## 'SCHIAP' COMES IN...AGAIN

Successful here in 2007 renewal of the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club, new Godolphin recruit **Schiaparelli (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) returned to earn the repeat when sauntering to an easy success Sunday at Milan. Dropping back in trip after finishing a tired third in the G1 Irish St Leger over 1 3/4 miles at The Curragh Sept. 12, the imposing chestnut quickly established his position at the head of affairs under Frankie Dettori. After setting a steady tempo, he was asked to stretch soon after turning for home and comfortably had the measure of **Voila Ici (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}), who paid for chasing the winner and was denied the runner's-up spot late on by **Sant'Antonio (Ity)** (Shantou). Schiaparelli was recording a fifth win at this level, having captured the 2006 G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg and the following year's G1 Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf and G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne alongside this race when under the care of Peter Schiergen. This was his first under the Godolphin banner, and was the natural progression from a pair of Group 2 wins in the July 30 Goodwood Cup and Aug. 23 Prix Kergolay at Deauville. ## GET STORMY GETS UP

Sullimar Stables homebred **Get Stormy** (Stormy Atlantic), in search of his first graded win in yesterday's GIII Bryant Station S., rallied stoutly down the center of Keeneland's turf course to win impressively. After wintering in Florida with trainer Caroline Webster, for whom he was zero-for-two at Tampa Bay, Get Stormy was returned to Tom Bush's care in the spring. The bay won his last two for the New York-based horseman, capturing a first-level allowance at Saratoga in front-running fashion July 29, then using those same tactics to add the Spa's Lure S. at 7-1 odds Aug. 29. Adjusting his running style a bit here, Get Stormy stalked the pace of **Major Marvel** (Bernstein) from the outset, forged to the lead at the furlong grounds and edged clear under Javier Castellano's drive. The late-running **Rescue Squad** (Dynaformer) nabbed place honors in the dying strides, with tepid favorite **Kinsella** (Mr. Greeley) settling for third. Major Marvel held fourth. "I handicapped this race; there was a little speed in the race," explained Castellano. "I just left him close to the pace, and he responded very well today." Cirrus des Aigles, his owners' first equine venture, has been the model of consistency throughout a busy career, hitting the board in each of his prior 19 starts apart from a debut fourth at Chantilly last October. His last seven outings have been exclusively in black-type company, and include victories in the Aug. 12 Listed Grand Prix du Lion d'Angers and the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at this track last time Sept. 19. Breaking smartly, he settled in second, three lengths off the leader Puchet (Arg) (Potrillon {Arg}), until taking closer order, albeit shuffled back one spot, with a half-mile remaining. Cirrus des Aigles was still full of run on the heels of the leaders as the field bunched passing the two pole.

Cirrus des Aigles made a dart for a gap along the rail approaching the final eighth and lengthened clear of a toiling pack to register a career high in impressive style. "What a wonderful and marvellous horse Cirrus des Aigles is," enthused trainer Corine Barande-Barbe. "He is the first one the owners have had and has instantly shown them the good side of racing. That was his most difficult task to date, but the one he has won with most authority, and he quickened beautifully off a fast pace. He is in the [Nov. 8 G1] Premio Roma, the [GI Nov. 29] Hollywood Derby and two races in Hong Kong, the [G1] Cup and the [G1] Vase [both at Sha Tin Dec. 13]. We will see how he comes out of this before deciding where to go next. 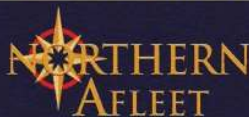

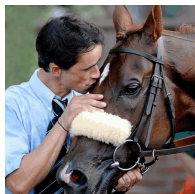

Positioned in a stalking second from the outset, he made his bid off the home turn and kept on strongly under continued urging to deny the tenacious Circumvent after a stretch-long duel. "I was pleased with Zeitoper, who is improving all the time," said trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "He has now won all three of his races and successfully stepped up in class here. Freshened after those battles, Red Desire returned to be second by a neck in the Sept. 20 G2 Kansai TV Tele-casting Corporation Sho Rose S. going 1800 meters at Hanshin, and was sitting on ready for this test. The filly was rated in midfield, with Buena Vista shadowing her, and found the gap she needed to stride to the front when they hit the stretch. Buena Vista, however, had to make her own opening, interfering with Broad Street in the process, before flying home late to just miss. Broad Street recovered to get third, but the stewards took a look at the video and disqualified Buena Vista, moving Broad Street into second. 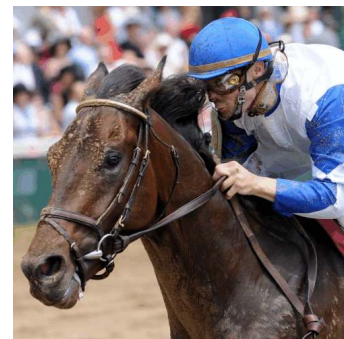

Sims added that he gained confidence in his charge as the race developed. "Down the backside, she was running easy," Sims said. "She was laying closer than usual because of the slow pace and some of the riders were staying off the rail. When the hole opened up, she shot right through there. When she shifts gears, she's gone. She's got a good turn of foot and the way she won yesterday, it probably didn't matter where she was."

QE II runner-up **Shared Account** (Pleasantly Perfect) came out of the race with a nick "on her front left ankle, behind, but other than that she's come out of the race pretty good," said Alice Clapham, assistant to trainer Graham Motion. "It's just one of those things that happens." Clapham added, "She ran good. She ran her race. She's a genuine filly; she never stopped trying. She's always better if she has something to run at. In the last two races, she's had to make the pace, but she's such a versatile filly that you can do whatever you want with her." Clapham thought the QE II might be the final race of the year for Shared Account.

