"We'll discuss whether she will run in the Classic [Nov. 7 or the GI Ladies' Classic Friday, Nov. 6] as soon as

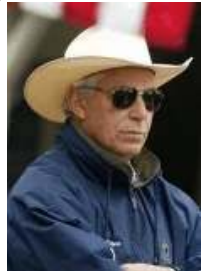

STARS OF TOMORROW, TAKE 1

The 2009 Fall Meet at Churchill Downs kicks off today with the Stars of Tomorrow I card, featuring 11 races for juveniles. **Dublin** (Afleet Alex), who hit the national radar with a sharp win in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. on Labor Day at Saratoga, saw his Breeders' Cup--and championship--hopes dashed when he was a flat fifth at 3-5 in the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Oct. 10. The chestnut colt has two solid works under the Twin Spires in the interim, and adds blinkers this time. "He has done very well since the Champagne," said Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I did not consider the Breeders' Cup with him, because I did not want to run him on the artificial [Pro-Ride surface at Santa Anita]." Lukas added, "He's my best two-year-old, and he may be one of the best in the country. Over the past few years, he ranks right with the best that I have had. I have been high on him since day one. He has a good pedigree and lots of ability." **Cont. p9**

Summer Bird Staying Busy

The Jayaramans' homebred **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) breezed five panels in :59.40 at Santa Anita yesterday.

"He galloped out strong," trainer Tim Ice said of his charge, who has notched wins in the GI Belmont S, GI Travers and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. "I got him [galloping out] in 1:12." Ice isn't too concerned with where the chestnut will be in the early stages of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic next Saturday.

"My horse will run accord-

ing to how the pace scenario sets up," Ice said. "He definitely can lay up close, and I also think he can be four or five [lengths] off of it. I think it's just a matter of seeing how the race sets up, let 'em break and see where you're at." Ice added, "If we can get a head start on them [into the stretch], I know we can kick away, and my colt, he doesn't stop until the wire comes. If they head him, he's going to have a lot of fight."

The Dirt on Mr. Sidney

Circle E Racing's **Mr. Sidney** (Storm Cat) drew into the \$2-million GI TVG Breeders' Cup Mile, but his connections are opting for the GI Dirt Mile on Santa Anita's Pro-Ride instead, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Though the five-year-old was not selected into the main body of that \$1-million race, a spot has opened up due to the defection of Sweet Hearth (Touch Gold), as well as Karelian (Bertrando), first on the preference list, headed to the Mile on grass. Mr. Sidney, who won the GI Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland in April, is coming off a third in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile over that course Oct. 10. The \$3.9-million KEESEP purchase has made just one appearance on an all-weather surface, finishing second by a half-length in a Keeneland allowance last October. "The turf mile looked extra deep," trainer Bill Mott told the *Form*. "Our horse actually handled the synthetic very good in his one race, and we just thought it made some sense to give it a try." Regular rider Kent Desormeaux will be in the irons. "Kent would be the first to tell you [that it was a] horrible ride; six-wide, overly confident thought we were going to win easy, we were second," owner Lee Einsidler told *DRF*. "We ran a '2' on the [Ragozin] sheets that day. If we run back to that race, that's a winning-type race in this race, we think."

Aikenite Drills at Belmont

Dogwood Stable's **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) tuned up for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile with a five-furlong drill in :59.94 on the Belmont training track yesterday morning. Jockey Alan Garcia was aboard for the bullet work, in which he bested stablemate Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) by :.01. "This was the colt's best work to date, as far as his enthusiasm goes," said Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "In the past, Aikenite has been rather lethargic as a workhorse, but he has become enthusiastic for

the task at hand, and has a spark that would indicate that he is coming up on a gangbuster race." Third in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga on Labor Day, the bay colt rallied from ninth to finish second by a half-length in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 10. The Todd Pletcher trainee is scheduled to fly out of New York Tuesday afternoon. "Aikenite has an easy-going character, and I expect him to handle the flight and his new surroundings with no problem," Campbell added. "He'll be able to gallop over Santa Anita's synthetic surface for several days, but we're not expecting any issues there, either."

CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN CO-OWNER DIES

Dr. Joseph Rauch, co-owner of GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hopeful Capt. Candyman Can (Candy Ride {Arg}) died suddenly Saturday at the age of 66, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Rauch, who also co-bred the three-year-old gelding, was the director of the urgent care department at Leesburg Regional Hospital near Ocala, Florida. "It was a shock for sure," trainer Ian Wilkes told the *DRF*. "I didn't know of any health problems that he had. From what I understand he died in his sleep. It's just hard to believe. You couldn't have a better owner. He loved knowing what was going on with his horses but wasn't the kind of owner who'd call you every day. We spoke about once a week. I was supposed to talk to him again tomorrow after Capt. Candyman Can had his final work for the Sprint." Winner of the GI NetJets King Bishop S. at Saratoga Aug. 29, the gelding was most recently runner-up to fellow Sprint aspirant Fatal Bullet (Red Bullet) in the GIII Phoenix S. at Keeneland Oct. 9. Wilkes told the *Form* that he would discuss Breeders' Cup plans with co-owner David Zell, but that he was inclined to go ahead and run because "that's what Dr. Rauch would have wanted."

