INTERNATIONAL DAY AT WOODBINE

Woodbine hosts its biggest day of racing this afternoon, with a trio of graded stakes worth a combined \$3.5 million (Canadian funds), and each offering the winner a berth on Breeders' Cup weekend. The GI Canadian International is the centerpiece of the card, offering a purse of C\$2 million, and each of the top three finishers from last year's running are back. **Marsh Side** (Gone West)

upset **Spice Route** (GB) (King's Best) and **Champs Elysees** (GB) (Danehill) in the 12-furlong event last October, and will be nothing close to the 29-1 he returned to his backers. He looks for redemption after being disqualified from the win in the GI Northern Dancer S., the course-and-distance prep for the International Sept. 20. European invaders look to dominate the market in the GI E.P. Taylor S., led by Augustin Stable's dual Group 1 winner **Rainbow View** (Dynaformer) and **Look Here** (GB) (Hernando {Fr}), the upset winner of the 2008 G1 English Oaks. **Cont. p2-3**

'GIRL LOOKS TO BOUNCE BACK IN QE II

Farnsworth Stables LLC's **Gozzip Girl** (Dynaformer), runner-up by a neck in the GI Ashland S. over the Keeneland Polytrack during the spring meeting, will attempt to atone for a sub-par effort in the GI Garden City S. when she faces a half-dozen other sophomore fillies in today's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup on the turf. The dark bay took advantage of a paceless renewal of the GI Sands Point S. at Belmont and led throughout in that May 30 test, then confirmed her status as the leading turf filly of her generation with a resounding 3 1/4-length victory in the GI American Oaks at Hollywood Park July 5. Her race in the Garden City was marred by an incident going into the first turn, where she clipped heels and nearly went down. Still, she was in with a chance at the quarter pole, but faltered late to finish fourth, 5 1/4 lengths adrift of the upstart **Miss World** (Bernstein). A bounce-back effort would earn Gozzip Girl a trip to the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, which is contested at the identical 10-furlong distance of her American Oaks victory. **QE II Challenge Cup cont. p6**



MORE DEADLY THAN THE MALE?

Newmarket's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. has been the stage for many female conquests over the years, and **Sariska** (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), named for a tiger reserve in India, will attempt to become the latest of the fairer sex to take the Champion S. While the recent list of starlets includes the distinguished names Time Charter (Ire) (Saritamer), Pebbles (GB) (Sharpen Up {GB}), Indian Skimmer (Storm Bird), Bosra Sham (Woodman) and dual heroines Triptych (Riverman) and Alborada (GB) (Alzao), and Lady Bamford's G1 English and Irish Oaks victress would stand proud amongst them if she were to best the colts here. She does not have the deep and testing conditions on which she thrived when recording an impressive success in the July 12 Curragh Classic, but the ground will be more forgiving than what she encountered when succumbing to Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York last time Aug. 20. "It's always difficult for fillies taking on the colts, but she is an exceptional one; Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) was able to do it, and I can't see why this filly shouldn't be able to do the same," jockey Kieren Fallon commented. **Cont. p4-5**

S. at the tail end of last year, has won half of his six sophomore outings, including back-to-back nose scores in the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville Aug. 30 and in the G1 Preis von Europa Sept. 29. He has handled his first trans-Atlantic journey like a pro. "In his stable, he's really laid-back," said Hayley Kelly, head

traveling girl for Johnston. "You wouldn't even think he's a colt. He's an absolute gentleman in his stable. Outside, his only fear is lightbulbs for some reason. Apart from his little quirks, he's fine. He's a very talented horse."

Just as Well (A.P. Indy) has been a revelation for his owner/trainer Jonathan Sheppard, with a win in the GIII Arlington H. July 11 followed by a runner-up effort behind Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 8. The dark bay ran an outstanding race in the Northern Dancer Sept. 20, rallying from last to be beaten a half-length in the finish. He proved the immediate beneficiary when the stewards decided to take down the number of Marsh Side, who interfered with Champs Elysees and was subsequently demoted to fourth.

TAYLOR MADE FOR THE EUROS

Since 1984, just seven renewals of the GI E. P. Taylor S. have been taken by horses based in North America, and that trend looks set to continue this afternoon with a pair of top-shelf raiders signed on. Trainer Ralph Beckett is no stranger to wins on the big stage on this side of the Big Pond, having sent Muhannak (Ire) (Chesster House) to upset last year's inaugural running of the Breeders' Cup Marathon at Santa Anita. The 38-year-old conditioner celebrated his first Group 1 victory last season when **Look Here (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) drew clear to take the Epsom Oaks by a widening 3 3/4 lengths. The bay, who has faced males more times than her own gender in her eight-race career, returned from a layoff to miss by a head when in the G1 Coronation Cup back at Epsom June 5. Third to Dar Re Mi in the G1 Pretty Polly S. at the Curragh June 27, she was sixth versus the boys in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 25. She put that effort behind her in her latest, getting nipped on the money in Newbury's G3 Arc Trial S. Sept. 18.

