MUSHKA PROMOTED TO SPINSTER WIN

It could be argued that European invader **Provisio (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) was the best distaffer in yesterday's GI Juddmonte Spinster S., but her erratic stretch drive left Keeneland stewards little choice but to disqualify her and promote the rallying **Mushka** (Empire Maker) to victory. Title sponsor homebred **Provisio**, third to Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville Aug. 2 and a neck winner over males in the G3 Prix du Pin at Longchamp Sept. 6, was relaxed in eighth under Rajiv Maragh as Mushka and Kent Desormeaux raced in second last. Coming from between rivals at the quarter pole, Provisio forged to the lead and looked like she was on her way to a first Grade I tally. But she veered sharply to the right when Maragh showed her the whip at the 16th pole and moved into the path of the hard-charging Mushka, who was forced to take up. Provisio straightened out and finished up 1 1/4 lengths to the good, but the damage was done. "My horse ran huge today and she was definitely the best," said Maragh. "I made the lead with her and then she stopped focusing, so I tapped her, and when I did she just bolted out. But that other horse was never going to pass me." **Cont. p2**

FOR GODOLPHIN, GIROLAMO OUT EAST...

Godolphin Stable's progressive **Girolamo** (A.P. Indy) went to three-for-three in 2009 yesterday when he rallied to his first black-type win in Belmont's one-mile GII Jerome H., and may have stamped his ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. "I haven't spoken to [trainer] Saeed [bin Suroor]," said assistant Rick Mettee. "There are a lot of ways to go." One of those ways could also be the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 28. The last three winners of the Jerome--Discreet Cat (Forestry), Daaher (Awesome Again) and Tale of Ekati (Tale of the Cat)--have gone on to take that showpiece. **Cont. p4**

Mushka Gets Her Grade I...

The Spinster was a career score for the durable, reliable Mushka. Purchased by Zayat Stables for \$1.6 million at the 2006 FTSAUG sale, she showed early promise in winning Aqueduct's GII Demoiselle S. at two. She failed to add to her stakes tally as a sophomore, however, and was sent through the Keeneland November sale, where she was purchased by Brushwood Stable for \$2.4 million. Kept busy this season, Mushka had won two of eight entering the Spinster, including an allowance win on Keeneland's Polytrack in April and, after a seventh in the GI Diana S. at Saratoga Aug. 1, a last-out victory in the Spa's GIII Glens Falls H. Sept. 7. Mushka was making just her second start on a synthetic in the Spinster and kept her record clean in an effort that could stamp her ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic Nov. 6. 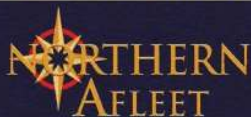

Winner of the GII Arkansas Derby last year, Gayego joined Godolphin late in the season and rewarded Sheikh Mohammed's operation with a win in the G3 Dayjur Mahab Al Shimaal at Nad al Sheba in early March and a runner-up to stablemate Two Step Salsa (Petionville) in the G2 Godolphin Mile a few weeks later. He was off for five months before returning with a professional win in optional claiming company at Saratoga Aug. 14 and was the chalk here facing a salty group. Jockey Garrett Gomez was eminently confident in his mount and was still ninth of 10 at the quarter pole. The pair moved wide for open air and, with Gomez employing only a vigorous hand ride, flew home down the center of the track. "They told me to just take my time with him and get him up under me and he'd come home no problem," said Gomez. Previous Passion's free-wheelin' ways carried him to yet another Grade I triumph, this time on the West Coast. The six-year-old gelding successfully defended his title in the GI United Nations at Monmouth in July, but found the rain-softened ground against him when a tired eighth in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 8.

