THISKYHASNOLIMIT SOARS IN IROQUOIS

Thiskyhasnolimit (Sky Mesa) rallied from well back, hit the front in deep stretch and powered clear late to win the GIII Iroquois S. by an expanding one length over **Uh Oh Bango** (Top Hit) at Churchill Downs Sunday. SASSY IMAGE TAKES POCAHONTAS

Sassy Image (Broken Vow) kicked into another gear late and drove clear to a two-length victory in Sunday's GIII Pocahontas S. at Churchill Downs. The chestnut filly saved ground while racing near the back of a tightly bunched pack as **Tiz Miz Sue** (Tiznow) and **Vivid Colors** (Roman Ruler) took the field along through fractions of :22.46 and :45.66. Behind a wall of horses turning for home, Sassy Image waited for room

before splitting foes in upper stretch and spurting clear of longshot **All Due Respect** (Value Plus) in the dying strides as **Decelerator** (Dehere) closed for second. The win gave trainer Dale Romans his second straight Pocahontas victory, following Sara Louise's (Malibu Moon) win in 2008. "I think she'll run all day," said Romans, who trains Sassy Image for his brother Jerry Romans. JAN VERMEER WINS CRITERIUM

Jan Vermeer (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), a lightly regarded 28-1 longshot, exited the gates in alert fashion and soon established a two-length break on the field in yesterday's G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. Shaken up with 350 meters remaining, the Aidan O'Brien trainee was ridden clear inside the final furlong to easily defeat recent Godolphin acquisition **Emerald Commander (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) with authority and earned quotes as low as 10-1 for next June's G1 Epson Derby. *Cont. p2*

Godolphin Brigade On Track

Team Godolphin was out in force at pre-dawn yesterday at Santa Anita, with five of the stable's Breeders' Cup hopefuls turning in workouts. Working five furlongs: Sprint hopeful **Gayego** (Gilded Time) went in 1:00.80; **Girolamo** (A.P. Indy), pre-entered in the Classic and Dirt Mile, went in :59.20; Dirt Mile hopeful **Pyro** in 1:03.40; and Classic/Dirt Mile hopeful **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor) in :59.20. Dirt Mile entrant **Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song) went six furlongs in 1:13. He galloped out seven furlongs in 1:26 2/5. "Everything went according to plan," said Henry Spiller, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "I'm very happy with how they worked. Regal Ransom worked first. He went off a lot better today. He went off in :12 4/5 and galloped out in :59 1/5 and did it very much in hand. I'm very happy with him." Oak Tree clocker John Malone caught Regal Ransom in fractions of :13 1/5, :24 1/5, :35 3/5 and :47 4/5. Jockey Richard Migliore, who worked both Regal Ransom and Gayego, added, "Both couldn't be better. Regal Ransom was aggressive with me again, but as aggressive as he was, he was more reasonable today. Gayego is just a very happy horse."

Fourth on debut at The Curragh Sept. 12, Jan Vemeer shed his maiden status with victory at Gowran Park two weeks later. He provided trainer Aidan O'Brien with a second triumph in this event, following Mount Nelson (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) in 2006, by claiming a career high in this first black-type go. "We were worried about the ground before the race, because his last run was on good to firm," O'Brien told *Racing Post*. "That's it for this year--he appeared to have plenty of speed." Jockey Colm O'Donoghue added, "He won very easily and he must be very smart. We were always going well." Last month's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Rosanara raced in rear for most of the contest, but was unable to move within striking distance and claimed third nearing the line. Thiskyhasnolimit was eighth of 10 in the early going yesterday as Raging Wit (Distorted Humor) and Oh Charlie Boy (Canadian Frontier) dueled through early fractions of :22.81 and :46.26. Bridgmohan angled Thiskyhasnolimit to the outside for the drive and the dark bay colt surged to the front with a furlong to run. "He trained extremely well here coming into this race, and he put forth the kind of race we were expecting," commented winning trainer Steve Asmussen. Thiskyhasnolimit was a front-running seven-length maiden winner at Churchill July 4, but fared less well in New York graded company, running eighth in the Aug. 20 GII Saratoga Special and third, beaten 12 3/4 lengths in the Sept. 19 GII Futurity S. at Belmont. "Obviously, we were extremely disappointed with his previous two starts because we always had high hopes for him," Asmussen added. "He looks to appreciate the added distance. His next target will be the [Nov. 28] GII Kentucky Jockey Club on closing day." **Cont. p3**

