromos winner **Hot Six (Brz)** (Burooj {GB}), who has drawn post position four. He arrived at Pascal Bary's Chantilly stable on Saturday night following a marathon 54-hour trip from his native country which was marred by delays in quarantine. **Tullamore** (Theatrical {Ire}) becomes the first Czech runner in the highlight, while Russian jockey Magomet Kappuchev will partner **The Bogberry** (Hawk Wing), owned by Russian Jockey Club Chairman Sergei Efros. Following the draw at France-Galop's headquarters near Paris, connections of G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. winner **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) were not overly pleased with his outside stall in 12. Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf and G1 St Leger hero will have to defy a double-figure draw, as his sire did six years ago, in his bid to provide trainer Sir Michael Stoute and owner/breeder Ballymacoll Stud a long-coveted first Arc success. "We would have liked to have been drawn a little bit lower, but can't do anything about that," Stoute commented. "We're very pleased with his preparation and he's in good form, but this is a high-class Arc. We're very happy with him and hope he puts his best foot forward. Whatever the ground, that shouldn't be a problem and we will hope for the best." Also drawn high is Martin Schwartz's G1 Prix Saint-Alary, G1 Prix de Diane and G1 Prix Vermeille heroine **Stacelita (Fr)** (Monsun {Ger}), who is even wider than the most recent to overcome such draws in Dalakhani and 2001 winner Sakhee. Her draw was met with disappointment by the owner's Racing Manager Michel Zerolo, who said, "It is far from ideal. A good pace is expected though and things could develop favourably for us, but we will need an extra pinch of luck here." **Arc field p6**

A complete unknown two months deep into 2009, **Summer Bird** is a household name at this point and can become the first sophomore since Easy Goer in 1989 to sweep three of the most important races on this circuit. "Any Grade I race is important, but when you add to it

the historical significance of Easy Goer being the last three-year-old to win the Belmont, Travers and Jockey Club Gold Cup in the same year, it's very meaningful," trainer Tim Ice commented. The attractive chestnut colt picked up the services of Kent Desormeaux for the GI Belmont S. June 6, and the two teamed to

roll home by 2 3/4 lengths. Ridden more forwardly than he'd like in the Aug. 2 GI Haskell Invitational S., a move borne mostly out of necessity over the speed-favoring Monmouth strip, Summer Bird was left six lengths adrift of Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro), but lost little in defeat. He was the recipient of another positive ride from Desormeaux in the GI Shadwell Travers S. Aug. 29, remaining in touch with the pace before staying on best of all for a 3 1/2-length victory. While Summer Bird would ideally come from further out of it, **Quality Road** has more tactical foot than does his classmate and displayed the ability to carry that speed nine furlongs when a brilliant winner of the GI Florida Derby Mar. 28. Derailed by foot problems which caused him to miss the Triple Crown, the Ned Evans runner resurfaced with Todd Pletcher and turned in a track record performance in the Aug. 3 GI Amsterdam S., besting Capt. Candyman Can (Candy Ride {Arg}). The form of that race was flattered when the latter returned to take the GI NetJets King's Bishop S. (by DQ). Quality Road and Summer Bird raced as a team down the Travers backstretch, but he may have been showing the effects of his layoff as he couldn't quite finish off the race and checked in third, beaten five lengths. **Macho Again** has not been this distance since finishing eighth in the 2008 Travers, but seems a different animal these days. Whereas he raced closer to the pace as a three-year-old, the gray has become increasingly effective by switching off early and charging home when it counts. Those tactics earned him a one-length victory over **Asiatic Boy** in the GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill June 13, but he couldn't quite get to Bullsbay (Tiznow) and settled for the place in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 8. He was the one doing the best work at the end of the GI Woodward S., but, giving eight pounds to the superfilly, his rally fell a head short. Jockey Robby Albarado has won this race three of the last six years, including aboard Curlin (Smart Strike) in 2007 and 2008.

