

STARS ON TOP AT CARTIER AWARDS

The debate as to who will be named the top performer at the Eclipse Awards will continue into the new year, but there's no controversy on the other side of

the Atlantic. Christopher Tsui's **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) was yesterday handed the accolade he had long since made a formality when named the Horse of the Year at the 2009 Cartier Awards. At the latest ceremony, staged at Claridge's Hotel in Mayfair, London, the his-

torical feats achieved by the John Oxx-trained homebred were celebrated as he scooped the title of champion three-year-old colt alongside the main honor. As he had on the racecourse, the bay son of the legendary Urban Sea (Miswaki) left his title rivals in his wake in the points-and-vote system, sweeping the G1 2000 Guineas, G1 Epsom Derby, G1 Eclipse, G1 Juddmonte International, G1 Irish Champion and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Among those shortlisted for the top prize were Ballymacoll's G1 King George and Queen Elizabeth S. and G1 Breeders' Cup Turf hero **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) and Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 St James's Palace S. hero **Mastercraftsman (Ire)** (Danhill Dancer {Ire}); the latter received the two-year-old colt award in 2008.

All That Glitters Really is Gold...

The Wertheimer brothers's dual G1 Breeders' Cup Mile heroine **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) was also in line for the Horse of the Year award and, although unlucky to come up against Sea the Stars in that category, was justly handed the champion older horse award. The Freddy Head-trained four-year-old also won the G1 Falmouth S., G1 Prix Rothschild and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois prior to her dazzling display at Santa Anita.

G1 Cheveley Park S. winner **Special Duty (GB)** (Hennessy) was crowned champion two-year-old filly. Susan Magnier and Diane Nagle's **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who retired this year after a sensational fourth G1 Gold Cup success, was named champion stayer and, in so doing, became the first to win a Cartier Award four times. 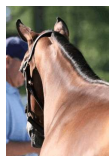

EMPIRE MAKER DAUGHTERS TOP EIGHTH

SESSION Trainer Bobby Frankel, who died Monday at the age of 68, received a fitting tribute yesterday during the eighth session of the Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington, with daughters of his protege Empire Maker sweeping the top three spots on the podium. Leading the session was racing or broodmare prospect Clear Sailing, who went to Larry Richardson, agent for Coteau Grove, for \$255,000. The three-year-old daughter of the 2003 GI Belmont S. winner is from the family of the sire Jump Start. Empire Maker was also represented by broodmares Passiflora and Ruby's Realm, who sold for \$180,000 and \$105,000, respectively. Both sophomore fillies were unraced. Keeneland continued to suffer across-the-board declines, with a modest improvement in the clearance rate serving as a bright spot. The November Sale continues through Sunday; sessions begin daily at 10 a.m. Full results and streaming video is available at www.Keeneland.com.

INTIKHAB COLT TOPS FOAL OPENER Yesterday's opening session of the Goffs November Foal Sale saw a son of Intikhab hold sway when selling to Redpender Stud for €33,000. Consigned by Caherhugh Farm Stud, Hip [216](#) is out of Poppys Footprint (Ire) (Titus Livius), a half-sister to listed winner Moyenne (Ire) (Trans Island {GB}). Buyer Jimmy Murphy said, "Intikhab is a sire I like, although I haven't been able to buy one over the last few years. This was a good colt, and I just thought that he fit the bill. He'll be back for sale again next autumn."

The Intikhab colt's pricetag topped the €26,000 paid by Mark Dwyer's Oaks Farm Stud for Abbey Leix Stud Farm's Hip [69](#), a colt by Acclamation (GB) whose dam Appleblossom Pearl (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) is a half-sister to the group-placed Godolphin performer Rabi (Ire) (Alzao). "He's a grand, straightforward type of horse," Dwyer commented. "If everything went the right way, he will hopefully be the type of horse that could go to Doncaster next year."

Of the fillies, Hip [47](#) was in demand, and that daughter of Kheylef from the draft of Mount Pleasant Farm was snapped up by Paula Flannery for €25,000. Her sire is also responsible for the recent G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte runner-up Ascot Glory (Ire), who features under the second dam. "It's a family that has been lucky for us before," explained Flannery, who achieved a smart return on the €16,000 paid for her yearling half-brother by Elusive City when selling at £90,000. "The Elusive City is with Richard Fahey, and he's there to run for the family next year, and the three-parts sister [Ascot Glory] is a good two-year-old in France. This filly will be back for resale next year."

Whitwell Bloodstock was the name on the docket for Ballybin Stud's Hip [135](#), a colt by Hawk Wing whose dam is listed winner Halicardia (GB) (Halling). "He's a good colt and he will be resold next autumn, either here or in Doncaster," commented Nicki Howarth after paying €20,000. "He's out of a good racemare and was just a very nice horse."

With the foal part of the November marathon trimmed from five days to four this year, comparative figures are not available, but the average of €6,808 was respectable, given the clearance rate of 42 percent. Selling continues tomorrow at 11 a.m. Full results can be found on www.goffs.com.

CHURCHILL TO HOST SIX NIGHT PROGRAMS IN 2010

Churchill Downs announced yesterday that it will host six night-racing programs in 2010. The Louisville racetrack averaged 29,705 patrons for its three "Downs After Dark" programs during this year's spring meet, and the strong attendance inspired officials to install permanent lights and offer more night racing in

2010. General admission to all "Downs After Dark" events will be \$10, with a pass for all six nights available for \$45. Customers may also buy a \$20 package that offers general admission, a box seat in the third-floor clubhouse and a pro-

gram. A "Date Night" dinner package that includes a reserved seat in Millionaires Row, a program and a buffet dinner is also available for \$59.90. This year, the track offered live music between races and food specials to create a "night club setting," and officials said patrons can expect more of the same in 2010. An evening card will kick off the fall meet, with opening day set for Halloween. In separate releases, Churchill announced that Musco Lighting was awarded the contract to install permanent lighting, and that admission for "Downs After Dark" and other ticket packages are available through its new online box office, <http://tickets.churchilldowns.com>.

Diabolical to New Mexico:

Internationally campaigned **Diabolical** (Artax--Bonnie Byerly, by Dayjur) has been sold to Fred Alexander's A&A Ranch in New Mexico, where he will stand at stud. His 2010 fee was not announced. The chestnut began his career racing in the United States for owners Puglisi Racing and Steve Klesaris, winning the 2007 GIII Maryland Sprint H. and GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H., having previously finished second in the GI De Francis Dash and GI Carter H. Sent abroad after he was acquired by Godolphin, Diabolical

cal won the 2008 G3 Mahab Al Shimaal S. and was third in this year's G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad Al Sheba. His best effort in Europe was a second in Ascot's 2008 G2 Diadem S. Runner-up in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint in his return to North America, he concluded his career with a sixth in the G1 Golden Jubilee at Royal Ascot June 20, retiring with a record of 31-9-8-4 and \$1,404,772 in earnings. "Diabolical was outstanding at two, a classic performer at three that stretched to a mile, and a top class older sprinter who raced on both dirt and turf and set track records over sprint distances," said Fred Alexander. "He has a great female line with plenty of class. What is more pleasing for me is that he is a gorgeous horse to look at."
