DANCING SHOES TOPS KEENELAND FRIDAY

For the first time since the opening session of the sale, a horse not from the Overbrook consignment topped yesterday's fourth session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. **Dancing Shoes (Ire)** (Danehill), a nine-year-old mare in foal to Unbridled's Song, sold for \$400,000 to Horse France's Robert Nataf. Nataf confirmed he purchased the mare ([hip 1162](#)) on behalf of an Irish group that includes Paul Shanahan and Coolmore.

"She is going to Ireland and the idea is to have her covered by Galileo (Ire)," Nataf said. Dancing Shoe's three-year-old filly Striking Dancer (Smart Strike) will run in Saturday's GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill. The filly is coming off a 5 1/4-length win against Keeneland allowance company in October. "She was, to me, the best in the catalogue in terms of conformation, breeding and service, being in foal to Unbridled's Song," Nataf explained. Dancing Shoes was making a quick return to the Keeneland

sales ring. The mare, in foal to Mizzen Mast, was purchased by the Greathouse family's Glencrest Farm for \$140,000 in January. "We thought the market was a little light in January, so we thought if the money was right we'd take a shot with her," David Greathouse said of the decision to buy Dancing Shoes in January. "The sole reason to buy her was to resell her this year." Greathouse added that he had been impressed by Striking Dancer's maiden victory at Churchill last November. After that win, Striking Dancer finished second behind War Tigress (War Chant) in the Caressing H. at Churchill, but she went to the sidelines after an allowance victory over the Gulfstream lawn in February. "Striking Dancer had a chip in her ankle after her win at Gulfstream, but fortunately for us she came back and won again before the sale," Greathouse said. When Glencrest purchased Dancing Shoes, the mare was in foal to Mizzen Mast; she sold yesterday in foal to Unbridled's Song. "We just really thought she was really that good," Greathouse said of the decision to breed Dancing Shoes back to the more fashionable stallion. "It was between Smart Strike and Unbridled's Song. I can't even tell you how we decided on Unbridled's Song. I think Unbridled's Song had a whole lot of good horses at the time I made the decision."

Bob Feld Has an Affair...**

Bloodstock agent Bob Feld, sitting front and center in the sales pavilion with an associate, turned back all challengers to land the day's second-highest-priced mare, the four-year-old mare **Vienna Affair (GB)** (Red Ransom--Wiener Wald, by Woodman). Feld, representing client Kevin Plank's Sagamore Farm, paid \$380,000 for Vienna Affair, who was offered by Damian and Braxton Lynch's Royal Oak Farm as hip [1076](#).

Vienna Affair was bred to both Rahy and Sky Mesa this spring, and is believed to be in foal to the latter.

"They said it was Sky Mesa, because Rahy didn't get any in foal last year," said Feld. "But they didn't test, and I suppose there's still an outside chance she could be the only mare in foal to Rahy. Nothing against Sky Mesa, but it would be kind of cool if we had the only mare in foal to Rahy right now."

Feld said that he had a budget of \$400,000 for Sagamore, and came in just under to land his lone purchase for the Maryland-based farm at Keeneland November. He selected the mare along with Sagamore's farm manager Tom Mullikin.

Vienna Affair hails from the extended family of Storm Cat, as her third dam is Terlingua, who produced Overbrook's star stallion. Her appeal had just as much to do with her immediate relations, however, as she is a half to three stakes horses, including last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner Crowded House (GB) (Rainbow Quest) and SW & GSP On Reflection (GB) (Rainbow Quest). She is also a three-parts sister to Argent du Bois (Silver Hawk), dam of G1 American Oaks winner Ticker Tape (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}).

Despite a pedigree that leans toward the spinach, and the fact that the Feld/Sagamore collaboration Shared Account (Pleasantly Perfect) was a Grade II winner on the green this season, Sagamore is not targeting turf families, said Feld.

"I mean, we don't mind grass," he said. "But like anyone else, Kevin would like to win a Kentucky Derby someday. We're just aiming for the best pedigree we can find for the money. Terlingua's the third dam, and it's a great family. We're really happy to have her."

Sagamore, based on the land and retaining the name of Alfred G. Vanderbilt's storied operation, currently has about nine broodmares, Feld estimates.

"We're still growing," he added. "When we started the project [in 2007], we said we'd take it in small steps. But I think we've come a long way with the numbers we have, with Shared Account winning a Grade II and placing in a Grade I."

