TATTERSALLS DECEMBER FOAL BEGINS

Tattersalls' December Foal Sale kicks off in Newmarket this morning with 950 lots catalogued, the smallest number at the auction since 2001. This year's Foal Sale--running through Saturday--is 311 lots lighter than last year's, and is also a day shorter. The sale, which begins at 10 a.m. each morning, is graded, with today's session expected to be the quietest day. The standard of foal steps up a level tomorrow, and the best lots are set to appear on the final two days, particularly Friday. For the complete catalog visit www.tattersalls.com.

Potential standouts include [Lot 751](#), an Oasis Dream (GB) colt who is the first foal of 2006 G1 1000 Guineas heroine Speciosa (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). Offered from Trickle-down Stud, the colt is bred by Speciosa's ownership partnership, headed by her trainer Pam Sly. [Lot 867](#) is a Hurricane Run (Ire) half-sister to G2 Debutante S. and Tattersalls sales race winner Lillie Langtry (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) offered from Ballinahown Stud. [Lot 802](#) has already appeared at Tattersalls once this year. A Bahamian Bounty (GB) filly, she was sold with her dam Ripples Maid (GB) (Dansili {GB}) for 132,000gns to agent David Redvers at Tattersalls in July in the late Rex Mead's dispersal. [Lot 840](#), bred by John and Bernadette Hayden and consigned from Rosetown House Stud, is a full-sister to G1 Darley July Cup heroine Fleeting Spirit (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), winner of the Cartier Sprinter Award last week. Montjeu (Ire) has only two lots catalogued, including [Lot 1019](#), a three-parts brother to G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud runner-up Mikhail Glinka (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), and Monday's 275,000gns December Yearling Sale top lot.

Among the higher-priced first-crop sires with foals on offer are multiple Group 1 winners Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill) (who stood for €50,000 in 2008), Manduro (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) (€40,000) and Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) (€40,000). The latter's offerings include [lot 1171](#), a sibling to GI E.P. Taylor S. winner Folk Opera (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}), offered from Moorpark Stud. "It may be a smaller catalogue than in recent years, but it's a quality one," commented Tattersalls Marketing Director Jimmy George. "All the current active top 20 sires in Britain and Ireland are represented, and the strength of our October Yearling Sales has engendered a feeling of cautious optimism."

MUNNINGS UNLIKELY FOR CIGAR MILE

Munnings (Speightstown) will likely miss the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. with an undisclosed foot problem, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Winner of the GI Woody Stephens S. and GI Tom Fool H. at Belmont this spring, the sophomore has not been able to work out in preparation for Saturday's race at Aqueduct. Trainer Todd Pletcher said that if Munnings was not able to breeze yesterday, he was not optimistic the chestnut would be ready for the Cigar Mile. If he misses Saturday's race, the **"TDN Rising Star"** will be pointed toward sprint races at Gulfstream Park. Munnings was third in the GI Vosburgh S. Oct. 3 in his most recent effort. Pletcher's other top three-year-old, GI Florida Derby winner **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality), remains on course for the Cigar Mile following another gate schooling session at Belmont yesterday.

Beginner's Luck...

It is only six years since Seamus Kennedy became involved in the bloodstock business but now--with business partner Michael Woodlock--he owns one of those mares every breeder dreams about having. Diary (Ire) (Green Desert) was sold for 7,000gns as a two-year-old by Darley and went on to win three races in Greece. Returning to the 2005 Tattersalls February Sale, she was picked up by Kennedy for just 11,000gns. "It was both the pedigree and the individual that appealed to me and I just got that crazy feeling when I saw her," recalled Kennedy. Now 10, the mare was sent to Namid (GB) by her new owners and the resultant colt--Total Gallery (Ire)--has proved a great flagbearer for her breeders, who race as Coleman Bloodstock. The three-year-old was trained by Stan Moore to win the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp on Arc day, and is set to run in Hong Kong next month. "He's going really well at the moment, and he'll hopefully win out there," added Kennedy. But Diary (Ire) has been no one-hit wonder. Her next foal is two-year-old Lady Darshaan (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}), who finished third in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket in July, and looks a leading Classic contender for next year after coming second in the G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September. "We've had a phenomenal year, and Diary has a High Chaparral (Ire) yearling colt, who is with Stan and giving all the signs of being special," Kennedy said. Kennedy's immediate concerns surround events at Park Paddocks this week, with six foals set to be offered from Shanaville Stables Friday and Saturday. They are headed by [lot 882](#), the latest foal from Diary (Ire), an own-sister to Lady Darshaan (Ire). "She's a really lovely looking filly and it's just worked out that we have our best bunch of foals this year," Kennedy continued. Diary (Ire) is in foal to Tamayuz (GB) this year. "It's great to have worked my way up since starting out at the bottom," he added. "The focus is now very much on quality rather than numbers with the mares."

