SOLID START TO TATTS OCTOBER BOOK 2

Sheikh Mohammed's buying team dominated the upper echelons of yesterday's opening Book 2 session of Tattersalls' October Yearling Sale, with his representatives John Ferguson and Richard O'Gorman buying all but two of the day's eight six-figures lots. Indeed Ferguson, O'Gorman, Rabbah Bloodstock and Shadwell combined to account for 1,960,500gns (29.2 percent) of yesterday's 6,715,500gns turnover. With an additional 41 lots sold, the aggregate was 12 percent up on 12 months ago--although that day had experienced a drop of over 50 percent on 2007. Yesterday's 33,410gns average was down 11.5 percent, while the 25,000gns median fell by 16.7 percent. The buy-back rate was 18.6 percent.

O'Gorman bid for the day's top lot, a Cape Cross (Ire) colt out of the well-connected True Crystal (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who brought 160,000gns. The colt, hip [867](#), was offered by his Co. Limerick-based breeders,

Bobby and Honora Donworth's Round Hill Stud. Trainer Clive Cox, standing with owner Alan Spence, was the underbidder.

"He was a very well-presented colt and his sire is flying. He has been bought for Darley," said O'Gorman, who added, "The market has been amazingly strong and I can't

believe that it has held up so well. I thought it would drop off a bit after last week, but this has been great for the industry and it seems very similar to last year--something few other businesses could achieve at the moment." *Cont. p2*

STARDOM BOUND TO RETURN IN GAZELLE

Stardom Bound (Tapit), last year's champion juvenile filly, is expected to return to the races in the Nov. 28 GI Gazelle S. at Aqueduct, according to the New York Racing Association press office. The gray filly has been off since running third in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland in April. The announcement of the star's return comes on the heels of a standout weekend for her owner, IEAH Stables. The recent IEAH purchase **Diamondrella** (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) won Saturday's GI First Lady S. at Keeneland, while **Court Vision** (Gulch) took the GI Shadwell Turf Mile S. **Burley's Gold** (Touch Gold) was second in Belmont's GII Jerome H. CLAIBORNE RELEASES 2010 STUD FEES

Claiborne Farm has announced its stud fees for the 2010 breeding season, with the most notable change a reduction to the fee of leading sire **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy). The stallion, who stood for \$80,000 last season, will stand for \$60,000 in 2010. This year, Pulpit has been represented by graded stakes winners Pyro, Rutherienne, Mi Sueno, Parading, Meteore, Aurora Lights, and Orthodox. Claiborne Farm also announced yesterday that all of its stallions will be limited to books of at most 100 mares. "It makes sense to try to help breeders when they are entering a competitive marketplace," said Claiborne's Bernie Sams. "We've always tried to set reasonable stud fees and to cap the number of mares bred."

Ferguson took second place on the pecking order when paying 130,000gns for a Rabbah Bloodstock-bred Exceed and Excel (Aus) colt consigned from Charlie and Tracy Vigors' Hillwood Stud. Hong Kong-based Jim Walker, an owner with Newmarket trainer William Jarvis, was underbidder for hip [708](#).

Ferguson also bought a 100,000gns full-sister (hip [928](#)) to Sunday's G1 Gran Criterium winner Hearts of Fire (GB) (Firebreak {GB}) sold by Terry Holdcroft's Bearstone Stud; a 100,000gns Rabbah-bred Dubawi (Ire) filly (hip [912](#)) offered by Biddestone Stud; and a 100,000gns Clodovil (Ire) half-sister (hip [884](#)) to this season's G1 Golden Jubilee S. third Lessons In Humility (Ire) (Mujadil) who was bred by Kevin Quinn and sold through Rathasker Stud.

Meanwhile, O'Gorman signed for a 100,000gns son of Dubawi (Ire)--Zacheta (GB) (hip [912](#)) who was another bred by Rabbah Bloodstock and sold by Biddestone Stud.

