CHEROKEE RUN PENSIONED

Cherokee Run (Runaway Groom--Cherokee Dame, by Silver Saber), the 1994 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero and later the sire of champions Chilukki and War Pass, has been pensioned due to fertility issues, according to published reports. The 19-year-old stallion will remain at Darley's Kentucky base. An \$85,000 OBSFEB purchase, the Florida-bred began his career for trainer Frank Gomez at Calder and went five-for-seven at two, capping 1992 with a second in the GIII What a Pleasure S. He was turned over to Frank Alexander at three and landed the GIII Lafayette S. and GIII Derby Trial before running second to ill-fated champion Prairie Bayou in the GI Preakness S. The dark bay later added the GII Dwyer S. to his trophy case, but, after disappointing in the GI Haskell Invitational H. and GI Travers S., targeted one-turn races when he returned for his four-year-old campaign. In 1994, he ran third in the GI Carter H. and second in both the GI Metropolitan H. and GII Tom Fool H. before landing the GII DeFrancis Dash Memorial H. Cherokee Run was runner-up in the GIII A Phenomen H. and third in the GI Vosburgh H. before besting the field in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill ([video](#)), which put him on top in the Eclipse Award balloting for owner Jill Robinson. He added the 1995 Gulfstream Sprint Championship H., but was retired after finishing fourth in the GIII Bold Ruler H. His record stood at 28-13-5-5, with earnings of \$1,531,849. Retired to Jonabell Farm for the 1996 breeding season, Cherokee Run was represented by an \$875,000 filly at FTFEB in 1999 from his first crop.

CONDUIT TO JAPAN FOLLOWING RACING CAREER

Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}--Well Head {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells) has been acquired by Shigeyuki Okada's Big Red Farm in Japan, where he will stand the 2010 breeding season. The four-year-old, set to defend his title in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 7 and pre-entered in the Nov. 29 G1 Japan Cup, will continue to race under the colors of his breeder Ballymacoll Stud. His purchase price and 2010 stud fee were not disclosed. The chestnut won last year's G1 Ladbrokes St Leger S. before he ventured to North America to annex the Turf. He added a third top-level victory in this year's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. July 25, and was most recently fourth in the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 4. Conduit boasts a career record of 13-6-2-3 and has earned \$3,755,300. At Big Red Farm, he'll join the likes of G1 Dubai World Cup winner Roses in May (Devil His Due) and G1 Hong Kong Cup hero Agnes Digital (Crafty Prospector).

Doing her business as Chilukki, she was crowned as champion two-year-old. Yonaguska brought \$1.95 million at that sale the following year and went on to share honors in the GI Hopeful S. in the summer. The stallion continued to provide a stream of solid campaigners before getting War Pass from his 2005 crop. That colt streaked to Eclipse Award honors following wins in the 2007 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Champagne S. To date, Cherokee Run has sired 41 black-type winners from 11 crops of racing age.

DUTROW CHARGES SITTING ON GO

Court Vision (Gulch), who returned to form in Keeneland's GI Shadwell Turf Mile S. Oct. 10, worked six furlongs in 1:14.50 at the Big A yesterday in preparation of the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Dutrow trained Kip Deville (Kipling) to a victory in the 2007 Mile at Monmouth and a second-place finish behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) last year. The conditioner isn't looking forward to looking horns with the super filly again. "I don't like it," Dutrow admitted. "But our horse is doing good, and as long as he gets a good trip and runs his race, we think that we're very, very live. We breezed him this morning; he's ready." Scheduled

to depart for Santa Anita Tuesday with the IEAH Stables colorbearer is GII Saratoga Special S. and GII Futurity S. winner **D' Funnybone** (D'wildcat). "I can't say that I'm concerned about it," Dutrow said of the Paul Pompa Jr. colorbearer switching to a synthetic surface. "If I was concerned, I probably wouldn't go. I'm just hoping he likes the track and is looking for two turns. He's in a zone. We think if he runs his race that we are the horse to beat." Dutrow also revealed that GI Champagne S. hero **Homeboykris** (Roman Ruler) would be making his next start in the GII Remsen S. Nov. 28. "I never wanted to send him out there [for the Breeders' Cup]," he commented. "His mind is not like Funnybone's, so I didn't want to go messing with his mind. We like him for the Kentucky Derby next year. Right now, out here with [exercise rider] Rudy [Rodriguez] everyday is a good thing. Anything else could turn into a disaster with him, so we want to keep him around here and run him right out of his stall and two turns. We're very happy with the schedule we have with him."

