MOMENT OF ZEN

In a race named for a distaff Horse of the Year--the GI Lady's Secret S. at Oak Tree--unbeaten **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) will attempt to equal the perfect 13-race streak of another Turf legend, Personal Ensign. The towering five-year-old nearly kissed her record goodbye last time when she barely got up in the final jump of the GI Clement Hirsch S. at Del Mar Aug. 9, but ended up in a familiar place: the winner's circle. "To remain unbeaten through all the ups and downs of racing, different race-tracks, different horses, different pace scenarios, it's amazing,"

trainer John Shirreffs told *Daily Racing Form*. "That's something we never imagined when she started racing. And then as she has continued to win it became something that was maybe possible. Now we're on the brink of it, so it's very exciting." **Cont. p9-10**

DAY OF WINE AND ROSES

A week after its Super Saturday card endured a downpour, Belmont Park will host a trio of Grade I events under sunnier skies, highlighted by the Champagne S. and Frizette S. for the juvenile set. The one-two finishers from Saratoga's GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S., **Dublin** (Afleet Alex) and **Aspire** (Tale of the Cat), will face off again in the one-turn mile of the Champagne. "He's got a really good mind," said Dublin's trainer D. Wayne Lukas. RACY NEGLIGEE IN DARLEY ALCIBIADES

Neglige (Northern Afleet) was supposed to make her first start for Sovereign Stable and John Terranova last Sunday in the Miss Grillo S., but was scratched when that event was washed off the grass. She had a win and a second in two outings on Woodbine's Polytrack, and her new connections opted for yesterday's \$500,000 GI Darley Alcibiades S. instead. It proved to be the right call. After saving ground early, the high-actioned bay switched out for running room, set her sights on the previously unbeaten favorite **She Be Wild** (Offlee Wild) and finished up determinedly to punch her ticket to the Breeders' Cup. "Absolutely," winning trainer John Terranova said when asked whether the connections would take advantage of the Alcibiades' status as a "Win and You're In" contest for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Santa Anita Nov. 6. Rider Rajiv Maragh added, "She kind of relaxed and was pretty much settled behind horses, so it made her finish better." **Darley Alcibiades cont. p2**

Were it not for John Terranova sending Fanny Freud (Freud)--a hopeful in today's GI Frizette S. at Belmont--to Woodbine for the Ontario Debutante S. Aug. 15, he probably wouldn't have been basking in the rainy winner's circle yesterday at Keeneland. Negligee, who debuted a winner for a \$62,500 tag at Woodbine July 25, caught Terranova's eye with her runner-up effort to Fanny Freud ([video](#)). "She impressed us up in Canada," Terranova explained. "Sovereign Stable subsequently purchased her. We brought her down [to New York]; she's trained real forward since." Negligee may have had just a pair of sprinting efforts under her belt, but those north-of-the-border starts were on Polytrack, and this rich affair worked out perfectly as Terranova's back-up plan. "She took to it in Canada," he noted. "We knew the surface wasn't going to be a question, just the two turns. But she trained really well."

Sent off at 12-1, Negligee settled kindly for Rajiv Maragh just off the pace while saving ground. The bay began to move forward on the far turn as She Be Wild took over, but was stuck behind a wall of horses at the head of the lane. A seam finally opened up and Negligee kicked into gear, reeling in the crowd's choice as the wire approached.

Negligee, whose catalogue page includes the likes of Zilzal (Nureyev), was purchased by Norman Casse for \$52,000 last year at Keeneland September. Casse's son Justin prepped the filly for OBS February, but she wound up RNA'ing for \$37,000, and made her first two starts for the senior Casse and Quintessential Racing. It's a safe assumption that they made a profit selling Negligee privately to Sovereign Stable. Sovereign Stable is a syndicate headed by Matthew Gatsas, whose family campaigned the popular Gander.

Fatal Bullet annexed Turfway's GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint last fall en route to a second in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Santa Anita, and earned Sovereign Award honors as Canada's Horse of the Year and champion sprinter. The bay gelding didn't see action again until July 19, when he successfully defended his title in the Bold Venture H. at Woodbine, but his synthetic consistency didn't follow him to Saratoga, where he faded to finish last of sixth in the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt Aug. 9. Back on his preferred Polytrack here, the four-year-old battled with E Z Dreamer through splits of :22.27 and :44.77. He seemed to be going better than that rival in the lane, and made it to the wire in time as sophomore challenger Capt. Candyman Can found his best stride just a tad too late. As a Grade I winner, the three-year-old was giving away four pounds to the winner. The Phoenix was a "Win and You're In" race, and Fatal Bullet will be heading back to Arcadia. "We needed that one to confirm to us that we belong with those horses," said winning owner Danny Dion. "We'll be back for the Breeders' Cup [Nov. 7]. He really doesn't like the dirt, so we are very happy the Breeders' Cup will be back at Santa Anita."