The most profitable offering was a colt by first-season Darley sire Shirocco (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) out of a sister to G1 Eclipse winner Compton Admiral (GB) (Suave Dancer). Hip [781](#) had been bought for 38,000gns last year to keep another foal company at Dominic Burke's Whitley Stud in Gloucestershire, and yesterday resold for 125,000gns to Blandford Bloodstock's Tom Goff. Jim Walker again was underbidder.

"He's been bought for an overseas client and will be trained in Newmarket," said Goff. "He was a lovely horse by a sire that a lot of us are taking very seriously."

"He's been bought for an existing owner. I used to buy a lot on spec, but I don't tend to these days--I like to sleep at night!"

MAWATHEEQ ADDED TO CHAMPION MIX

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Mawatheeq** (Danzig) was yesterday supplemented for Saturday's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. at a cost of £30,000. With Khalid Abdullah's **Zacinto (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) the most high-profile scratching at the five-day stage, the addition of the Shadwell homebred left 17 in Newmarket's 10-furlong contest. Successful in the G3 Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot last time Sept. 27, the four-year-old Mawatheeq will bid to emulate his relation Nayef in coming off a win in that contest en route to glory here eight years ago.

"He was very good at Ascot, and he is much the same as he was then," trainer Marcus Tregoning told *PA Sport*. "Obviously, it's a jump up, but he is ready for a jump up, and he's a fresh horse. It's obviously the same as what we did with Nayef, and I think he'll go to Newmarket with a good chance. He's bred very similarly to Nayef, so in that respect they are not too different. Physically, they are quite different, as Nayef had so much scope and a huge stride, whereas this horse is rather different, but he's very strong and has a good turn of foot. With Zacinto out, that is one less to worry about, but quite honestly we'd be quite happy to take anything on at this stage, as he's in great form."

Aidan O'Brien intends to send Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 Irish Derby hero **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) to the race, and he has the same two pacemakers used in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in **Set Sail (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) and **Grand Ducal (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) still engaged.

Michael Bell has declared Lady Bamford's G1 English and Irish Oaks heroine **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), while Sir Michael Stoute has a duo headed by Khalid Abdullah's G2 Princess of Wales's S. winner **Doctor Fremantle (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). Henry Cecil could also saddle one for that operation in last year's runner-up **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory). France could be represented by Daniel-Yves Treves' G1 Prix d'Ispahan winner **Never On Sunday (Fr)** (Sunday Break {Jpn}) and Lady O'Reilly, the Moussac Family and Lucien Urano's G1 Prix Jean Romanet scorer **Alpine Rose (Ire)** (Linamix {Fr}).

IEAH Makes Plans for Weekend's Runners...

IEAH President Mike Iavarone said **Burley's Gold** (Touch Gold) will start next in the GIII Discovery H. at Aqueduct Nov. 21. **Court Vision** (Gulch) will head to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Diamondrella could start in either the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint or take on her stablemate in the Mile. "I think Court Vision is going to run an electrifying race," Iavarone said. "I'm going to take to [Angel] Penna this week," he added of **Diamondrella (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). "We'll look at the 6 1/2 furlongs down the hill, but if he thinks we have to go a mile around two turns, we can't keep them apart. I'm not going to penalize Angel because of Court Vision." IEAH's **Amen Hallelujah** (Montbrook), third in Friday's GI Darley Alcibiades, will be pointed towards the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.

Classic Plans for Mine That Bird...

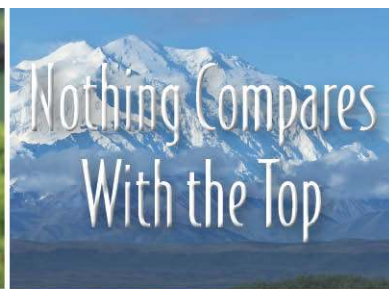
GI Kentucky Derby winner **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone), sixth in the Saturday's GI Goodwood S. at Santa Anita, will aim for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, trainer Chip Woolley reported yesterday. "We were disappointed with his race in the Goodwood, but now that I've had a chance to sleep on it and talk things over with the owners, we're going to the Breeders' Cup Classic," Woolley said. "My horse closed and he ran pretty fast when you go back and analyze the race. My horse finished up the last five-eighths in :58, but what are you going to do? The other ones aren't slowing down when they go a :48.54 half. I'll bet you there's not a Grade I in the country run that slow for the first half-mile all year--not on a fast racetrack." Mine That Bird jogged one mile Monday. "The horse is real happy today," Woolley continued. "He wants to play a little."