BECKETT HOPES FOR MORE MUHANNAK MAGIC

Trainer Ralph Beckett was yesterday hoping that **Muhannak (Ire)** (Chester House) could return to form and provide the stable with a second renewal of the Breeders' Cup Marathon. Winless since his upset win in the inaugural running of that contest over 1 1/2 miles 12 months ago, Richard Pegum's five-year-old was a latest fifth in the G3 Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot Sept. 27. "He's a horse that does thrive on a change of environment, and we felt his run in the Cumberland Lodge was very good," Beckett said yesterday. "Ironically, having whined about the change in distance of the Marathon, he now looks like he wants all of the new trip and his work is good and he's in good shape. He flies out tomorrow morning."

Anthony Bonomo Jr.'s **Connie and Michael** (Roman Ruler), an impressive 7 3/4-length debut winner at Keeneland Oct. 17 ([Video](#)), worked five furlongs beneath Kent Desormeaux in 1:01 at Churchill Downs Friday. She is being pointed toward the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Oak Tree. "She went out for a breeze with a capital B," Desormeaux said of the move. "She was just cruising out there, and she galloped out strong." Trained by Ken McPeck, the bay was a \$80,000 KEESEP yearling graduate.

BC STARTERS RUNNING FOR A GOOD CAUSE

The connections of seven Breeders' Cup entrants have pledged a percentage or portion of their charge's earnings to the New Vocations Racehorse Adoption Program. They include IEAH Stables (Court Vision {Gulch}, Diamondrella {GB} {Rock of Gibraltar [Ire]}, and Radiohead {GB} {Johannesburg}); Charles Winner, David Bienstock, and Paul Mandabach (Magical Fantasy {Diesis [GB]}); Chasing Dreams Racing (Noble's Promise {Cuvee}); Sovereign Stable (Negligee {Northern Afleet}); and Brushwood Stable (Mushka {Empire Maker}). "Times are tough right now, and the number of horses needing our services continues to rise," explained program director Anna Ford. "We are truly grateful to have these owners pledge their support during this year's Breeders' Cup. I think a lot of their success at the track has been due to the fact that they truly care about the welfare and safety of their horses both on and off the track. It is our hope that more owners will choose to follow their lead. What a statement it would be if every starter made a pledge." New Vocations focuses on placing retired Thoroughbred and Standardbred racehorses into new homes and careers.

Defending race champion Vodka dominated against fillies and mares in the May 17 G1 Victoria Mile and prevailed versus males in the G1 Yasuda Kinen June 7 before Company snapped her two-race winning streak. The 2006 JRA champion two-year-old colt **Dream Journey** took the G1 Takarazuka Kinen June 7 and was runner-up in the Sept. 27 G2 All Comers S. in his last two starts, but was well-beaten in his two previous efforts over left-handed courses.

MULLINS GETS SIX-MONTH BAN FROM NYRA

Officials at the New York Racing Association announced yesterday that California-based trainer Jeff Mullins has been handed a six-month suspension for violating NYRA's monitoring barn rules and regulations last April at Aqueduct. The ruling will prohibit Mullins from entering any horses into NYRA races, will forbid him access to NYRA property and will prohibit the transfer of any of his horses in an attempt to run in New York. The penalty is being imposed by NYRA and not the New York State Racing and Wagering Board (NYSWRB), which makes it unlikely that other jurisdictions will impose penalties of their own. The NYSWRB previously suspended Mullins for seven days. The

Mullins-trained Gato Go Win (City Place) was scratched out of the Gill Bay Shore S. Apr. 4 after the conditioner was found in the monitoring barn with an empty dose syringe, in direct violation of policy. Another horse trained by Mullins, I Want Revenge (Stephen Got Even), won the GI Wood Memorial S. later that same day. Following a two-day administrative hearing this week, it was determined that this additional penalty should be imposed since outside counsel from a third-party law firm found that testimony submitted by Mullins during the initial investigation "conflicted significantly with the credible and persuasive testimony of other witnesses, including one presented by [Mullins]." The trainer also originally denied bringing the dose syringe to the monitoring barn. C. Steven Duncker, chairman of the NYRA Board of Directors, said: "The events leading up to the imposition of today's penalties demonstrates NYRA's twin commitments to racing integrity and due process. WARBLING (Unbridled's Song)

It took some time to get **Warbling** to the races, but she proved more than worth the wait with her stellar debut at Keeneland yesterday. The victory, and the manner in which it was accomplished, came as no surprise to trainer Eddie Kenneally.

"We've liked her for a long long time," Kenneally said. "She went by other horses with ease in the morning, just like she did in her race. We were very enthusiastic about running her. We had a good feeling bringing her up to the races first time."