Ring in the New...

Former Trafalgar House chief executive Sir Eric Parker purchased Crimbourne Stud in 1991, the year that Seagram (NZ) carried his colours to victory in the Grand National chase, and set about assembling a quality broodmare band on the 130-acre estate. The West Sussex stud is sending six foals to Park Paddocks this week, and stud manager Peter Naughton believes that the pick of the draft is a pair of youngsters by prominent first-season Darley stallions.

"The Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo) colt and the Authorized (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) filly are our trump cards," commented Naughton. "We have a total of three foals by first season sires in Authorized, Teofilo and Rail Link (GB) (Dansili), and I am sure, the way these things go, that not all of them will prove to be fashionable. It can be very hard for the first-season sires to get the thumbs-up from pinhookers. The bloodstock market can often take against a stallion quite easily." **Cont. p3**

'Ring in the New' cont...

Of particular interest is [lot 1185](#), the filly by 2007 Derby winner Authorized, who is out of the successful Crimbourne Stud mare Coyote (GB) (Indian Ridge). The well-bred mare was acquired for 150,000gns at the 2003 Tattersalls December Sale. The filly is a half-sister to a pair of stakes winners, notably this season's G3 Park Express S. heroine Oh Goodness Me (GB) (Galileo), catalogued as [lot 1390](#) in the Tattersalls December Sale. Remarked Naughton, "We have just been a bit unfortunate with Coyote's foals in the past two years. The year before last she had a really nice Azamour (Ire) (Night Shift) colt, Huff And Puff (GB). The fashion wasn't that keen on that sire by the time Newmarket came, but he looks like he could be up to listed or group class next season. This year she had a Medicean (GB) (Machiavellian) yearling filly, and that stallion had a poor year, too, so she sold for 105,000gns at Tattersalls in October, which was less than we had hoped. You would think that Authorized would be a popular sire. As you see with a lot of the yearlings this year, bigger pinhookers are buying horses by Darley stallions to sell on again as breeze-up horses, because the Darley contingent were the main breeze-up buyers last year. So, hopefully, people will be thinking this time that if they buy an Authorized foal, they should be able to sell it on again. And with a foal of Coyote's, you are not just buying a racehorse, you are also buying a broodmare."

Coyote, whose dam Caramba (GB) (Belmez) won the G2 Nassau S., was catalogued to be sold at this year's auction, but has been withdrawn in favour of an assignation with a racing great. "The first foal we had from Coyote was the Montjeu (Ire) colt, Eradicate (Ire), who is a listed winner," recalled Naughton. "She's now in foal to Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}), carrying a colt, and she is going to visit Sea The Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross), so these are exciting times. He continued, "We have six foals in total going to Tattersalls this week, and the others are nice individuals. The Teofilo colt, [lot 1183](#), out of the Group 3 winner Jessica's Dream (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) is very nice and his yearling brother by Galileo sold for €350,000 at Deauville this summer. "We also have a Nayef (Gulch) colt, [lot 1184](#), who is a nice individual out of Shersha (Ire) (Priolo). There is also [lot 1187](#), a Royal Applause (GB) (Waajib) filly, and a Clodovil (Ire) (Danehill) filly, [lot 1186](#), both of which we are selling for Sandy Bone from Triple H Stud. They are all really nice horses, but it is very hard to predict because each sale goes along and does a different thing."

Naughton is optimistic about Tattersalls, although he knows as well as any horseman that nothing can be taken for granted. "I think the sale should be fine this week," he explained. "It is like anywhere at the moment, the good-looking individual by a fashionable sire will make really good money. Anything that is not correct, out of a stallion that is slightly out of favour, will not. That is the way the sales have been going for years. I think a few years ago, the middle market was being held up by the fellow willing to take a chance on a stallion that was out of fashion that year, but might be back in vogue by the time he comes to sell it as a yearling. But it looks like there are not many people to take any chances. You are wasting your time taking a horse to the sales nowadays if it isn't A1, because it is not a day at the races, you are not going for a jolly day out. You have to go there with something you believe will actually sell for you."