Abrams Has Ambitious Plan for Lethal Heat...

Barry Abrams, who is known for wheeling his horses back quickly, has mapped an ambitious plan for **Lethal Heat** (Unusual Heat), second behind Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in Saturday's GI Lady's Secret S. The 55-year-old trainer hopes to run the four-year-old filly in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic on Nov. 6 over the Santa Anita Pro-Ride surface and again in the following day's Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. "They do it in other countries," Abrams said. "Lethal Heat ran twice last week and finished second both times, once against males in the California Cup Classic, and then against Zenyatta, and she's a great horse."

Boys in Blue Buy Chabal...

Godolphin extended its customary autumn spending spree yesterday when adding the G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. runner-up **Chabal (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) to its roster. Owned in partnership by one of his breeders Lady O'Reilly and Jim and Jackie Bolger, the bay was beaten a neck by another recent Godolphin acquisition in Kingsfort (War Chant) in the Sept. 12 Curragh contest and was quoted as favorite by the bookmakers for Saturday's G1 Jumeirah Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. Trainer Jim Bolger told the *Racing Post* yesterday, "I can confirm that Chabal has been sold, and that he will be running for me for the last time in the Dewhurst on Saturday. He has been bought by Sheikh Mohammed and will be racing for Godolphin." Racing Manager Simon Crisford told *PA Sport*, "He's an interesting horse for next season, and we will see how he runs on Saturday before we start making any plans for him." There were three other entries from Godolphin at yesterday's five-day stage, including the G3 Prix la Rochette winner and G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere third **Buzzword (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), while Aidan O'Brien was responsible for six of the 23 possibles headed by ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Steinbeck (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}). Of the main contenders, G1 Prix Morny hero **Arcano (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) and G2 Richmond S. winner **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) remain on target.

Lady Arianna, third as the favored part of a two-horse entry in the G1 Clasico Polla de Potrancas (Peruvian 1000 Guineas) Sept. 13, rebounded with a formidable victory in the Peruvian Oaks and second leg of the Quadruple Crown series for three-year-old fillies. Piloted by leading jockey Carlos Trujillo, Lady Arianna closed steadily from off the pace to gain command in the stretch and draw clear as the solid favorite in the field of seven Southern Hemisphere sophomore fillies. Pace-maker Patola held second, 6 3/4 lengths clear of 1000 Guineas runner-up Mi Curli. Lady Arianna completed the 10-furlong race over a deep conventional dirt course in 2:08.00, setting the fastest clocking in the last 10 years.

The top three finishers will likely renew their rivalry when they match strengths against colts in next month's G1 Clasico Derby Nacional, the third leg of the Peruvian Quadruple Crown for three-year-olds over 1 1/2 miles on dirt. Lady Arianna is by former Peruvian leading freshman sire Play the Gold, sire of Peru's top-rated two-year-old female Pukas (Per). Notable past winners of the Peruvian Oaks include 1992 winner Camiunch (Rumbo), winner of the '94 Dahlia H. at Hialeah; and 1999 champion Batuka (Bates Motel), winner of her U.S. debut in the 2000 Hialeah Breeders' Cup H. at Gulfstream Park.

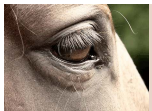

With the GI Goodwood S. going off late, at nearly midnight for us Brits, I didn't see the result until I thumbed my way through Sunday's *TDN*. I must admit to being more than a little surprised to see that victory had gone to the British-trained Gitano Hernando, at odds of 18-1.

For a start, the records show that it takes a very good three-year-old to defeat his elders in this mile-and-an-eighth contest, the only sophomores on the race's lengthy honor roll being Tiznow in 2000 and Tiago in 2007. Gitano Hernando, on the other hand, had only once stepped into stakes company, when he was unlucky to be narrowly beaten in the G3 Dee S. over Chester's tight turf course in May. He had then put up an excellent display after more than four months off the track to defeat a quality field in a conditions event over a mile and 141 yards at Wolverhampton, to improve his all-weather record to two from two.