Even-money favorite Dublin (Afleet Alex), winner of the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S., offered no rally and finished seventh. "He never got into the race like he normally does," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He usually just pulls himself into the race, but he didn't today. He's been training wonderful. We'll just step back and analyze him and see."



Sassy Image Takes Pocahontas (cont. from p1)

Dale Romans admitted he did have a few anxious moments as he watched Sassy Image turning for home in the Pocahontas. "You just don't know [what will happen] when you turn for home and you're down on the inside all boxed up like that," he explained. "Are they going to get through? I just thought if [jockey Robby Albarado] found a seam that she would kick through and she did." Romans said the Nov. 28 GI Golden Rod S. at Churchill would be next for Sassy Image. Jerry Romans was enjoying his biggest moment as a Thoroughbred owner. "I've got five horses with Dale, and she's by far the best," he said. "She's the best one I've ever had. These are once-in-a-lifetime types of horses, for me anyway. Not necessarily for Dale training-wise, but for us to own." Sassy Image's effort impressed jockey Robby Albarado. "The filly (Sassy Image) ran great," Albarado said. Dale gave me some instruction to keep her a little bit closer today, so I jumped her out a little earlier and got some forward position going down the backside. I was always very comfortable during the race and just had to find a place to get through. She found the spot up the rail and just went on without me really asking anything of her."

The consistent Criticism, winner of this race a year ago, has hit the board in eight of her last nine starts--all graded events. She was overtaken late by Pure Clan while running second in the Oct. 3 GI Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont last time out. Making the final start of her career, Criticism chased pacesetter Queen of Hearts (Thunder Gulch) through an opening quarter in :25.88. She took charge after a half-mile and gave her backers no anxious moments with a confident victory. "I wanted to just lay right off of [Queen of Hearts], but my filly was feeling so good today," winning rider Javier Castellano said. "She wanted to run, and I didn't want to fight her. I just let her go on to the lead and she really enjoyed the trip. The pace was very slow and that's why she won today. She had given me a good run the whole race and, turning for home, I wanted to be patient, and make the job a little easier." Winning trainer Tom Albertrani added, "I was very pleased with her race today. I was glad Javier got her to settle off the bridle--it looked like she was maybe on the bit too much the first three-eighths or so, and then when he made the lead with her it looked like he was able to really start controlling the race and he had plenty left." **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#) or the [brisnet.com PPs](#). Successful in the main event on this card last year, the G1 Criterium International, when trained by Paul Blockley, Zafisio had failed to add to that banner achievement in four subsequent starts. He ran fifth in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud last November and returned for this campaign with a second in the May 10 G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen. Off the board in the June 7 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club next time, he was a last-out third in the Sept. 13 G3 Solonaway S. at The Curragh and relished the mud here to claim this prize. Stalking the leaders after the initial strides, Zafisio responded to pressure in the straight to lead approaching the final eighth and was ridden out in the closing stages to comfortably hold last-out conqueror Border Patrol. "That was excellent and we're very pleased," trainer Roger Curtis told *PA Sport*. "Zafisio has been in great nick and he just needs to have a decent cut in the ground. When he was beaten by Border Patrol at The Curragh last time it was sticky, but when he can really get into the ground he's a top-class performer. He quite likes Saint-Cloud and he quite likes Dominique Boeuf. He could run in in the Nov. 15 G3 Hessen Pokal at Frankfurt. **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#).**

