### THE 'MANE' ATTRACTION

It wasn't nearly as impressive as his tour-de-force maiden victory at Keeneland last month, but WinStar Farms's **American Lion** (Tiznow) got the job done with a workman-like performance in Saturday's GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Favored at 3-5 with jockey Julien Lejaroux in for the ride, he raced with the early leaders through fractions of :22.59 and :45.81. Under a ride on the turn for home in third, the handsome bay came with giant strides to hit the front in the stretch and was saved by the wire to hold the fast closing 20-1 **Get My Fix** (Posse) by a half-length.

"This horse is very sensible, but he's still unfocused," trainer Eoin Harty said. "Coming down the stretch he was flicking his ears and looking at everything. But there's plenty of time to correct that before Derby Day, if we get that far. At the three-eighths pole, I thought he was in trouble. It looked like he was under a ride and going nowhere. ### HOME 'FIELD' ADVANTAGE

Turtle Bird Stable's **Haynesfield** (Speightstown), a superstar over Aqueduct's inner strip last winter before the wheels came off in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 7, returned to the Big A with a dazzling performance in Saturday's GIII Discovery H. Backed as the third choice at 7-2, he sat a staking second as **Redding Colliery** (Mineshaft) cruised through fractions of :24.25 and :48.84. With Ramon Dominguez aboard, Haynesfield rallied in tandem with favored **Gone Astray** (Dixie Union) on the turn for home to inhale the pacesetter, and blew that one away in the stretch, scoring by 4 1/2 lengths over **Bad Action** (Brahms). The GII Pennsylvania Derby and GII Ohio Derby hero tired to third. Toby Sheets, assistant to winning trainer Steve Asmussen, said, "We thought that last year, but he was a little immature. He's definitely grown into himself. It's nice to have the privilege of a horse like this. No thoughts whatsoever as to what's next; we'll see how he comes out of it and go from there." Haynesfield reeled off runaway victories in Aqueduct's Damon Runyon S. Dec. 7, Count Fleet S. Jan. 3 and Whirlaway S. Feb. 7 before finishing a well-beaten eighth in the Gotham. Given plenty of time to recuperate from that effort, the chestnut resurfaced with a close second against Empirebreds in the six-furlong Sir Keys S. at Belmont Oct. 2. He entered off a victory in the nine-furlong Empire Classic S. Oct. 24. **Discovery chart p2**

Transferred to Eoin Harty, he couldn't have been anymore impressive in his second attempt at Keeneland, scoring by 6 3/4 lengths. Jockey Julien Leparoux has been aboard the WinStar colorbearer in each of his two wins. "This was a good learning experience for him," Leparoux commented. "He needs to learn more and he's still a big baby. That's good though, because he's still winning. When the other horse came up to him at the wire, he just took off again. It's not like he's

tired or anything. He's just a little green, but he's a nice horse."

**BON NUIT STARS AT GOFFS** Goffs' November Sale turned its attention to breeding stock yesterday, and it was the seven-year-old **Bon Nuit (Ire)** (Night Shift) gaining top billing when selling for €230,000. Successful once and placed five times at the listed level, the Howard Spooner-owned mare was consigned as [hip 1036E](#) as part of a supplementary draft from Ballincurrig House Stud. From the immediate family of sire Anshan (GB) (Persian Bold {Ire}), she was offered in foal to Pivotal (GB), and it was Goffs auctioneer Clive Gardner who prevailed with a bid of €230,000. Her sire Night Shift was also responsible for Roundhill Stud's eight-year-old **Comeraincomeshine (Ire)**, who sold for €160,000. She is a half-sister to the high-class miler Where or When (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), and has already produced this year's Listed Sandy Lane S. winner and G3 Fred Darling S. third Danehill Destiny (GB) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). In foal to Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill), she was snapped up by Newsells Park Stud. "She will be visiting their stallion Mount Nelson (GB) next year," agent Oliver St Lawrence explained. "Julian Dollar, who is here, and I loved her when we saw her, and she's a very attractive proposition. She's a good-looking mare whom Mount Nelson should put some size into, and she's already bred a stakes winner and has a Galileo to run for her next year." Tina Rau Bloodstock earlier paid €135,000 for Castletown Stud's 15-year-old **Indian Jewel (Ger)** (Local Suitor), in foal to One Cool Cat (Storm Cat). From a prolific black-type-producing German family, she is responsible for three such performers, including the Listed winner Irulan (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}). Forenaghts Stud was the name on the docket for a notable member of the Darley draft, the four-year-old **Queen's Hall (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}), carrying a foal by King's Best. **Cont. p6**