Scratched from the Oct. 3 GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational at Belmont Park when that course came up bog-like, Previous Passion was pointed toward this 'other' Hirsch and came through as the public's choice. On the engine in typical fashion, he clicked off honest :47 2/5 and 1:11 2/5 splits and was always finding more in the lane. Hearts of Fire was starting his career when taking Doncaster's Mar. 28 Brocklesby Conditions S., which for many years was the traditional opening salvo of the two-year-olds. After three reversals at five furlongs, the bay showed his appreciation for a step up to six when runner-up to Duplicity (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the Listed Rose Bowl S. at Newbury July 17. At seven furlongs for his next two, he lifted the Listed Prix Francois Boutin at Deauville Aug. 16 and G3 Zukunfts-Rennen at Baden-Baden Sept. 4. Hearts of Fire, trying a mile here, was settled in rear early off the pace set by Vale of York, and made his move from between horses as that rival took control passing the quarter pole. Gladiatorus was a top-class juvenile in this country and, after a quartet of Listed wins, went down fighting to Scintillo (GB) (Fantastic Light) in the G1 Gran Criterium on this card. Transferred to Godolphin, the bay failed to appear for the operation at three, but was a revelation this year in the care of Mubarak bin Shafya. His dominating front-running displays lit up Nad Al Sheba during the Carnival; he took the Feb. 19 G2 Al Fahidi Fort and Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Duty Free by a total of nine lengths before coming back to Godolphin. In his first outing in the royal blue, Gladiatorus started the June 16 G1 Queen Anne S. as the 9-4 favorite, but could finish only sixth after the aggressive tactics employed in the desert failed to have the same effect at Royal Ascot. Out of the frame in both the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 16 and G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp last time Sept. 6, he regained the winning thread in style here at what would have looked generous odds a few months ago. Rolling to the front after a furlong, he never looked likely to be engaged thereafter, and kept up the gallop in isolation in the straight to allow a jubilant Ahmed Ajtebi some time for showboating in the final 50 yards. "Gladiatorus won really well, with plenty in hand. It is pleasing to see him back to his best," Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. Girolamo made a sharp debut for Darley at Saratoga last August, winning by daylight as the favorite, but failed to hit the board in Belmont's GII Futurity S. and GI Champagne S. for Kiaran McLaughlin and went to the sidelines. He returned from the 10-month absence wearing Godolphin blue for the Saeed bin Suroor barn, and looked a different horse taking a Spa allowance by four lengths Aug. 9 and doubling up in a Belmont optional claimer by 5 1/2 lengths Sept. 13. The odds-on pick in his return to stakes company, Girolamo broke a step slowly, but recovered quickly and was up to track in third as Pitched Perfect (Pleasantly Perfect) ensured a snappy pace. Kensei and jockey Edgar Prado made an early move approaching the quarter pole, but it was Girolamo and Alan Garcia who were going best in the stretch and edged away to a confident win. "It was a best-case scenario," said assistant trainer Rick Mettee. "We thought we'd be laying where we were. Alan did the right thing laying off Edgar on Kensei. He was able to outfight that horse, who's obviously a good horse. He was able to sit off and make the run. 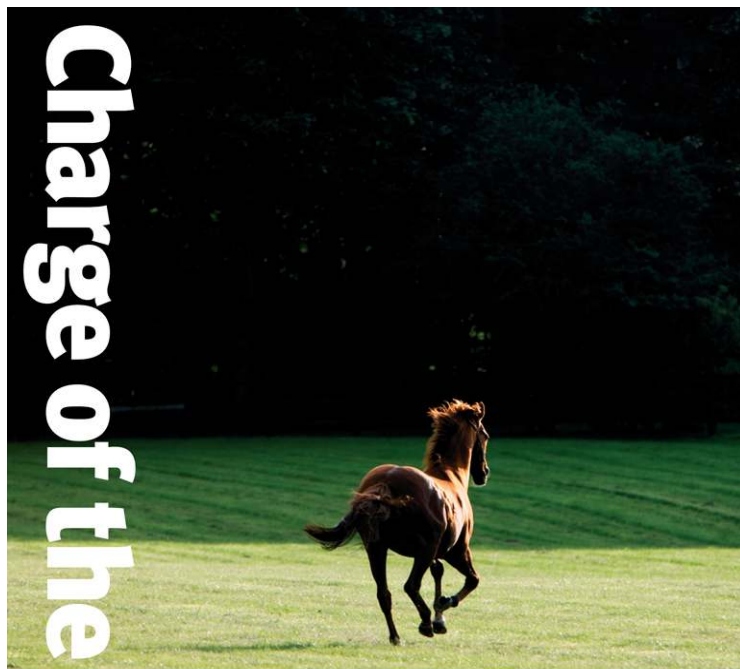
Bear Tough Guy, a three-parts brother to the good distaffer Leah's Secret, showed he had some of his sister's ability with an initial black-type badge here. A modest \$27,000 OBSAPR juvenile purchase, Bear Tough Guy was a 12-1 outsider when he captured his debut going a mile over Woodbine's turf course Sept. 13. Offered as a 3-1 shot taking a big step up in class here, the colt was never far back under Eurico da Silva, challenged Korvette Kid at the top of the stretch and, after an extended duel, got the nod in a three-horse photo. It was