George Strawbridge's white and green silks were carried to victory in this event by Kool Kat Katie (Ire) (Fairy King) in 1994, and his outstanding **Rainbow View** (Dynaformer) is the 8-5 choice on the morning line here. Perfect in four juvenile starts, including the G1 Fillies' Mile, she was unable to find the winner's enclosure in her first five outings this term, but rediscovered her winning form last time out, taking the G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown Sept. 5. Jockey Julien Leparoux, who has been the regular rider for Augustin's Forever Together (Belong to Me) and Informed Decision (Monarchos) this season, gets the call from trainer John Gosden. **Treat Gently (GB)** (Cap e Cross {Ire}), a Group 2 winner in France and third to subsequent G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) in the G1 Prix Vermeille last season, could not have been more impressive in her U.S. debut, tracking a slow pace before swamping five overmatched rivals by a deceptively easy half-length margin at Belmont July 9. Her dam, Kid Gloves (GB) (In the Wings {GB}), is a half-sister to Juddmonte blue-hen Hasili (GB). Her six Grade/Group 1 winners include International hopeful Champs Elysees (GB).

Call the Doctor...

Khalid Abdullah's **Doctor Fremantle (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) is an interesting contender who bids to provide trainer Sir Michael Stoute with a third edition of the G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. Just shy of the very best last term, the homebred is three-for-four in 2009,

most recently taking the July 9 G2 Princess of Wales's S. on the July Course here and G3 Arc Trial at Newbury Sept. 18. "He had problems with his feet last year, but he's been fine this season,

and has won three of his four races," Stoute said. "He seems equally as effective at different trips--it's just the opposition I'm worried about." Godolphin, chasing a first Champion, are represented by the consistent **Campanologist** (Kingmambo), who needs to improve on all form. After winning the G3 Winter Hill S. at Windsor Aug. 29, he was third behind Doctor Fremantle in the Arc Trial, and found Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Mawathee** (Danzig) 2 1/2 lengths too strong when trying to give that rival three pounds in the G3 Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot last time Sept. 27. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented, "Campanologist tries his hardest all of the time, and he has been doing some nice work recently. We thought that he deserved another chance in Group 1 company, but it looks like it will be a tough race for him." Of Mawathee, trainer Marcus Tregoning said, "He looks a picture and is ready to run his best. I think it gives you an advantage having a fresh horse--you can often find a few pounds with a horse who has had a light campaign like he has had. He is a Danzig half-brother to Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway), and 10 furlongs should be fine for him."

A Pipedream?...

Others who need to step up a notch are the Cheveley Park Stud duo **Pipedreamer (GB)** (Selkirk) and **Virtual (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}). While the latter boasts a success at the highest level after nosing out Alexandros (GB) (Kingmambo) in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 16, he has stamina to prove following a latest third in the Sept. 6 G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Pipedreamer comes here off the back of a battling score in Longchamp's G2 Prix Dollar Oct. 3, and conditioner John Gosden commented, "[Pipedreamer] didn't run from May until the Prix Dollar at Longchamp, but that wasn't by choice. These things happen to horses as they do to athletes, but he has come back in great form now. I asked Jimmy Fortune to ride Virtual, as I specifically trained him for this race, and he also won the Lockinge on him. Personally, I wouldn't say there isn't anything between them. Virtual has been trained for this race, while it is something of an afterthought for Pipedreamer." Susan Roy's June 17 Hunt Cup H. winner **Forgotten Voice (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) has a few pounds to find on the principals, based on his latest third placing in the G3 Joel S. here Oct. 2, but trainer Jeremy Noseda is taking a chance. "We've got nothing to lose with Forgotten Voice and have decided to roll the dice," Noseda said. "He is in good order and should have his preferred quickish ground. I see no reason why he won't get the trip. It's key to him that the race is run at a good pace."