Shared Account, purchased by Feld for \$170,000 at the 2007 September Sale, won Saratoga's GII Lake Placid S. over the summer and was runner-up in both the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. and GI Garden City Breeders' Cup S. Sagamore's Kevin Plank is the CEO of Under Armour. -LM

**Sanibel Island Brings \$350,000...**

Steven Nicholson, bidding on behalf of a partnership which includes Hargus and Sandra Sexton, acquired the 11-year-old mare **Sanibel Island** (Capote) ([hip 997](#)) for \$350,000 Friday at Keeneland. The bay mare, part of the Overbrook Farm dispersal, is in foal to Macho Uno. She is the dam of graded stakes placed Island Warrior (Cherokee Run). "She's got a great pedigree," explained Nicholson. "She's already proven herself as a stakes-producing mare." Sanibel Island is out of Overbrook champion Flanders (Seeking the Gold) and is a three-quarter sister to champion Surfside (Seattle Slew). She was followed into the ring by her weanling colt by Street Cry (Ire), who brought \$50,000 to the bid of Black Stone Farm. Her yearling colt by Distorted Humor attracted a final bid of \$350,000 at Keeneland September. "I think there is a lot coming with her with the Distorted Humor and the Street Cry," Nicholson explained. "It's probably not the best-looking Street Cry we've seen, but the \$350,000 for the Distorted Humor is good." Nicholson admitted that, with all the competition for Overbrook mares, he thought he had found a bargain. "With the way the Overbrook mares have been selling, they've been selling pretty well, so I think we got a good price," he said. Sanibel Island will head to the Sexton's Oak Crest Farm in Versailles.

**KatieRich Strikes for Two on Friday...**

Mark Hubley, the representative jack-of-all-trades for KatieRich Farms, added two mares to the young operation's fold yesterday when purchasing hip [1072](#), the six-year-old mare **Unkatzable** (A.P. Indy--Katz Me If You Can), for \$340,000; and hip [1156](#), the 10-year-old **Daisyago** (Affirmed--Ladyago), for \$130,000. Earlier in the sale, Hubley had also purchased hip [385](#), the 13-year-old **Byzantine** (Quiet American--Regent's Fancy), for \$250,000.

"I thought, for the mares available today, she was one of the better ones," Hubley said of Unkatzable shortly after signing the ticket for the co fourth-highest-priced mare Friday. "I've been shut out on a few. It was more than I wanted to spend, but she has a lot of upside. She's young, and it's not easy to get these kinds of mares. She's not a real big mare; I would have liked to see her have a little more size. But she's nice."

A three-time winner, Unkatzable sold in foal to Yes It's True and is a daughter of MGSW Katz Me If You Can. That mare brought \$510,000 during Thursday's third session. Unkatzable is a half-sister to Country Romance (Saint Ballado), who was knocked down for \$280,000 Thursday. All three were consigned by Eaton Sales for the complete dispersal of Overbrook Farm.

Gardens Glen Farm consigned the aforementioned GSP Daisyago, who sold in foal to *Belong to Me*. Eaton Sales, agent for Elkhorn Creek Farm LLC, offered *Byzantine*, in foal to *Pulpit*.

KatieRich is the nom de course of the New York City-based Larry Doyle, who is president, CEO, and co-founder of Kinetics Asset Management, a money-market operation. In January of 2008, Doyle, who has had a limited role in the industry for some two decades, stepped up his game when he purchased 330 acres of farmland near Midway for a reported \$6 million. He and Hubley have been building up KatieRich since.

Mark Hubley has been Doyle's longtime trainer, and has now assumed the role of general manager of KatieRich, as well. The farm is named after Doyle's two children.

Asked if KatieRich is a commercial or breed-to-race operation, Hubley said, "I don't know what we are. Larry's a pretty impulsive guy. But I imagine we'll be commercial with this mare [Unkatzable]."

Hubley, who trains a handful of horses at the Paris Pike Training Center, said Doyle currently has about 10 mares. -LM

**Nardelli Sibs Quick Off the Blocks With Tiznow Colt...**

The brother-and-sister team of Kim and Rodney Nardelli got their Keeneland November off to a fast start when their first horse to sell, a strapping Tiznow colt catalogued as hip 963, was knocked down for \$250,000. Pinhooker Brian Graves signed the ticket as BG Stables for the youngster, the second-highest price for a weanling on the day. The Nardellis sold the colt through there Nardelli Sales consignment, and also co-bred the dark bay in partnership with Thomas Lander IV and Adam Ainspan.

