BLAME GAME IN THE CLARK

While Mine That Bird (Birdstone), Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) and Summer Bird (Birdstone) were accounting for this year's Triple Crown series, **Blame** (Arch) was busying himself with clearing his allowance conditions. If the learning curve was on the slower side then, it certainly isn't that way anymore, as the homebred came from centerfield to take down a talented and diverse collection of handicap horses in Friday's GII Clark H. Conqueror of subsequent MGSW Gone Astray (Dixie Union) in Saratoga's Curlin S. Aug. 2, the attractive bay never threatened Regal Ransom (Distorted Humor) when second in that's one's GII Super Derby score Sept. 19, but bounced back with a 1 1/4-length win over his elders in the GII Fayette S. at Keeneland Oct. 31. Settled four wide off a moderate gallop up front, Blame tugged jockey Jamie Theriot towards the front five deep on the final turn. He responded when set down, struck the lead at the eighth pole and held sway late, as GII Indiana Derby hero **Misremembered** (Candy Ride {Arg}) made up ground at the inside. Defending champion **Einstein (Brz)** (Spend a Buck) ran well from the 14-hole to be third, while **Giant Oak** (Giant's Causeway), the Indiana Derby runner-up, was an excellent fourth. Blame will spend the winter in New Orleans with an eye on the 2010 Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill. Since the race was first run back in 1988, no horse has ever won the GI Metropolitan Mile H. and the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. in the same year. That is precisely

what Marc Keller's **Bribon (Fr)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) will set out to do when he faces a compact, but accomplished field of six in the final Grade I event on the New York circuit in 2009. A virtual unknown who had thrown up the occasional big figure going

into last year's event, the chestnut was making a run when he was hampered by the stricken Wanderin Boy in upper stretch. He flew home when he leveled out and was doing his best work at the finish, missing by 3/4 of a lengths in third. "I remember getting ready for this race last year--it was his first big attempt," recalls trainer Bobby Ribaud, "and it seems like we haven't stopped since." **Cont. p2**

Bribon's Met victory came at the expense of **Driven By Success**, with whom he rematches this afternoon. The New York-bred set quick fractions in the Memorial Day feature before weakening a bit to finish third. A bit of a question mark at the mile and at this level, he played to his strengths in his latest, taking a sloppy renewal of the Hudson S. by three easy lengths Oct. 24. Ramon Dominguez, aboard the gelding for each of his four career victories, has the call for trainer Bruce Levine.

Three other previous Grade I winners add intrigue to today's race. **Kodiak Kowboy**, fifth in last year's Cigar and victorious in this track's GI Carter H. in the spring, enters off a score in the GI Vosburgh S. at Belmont Oct. 3. **Vineyard Haven** is near perfect in two stateide tries this year, having finished first in the GI NetJets King's Bishop S. Aug. 29 (but DQ'd to second) prior to a game score in the GI DeFrancis Dash Oct. 24. **Pyro**, who outfinished Kodiak Kowboy to land the GI Forego S. Sept. 5, makes the final start of a successful career. He was most 10th in the GI BC Dirt Mile Nov. 7.

The late Bobby Frankel won this prestigious event no fewer than eight times, amazingly all in the span of 13 years, and had a four-year streak snapped last year by Cocoa Beach (Chi) (Doneraile Court), who defeated the Frankel-trained Precious Kitten (Catienus) and Visit (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}). Five of Frankel's Matriarchs came for Juddmonte Farms and **Ventura** should be favored to add to that today. The GI Woodbine Mile winner enters off a runner-up effort in defense of her title in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint Nov. 6.

Diamondrella looks to get back on track in her first start for the Gary Stevens barn. Formerly trained by Angel Penna Jr., the bay goes in search of a third Grade I at a mile on the turf. She previously defeated Forever Together (Belong to Me) in the GI Just a Game S. in June and in the GI First Lady S. at Keeneland Oct. 10. She was a disappointing 11th in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint Nov. 7.

S. by 1 1/4 lengths prior to an all-out success in the Santa Anita Oaks Mar. 7. Shipped out of California for the GI Ashland S. during the Keeneland spring meeting, she could not muster up the same sort of eyecatching finish that became her trademark in the Golden State and settled for third at odds-on. From there, a trip to the Kentucky Oaks was

shelved and a spell on the sidelines ensued. "We knew she was going south on us when we got her in the spring," said Mike Iavarone, president of IEAH Stables. "She was just not sending us the right signals. Sometimes horses just don't progress physically from age two to three. She's really grown up in her time off, especially physically." Mike Smith, the only jockey Stardom Bound has ever known, is in for the ride. If the favorite is the "then" horse, **Unrivaled Belle** is the "now" horse in the race. Sideline off a debut second at Keeneland Apr. 9, the grey daughter of MGSW Queenie Belle (Bertrando) has since rattled off three straight, capped by a 6 3/4-length romp in Belmont Park's Real Prize S. Oct. 23.