LADY'S SECRET S. RENAMED FOR ZENYATTA

Oak Tree Racing Association announced that it has renamed the GI Lady's Secret S. the Zenyatta S., in honor of the 2008 champion older female and 2009 Horse of the Year hopeful. Jerry and Ann Moss's **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}), undefeated in 14 starts, prepped for her victory in the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic with a score in the Lady's Secret, and used the race as a springboard for her triumph over males in this year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "When the history books are written, we feel that what Zenyatta accomplished here on Nov. 7 will go down as one of the all-time great achievements in American racing," said Oak Tree Director and Executive Vice President Sherwood Chillingworth. "Lady's Secret was a great mare herself. She won the [Breeders' Cup] Distaff here in 1986 and went on to be named Horse of the Year, but what Zenyatta did here against the best horses in the world is something none of us who witnessed it will never forget. At first, Jerry [Moss] was reluctant to accept our offer of renaming the race because he was a personal friend of [Lady's Secret's owner] Gene Klein. But after he and Ann thought about it for a couple days, he called back and said they thought Zenyatta would be flattered by the comparison and to know she was held in such high esteem." Inaugurated in 1993, the Lady's Secret S. is for fillies and mares, three-years-old and up, and is contested at 1 1/16 miles on the main track during the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita.

RACHEL ALEXANDRA BACK ON TRACK

Horse of the Year candidate **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) has returned to the track for the first time since she arrived at Churchill Downs Oct. 7, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The three-year-old filly, who had been taking it easy since winning the GI Woodward S. over older males Sept. 5, jogged a very easy mile Monday and Tuesday. She had been done little more than graze and stand in her stall until about 10 days

ago, when she began walking under tack on the shed row each morning, according to *DRF*. "She was ready to get out there and do something, finally," Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen, told the trade daily. "She's put on a lot of weight, looks beautiful, [and is] traveling great. We just wanted to get her back out there a few days because she's so familiar and comfortable with the track here at Churchill." While the exact day remains to be determined, Blasi said Rachel Alexandra will ship to the Fair Grounds in New Orleans after the Churchill meet concludes Saturday. Asmussen and principal owner Jess Jackson have said they plan to race Rachel Alexandra as a four-year-old. She is currently on a nine-race winning streak, which includes Grade I victories in the Kentucky Oaks, Preakness S., Mother Goose S., Haskell Invitational S. and Woodward S. in her last five starts.

TIZWAY HANDLES INTERCONTINENTAL TRIP

Tizway (Tiznow), a hopeful for the G1 Japan Cup Dirt at Hanshin Racecourse Dec. 6, was reported by *Daily Racing Form* to have handled the 15-hour flight from New York to Narita International Airport near Tokyo without problem. Third behind Summer Bird (Birdstone) and Quality Road (Elusive Quality) in the Oct. 3 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup last time, Tizway arrived in Japan Monday and will be stabled at the Japan Racing Association's Horseracing School Quarantine Stables at Shiroi until Dec. 3. He'll subsequently be transferred to Hanshin near Osaka. "It was his first long-distance travel, but his condition seems to be OK," said Tizway's groom Everardo Cambray. "As of now, I've been told by [trainer H. James] Bond to only walk him on Tuesday and check his condition." At Shiroi, Tizway joined Summer Bird, who arrived in Japan last Thursday following a fourth in the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The Japan Cup Dirt will be contested at 1800 meters on Hanshin's right-handed course one week after Sunday's G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse.

Hanford, Oldest Derby-Winning Jockey, Dies at 91:

Ira "Babe" Hanford, who became the first apprentice jockey to win the Kentucky Derby when he guided Bold Venture to victory in 1936, died Saturday in Ocala, FL, after a lengthy illness. He was 91. One of 10 children, Hanford grew up in Fairbury, NE, and followed his two brothers to the East Coast to become a jockey. His older brother "Buddy" died after sustaining a head injury in a race at Pimlico in 1933. His brother Carl, now 93, is the Hall of Fame trainer best known for conditioning five-time Horse of the Year Kelso. In addition to his brother and wife Virginia, Hanford is survived by his sons Glenn and Gary and numerous nieces and nephews, including trainer Gail Hanford. A private funeral is scheduled for Saturday. In lieu of flowers, the family has requested that donations be made to the Kentucky Derby Museum to help its recovery from August flood damage.

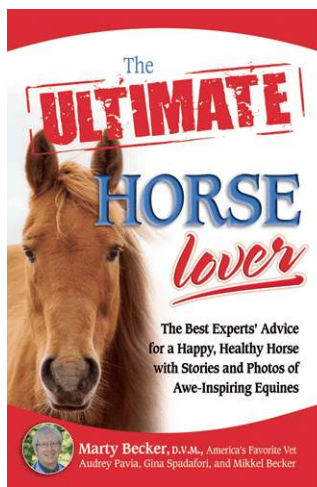