"He's a good colt," Kim Nardelli, deep into the Keeneland property back in Barn 46, said afterwards. "He scoped well, and he's by a good sire. We're friends with the WinStar guys, and breed a lot of mares to their stallions." Cont. p5

The Nardellis' involvement with the colt's dam, the Cherokee Run mare Pnut Butter Cookie, dates back to 2005. They purchased the then-three-year-old for \$37,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky February Sale.

"We bought her as a racing prospect for a small racing partnership we had," Kim explained.

Pnut Butter Cookie made just one start for the partnership, and while she didn't pan out on the track, the Nardellis liked her enough to buy out some of the partners to the tune of \$57,000 when Pnut Butter Cookie was put back through the Kentucky February Sale in 2006.

"Some of the partners were bought out, and some others were added," Kim reported.

Sent to Indian Charlie in his first year at stud, she produced the filly Red Sierra, who made \$50,000 at last year's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky October Sale. Red Sierra, now two, has not yet started.

Pnut Butter Cookie's second foal, a filly by Suave, was bought back for \$37,000 as a yearling this past September, and while her first two foals failed to light up the sales board, her third would prove the charm.

The Nardellis sent two other weanlings through the ring yesterday that they bred or bred in partnership: [972](#), a Stormy Atlantic--Princess Sequoia colt, went to Walnut Hill Stables for \$85,000; and hip [1286](#), a Malibu Moon--Listen filly who went to Alistair Roden Bloodstock for \$160,000.

Hip [1216](#), a Touch Gold--French Madam weanling colt, which the Nardellis consigned on behalf of Up the Creek Bloodstock LLC, was bought back for \$57,000.

The Nardellis were raised in North Carolina and grew up with show horses and hunter/jumpers. In the early 1990s, they began making trips to Kentucky, buying weanlings, then pinhooking them back as yearlings. In 1996, they made the decision to move to the Bluegrass, and two years later purchased a 250-acre property which they still own today.

"We just loved the industry," Kim said of the decision to move tack to Kentucky.

Since then, the Nardellis have built up an 80-strong broodmare at the farm, of which they own about half.

"Most of our mares we own by ourselves, but we have partners on a few," Kim said, who added that they consign pretty much only horses they've raised at the farm. "We just sell our own horses and we do sell horses for our year-round clients, but we don't solicit horses for the consignment."

Asked why they decided to offer the Tiznow colt as a weanling, Kim explained, "The past few years, we've been offering our whole foal crop as weanlings. It's less expensive for us, there's less time raising them, and there are more buyers."

In addition to raising and selling, the Nardellis also keep themselves busy with other facets of the industry.

"We still do some weanling pinkooks, we'll break a handful of horses at the farm, and we'll race a few for ourselves," Kim explained. "We'll do some lay-ups--not a lot, but a few for our clients." -LM

**Keeping it Real at Keeneland..**

While the final session of Book 2 didn't present the fireworks seen earlier in the week at Keeneland, officials were please with the trade observed Friday.

"It was a lot more consistent with a lot more American participation in the mares than I thought there would be," said Goeffrey Russell, director of sales at Keeneland. "It was also a lot more spread out with the horses being spread out over more buyers. That is always a healthy sign."

Among the most impressive figures of the session was the dramatic drop in the RNA rate from last term. This year's percentage of 18.94 fell from 35.16 percent in 2008, registering a dramatic drop of 46.13 percent.

"The people have come to this market understanding where we are in the market," said Russell. "I also think consignors appraised their horses very well and a lot of credit goes to them in their appraisals."

Friday's fourth session grossed \$20,399,700 for 244 head sold, up from \$16,556,000 for 201 sold in 2008. Average rose to \$83,605 from \$82,368 last term, while median for the session dipped to \$65,000 from \$60,000 one year ago. Through four days, the gross fell from \$131,281,000 to \$118,884,200 this year and average dropped to \$150,296 from \$181,327 in 2008. This year, median dipped to \$95,000 from \$100,000.

"There is a sense of realism here and people know where they are and they have more of a comfort level because they know what to expect," added Russell.