a productive weekend for trainer Reade Baker and da Silva, who teamed to win Friday's GIII Phoenix S. at Keeneland with Fatal Bullet (Red Bullet) and Saturday's GIII Mazarine S. with the two-year-old filly Biofuel (Stormin Fever) at Woodbine. Hough Duo Likely to Get Break...

The E. Paul Robsham Stable duo of **Discreetly Mine** (Mineshaft) and **Awesome Maria** (Maria's Mon), runners-up in Belmont's GI Champagne S. and GI Frizette S., respectively, were in fine fettle Sunday morning, trainer Stanley Hough reported. The conditioner confirmed that both juveniles would likely not go to the Breeders' Cup, and instead be given the rest of the year off. "The plan is to...maybe bring them back sometime during the winter at Gulfstream," Hough said. "I'm just going to try to get them ready for their three-year-old season."

Summer Bird To Leave for Cali This Morning...

Summer Bird (Birdstone), who completed a rare sweep of the GI Belmont S., GI Shadwell Travers S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, galloped at Belmont Park Sunday morning in advance of a trip to California that begins today. The three-year-old was scheduled to depart at 5 a.m. this morning for a flight that will stop in Lexington, Kentucky and Oklahoma City before landing in Southern California. Drs. Kalarikkal and Vilasini Jayaraman's homebred colt is being pointed toward the \$5 million GI Breeders' Cup Classic, although trainer Tim Ice said there remained a "very slim" chance he would go in the 1 1/2-mile GI Breeders' Cup Turf. "It's 99 percent he'll go in the Classic," said Ice. "We'll have to see how things go when he gets out there. He worked over the [synthetic] surface before I got him, when he was with John Sadler, so it's not going to be something new to him."

Brown claimed the gelding for \$25,000 after a win at Gulfstream in April, and has saddled him to three wins from four starts, including a 1 1/2-length success in the GIII Jaipur S. at Belmont in July. **Silver Timber** was also nominated to Oct. 17 GII Nearctic S. at Woodbine, which offers a C\$500,000 purse, but opted for the \$125,000 Woodford because of the timing of the race. "Running here gave me an extra week before the Breeders' Cup--that was my main reason," Brown said of the decision. "I left a lot of purse money on the table not going to Canada. I gambled and said, 'If I win here, that's still a good paycheck, and I gain the extra week of rest.'" The former Bobby Frankel assistant added, "He runs better fresh. I think when you run this horse too close together he's not as effective."

BC Mile Next for Zacinto...

Connections of **Zacinto** (GB) (Dansili {GB}) have ruled in favor of the GI Breeders' Cup Mile over Saturday's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. Runner-up to Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot last time Sept. 26, Khalid Abdullah's three-year-old will now head straight to Santa Anita. The owner-breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "The horse is fine, but we have decided to go to the Breeders' Cup with him instead." First or second in all five career starts, **Zacinto** took the Listed Thoroughbred S. at Goodwood Aug. 1 in his belated 2009 debut. GI Kentucky Derby hero **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone), sixth as the 3-1 second choice in Saturday's GI Goodwood S., came out of the race in good shape, but his next move is undecided. "He looks OK this morning," trainer Chip Woolley said. "He came back good, I think." Looking head, Woolley added, "I haven't talked to the owners much since we've run, so I'm not sure exactly what we'll do from here, but the horse ran pretty good [beaten about four lengths]. 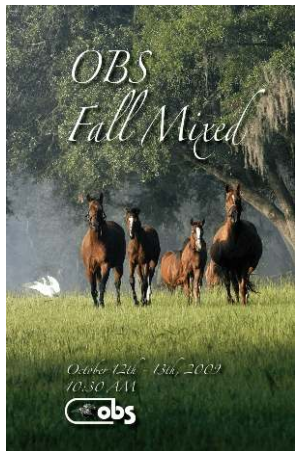
