

ASK AND THOU SHALL RECEIVE

Ask (GB) (Sadler's Wells) closed out his 2009 campaign in style, gamely driving home a 1 1/4-length winner over **Schiaparelli (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) in Sunday's G1 Prix Royal Oak at Longchamp. Ask's only previous visit to France yielded a sixth-place finish in last term's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, at this track, and he closed the season with an off-color seventh in the G3 St Simon S. at Newbury exactly one year ago. Coming back this

year to lift the May 15 G2 Yorkshire Cup, he registered a career best in a thrilling finish to the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom in his penultimate start June 5. Ask went postward for this eighth Group 1 attempt coming back off a commendable third to stablemates Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and Tartan Bearer (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}) in the July 25 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot, and doubled his top-level tally in game fashion. Positioned in third for most of this marathon, he suffered the consequences as **Askar Tau (Fr)** (Montjeu {Ire}) bumped into **Sevenna (Fr)** (Galileo {Ire}) at the top of the straight, but recovered within a matter of strides. Sent in pursuit of Schiaparelli passing the quarter-mile marker, he was still two lengths in arrears entering the final eighth and stayed on resolutely under continued urging to wrest victory from that rival nearing the line. "Ask is finished for the season and stays in training next year," owner Patrick Fahey told *Racing Post*. TATTS AUTUMN HIT SALE TODAY

Tattersalls' unique Autumn Horses in Training Sale gets underway in Newmarket this morning at 9:30 a.m. The world's largest exchange of horses of racing age draws a crowd from across the globe looking for flat prospects, although traditionally they face strong competition from British and Irish jumping buyers. Sugar Ray (Ire) (Danehill) set a sale record price of 600,000gns last year when bought by Anthony Stroud for Godolphin and, with the imminent opening of Meydan racecourse in Dubai, it is expected that the various agents used by the Maktoum family will again be busy over the next four days along with others shopping for the 2010 Dubai Carnival. **Tatts Cont. p3**

INDIAN BLESSING TO MISS BREEDERS' CUP

Trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form* Sunday that Hal and Patti Earnhardt's dual champion **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie) will not be pre-entered for the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Santa Anita Nov. 6. Baffert cited the four-year-old's apparent dislike of Santa Anita's Pro-Ride surface in recent works. "I think I'm going to pass," Baffert told the publication "She just doesn't like the track. What can you do? She looks good. It's frustrating. I'm not going to pre-enter because I don't want the temptation to change my mind." Baffert confirmed that Indian Blessing is scheduled to be bred next spring and said he was unsure if the filly would start again before being retired. To date, Indian Blessing has compiled a record of 16-10-5-0 and earned \$2,995,420. She was runner-up to Ventura (Chester House) in last year's Filly & Mare Sprint. **Breeders' Cup News cont. p6**

Leaner Catalog for Tatts Autumn...

There are 1,527 lots listed in this year's main catalogue--182 fewer than last year's record-sized sale--with an additional six supplementary offerings that could include some of the week's highlights. Included among the supplementary lots are a pair from Ger Lyons' stable in Ireland that look sure to prove popular. Two-year-old **Mister Tee (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), [lot 568A](#), won the Listed Star Appeal S. at Dundalk Oct. 9 and also finished second in this season's G2 Futurity S. His three-year-old stablemate **Summit Surge (Ire)** (Noverre), [lot 534A](#), heads to the sale on the back of a success in the G3 Amethyst S. at Leopardstown on his latest outing. He has also tasted success at the Dubai Carnival, scoring in a valuable contest at Nad Al Sheba in February. Another extra lot is the two-year-old In Some Respect (Ire) (Indian Haven), [lot 334A](#), who finished second to Alfred Nobel (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in this season's G2 Railway S. for trainer Andy Oliver, while five-year-old **Tariq (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), [lot 342A](#), has tasted success at the group level, having won the G2 Betfair Cup at Goodwood in 2007. As always at this event, there are a huge number of withdrawals, including some of the best lots catalogued. But among the juveniles still slated to appear is [lot 425](#), **Big Audio (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}), whose two listed victories for Richard Hannon this season include the Chesham S. at Royal Ascot. His stablemate **Full Mandate (Ire)** (Acclamation {GB}), [lot 432](#), is owned by a partnership headed by bloodstock agent Peter Doyle's wife Anna and--having finished second in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot--went on to be runner-up in the Goffs Million Sprint at The Curragh. Other interesting juveniles include **Icon Dream (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), [lot 647](#) and winner of his only start in a Tipperary maiden for trainer David Wachman, and [lot 992](#), **Star-gaze (Ire)** (Oasis Dream), who finished third in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood for Andrew Balding. *Cont. p5*

