## FALLS CITY SERENADE

Churchill's GII Falls City H. was supposed to mark the career finale for **Serenading** (A.P. Indy), but those plans might be changing. Serenading notched her first win of 2009 in her latest effort, the Maple Leaf S. at Woodbine Nov. 7, and was trying conventional dirt for just the second time in her career. In second early, the bay mare got first run on millionaire **Unbridled Belle** (Broken Vow) and **Morena** (Per) (Privately Held) turning for home, and kicked from those rivals to earn her first graded trophy. "Prior to the race, we thought she did everything she

needed to do for [co-owner John Sikura]," explained winning trainer Josie Carroll. "She's been a great mare. But he said if she proved herself capable of winning Grade IIs or better, then perhaps we'd keep her going. So I'll sit down with him and make sure everything is good after the race and see what happens next." Cherokee Country needed three starts to shake off the rust of a 20-month hiatus, but got it done in an allowance at Philly Park June 16. Third in each of his next three appearances, the five-year-old paired up allowance wins in Philadelphia Sept. 7 and Sept. 28--setting a track record in the former--and came into this contest off a fourth in the seven-furlong GIII Bold Ruler H. on Halloween at the Big A. Unhurried early by jockey Jose Lezcano as Hatfield and Go Go Shoot (Songandaprayer) went at it through splits of :21.80 and :44.31, the bay took to the center of the track to deliver his challenge and finished up strongly to post a holiday surprise. "He had been off for nearly two years, first with a leg injury, and then a shoulder injury," explained winning owner Lou Cacchio. "He came back great this year; broke the track record for 6 1/2 furlongs at Philadelphia Park [1:14.39] three starts back. He had a bit of bad luck in the Bold Ruler. He hesitated at the start, and probably lost five lengths right there. There was a lot of speed in this race, and we thought it would set up for him. We'll look next at the Gravesend [Dec. 26] here."

**Cowboy Cal**, second by 3/4 of a length in last year's GI Hollywood Derby, prepped for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Nov. 7 with a front-running score in the GII Oak Tree BC Mile Oct. 10. Forwardly placed through a :45 1/5 half in the big event, the dark bay faded to 10th behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa). "I talked to Todd and he feels the colt seems to have bounced back in good shape," John Adger, racing manager for owner/breeders Robert and Janice McNair, told *Daily Racing Form*. "I think he got caught up in a hot pace last time. We're hoping he'll be able to bounce back." Blue Chagall had the ultimate equipment change over the summer, and comes into this one off two straight wins, an optional claimer at Del Mar Aug. 15 and the Lure S. at Oak Tree Oct. 18. "Since I gelded him, he's been a different horse," trainer Julio Canani told *DRF*. "He's doing unbelievable."

Scratched just a few hours before the GI Kentucky Oaks with a foot problem, the dark bay ran second as the 4-5 chalk in the GI Acorn S. at Belmont June 6, and missed an engagement in the GI Test S. at Saratoga after getting cast in her stall. She has her work cut out for her against **Sara Louise**, though. That filly, who defeated Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the one-turn mile of the GIII Pocahontas S. in 2008, returns to dirt following a fourth against a salty group in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint on Santa Anita's Pro-Ride Nov. 6. "I thought it was a very good effort for a lightly raced three-year-old," Godolphin assistant Rick Mettee said of her trip west. "I think the one-turn mile should be a good race for her. She came from California and worked well here, and she should get a good pace."

**SOLID TRADE ON SECOND DAY** Day two of the Tattersalls December Foal Sale saw strong demand for the standout lots, resulting in five six-figure transactions and figures that showed big advances on a disappointing equivalent session 12 months ago. The 4,709,800gns turnover was up 39 percent on last year. The 27,068gns average rose by 22 percent and the 20,000gns median increased 54 percent. The 81-percent clearance rate compared with 71 per cent in 2008.

Blandford Bloodstock, the Newmarket agency run by Tom Goff and Richard Brown, accounted for three of the top five lots. It was Brown that led the way when seeing off Matt Coleman of the Anthony Stroud agency for [lot 746](#), a 165,000gns colt from the first crop of Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). Out of Triton Dance (Ire) (Hector Protector), he was bred by Neville Poole and George Thornton, and consigned through Paul and Sara Thorman's Trickle-down Stud.

"He's for an existing client, and he could be kept to race or for resale," Brown said. "We'll see how he develops in the spring. I'm a big fan of the sire--his stock look very good."

Paul Thorman was pleased for his clients.

"They paid a lot of money for the mare carrying [G3 Tetrarch Stakes third] Count John [{Ire}] by Intikhab)," Thorman explained. "But conformationally he was not good, and only sold for 5,000gns as a foal. Then she had a Dansili who was gorgeous, but a wobbler, so they deserved a good payday. This fellow was a star."

Teofilo's red-letter day continued when Shadwell's Angus Gold signed for [lot 738](#), a daughter of the Darley sire out of listed winner Andbell (Fr) (Common Grounds {GB}), who made 150,000gns.

"I've been very impressed with the stallion's stock," said Gold. "She's the first foal we've got this week, and she'll go back to Derrinstown Stud in Ireland and then go into training when the time comes."

The filly was bred by Simon Tindall, who founded the Haymarket publishing group, and was consigned from Bob McCreery's Stowell Hill Stud.

Richard Brown also signed for a 135,000gns first-crop son of G1 Epsom Derby winner Authorized (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), bred at Brook Stud and consigned through the Castlebridge Consignment. He was catalogued as [lot 756](#). His dam, the unraced Scarlet Empire (Ire) (Red Ransom), was purchased at the Goffs February Sale in 2008 for €23,000, and made her first trip to the breeding shed the following month.

"[Lot 756] was bought for James Egan's Corduff Stud and will come back here to October Book 1 next year," said Brown. "He was a straightforward and athletic foal by the Derby winner, and comes from a current family as his dam is a half-sister to G3 Arctic (Ire) (Shamardal)."

Blandford's Tom Goff bid 130,000gns for [lot 730](#), a Galileo (Ire) half-brother to three winners. The son of Belle Allemande (Royal Academy) was bred by Mary O'Sullivan's Devon-based Howard Barton Stud, and sold by Juliet Minton's Mill House Stud.

"He's been bought for a client who will make a decision next year whether he goes into training in 2011 or is reoffered as a yearling," said Goff. "He was a racy, athletic colt and had lots of quality; he was just a lovely, loose-moving Galileo."

Pinhooker Charlie Vigors of Hillwood Stud was the final six-figure buyer, spending 100,000gns on another Trickleddown offering, [lot 742](#), a Nayef colt bred by Honeypuddle Stud.

"He'll come back here next year, and he was a lovely colt," said Vigors. "It's a good page and we hope he goes the right way. They are a very good bunch of horses here, but everyone seems to be in on the nice ones, and you have to pay a slight premium to get them."

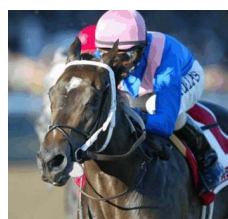