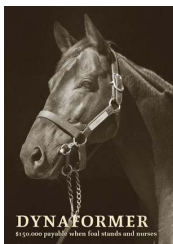

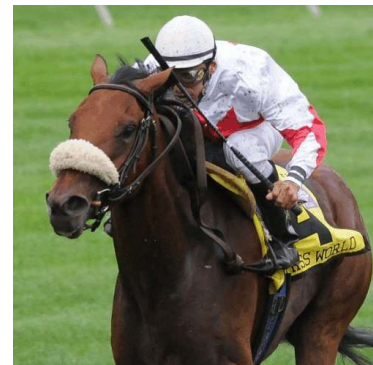

★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ Steinbeck, rested since his debut success in a six-furlong Naas conditions event May 13, faces a baptism of fire here. What is clear is the regard in which he is held at Ballyodyle, and Aidan O'Brien said earlier this week, "Steinbeck had a little break after his last run, and he's been back in full work for a little while now. We were very happy with his last piece of work, and we always thought he was a very nice horse. The Dewhurst is an important race, and we are happy with where he is at the moment." Johnny Murtagh told *PA Sport*, "He's a very good horse, and everyone knows what we think about him. Obviously, it's going to be a big ask having his second-ever run in a race like the Dewhurst, but we think he's up to it." Jim Bolger is looking for a fourth consecutive renewal with **Chabal**, who was acquired by Godolphin after his second in the G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. at The Curragh Sept. 12. "It will be really interesting to see him run, and he looks a really exciting prospect for next year," Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "We hope he's a Guineas horse, but tomorrow will tell us a lot more about him." **Buzzword**, who races in the royal blue, beat Siyouni (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}) in the G3 Prix La Rochette at Longchamp Sept. 6 before finishing third behind that rival in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere back there last time Oct. 4. "I thought Buzzword ran a good race at Longchamp last time out, and he came back from that run in really good order," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He's a really tough horse who takes his racing well, and he is improving all of the time. It's obviously going to be a tough race, but I have been pleased with his preparation and he has the class to run well." Clive Cox saddles the June 16 G2 Coventry S. runner-up and July 29 G2 Vintage S. winner **Xtension**, and is expecting big things. "It's a hot race, as you would expect for a Group 1," Cox said. "After he won the Vintage, we took a view that rather than run with a penalty, we'd wait for a Group 1. We've given him time and he has continued to mature and develop. He still excites me enormously with the way he's going, and we're very much looking forward to it." **Dick Turpin** took the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 31 before adding the Tattersalls Ireland Sale S. to his tally at Fairyhouse Aug. 22. He was only fifth in the Lagadere, but trainer Richard Hannon's son and assistant Richard Hannon Jr. said, "He's come out of his run at Longchamp in good order and he didn't really have a race there--he didn't get any daylight and was shoved around from start to finish. I don't think that seven furlongs on good ground will be a problem for him, and he would have a great chance at Newmarket on the level of form he showed at Goodwood and Fairyhouse. He's certainly a lot better than he showed in Paris, and he's not over the top at the moment."

McPeek Runners to Dot Juvenile Races...

Following the victory of **House of Grace** (Limehouse) in Thursday's JP Morgan Chase Jessamine S., trainer Ken McPeek looks set to be represented in each of the four two-year-old races on Breeders' Cup weekend Nov. 6 and 7. In addition to House of Grace, who is being pointed for the Juvenile Fillies Turf, **Beautician** (Dehere) will represent the stable in the GI Juvenile Fillies on the Pro-Ride. On the colts' side of the ledger, **Noble's Promise** (Cuvee), the upset winner of the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity, will carry the hopes of the barn in the GI Juvenile, while GIII Summer S. hero **Bridgetown** (Speightstown) will take his chance in the Juvenile Turf. "They are all going out on the 19th," McPeek said. "I want to go out early this year to let them get acclimated, especially after all the cold weather here. Last year, I went out late with Dream Empress (Bernstein, who ran second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies)." Additionally, McPeek said that **Teamgeist (Arg)** (Mutakddim), third in the GI Juddmonte Spinster last weekend, could be supplemented to the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic.

Motion Fillies Also Set to Head West...

Trainer Graham Motion said yesterday that **"TDN Rising Star" Smart Seattle** (Smart Strike), nosed out of the win in Thursday's Jessamine S., will head to Santa Anita along with her barnmate **Zilva** (Successful Appeal), who was a respectable fourth in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. Oct. 9. "I'll probably run one of the two in the turf race, depending on how they're still doing," Motion said, referring to the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf over one mile Nov. 6. "My thoughts would be to probably ship them out to California next week and to have the luxury of having the two fillies that are obviously very nice fillies, and make the decision once we're out there as to who's doing well and run the one who's doing well in the Breeders' Cup on the turf."