GI Champagne S. hero **Homeboykris** faces runaway GI Nashua S. winner **Buddy's Saint** in the first two-turn try for either juvenile. Homeboykris was purchased privately after breaking his maiden at Calder in his second start July 11. The bay gelding was transferred to trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. and, making his first outing under new management in the Oct. 10 Champagne, closed from just off the lead to score by 1 1/2 lengths. He has not been out since. "He's doing better than ever," said trainer Juan Rodriguez, subbing for the currently suspended Dutrow. "So far, he's done everything we've asked him to do. Two turns should be no problem for him." Buddy's Saint eked out a head victory in a Sept. 26 maiden test going 6 1/2 panels at Belmont Park, and stepped up to make his second start in the Nov. 7 Nashua. Let go at nearly 4-1 while adding Lasix for the first time, he romped home a 12-length winner, earning him morning-line favoritism here. The bay shipped from his home base at Belmont to work at the Big A Nov. 22, going five panels in 1:01. "He's had two starts and only shipped the one time," said trainer Bruce Levine. "He's still a green horse and I thought it wouldn't hurt him to ship once more, go through the motions again. He went well, all systems go, and we're excited to run him."

Phipps homebred **Protesting** took four starts to graduate, but looked sharp when breaking her maiden by five going the Demoiselle distance on the Keeneland Poly Oct. 23 ([video](#)). The dark bay filly has been working steadily since returning to New York. **Fuzzy Britches** heads opposition on the strength of her second in the Sorority S. at Monmouth in September and third in the off-the-grass Miss Grillo S. at Belmont Oct. 4. She tries two turns and a trip beyond a mile for the first time, but her connections are confident she is up to the task. "She should be able to handle it," said trainer Juan Rodriguez, standing in for the suspended Rick Dutrow Jr. "She's a good filly, and we hope she might be able turn into a graded-stakes horse." George and Lori Hall send out the entry of **In the Rough**, a 6 3/4-length maiden winner going a route over a sloppy Meadowlands strip Oct. 24; and **Profiteroles**, who graduated by 5 1/2 lengths in a one-mile test at that oval Nov. 13.

Upperline, two-for-three, makes her graded and traditional dirt bow. The bay opened her career with a maiden win at Arlington in July, and recovered from a rough start to be second behind pro-tem champion She Be Wild (Offlee Wild) in the Aug. 8 Top Flight S. at that track. Stretching out to two turns for a Keeneland allowance test Oct. 16, she rallied to take it by a neck over **Vivid Colors**, and looms the one to beat here. Vivid Colors came back to set a pressured pace in the Nov. 1 GIII Pocahontas S. going a mile over this strip, and weakened late to be fourth, three lengths behind today's morning-line chalk **Sassy Image**. **Decelerator** closed to be second in that test, while **All Due Respect** pressed the pace and took the lead at the eighth pole before yielding late to be third.

The first Grade I starter sent out by Humberto Ascanio, Fluke was let go at 9-1. Jockey Joe Talamo took advantage of his inside draw to ride the rails and save every inch of ground as Enriched (High Brite) set the pace from Ever a Friend and a stalking Cowboy Cal. The pacesetter gave way turning for home and was immediately passed by Ever a Friend, but it was Fluke, who knifed through in the two path, who took it going away. "Bobby told me to get him ready," said an emotional Ascanio, his 15-month old grandson cradled in his arm. "Be positive, he is training good. He was right. My job was to continue training. Both hugged the inside throughout, but the former charged past the Canadian raider one off the inside at the quarter pole and cruised in a handy winner.

RACING Round-Up

UIGEA REGULATIONS DELAYED The United States Department of Treasury and the Federal Reserve have authorized a six-month delay in the implementation of regulations associated with the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act (UIGEA). The regulations, originally scheduled to take effect Dec. 1, will now be delayed through June 1, 2010. The UIGEA and its corresponding regulations mandated that payment systems develop safeguards to protect against unlawful forms of online gambling, called "restricted transactions." Activities that previously have been permitted under the Interstate Horseracing Act (IHA) have been expressly excluded from the definition of restricted transactions, meaning that no activities under the IHA can be blocked.

The regulations do, however, provide a legal safe harbor for those wishing to "overblock" online transactions, even those which have been deemed legal under the IHA. "This is an important win for the racing industry," said Alex Waldrop, president and CEO of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. "Horseracing has invested hundreds of millions of dollars in technology and infrastructure to develop the market for advance deposit wagering. That market now represents nearly 15 percent of the \$14-billion market for pari-mutuel wagering. We will continue to work diligently with the financial services industry and our ADW service providers to ensure that online pari-mutuel wagers are processed in accordance with the Interstate Horseracing Act." The NTRA and others petitioned the Treasury and the Fed in September to delay regulations under UIGEA, citing concerns about overblocking. More than 40 members from both sides of the aisle of the U.S. House of Representatives and Senate expressed support for the delay, which has also been endorsed by the banking community.