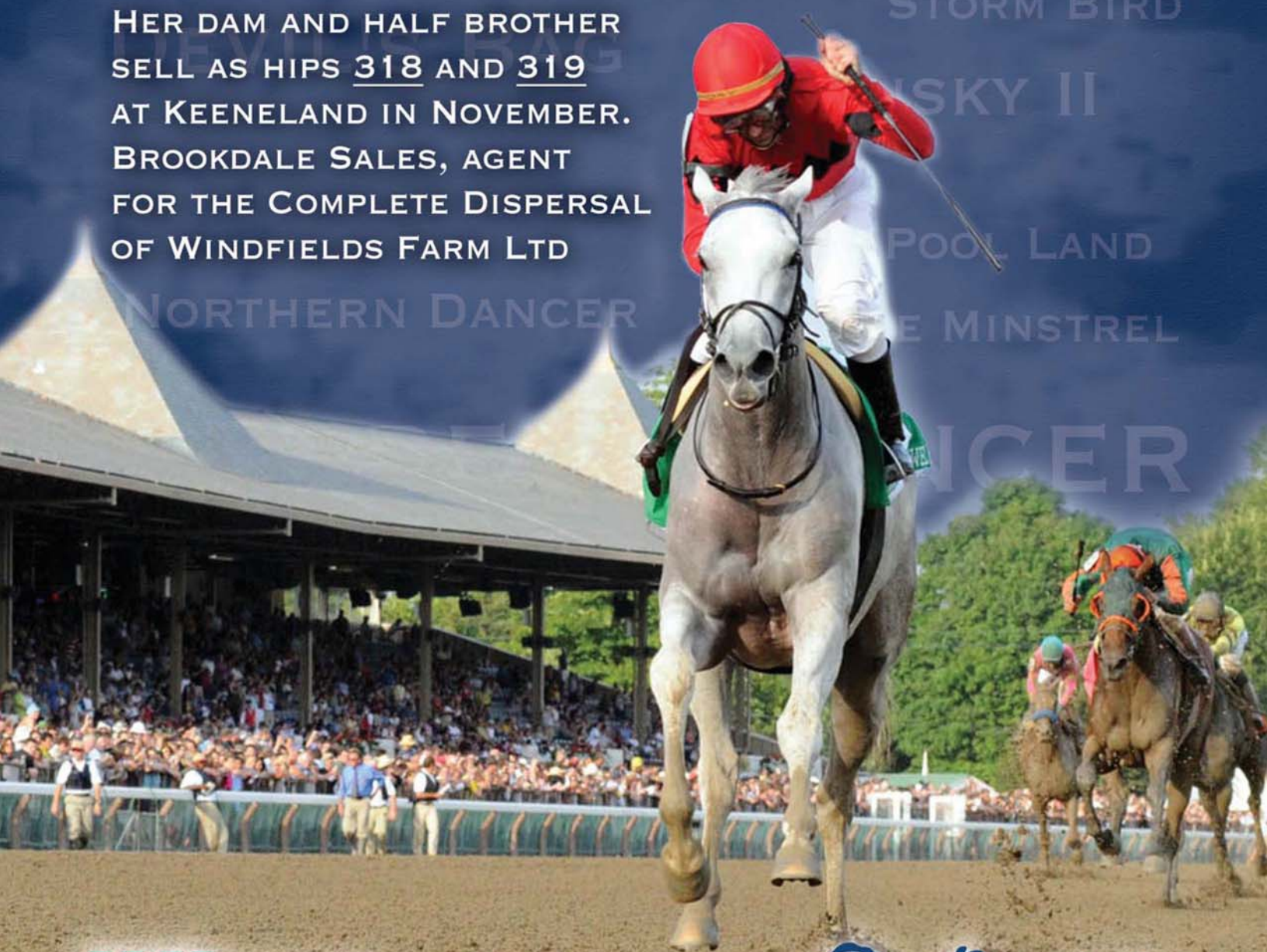