Barry Berkelhammer found Warbling for owner Joseph W. Sutton at the 2007 Keeneland September sale.

"As we all say, she was very athletic, very balanced, but the biggest thing I remember about her is that she had a lovely walk on her," Berkelhammer recalled.

The hammer fell at \$260,000, a fair price, according to the bloodstock agent.

"She has a beautiful pedigree and, at the time, the market was a lot stronger," Berkelhammer said. "That was about what we figured it would take to get her. Of course, now that might look like a bargain."

The filly was sent to Berkelhammer's farm for early training.

"She was always very smart," he remarked. "She was a little bit immature physically--it took her some time to catch up to where she could withstand the training. But there was always a lot to like about her."

Warbling didn't make it to the track until late in her juvenile year.

"I got her in December of last year at Palm Meadows, and she was special from the beginning," Kenneally said. "We loved her."

The grey was working bullets in South Florida, then shipped to Keeneland for what was planned to be her career opener. But things didn't go as her connections had hoped.

"We had her ready to run in April, but she had a little setback," Kenneally explained. "It was nothing major--we just sent her to the farm and gave her a little time off."

Warbling was back on the work tab with a bullet three-eighths in :35 2/5 at Churchill Sept. 2, and had dashed off three more bullets in her five works since.

Those morning trials were reflected on the tote board, as she was hammered down to 3-5, and she won like a filly with a future.

"She was very impressive," Berkelhammer offered. "We thought a lot of her when we sent her to Eddie, and Eddie has always talking highly of her. It was up to her to prove it today, and she did. She was an absolute professional."

Warbling handled maidens with ease, but don't expect to see her in black-type company any time soon.

"We'll take it one step at a time," Kenneally said. "We've been very patient with her so far--we're not going to rush her into the deep end. She'll winter at Palm Meadows."

Berkelhammer, who was introduced to Joe Sutton by Duncan Taylor of Taylor Made, also bought Cowgirl Mally (Gone West) for the owner. A \$170,000 KEESEP yearling last fall, the filly was third in Saratoga's Gill Schuylerville S.

Sutton, a venture capitalist who served as an Enron executive from 1992 to 2000, got into racing about 15 years ago. A former career army officer from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, he was bitten by the racing bug while stationed at Fort Knox in Kentucky, and learned the ropes from Dr. Laszlo Makk. His stable, which includes a number of horses raced in partnership as well as breeding stock and young horses, totals between 30 and 40 head.

Jockey Brimo in Critical Condition Following Spill:

Jockey Julia Brimo, the 2003 Sovereign Award recipient as top apprentice jockey in Canada, is listed in critical condition by the University of Kentucky Medical Center after suffering injuries in a spill in Keeneland's first race Friday. Brimo's mount, Golden Stride, fell after clipping heels with another rival halfway through the nine-furlong contest. Trainer Mark Casse told *Daily Racing Form* that his ex-wife, Jennifer Christiansen, was at the hospital with Brimo and that she said the rider had suffered head and back injuries. Casse also told *DRF* that Brimo has movement in her legs, but was placed in an induced coma because of recurring seizures.

MOORE REFLECTS ON CHAMPIONSHIP

Ryan Moore was presented with his second British Jockeys' Championship yesterday and reflected on his season before looking ahead to his upcoming challenges. Currently on 174 wins, Sir Michael Stoute's retained rider is due to partner a host of main chances at Santa Anita next weekend, including Khalid Abdullah's **Zacinto (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and Ballymacoll's **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) in the Mile and Turf, respectively; as well as Michael Tabor's G1 Dewhurst S. winner **Beethoven (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}) in the Juvenile. Moore said, "I had a nice year and a few big winners along the way, and I've cut down a lot on my rides from three years ago to be a little bit fresher and avoid bans. I'm very lucky to ride for Sir Michael Stoute and his owners and Richard Hannon, dad [Gary Moore] and Newmarket trainers like William Haggas and Jeremy Nosedo. Winning the King George on Conduit was the highlight, as it's still the most important race in England after the Derby. There is still plenty more to do and the big races, rather than the championship, are the most important thing." Of Conduit, who will be bidding to record back-to-back renewals in the Turf on Saturday and Zacinto, he added, "Conduit probably hasn't been quite at the same level as last year, but hopefully he's where we want him now. The Mile is not an easy race and you need a good draw and luck, but Zacinto's last run [when second in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S.] was a massive effort--Rip Van Winkle is as good a miler that has been around for the last few years and we gave him a fright. Obviously, it's a big step up against Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) and Delegator (GB) (Dansili {GB}), but we'd like to think he's progressed a bit more and we've got to have a crack."