## FOREIGN APPEAL

Throughout the current selling sales season, the economy has left much to be desired on the domestic front. However, Keeneland and Fasig-Tipton received a much-needed shot in the arm with convergence of a strong cast of international buyers in Lexington this week. In evidence at both venues were representatives from a number of regions, including Australia, Europe, Japan, South America and Russia. Both Keeneland and Fasig-Tipton have expanded promotional foreign programs in recent years, and have both reaped the rewards of their extensive efforts.

"Foreign buyers are consistently 25-30 percent of our business in any given sale," said Chauncey Morris, Keeneland's sales marketing director. "Australia is particularly sweet, because we have been working diligently on that continent for three years. Our efforts to reach out to our international buying bench is something that we do 12 months out of every year."

Explaining the advantages of expanding the international buyers base, Robert Nataf of Horse France said,

"The good news is that Keeneland is opening itself up to new buyers; you have Turks, Azerbician, Russian, Israeli, the Japanese came in force, before it was merely restricted to big European and big American interests," Nataf explained. "In a way it is a good. In a way it looks like we could be at Tattersalls with a very cosmopolitan clientele."

Among those buyers who have made their presence felt at Keeneland this week is Sydney-based Vin Cox, who interned with Keeneland in the early '90s, then returned to Australia after that stint to develop his bloodstock agency. Active as a buyer at Keeneland since 1997, Cox purchased a pair of mares during the opening session, including SW Tears I Cry (Chester House) for \$735,000. During yesterday's session, the Australian paid \$245,000 for Sherine (Precise End).

"That which has surprised me is the level at which Australians have been buying," Cox admitted. "They bought Black Mamba (NZ) (Black Minnaloushe) for \$1.5 million [purchased by Evergreen Stables Farm at Fasig-Tipton November Tuesday]. In the past we may have had a dozen people, this year it's more like 40. To the point where some people have complained that there too many Australians here. We do tend to fall on the same horses, which is obvious."

## The Price is Right...

While the strength of international currency versus the U.S. dollar is very important, Morris is quick to point out that it is not the only factor at work in the American Thoroughbred marketplace.

"When horse people are concerned, when the exchange rate is in your favor, it just allows you to buy more horse, it doesn't necessarily make the decision as to whether or not you are going to get on a plane," said Morris. "It allows you to spend more money that you otherwise would have." Those who decided to take advantage of a weak American dollar and did get on a plane to Lexington obviously pleased local consignors with their increased support. Among the operations selling this week was Meg Levy of Bluewater Sales. "We're so glad to see that the Australian currency is getting stronger," said Levy. "There is definitely more foreign buying interests than I have ever seen here. It's just fabulous. I really think they are helping support the market. There has been quite a bit of Australian and Japanese activity, in particular. We've seen some Europeans, but many more Australians and Japanese than in the past." **Cont. p8**

Cox indicated that his number of purchases this year have roughly stayed the same as last year, however, that was not necessarily the case with other Australian buyers, who also sought to take advantage of the increased strength in the Australian dollar versus its U.S. counterpart. He admits that he has sought to improve the quality of stock that would be returned to Australia, while it was evident that others have attempted to increase the number of their broodmare and young stock.

“The strength of the Australian dollar is a huge factor,” said Cox, explaining the influx. “We are fifty percent better than we were last year. We were at 63 cents [to the U.S. dollar] last year and this year and now it’s 93 cents. That is a significant move for us and it allows us to get into

pedigrees and bloodlines that had previously been out of our reach.”

Despite the obvious benefits of increased international buying, Nataf indicated that it often leaves a void in the market place down the road.

“The exchange rate has been strong [internationally] for the last few years, and the Europeans have bought a lot of good mares in the U.S. Unfortunately, those good mares are not showing up in the current catalogues.”

And despite the woes of the American economy, other international markets have failed to reach similar lows.