Circumvent broke through at Southwell first time Aug. 25, but slipped one notch when tackling conditions company at Kempton next out Sept. 5. He resumed the winning habit with success in a novices' event at Leicester last time Sept. 21, and refused to buckle in this pattern-race debut to claim a personal best in determined fashion. Circumvent was positioned in third initially, but came under pressure when relegated to fourth just after halfway. Responding to continued urging, he moved to within striking distance of his three rivals approaching the final furlong and kept on resolutely in the closing stages to prevail in a bunch finish. "It's a marvellous story, as we bred the dam, second dam and third dam," said co-owner and breeder Ed Goodwin. "It's nice to see small breeders like us can still be in the game against such big names as Godolphin and The Aga Khan. Circumvent really enjoys his racing, but we'll see how he comes out this race before talking to the trainer. Maybe we could come back to France for the [G1] Criterium International [over course and distance Nov. 1]."

Justenuffhumor looks to maintain his perfect turf record here. The half-brother to 2006 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine Dreaming of Anna (Rahy) had a forgettable debut on the local Polytrack last fall, but,

switched to the infield this year, has rattled off seven straight wins, including a pair of stretch-running scores at Saratoga. After going clear in the 8 1/2-furlong GII Fourstardave H. Aug. 2, the bay came running late to take the nine-panel GII Bernard Baruch H. Aug. 28. Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin believes there's an excuse for the sole blip on his charge's record. "He was really

struggling at the gate last year, and the gate crew did a tremendous job with him," McLaughlin said. "If they had not spent the time with him, there is no telling where we would be now." Justenuffhumor is also a half-brother to the versatile Lewis Michael (Rahy), and there's a nice grass horse named Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) under the second dam. "With his breeding, he can run on anything, and I'd hate to rule out Polytrack because of the one race, but his head just wasn't into it," McLaughlin added. The four-year-old has three wins on courses that were less than firm, and his conditioner isn't worried about the prospect of rain. "Soft ground might be good for us," McLaughlin said. "He is maybe better at a little more than a mile, so a demanding, soft course may help us. Of course, it will help **Mr. Sidney**, too." Mr. Sidney has gotten good several years after going for \$3.9 million as a yearling. The regally bred bay's biggest wins have come over sticky ground, including the GI Maker's Mark Mile over this course and distance in April and, two starts later, the GII Firecracker H. at Churchill July 4. He has not seen action since flattening out to sixth in the 10-furlong GI Arlington Million Aug. 9. **Court Vision**, scratched out of the GII Kelso H. when that Belmont contest was washed off the turf last Sunday, makes his first start for trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. Sixth in his last out for Bill Mott, the GI United Nations S. at Monmouth July 4, the Grade I winner has since undergone surgery for a problematic testicle. **Cont. p6**

The ultra-consistent **Battle of Hastings** tests his elders for the first time. After pairing up hard-fought wins in the GII Colonial Turf Cup June 20 and GII Virginia Derby July 18, the bay gelding came up a nose short in the GII Del Mar Derby Sept. 6. He shortens up to a mile for the first time since rallying to capture Santa Anita's La Puente S. Apr. 11. His connections opted for this race over a spot versus his peers in Illinois. "We were thinking of the [GIII] Hawthorne Derby, but the owner lives just down the road here and Carlsbad [Rocky Bar] was coming here anyway [for the GII Thoroughbred Club of America S.]," said Ral Ayers, assistant to trainer Jeff Mullins. He added, "Nothing is firm yet, maybe the Breeders' Cup, but this will give us a chance to see how he does against older horses."

Dixie Band is unbeaten in three tries in Arlington's Polytrack, including a win in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity Sept. 5. That was run at a one-turn mile, and the bay has drawn the rail as he attempts two turns for the first time. Trainer Wayne Catalano sees this as a litmus test for the gelding. "He's run pretty good for us, and we'll just see [what we're going to do with him]," Catalano said. Immediately to Dixie Band's right is **Backtalk**, who captured the GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill July 3 and GII Sanford S. at Saratoga July 30 before finishing fourth in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. on Labor Day at the Spa. The chestnut earned a bullet for his local six-furlong drill in 1:12 4/5 Oct. 5, and trainer Tom Amoss thinks the juvenile can do just as well on the all-weather in the afternoon, too.