Regal Ransom a Breeders' Cup Question Mark...

Godolphin's **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor) breezed six furlongs Thursday in 1:13.24 at Belmont Park and will ship to California this coming Monday, though his Breeders' Cup destination is as-yet undetermined. "Saeed wants to see how he handles the synthetic surface," said assistant trainer Rick Mettee. "He ran poorly on the synthetics before [eighth in last year's GI Norfolk S.]. We'll see how he trains this year."

Godolphin Fillies Get Feel for Pro-Ride...

Under the supervision of assistant trainer Henry Spiller, **Seventh Street** (Street Cry {Ire}) and **Sara Louise** (Malibu Moon) each went a half-mile over the Santa Anita Pro-Ride surface yesterday morning. With Richard Migliore in the saddle, Seventh Street, a dual Grade I winner this season, covered the distance in :49.80, while Sara Louise stopped the clock in :49.40. "I'm very happy with their first work over the track," Spiller commented. "I think they handled the surface well." Spiller added that champion **Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song), a candidate for the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, will likely work a half-mile Sunday morning.

Woolley a Classic Go, Zenyatta or No Zenyatta...

Trainer Chip Woolley is not going to let the participation--or non-participation--of **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) impact him in any small way as he prepares **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 7. "Don't get me wrong, Zenyatta is one of the top 10 fillies of all time in my book, but she's never beaten the boys, so it won't make any difference to me if she runs in the Classic or not," Woolley said. "If she were to win, she could retire 14 and 0. But even if she wins the Breeders' Cup Classic, she's not going to beat Rachel Alexandra for Horse of the Year. She has nothing to gain by taking a chance of getting beat, either." For his part, trainer Barry Abrams, is and has been an ardent supporter of the Jerry and Ann Moss runner. "If Rachel Alexandra can beat the best older boys on the East Coast [in the Woodward], Zenyatta can definitely beat the best older boys on the West Coast," Abrams said. "Except for the Europeans, Zenyatta would be facing the same boys in the Classic that Rachel Alexandra beat back East. All the best horses on the East Coast ran against Rachel Alexandra." Abrams plans on sending out **Lethal Heat** (Unusual Heat) in the Ladies' Classic and then wheel her back in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint the next day.

NJ HORSEMEN'S REPS: RACING NEEDS 'LONG-TERM' SOLUTIONS

Representatives of the New Jersey horseracing industry expressed disappointment yesterday over Governor Jon Corzine's decision to cancel Wednesday's blue-ribbon panel meeting, but remain hopeful the state will eventually legalize alternative gaming at the state's racetracks, or at a proposed casino at the Meadowlands Sports Complex in East Rutherford.

The meeting is expected to be rescheduled for November, and is not off the agenda completely, as originally reported.

Corzine, who formed the 15-member commission to make recommendations for improving the financial health of racing in the state, said he opposed the legalization of slot-machine-style gambling at the state's racetracks during an Oct. 9 press conference in Atlantic City. After members of the industry voiced their disapproval of his stance, Corzine announced, with one-day's notice, that he was canceling the meeting, citing the unavailability of two of the panel members.

"I was surprised at the timing of [Corzine's] coming out with that position," said Dennis Drazin, president of the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, and a member of the commission.

According to Drazin, the panel is charged with finding a way to boost racing's revenues after a purse subsidy agreement with Atlantic City casinos expires next year.

"We'll consider all possibilities, whether it's increasing handle, or getting casinos at tracks," he said.

Some panel members, therefore, were caught off guard when Corzine, who is up for reelection this year, took a stand against alternative gaming at racetracks. But there is still optimism that some kind of compromise can be reached.

"The one thing I was encouraged by is that [Corzine] said that if you're going to do something, it didn't make sense to just put in slots; it'd make more sense to put in a full-fledged casino at the Meadowlands, which would then require a referendum," Drazin remarked. "I was not surprised by that, because it was my conclusion, and it's supported by a number of panel members."

Such a casino, even if it only offered slots or VLTs, could generate up to \$1.5 billion per year, according to Drazin. With table games, that figure could be as high as \$2.5 billion. Drazin, however, fears it might take too long for the proposal to become legalized.

"We don't have any funding after 2010, so we're going to need to need some short-term relief starting with 2011 until we get to the point where there are VLTs or slots at a racetrack," Drazin said. "Frankly, I think it's inevitable it will happen--the state of New Jersey needs revenues. But I can't get you the actual timing of it."