Blame emerged as a three-year-old to watch with a determined allowance victory under the lights at Churchill July 2, then captured Saratoga's restricted Curlin S. Aug. 2 over Gone Astray (Dixie Union), who went on to win the GII Pennsylvania Derby and GII Ohio Derby in his next two. The Dilschneider/Claiborne homebred attempted to follow

"I had a perfect trip," said rider Jamie Theriot. "He was nice early, kind and relaxed. He's a push-button horse. Every time I call on him, he's there for me. Unbridled Belle dominated her rivals with an 11-length romp in the GIII Obeah H. at Delaware June 20. Third in the \$1-million GII Delaware H. July 19, the six-year-old put in one of the worst showings of her career when she faded badly to finish eighth, beaten 42 lengths, in the GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga Aug. 30. Trainer Todd Pletcher went over her and determined nothing was wrong, but took off her usual blinkers for the GI Beldame S. Oct. 3. The big mare led most of the way before settling for second to GI Breeder's Cup Ladies Classic hopeful Music Note (A.P. Indy), and there were no distaffers of that caliber here. The odds-on choice settled in fourth along the fence as Weathered showed the way through splits of :49.19 and 1:12.84, but loomed into contention under a confident Ramon Dominguez turning for home, and the race was pretty much over. "She gave me a good run and in the last eighth I just wrapped up on her," said Dominguez. Winning trainer Todd Pletcher added, "You always want to see them finish up their careers well. She's been so good to us for a number of years. It's nice to see her doing as well as she is at the moment. 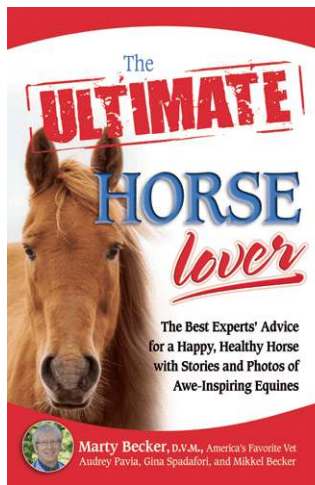



In a surprise announcement, Godolphin's head trainer Saeed bin Suroor said on Saturday morning that **Kirklees (Ire)** (Jade Robbery) would not be a starter in the A\$5.65-million race. Bin Suroor said he did not like the look of Kirklees when he saw the horse after the trainer arrived in Melbourne on Friday. "I'm not happy with how he is," bin Suroor told reporters at Sandown quarantine centre early Saturday. "He's not the same horse he was in England. We don't want to take a risk with him. We will take him back to Dubai. He will not be running in the Cup." The Godolphin conditioner did confirm that **Crime Scene (Ire)** (Royal Applause {GB}) would take his place in the field, and would be equipped with blinkers.

Efficient Out...Again...

The Lloyd Williams-owned pair **Efficient (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) and **Ziping (Aus)** (Danehill) will stay home at Macedon Lodge Tuesday with the high-profile owner ruling both out of the Melbourne Cup. Efficient has been scratched due to a long-term injury to his offside foreleg, and Ziping was withdrawn after being scratched at the barriers in the Mackinnon S. when cast. Williams told stewards that Efficient had not responded to ongoing treatment for a recurring leg injury, after saying Thursday that his stable staff were managing the problem. Bailey said that Williams told him he was "acting in the best interests of the horse. Mr. Williams's own vets said the horse could run and run well, but he felt in the best interests of the horse he wasn't prepared to take the risk," Bailey said. "As a result, Mr. Williams told me he would not be accepting with the horse. He said he was simply acting in the best interests of the horse." It's the second successive year that injury has forced Efficient from the Melbourne Cup. In 2008, he missed the Cup with an injury to his off-foreleg. Efficient was \$8 third favourite with TAB Sportsbet before he dropped out.

Casey Hospitalized With Bruised Liver:

Apprentice rider Amanda Casey will remain in North Shore University Hospital on Long Island for about a week as she recovers from a bruised liver. The injury was suffered Friday when she was kicked by her mount in the paddock prior to the start of the afternoon's final race. Casey, who had registered her first career victory earlier on the program, was taken by ambulance to North Shore and was admitted to the intensive care unit after being diagnosed with internal bleeding. "They chose not to do surgery, which is a good sign," said Casey's agent Joe Ceraulo Saturday morning. "They want to keep a close eye on her for a week. They said best-case scenario, she will probably be out from four to six weeks." Casey was accompanied to the hospital by a registered nurse from the New York Racing Association, Inc.'s Jockey Medical Advocate Program, which was implemented a year ago to assist both jockey and family members with medical and administrator matters in the event a rider is injured. "Having the nurse advocate there really moved the needle," said Ceraulo. "We were waiting a while for a bed to open, but everything else went very smoothly and quickly."

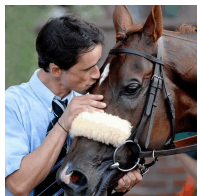