CONDUIT READY FOR LAST HURRAH Dual G1 Breeders' Cup Turf hero **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), will bid to give trainer Sir Michael Stoute a third G1 Japan Cup in his career closer at Tokyo Sunday. The Ballymacoll Stud bred, who also won last year's G1 St Leger and this term's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S., was purchased by Shigeyuki Okada's Big Red Farm prior to his second Breeders' Cup victory at Santa Anita earlier this month. He also ran fourth in the Oct. 4 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in his penultimate start. "He was a bit lazy Friday morning, he always is, but he's been through a lot of travelling in a short period," Stoute told *PA Sport*. "We always knew that it was a tight schedule, we had to try and get him in good shape after the King George for the three races--the Arc, the Breeders' Cup Turf and the Japan Cup. He hasn't done anything too severe between the races because of all the travel. It doesn't matter if he races going left or right, he's done well in both."

GALILEO COLT TOPS DAY 3 AT TATTS FOALS

A 400,000gns Galileo (Ire) colt out of 2004 G1 Prix Saint-Alary heroine Ask For The Moon (Fr) (Dr Fong) stole the show at Friday's flagship penultimate session of the December Foal Sale at Tattersalls in Newmarket.

Demi O'Byrne signed for the well-developed January-born colt. High-stakes pinhooker Eugene McDermott of Kennycourt Stud was underbidder on [lot 991](#).

"He's for the usual team and has been bought to race," said O'Byrne. "He was very mature and you could almost put a saddle on him now. He was a lovely strong horse out of a good mare. He'll come back home and go into training when the time comes."

The colt, bred by A-Mark Racing et al, was prepared for the sale by Jacqueline Norris's Jockey Hall Stud on behalf of James Hanly's Ballyhimikin Stud.

"In my 15 years doing this job, he was the most impressive foal I have prepped," said Norris. "He probably had 200 shows before going through the ring and just had everything."

It was a day when most of the top lots went to end users, rather than pinhookers, and so was the case with [lot 933](#), a filly by Medicean (GB). Purchased by Alan Cooper on behalf of Maria Niarchos and family, the half-sister to G1 Derby runner-up Dragon Dancer (GB) (Sadler's Wells) realized a 320,000gns final bid. Blandford Bloodstock's Tom Goff was the underbidder on the filly, who comes from the outstanding family of Kirsten Rausing's foundation mare Alruccaba (Ire) (Crystal Palace {Fr}).

"She's a lovely filly and the Machiavellian [Medicean's sire] on a Hernando mare is our blood," said Cooper. "We have the three-parts brother--Ajaan--with Henry Cecil and we hope he goes on next year. This 'Al' family of Kirsten's is extraordinary and let's hope the filly can run."

Another filly bought as a long-term breeding prospect was a sister to this season's G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up Lady Darshaan (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}), sold by Shanaville Stables for breeders Seamus Kennedy and Michael Woodlock.

Hugo Lascelles, acting for Anthony Oppenheimer of Hascombe and Valiant Studs, bought the filly with Eddie O'Leary of Lynn Lodge Stud coming out second best when the bidding hit 300,000gns.

"She was an absolute queen and I thought she was the best filly in the sale," said Lascelles. "There's a lot to look forward to with Lady Darshaan, so you've got a lot of chances with something like her."

"She's for Mr. Oppenheimer to keep and race and is one for the long haul that will come to the stud eventually. We try and upgrade the stock when we can."

Eugene McDermott, who was underbidder on the sale-topping Galileo, had earlier fought off John Ferguson to get a 240,000gns Oasis Dream (GB) colt bred by Ptarmigan Bloodstock and sold through Kirsten Rausing's St Simon Stud.

"He'll come back to my Kennycourt Stud and then be reoffered and we hope to make a profit," said McDermott. "We tend to trade at the high end of the market and I thought this colt was the pick of the day. I think that everything about Oasis Dreams is the tops."

"We got eight foals at Goffs and this was the fourth one we have got here and I'm definitely optimistic about the yearling market next year."

But despite Dubai's current economic problems, Ferguson was as busy as ever stocking up on 2011 racing prospects for Sheikh Mohammed.

He was the day's biggest spender after getting eight foals for 1,115,000gns headed by a colt by Invincible Spirit (Ire), who brought 260,000gns. Offered late in the session as [lot 1022](#), the colt--bred by former jockey Walter Swinburn and sold from his family's locally-based Genesis Green Stud--is a half-brother to G1 French 2000 Guineas winner Landseer (GB) (Danehill).

Although still adrift of the 2007 record-breaking figures, the sale bounced back from a disappointing renewal 12 months ago.

The 9,951,900gns turnover was up 55 per cent, the 61,813gns average rose by 21 percent and the 40,000gns median was up 14 percent. The clearance rate was 80 percent, compared to 69 percent last year.

He will arrive in Italy next week and may also undertake Southern Hemisphere coverings next year. Red Rocks, who ran fifth in his fourth Breeders' Cup Turf attempt at Santa Anita Nov. 7, retires with a career record of 24-6-4-3 and earnings of £1,623,003.