“Our market is off, but it wasn’t a significant drop. There is relative confidence around. It’s not going to be gangbusters by any stretch of the imagination this year, but it will probably be in line with where we were last year. Even in September, it was staggering in the difference between the confidence between Australia and the United States. Over here, everyone was quite down with where the industry was here, whereas in Australia, it was quite the opposite. We had a good racing product and it’s well funded. There are things we have to improve in Australia, but we are certainly in a good position.”--CB

**ONE MORE FOR THE DON?**

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has been the Don of this contest since the turn of the century--with three wins and four seconds--and he saddles a sturdy team of three for this season's renewal, Europe's final Group One contest of the year. **Don Carlos**, the choice of stable number one Johnny Murtagh, ran third on debut at Cork Oct. 17 before breaking through at Leopardstown nine days later. He enjoys a similar profile to the G1 Irish Derby winner Soldier of Fortune (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who finished second here in 2006 after winning his maiden at the second attempt. Fellow Ballydoyle incumbent **Mikhail Glinka** lines up off a success in the rescheduled Listed Eyrefield S. at Leopardstown Nov. 5, where stablemate **Banyan Tree** finished fourth.

Godolphin's beige colors will also be on display and are to be carried by the unbeaten **Simon de Montfort**. The Andre Fabre trainee took out a one-mile maiden at Chantilly Oct. 6 and retained his perfect record, going a panel further, with an impressive three-length score in a Longchamp conditions event last time Oct. 25.

"The Cigar Mile is a possibility. Obviously, we would need everything to go perfectly between now and then, but he is under consideration. [Former NYRA starter] Bob Duncan will start working with him Wednesday morning."

## Indian Blessing to Zensational...

Owners Hal and Patti Earnhardt have announced that their champion **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie) has officially been retired from racing and will visit Eclipse Award candidate Zensational (Unbridled's Song) in his first year at stud in 2010. "The reason we are breeding Indian Blessing to Zensational is to come up with the perfect thoroughbred," said Hall of Fame Trainer Bob Baffert. "They were both unbelievable on the racetrack with perfect conformation and exceptional brilliance. We are all after the super horse and I was blessed to train both of them." The Earnhardts bred Indian Blessing from Shameful (Flying Chevron), and she made an immediate and smashing impression, winning each of her three juvenile starts capped by a front-running success over Proud Spell (Proud Citizen) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. A seven-length winner of the GI Test S. and GI La Brea S. at three, she was crowned champion female sprinter in 2008. Runner-up in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen S. this past March, she closed her career on a winning note in the GI Gallant Bloom H. at Belmont Park. She retired with a record of 16-10-5-0 and earnings of \$2,995,420.

**Dominguez Passes Cordero in NYRA Yearly Wins:**

While the record 433 wins on the New York circuit recorded by Steve Cauthen in 1977 is likely out of reach, jockey Ramon Dominguez registered his 341<sup>st</sup> victory at NYRA facilities yesterday, passing Angel Cordero Jr. to take second position on that list. "I'm very happy that I have been able to do so well in New York," Dominguez said. "Like I always say, it's nothing but a reflection of the type of horses that I ride and the support that I get from horsemen and owners. It's overwhelming, especially with such a colony of great riders here." Just four riders have booted home as many as 300 winners in a single season at Belmont, Saratoga and Aqueduct combined. Cordero rode 340 winners in 1982 and 309 the following season, while fellow Hall of Famer Mike Smith scored with 330 mounts in 1991 and 313 two years later. In 2006, jockey Eibar Coa rode 303 winners. Earlier this season, Dominguez broke another record previously held by Cordero when he visited the winner's circle 98 times at the spring/summer meeting at Belmont Park.

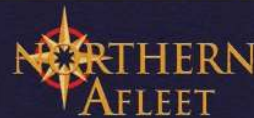

With seven wins from 54 rides (entering Friday's races), he has already equaled his victory total from the spring stand, when he had a total of 100 mounts. "Everything is better," Goncalves, 27, commented on the difference between the two meets. "I am getting on better horses and more people are watching me ride." Goncalves won the riding title at the Turfway meet in September and was aboard six winners at Keeneland, good for a tie for eighth. He also recorded his first graded stakes winner, guiding Satans Quick Chick (Sky Mesa) to score an upset in the GII Lexus Raven Run S. Oct. 24. According his agent Steve Elzey, Goncalves will ride the month of December back at Turfway Park before joining the jockey colony at Oaklawn Park.

"The Board felt that, based on their knowledge of the programs and benefits provided by the CTT, it was in the best interests of the membership to take the necessary steps to ensure that the California Thoroughbred Trainers organization remains the official representative of all thoroughbred trainers in the state and to avoid such a campaign." Some Board members plan to run for re-election in January, others remain undecided.