Wolverhampton, together with Britain's three other synthetic tracks currently in operation, is proving a good arena for horses to demonstrate their potential to American buyers. That said, it doesn't yet stage any group races, and only one listed race, so the *Racing Post* handicappers could be forgiven for rating Gitano Hernando's recent Wolverhampton victory no higher than 109, compared to the 135 awarded to the outstanding turf horse Sea the Stars and the 129 achieved by the world's leading dirt horse, Rachel Alexandra.

One man who was very impressed with Gitano Hernando's Wolverhampton performance was his new rider, Kieren Fallon, as the colt's talented trainer Marco Botti reported: "It was very firm at Chester and he came back very sore, so that I had to stop him for a while. Kieren was very happy and said he is definitely a group horse."

That soreness forced connections to abandon plans to challenge for the GI Belmont S., but the enforced rest may prove a blessing, as Gitano Hernando will be fresher than many of his potential rivals in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

Botti said at Wolverhampton that his colt's immediate target was a Group 3 on Dundalk's all-weather track on Oct. 2, which ultimately produced a very smart performance from the Breeders' Cup Classic candidate Mastercraftsman. However, the Irish race carried less than half the prize-money of the Goodwood S., so the decision to send Gitano Hernando to Oak Tree paid off handsomely—as did the decision to keep Fallon in the saddle.

It is easy enough to see why Team Valor initially came to be attracted to Gitano Hernando after the youngster had carried the colors of Mrs. Renata Jacobs, of Newsells Park Stud, to victory in a Wolverhampton maiden 11 months ago. His ability to handle Polytrack made him a candidate for switching to the States, as did the fact that both of his parents, Hernando and Gino's Spirits, had shown very good form on American turf tracks.

Hernando, winner of the 1993 Prix du Jockey-Club, had been a close second in the GI Turf Classic on one of his ventures to the U.S. and several of his progeny have thrived on American turf tracks. The prime example has to be Sulamani, who went one better than his sire in the Turf Classic and also gained Grade I victories in the Arlington Million and the Canadian International. Then there's Atlando (GIII Knickerbocker H. and GII San Luis Obispo H.), Arvada (GII La Prevoyante H. and GIII Glens Falls H.), Just Wonder (GIII Cinema H.), Herboriste (second GII Sheepshead Bay H.) and Playact (twice second at Grade II level).

Gitano Hernando is therefore his sire's second Grade I winner in North America and his fifth in all. In addition to his American successes, Sulamani had followed Holding Court as the second son to emulate Hernando's win in the Prix du Jockey-Club. More recently Hernando scored a third Classic triumph as a sire when his daughter Look Here took the 2008 Oaks. Casual Conquest was another 2008 classic contender, finishing third in the Derby and second in the Irish Derby, and he has achieved Group 1-winner status this year, in the Tattersalls Gold Cup.

Despite making this sizeable impact at Classic level, Hernando has rarely been fashionable—to the extent that he had only 28 foals in 2001, 36 in 2002, 46 in 2006 and 38 in 2007. It is a similar story with Hernando's current yearling crop, which numbers around 35, and he reportedly covered 44 mares in 2008. Hopefully the exploits of Look Here and Casual Conquest will have ensured much more support for the 19-year-old stallion this year, when Gitano Hernando's dam Gino's Spirits returned to him.

Gitano Hernando is the third stakes winner that Hernando has sired from mares by sons of Danzig, one of his predecessors being the French Group 3 winner Indian Daffodil (out of a Danehill mare). Gitano Hernando's broodmare sire Perugino isn't nearly such a well-known name as Danehill.

Perugino narrowly won a six-furlong maiden race at Leopardstown on his two-year-old debut, with a performance rated only 84P by Timeform. He never ran again but his exceptional pedigree guaranteed him his chance at stud. With a son of Northern Dancer as his sire and Fairy Bridge as his dam, Perugino was a three-parts brother to Sadler's Wells, Tate Gallery and Fairy King.