New Jersey racing stakeholders have, so far, been unsuccessful in their attempts to expand casino-style gambling outside Atlantic City. In lieu of slot machines or video lottery terminals at racetracks, Atlantic City casinos have subsidized purses. Under the current three-year arrangement, the casinos provide \$30 million a year to racing, with the money divided between Thoroughbred and Standardbred interests. The agreement runs out at the end of 2010.

Purses during this year's Monmouth Park meet averaged between \$325,000 and \$350,000 per day, according to Drazin. If the deal with Atlantic City casinos is not renewed, or if tracks aren't authorized to conduct expanded gaming, purses could drop below \$200,000 per day.

"[Purses that low] will not put out a good product and will help destroy the industry," Drazin said. "You have to be competitive with the purses you are offering. There will be a reversal in terms of who is second to New York in the Midlantic region."

Fellow panelist Tom Luchento, president of the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey, said revenue from alternative gaming could later be complemented with additional off-track betting and lower takeout rates. Luchento, who is less optimistic than Drazin that Corzine would support a casino at the Meadowlands, believes the Atlantic City casinos might be interested in a partnership where they would manage the slot operations at the tracks and keep a percentage of the revenues.

"When the casinos realize they are going to get killed when they have table games over in Pennsylvania and Delaware, they are going to have to make a decision," Luchento said. "And I hope that decision doesn't come too late for them to save themselves, or buries us."

But Luchento believes that racing will need the cooperation of Atlantic City, in one way or another, to remain healthy.

"Someone said at the last meeting, 'What if they don't want to partner with you?' Well, that's fine. Anybody might want to partner with us if we get the OK to get slot machines or VLTs in New Jersey. We don't need Atlantic City," he said. "But it seems, without Atlantic City's OK, we'll never get [slots], because that seems to be the driving force in the legislature."

The uncertain future of racing in the state is even more daunting for breeders.



"We need a long-term solution," said Mike Campbell, executive director for Thoroughbred Breeders' Association of New Jersey. "After a horse is born, they might not get to the track until three or four years down the road. There is no confidence right now for breeders in New Jersey."

The panel's report is due July 1, 2010, but Campbell expressed the wish that the deadline was sooner.

"We'd like the report to be made sooner than that, because the purse supplement expires by the end of next year and nobody knows what [purses] they'll be running for by the end of next year," he said, but added, "I am hopeful it's just a temporary setback, and that they'll have a meeting in November and that we can move forward with the panel, and get some recommendations to the Governor by July 1 of next year."

TATTERSALLS OCTOBER BOOK 3 FINALE Book 3 of Tattersalls' October Yearling Sale concluded last night with a set of figures that would have delighted many before the eight-day sale began. The sale's three books brought a combined turnover of 76,743,000gns, up from 72,439,300gns in 2008 (when there was also a Book 4 sale). The average was 55,854gns, down 4.4 percent on 2008, while the 78.3 percent clearance rate rose from 69.9 percent last year. Dave and Debi Curran's Gazeley Stud sold yesterday's top lot, [hip 1915](#), an Invincible Spirt (Ire) colt who was bought for 50,000gns by local trainer Marco Botti. Breeze-up consignors Jamie Railton was underbidder for the son of Gracious (GB) (Grand Lodge). "It's been difficult to buy, but this was one of the nicest horses here and he should be a two-year-old," said Botti. "We've been trying to buy a nice colt, but we struggled in Book 2, so I'm pleased to have bought this one." At the sale's conclusion, Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony noted, "At the end of last week, we expressed delight at the strength of Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, and it has been a real boost for the British and Irish bloodstock industries to have reached the end of Book 3 having seen sustained demand for quality yearlings from start to finish. There was understandable trepidation going into this year's Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, and there would be few pundits who would have anticipated similar turnover to last year, let alone a significant rise, but the total turnover has comfortably exceeded last year's figure and is the third highest ever, behind only 2006 and 2007. The increase in turnover is a great morale boost for breeders and a tribute to the quality of the yearlings that they have presented over the last two weeks." Mahony added, "Without doubt the most telling statistic has been the combined clearance rate of nearly 80 percent. The competition for yearlings at all levels of the market has been the feature of the 2009 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, and to have sold a higher percentage of yearlings in 2009 than in the record year of 2007 is extraordinary." Looking ahead, he remarked, "Stiff challenges remain, and it would be wrong to pretend that everything is now rosy, but at the same time the past two weeks have demonstrated an enduring global appetite for the sport of racing, which has been a pleasure to see."