A large dispersal by owners Harry Findlay and Tony Bloom includes [lot 455](#), the Tom Dascombe-trained **Above Limits (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), who has placed twice in listed company this season. Among the older horses on offer is three-year-old **Bonnie Charlie (GB)** (Intikhab), [lot 818](#), who came fourth in the G3 Bengough Memorial S. at Ascot last time out, and [lot 574](#), **Brave Prospector (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), who was third in the same race. The G1 Irish 2000 Guineas fifth **Fergus McIver (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) is offered from Jim Bolger's stable as [lot 720](#).

Meanwhile, **Above Average (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}), [lot 494](#), won the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown in April for trainer Barry Hills. Sprint buyers will look at his five-year-old stablemate **Prime Defender (GB)** (Bertolini), [lot 491](#), who finished a close fifth in the G2 Diadem S. at Ascot in September. The John Oxx-trained **Pittoni (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre), [lot 599](#), has landed a maiden since the catalogue went to press, while Aidan O'Brien's draft includes the classy three-year-old **Von Jawlensky (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), [lot 634](#), who cost 600,000gns as a yearling.

A sizeable Juddmonte draft includes [lot 1074](#), **Putney Bridge (Mizzen Mast)**, who has a couple of good recent group places in France for trainer Criquelette Head-Maarek. [Lot 264](#), the German-trained **Adelar (Ger)** (Samum {Ger}) was beaten a neck in a Deauville Group 3 in August.

Local trainer Sir Mark Prescott's draft is always popular here and jumping buyers could be interested in the promising three-year-old **Braveheart Move (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), [lot 731](#), while [lot 1103](#), the Luca Cumani-trained **Leverage (Ire)** (Xaar {GB}), looks to be progressive.

Einstein Readies for Classic...

In his final pre-race training move over his home track, Stronach Stable's **Einstein (Brz)** (Spend a Buck) zipped through five furlongs in :59.80 at Churchill Downs Sunday morning. The fastest of 54 at the distance, the Classic contender was accompanied by jockey Julien Leparoux. The Brazilian-bred--working in tandem with a pair of juveniles from the barn of trainer Helen Pitts--posted intermediate splits of :23.80 and :36, galloping out six furlongs in 1:12.80. "We started about three or four lengths behind [his stablemates], but I caught them at the three-eighths pole and he finished very strong to the wire," explained Leparoux. "It was perfect. It was a very nice breeze. He is strong and he's going to be ready for the Breeders' Cup." Pitts confirmed that the winner of the GI Santa Anita H. would leave for California Tuesday and would have only one major work--going a half mile--over the Pro-Ride surface at Santa Anita. "I just wanted to give him something to keep him interested," said Pitts, explaining her decision to send Einstein out with workmates. "He works good on his own, but he gets bored doing it. He likes being able to run at something in the mornings--he likes clocking something and running past them."

Misremembered to Bypass Dirt Mile...

Misremembered (Candy Ride {Arg}) will not make it into the line-up of this year's GI Dirt Mile and will instead make his next start in the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 27, according to trainer Bob Baffert. "He's a big, immature horse," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "I want him for the Strub [series during Santa Anita's winter-spring meeting]." Winner of this season's GII Swaps S. and GII Indiana Derby, the chestnut worked six furlongs in 1:11.80 Saturday.

Summer Bird Drills Five Panels at Santa Anita...

Three-time Grade I winner **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) strutted his stuff after the second race at Santa Anita Sunday as he continues to march toward a start in the Classic Nov. 7. Under regular rider Kent Desormeaux--who flew in from New York for the move--the chestnut completed five furlongs in 1:00.45. Winner of the GI Belmont S., GI Travers S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, the colt recorded internal fractions of :24.42 and :48.56 before galloping out six panels in 1:13.03. "The work was great," said trainer Tim Ice. "This was exactly what we wanted. He looked super getting over the track and he's been getting over it very well ever since we got here. Kent had a ton of horse under him and he just let him work on his own, within himself. I'm super-happy with how he's trained here and how he's handled everything." Ice said that Summer Bird would return to the track Tuesday and would have one more breeze prior to the Breeders' Cup, likely drilling five eighths Saturday.

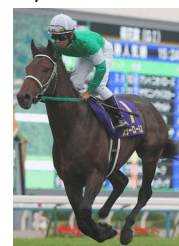