**JOCKEY PACE DIES IN BLUE RIBBON DOWNS**

**SPILL** Jockey Mark Pace, 58, died Sunday after going down in a spill during the first race at Oklahoma's Blue Ribbon Downs, reports *Daily Racing Form*. Pace was on 59-1 longshot Reep What You Sow (Games People Play) in a \$5,000 maiden claiming race when the three-year-old filly hit the rail on the backstretch and unseated the rider. Pace was taken to Sequoyah Memorial Hospital in nearby Sallisaw and was pronounced dead at 12:52 p.m., according to *DRF*, who cited Jerry Green, the chaplain based at Blue Ribbon. Reep What You Sow was a pick-up mount for Pace, who was believed to have recently resumed riding after a 10-year absence. Officials at Blue Ribbon called off racing Sunday following the second race after learning of Pace's death.

**Mena Unseated, Sent For X-Rays:**

Jockey Miguel Mena was sent to the University of Kentucky Medical Center for precautionary X-rays after he was unseated from his mount at the start of Keeneland's first race Sunday. Mena suffered a soft-tissue injury to his neck and left thigh, but was described as "awake and alert" by Keeneland medical personnel. His mount, She's Due (Devil His Due), stumbled leaving the gate at the start of the 1 1/16-mile \$25,000 claimer. Mena was replaced on all of his mounts for the balance of the afternoon.

**Albarado, Off Sunday Mounts, to Return Wednesday:**

Robby Albarado, leading rider at the current Keeneland meet with 10 victories, took off all of his mounts Sunday after a spill in Saturday's sixth race. "He's fine, he just looks like he got in a fight with Mike Tyson," said Lenny Pike, Albarado's agent. "His right eye is almost swollen shut and he can't ride today, but he will ride Wednesday." My Baby Baby (Bernstein) stumbled at the start of Saturday's sixth race, a 1 1/16-mile turf allowance, and unseated Albarado. Albarado suffered contusions to his face and did not ride the rest of the card. One of the mounts he lost was the call on El Brujo (Candy Ride {Arg}), who won the Gill Perryville S. under Edgar Prado.

**Trakus Says Mushka Would Have Won Spinster:**

The demotion of **Proviso (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) from first to second in the Oct. 11, GI Juddmonte Spinster S. left fans debating whether or not her interference of **Mushka** (Empire Maker) cost the latter a sure victory. Jockey Kent Desormeaux, aboard Mushka, insisted he and his mount would have gotten up in plenty of time had Proviso not bore out at the sixteenth pole, and it turns out Trakus technology agrees. Data from Trakus, the electronic tracking system that determines the exact location of each horse throughout a race, indicated the closing speed between the two horses prior to the bump was 1.5 mph, or roughly 2.2 feet per second. This means if there was no bump, and the speeds of the two horses were constant for the remainder of the race, that Mushka would have gained 2.2 feet--or approximately a quarter-length--on Proviso for each second of time remaining in the race until the finish. Michael Ciacciarelli, chief operating officer for Trakus, said that, given the remaining distance and time from when the bump occurred, and assuming the speeds remained constant, Mushka would have taken the lead from Proviso approximately two seconds later, ultimately winning by 0.3 seconds, or about 1 1/2 lengths. Proviso was moving 36 mph before and after the bump, finishing the final 333 feet with a 35.8 mph average speed. Mushka was moving 38 mph before the bump, dropped to 34 mph after the bump and finally recovered to finish the final 331 feet with a 35.3 mph average speed. The bump occurred approximately 380 feet from the finish, where the horses were approximately three-quarters of a length apart.

**1,600 Students on Hand for College Scholarship Day:**

More than 1,600 college students from Kentucky and neighboring states braved chilly temperatures to take part in Keeneland's 15th College Scholarship Day on Friday. Keeneland, in conjunction with the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association, has awarded a total of \$150,000 in scholarship money during its 15 College Scholarship Days, held each spring and fall meeting. On Friday, 1,368 full-time students registered to win one of the 10 \$1,000 scholarships given away after each of the afternoon's races. The winners were: Judson Pitman, University of Kentucky; Alexandria Rydz, Midway College; Noah Wright, University of Kentucky; Rachel North, University of Kentucky; Brian Anderson, Centre College; Eli Capps-Amburgey, West Virginia State University; Ben Johnson, University of Kentucky; Rachael Long, University of Pittsburgh; Lisa Schiefer, University of Kentucky; and Kendra Herzberger, University of Kentucky.

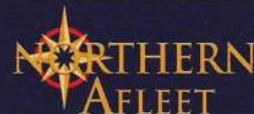

"I have a broken [right] collarbone, a broken acromion [part of the scapula], a broken shoulder blade, and a pinched nerve in my back, for which I have to see a spine surgeon on Wednesday," said the 21-year-old native of Oceanside, New York. "I already broke my neck and back in two places, and each time doctors have told me that's it, as far as riding is concerned. I've got a family now, so I feel lucky if I can walk away from this one. I've got a beautiful wife [Trinity] and a beautiful little boy [Owen]. I've got to take care of them. It wouldn't be fair to them for me to ask them to push me around in a wheelchair. I rode for five years. It was a fun career, and I will miss it terribly." The Kaenels reside in Glendora, California. The tall and lanky Kaenel is the son of former rider Cowboy Jack Kaenel, who was the youngest jockey to win a Triple Crown race when he rode Aloma's Ruler at the age of 16 in the 1982 GI Preakness S.