Pure Clan is the choice here to register a mild upset. An even 10th in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Filly/Mare Turf, the chestnut has faced the starter just three times this season. A neck second to the talented Acoma (Empire Maker) in the GIII Mint Julep H. over the Churchill turf June 6, she outclassed her rivals to take the GIII Modesty H. at Arlington by an easy 2 1/2 lengths, with **Dynaforce** a pace-pressing third. She was left with too much to do in the GI Beverly D. S. back in Chicago Aug. 8, rallying from last of eight to drop a 1 1/2-length decision to the Bill Mott trainee. Look

for her to be a touch handier this afternoon. Dynaforce caught a yielding turf in this event last year, got away with murder on the front end and streaked home to score by four. There is significantly more pace signed on this year, making Dynaforce a likely underlay. **Moneycantbuy-melove** makes her U.S. debut and gets regular rider Jamie Spencer in the irons. Winner of Goodwood's Listed Height of Fashion S. over today's trip May 21, she got the better of 18 other rivals to take the one-mile Listed Sandringham H. at the Royal meeting June 17. She stepped up to the top level last time out and gave a very good account of herself, rallying from ninth to be third to Midday (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) and Rainbow View (Dynaformer) in the G1 Nassau S. Aug. 1. Lasix goes on for the first time this afternoon on the sophomore, who is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup.

Ghanaati returns to the scene of her G1 1000 Guineas triumph with connections praying that she can return to that form after a latest defeat in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood. Despite finishing third behind the stellar performers Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) in that July 29 contest, there was a feeling that Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's homebred had underperformed. Measured against her prior impressive success in Royal Ascot's G1 Coronation S. June 19, that is a fair argument. "Hopefully, if she comes back to her best she'll take plenty of beating," the owner-breeder's racing manager Angus Gold told *PA Sport* yesterday. "Obviously, this time of year you never know with fillies in the autumn. She's been on the go a long time, but everyone seems happy with her at the moment." **Fantasia** looked all over a Classic winner last term when winning the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood in August and finishing runner-up to Rainbow View (Dynaformer) in Ascot's G1 Fillies' Mile the following month. After a highly impressive return success in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. over seven furlongs here Apr. 15 came a deflating third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 10, which preceded a disappointing seventh in the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly June 14. Earning a break there, she warmed up for this with a smooth win in Doncaster's Listed Sceptre S. last time Sept. 10. "Fantasia is probably in better form now at home than we have ever had her and, though the fast ground at Newmarket is of slight concern, she will not go down without a fight," trainer Luca Cumani commented on his website. **Strawberrydaquiri** is a major improver, having rattled off a trio of Listed successes in Sandown's July 4 Distaff and Aug. 22 Atalanta S. and Ascot's July 24 Valiant S.

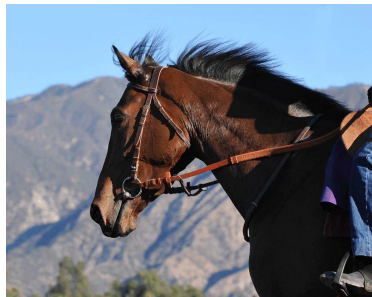

Just 12 months ago, Martin Schwartz made an inspired purchase of **Elusive Wave (Ire)** (Elusive City) for €660,000. The following day, she ran second in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and went on to Classic glory in this year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches. In 2007, the €665,000 Sale-topper was **Racinger (Fr)** (Spectrum {Ire}), who has since collected last year's G3 Prix Messidor and this year's G3 Prix Quincey. Previous graduates include the 2006 GII San Luis Obispo H. winner **Atlando (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}), the multiple Grade 1 scorer **Megahertz (GB)** (Pivotal {GB})--who was sold to Oceanic Bloodstock for what seems a bargain €600,000 eight years ago--and the fellow top-level scorers **Elmhurst** (Wild Again) and **Aube Indienne (Fr)** (Bluebird). Topping the alumni is **Urban Sea** (Miswaki), whose son Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) is on the verge of attempting to emulate her Arc victory of 1993. 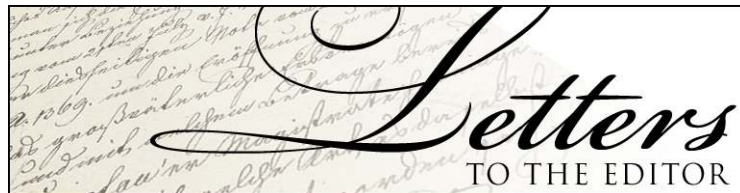