The mares Perugino covered in his first two seasons were perhaps more notable for their quantity than their quality and he was then leased to Japan in 1997. He also occasionally shuttled to Australia before taking up permanent residence there for a few years. During the course of this globe-trotting career Perugino sired the champion Australian sprinter Testa Rossa, the dual Australian Group 1 winner Sudurka, the German Oaks winner Next Gina, the accomplished English sprinter The Tatling and the 2008 Arc third It's Gino. He is also responsible for Harchibald, a leading hurdler for numerous years.

Gino's Spirits was remarkably tough for a filly whose sire ran only once. After becoming a listed winner on her 18th start in Britain, she took second place in the G2 Sun Chariot S. and headed to the December Sales following her 20th appearance. Bought for 66,000gns, Gino's Spirits continued to work hard and was rewarded with a Grade III victory in the Noble Damsel H. on turf. She also won three other stakes races at around a mile at five before being sold again as a veteran of 40 races. She returned a handsome profit, with Newsells Park Stud having to go to \$550,000 to secure her at Keeneland in 2001.

Part of her appeal lay in her being a granddaughter of another tough performer in the Classic-winning Mrs McArdy. After ending her juvenile campaign with four consecutive victories, Mrs McArdy continued to make considerable progress at three, when her victories included the Free Handicap and the 1000 Guineas.

Mrs McArdy set a record price for a horse in training when sold to the Firestones for 154,000gns at the end of 1977. Her best effort as a broodmare was the Group 1-placed Citidancer (not to be confused with the American stallion of the same name) and in 1989 she was sent to Japan, where one of the foals she produced became the dam of the Japanese champion Admire Cozzene.

Pennsylvania Cuts Horsemen's Slots Revenue:

In a budget passed by Pennsylvania lawmakers Friday, the percentage of slots revenue received by the state's horsemen has been cut, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Horsemen had been receiving 12 percent of the gross revenue from slot machines, but that figure has been reduced to 10 percent under the new budget. The change could mean a reduction of \$30 million in subsidies. In 2008, horsemen at the state's three Thoroughbred tracks and three harness tracks received \$194 million in subsidies from slot machines. According to the Form, 80 percent of the revenue went directly to purse subsidies, while 16 percent went to breeders awards and four percent to the state's horsemen's organization for health and pension fund benefits.

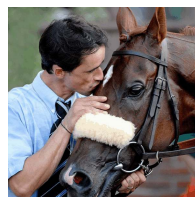

An Explanation of Black Type and Stakes Terms

Black Type

Advertisers using "black type" in their ads in the *TDN* are referring to stakes races which will appear in all major sales catalogues, and which:

- *Have a minimum purse value of \$50,000 distributed on the day of the race.
- *Close at least 72 hours prior to its running, and have a nomination fee paid by the owner of the entrant.
- *Have all entries be eligible for the purse monies used to determine the minimum purse value.
- *Meets specified requirements as related to restrictions and preferences.

Non Black-Type Stakes

The word "stakes" refers to non-black-type stakes, which do not appear in the catalogue page. They are:

- *Races in which the prize money offered is made up at least in part of money put up by the owners of the horses entered, but which offers a purse of less than \$50,000; or excludes horses from black-type money levels due to eligibility requirements;
- *In an advertisement, this could also refer to a mix of black-type and non-black-type stakes (as in Sire X has 73 lifetime stakes winners).

Graded/Group Stakes

There are 16 countries in the world where the racing is of a quality such that that country is allowed to determine its own Graded or Group stakes races, and they are accepted automatically as such in the catalogue.

They are: Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, France, Germany, Great Britain, Ireland, Italy, Japan, New Zealand, Peru, South Africa, the United Arab Emirates and the United States of America.

Other countries' "Group" or "Graded" stakes either count as a black-type race, or just a win, depending upon the country, but they do not have a Grade attached to them in the catalogue. The only exceptions to this rule are 14 races annually in Hong Kong, Scandinavia, Singapore and Turkey of international quality. In short, though, know that if it has a Grade on it in the *TDN*, it's a real Grade.