"[Backtalk] ought to be able to handle the synthetic as well as he's handled dirt," Amoss told *Daily Racing Form*. "We're very comfortable with the transition." Backtalk has done his best running from off the pace, and he'll have to face a full field this afternoon. "It's an extremely deep race, and like a lot of races for young horses, there's a lot of opportunity for them to step forward," Amoss added.

Make Music for Me--still a maiden--ships in off two straight seconds at Del Mar to West Coast leader Lookin at Lucky (Smart Strike). Just 3/4 of a length behind that bay in the GII Best Pal S. Aug. 9, he was a length back in the GI Del Mar Futurity Sept. 7. "The owners [Ellen and Peter Johnson] are from Wisconsin, and they liked the bigger purse," said trainer Alexis Barba, who had considered the \$300,000 GI Norfolk S. last Sunday at Oak Tree for the colt. "We were not ducking Lookin At Lucky and I thought he had a good chance to beat him at Santa Anita," Barba said. "But I liked having the extra week, and trying something new appealed to me." The connections of **Roman Invasion**, owners Lori and George Hall and trainer Kelly Breen, have been eyeing this race since the \$90,000 KEESEP purchase aired by 10 3/4 lengths in an off-the-turf maiden at Delaware Sept. 29 ([click here](#) for "In Sharper Focus"). **Hockley**, produced by a half-sister to the swift Old Trieste (A.P. Indy), stretches out for the first time while looking for his first win, but he's faced some serious horses in maiden company. Second to the aforementioned Dixie Band in an Arlington maiden June 21, the dark bay mirrored that effort behind Dublin (Afleet Alex)--subsequent winner of the Hopeful--Aug. 1 at Saratoga, and most recently ran third in another Spa maiden Sept. 5.

Champion and GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf heroine Forever Together has been first or second in her four outings this term. The winner of the Apr. 11 GII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland, she followed her runner-up effort in the Just a Game with a head tally in the Aug. 1 GI Diana S. The grey was favored at 3-10 in the Sept. 20 GII Canadian S., but came up a nose short. She followed the same route--and pattern--to her Breeders' Cup triumph last year. "She got beat in the Just a Game last year and this year and also in the Canadian at Woodbine," trainer Jonathan Sheppard said. "She won the Diana last year and this year." **Acoma**, a multiple graded winner on the dirt, is perfect in three turf tries as well. The bay captured the GIII Valley View S. at Keeneland and the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill last fall. She moved back to the dirt for her first two starts this term, winning the GIII Azeri S. and finishing third in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn, before adding the grassy June 6 GIII Mint Julep H. at Churchill to her resume. She enters this off a disappointing sixth in the 10-panel GII Delaware H. on the main track July 19.

Informed Decision has been one of the premier sprint fillies over the past two seasons, and has never tasted defeat in five starts over a synthetic surface. That includes a trio of wins on Keeneland's Polytrack, in allowance company in April of 2008, the GII Raven Run S. last October and, earlier this April, in the GI Vinery Madison S. over Ventura (Chester House). Citing a "timing issue," Churchill Downs Vice President Steve Bailey told *Racing Post*, "We are unsure that the current state of international simulcasting would allow us the best opportunity to achieve our goals of building international wagering on the Kentucky Derby along with increasing interest in the participation by European horses in our race." The 2009 running was taken by Sheikh Hamdan's Mafaaz (GB) (Medicean {GB}), but the colt did not take his spot in the Derby field following an eighth-place effort in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. in April. Added Kempton Managing Director Amy Starkey, "Obviously, this is very disappointing, after such a successful Challenge S. in March, which drew a good evening crowd to the racecourse and created a buzz within the racing industry." She continued, "We won't be frustrated and will continue to seek out innovative opportunities to internationalize our sport, and the part that Kempton, as one of only two British racecourses hosting racing under floodlights, plays in it."



AQLAAM TO NUNNERY STUD

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G1 Prix du Moulin hero **Aqlaam (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}--Bourbonella {GB}, by Rainbow Quest) will stand at his owner's Nunnery Stud in Norfolk, it was announced yesterday. He was also third in that venue's G1 Queen Anne S. and runner-up in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville. He retires as the winner of four of his nine starts with earnings of just over £500,000. Angus Gold, racing manager to the owner, told the *Racing Post*, "Aqlaam has a lovely attitude, plenty of speed and did incredibly well considering his injuries." Fees will be announced later.