Out of the proven producer Anna Matrushka (GB) (Mill Reef), she is a full-sister to the smart Andean (GB), and half to a host of smart performers, including the 1996 G2 Prix de Royallieu and G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris winner Annaba (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}). "I've bought her for Tony Smurfit," explained Dermot Cantillon after paying €100,000. "He owned Princess Dansante (Ire), who was by King's Best and was the top-priced mare in Europe last year when she made 1.7-million guineas. This filly obviously ticked all the boxes, and she was sold in foal to King's Best, whom we're fans of." Darley's consignment was also responsible for the five-year-old **Dabawiyah (Ire)** (Intikhab), a daughter of the group scorer The Perfect Life (Ire) (Try My Best) from the family of Last Tycoon (Ire), who sold to Bobby Dunworth in foal to Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) for €95,000; as well as [hip 1025](#), the 17-year-old **Golden Digger** (Mr. Prospector), who is carrying a half by Invincible Spirit (Ire) to the triple Group 3 winner and 2001 G1 National S. runner-up Naheef (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) and was knocked down to MAB Agency for €85,000; and [hip 970](#), four-year-old **HMS Pinafore (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}). A half-sister to the group-winning Silver Touch (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) selling in foal to Exceed and Excel (Aus), she went to McKeever St Lawrence for €67,000. The daughter of Blandford Stud's Padraig Campion, 22-year-old Sarah Campion has spent nearly her entire life around horses at the family's operation. But the University of Kentucky student celebrated a first this week, signing for a horse as a bloodstock agent. Campion went to \$50,000 for [hip 3525](#), a colt from the first crop of champion Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even).

"He had a great look about him," Campion said yesterday, the strains of the Keeneland auctioneers in the background. "He had a nice walk, physically he was a nice horse. He was quite a standout for the book he was in and he had a great way about him--a very classy-looking colt. I spent a little more than I wanted to, but the underbidders were some very good horsemen and it was nice to know that there were some good, trained eyes on him. That made me feel good about it."

Given the prevailing market conditions, one might find it enterprising to attempt to make inroads. But not for Campion, who sees it as a logical progression.

"It's really the only thing that I am passionate about," she admitted. "My mom and dad are both from Ireland and came to America to work with horses. I wasn't old enough to know a time like this before where it was so hard, but I am very optimistic that it will turn around."

"You're seeing trends where quality is selling. I believe that it will turn around. [Blandford Stud] had a very good year this year. We had some good-quality stock, and we did well with them. It's really more of an issue with the lesser-quality stock, and in all fairness, no matter what kind of economy it is, if it's not a nice horse, it shouldn't be bringing money. There's still going to be a Breeders' Cup next year and an Arc and the Derby, and as long as we can get people to be passionate about the sport and keep it going, I've got a lot of faith."

Shortly after the turn of the calendar, Campion will take something of a sabbatical from her university studies to take part in an internship program put on by the Irish National Stud. **Cont. p8**

"It's a six-month program to get good experience abroad and I'll try to take in as much as I can while I'm young," Champion explained. "My parents both did the internship. You work on Stud during the day and take classes and lectures at night. It's a great way of meeting people and making connections and hopefully learning a lot."

And as for her purchase this week?

"We will pinhook him," Champion confirmed. "He's at our farm in Paris. This is the first time I've signed a ticket as an agent. We'll keep and prep and bring him back for the September sale, fingers crossed, and try to make a profit. He'll be offered under the Blandford banner."

In her brief time in the business, Champion has acquired a lot of knowledge she hopes will help her down the line.

"I have learned that it's a very tough game," she stated. "You need a lot of luck, but it's fun to hit that big horse, that big resale or winning races. It's all very exciting. There's good years and bad years, but it's all great. Growing up on the farm, I was part of all the day-to-day activities, watching foals from the night they were born and then taking them to the sale next year. 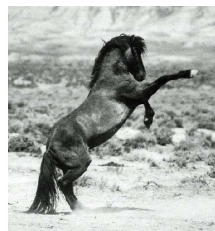