GOULASH, DAM OF ASHADO, EUTHANIZED

Goulash (Mari's Book--Wise Bride, by Blushing Groom {Fr}), the dam of dual Eclipse Award winner Ashado (Saint Ballado) as well as four other stakes horses, was euthanized Sept. 30 due to complications from laminitis. She was 16 years of age. It was previously reported that chronic arthritis in the mare's left front ankle resulted in the joint being fused in a procedure called an arthrodesis. She ultimately developed laminitis in her right front foot. Bred by Haras Santa Maria de Araras, Goulash made the first half-dozen starts of her career for that operation before being claimed for \$50,000 by Desperado Stables and Ted West. The bay would go on to win half of her six appearances for those connections, including a victory in the Las Ninas S. and a near-miss second in the Gill Linda Vista H. Goulash was entered for the 1998 Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale, where she was purchased by Aaron and Marie Jones for \$100,000 with the intent of breeding her to Saint Ballado, a stallion the couple owned with Taylor Made. The mating proved extremely successful, as it resulted in MSP Ballado's Halo and GSW Saint Stephen before striking gold with Ashado. Campaigned by a partnership including Starlight Stables, Don Lucarelli and Johns Martin, Ashado went on to win seven Grade I events, highlighted by the Kentucky Oaks and the Breeders' Cup Distaff. She was named champion three-year-old filly in 2004 and champion older mare the following season and was sold to John Ferguson for \$9 million at the 2005 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Goulash was also the dam of the recently deceased GISW Sunriver (Saint Ballado) as well as MSP Storm Creek Rising (Storm Creek). The mare was represented at this year's Keeneland September sale by an Unbridled's Song colt that was purchased by Demi O'Byrne for \$925,000. Goulash, who was not bred this year due to her declining health, was to be buried at Taylor Made.

LEMAIRE MISSES ARC WEEKEND Christophe-Patrice Lemaire will not be able to ride this weekend after suffering a hairline fracture of his collarbone at Saint-Cloud yesterday. The injury occurred as a result of a fall in an Arabian race staged on the card and means that connections of Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) will need to find another pilot in Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. The news follows the similar bombshell of Christophe Soumillon being absent for the feature weekend after fracturing his elbow at Nancy last month.



David Williams' hypocrisy on the issue of expanded gaming never ceases to amaze me. When someone is as opposed to something as vehemently as Williams is opposed to expanded gaming, his opposition is usually based on moral/religious grounds or a substantial financial interest.

Williams' opposition to expanded gaming is obviously not based on moral/religious grounds because he himself is a big-time gambler who frequents the Indiana riverboats. That leaves only a substantial financial interest to explain his opposition to expanded gaming. To paraphrase Williams in his "Special to the Courier Journal" piece on the editorial page of the Sept. 31, 2009 issue, let's look at the facts.

- Fact No. 1: As stated above, Williams, by his own admission, regularly gambles at the Indiana riverboats.
 - Fact No. 2: An independent survey, commissioned by the gaming industry, has shown that more than 500,000 Kentuckians gamble more than \$600,000,000 a year at the Indiana Riverboats along the Ohio River.
 - Fact No. 3: Expanded gaming in Kentucky would have an adverse impact on the profitability of the Indiana riverboats.
 - Fact No. 4: It would be worth millions of dollars to the Indiana riverboats to keep Kentucky from adopting expanded gaming.
 - Fact No. 5: Williams is the one person who currently has the power to block expanded gaming in Kentucky and has exercised that power at every opportunity, despite the fact that numerous polls have shown that approximately two-thirds of Kentuckians favor expanded gaming at the state's racetracks.
- These facts suggest that the Indiana riverboats have had both the motive and opportunity to "comp" Williams and provide him with the "substantial financial interest" that could explain his vehement opposition to expanded gaming in Kentucky.
