He had to fight off two fellow Grade I winners, but **Kodiak Kowboy** (Posse) outgamed GI Met Mile H. hero **Bribon** (Fr) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) and GI DeFrancis

Dash victor **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}) to get his picture taken after the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct yesterday. Content to sit in the middle of the pack as **Driven By Success** (Precise End) and Vineyard Haven dueled it out through fractions of :46.80 and 1:11.54, Kodiak Kowboy was still in

hand while tucked behind Godolphin's gray as they rolled out of the bend. Bribon got a clear run on the outside, going up to join Vineyard Haven at the top of the lane. While those two went at it on the front end, jockey Shaun Bridgmohan let the Kowboy drift to the outside, then went to work, and the bay responded. He got on even terms with the leaders in the shadow of the wire and prevailed over a pair of gallant rivals. It was a fitting performance for his career finale. "This horse has been so good for us," said Tom Ludt, president of co-owner Vinery Stables. "Now he's going home to be a dad." Cont. p2

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}), who successfully defended his title in the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Turf last out at Santa Anita, faces a tough challenge as he attempts to add another major international race to his trophy case in today's G1 Japan Cup. Trainer Sir Michael Stoute has won the Japan Cup twice, with Singspiel (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) in 1996 and Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent) the following year. But only two overseas runners, Falbrav (Ire) (Fairy King) in 2002 and Alkaased (Kingmambo) in 2005, have managed to overcome the home team this millennium. Conduit had an easy canter in Tokyo Saturday morning as his final prep for the race. Stoute assistant Anthony Cromby, who travelled to the U.S. and to Japan with the colt, remarked earlier this week, "We took him back [to England] from America to see how he was within himself, physically and mentally, and the boss thought we'd give him a shot at the Japan Cup. He's mentally strong and he takes everything in his stride, and he's improved with age." Cromby added, "He's a quick recoverer--you obviously lose a little bit of weight after you've traveled, but he'd soon put it back on during his week at Shiroi, and he's back to his old self." Not His First Time at the Rodeo...

A Sovereign Award winner at two, Kodiak Kowboy had a solid campaign at three, winning the GII Amsterdam S. and GIII Sport Page H., and losing by just 3/4 of a length when third in the GI Vosburgh S. He may have hung a bit late in the 2008 edition of the Cigar, finishing fifth, but he proved a different animal this time around. The colt took the Apr. 4 GI Carter H. by a head in his second start this season, and added a lucrative Philly Park stakes June 27. Third in the Aug. 9 GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga and second by a half-length to Pyro (Pulpit) in the Sept. 5 GI Forego S., he entered his second Cigar bid off a half-length score over Fabulous Strike (Smart Strike) in the Oct. 3 Vosburgh. He was considered a candidate for the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but was pulled from the line-up to await this test, and showed his appreciation for the extra time between races with a superior effort. "We couldn't be happier," Tom Ludt added. "He was a little closer to the pace than normal, but he was just sitting there so comfortably. Shaun rode a great race." Added Bridgmohan, "I had such a great trip. I was just very patient with him, and when I asked him, he responded like the professional he's always been." "I like [Vineyard Haven] to be there in front, that's the plan," bin Suroor remarked. "But the horse is not the same as we saw in his last two races. I talked to [jockey Alan Garcia], and he said he was struggling, and when he went to ask him, there was nothing there. I was disappointed with the result." He continued, "Pyro, he was traveling very well, but he did not finish his race." Garcia said regarding Vineyard Haven, "My horse just didn't have it like he did last time [in the DeFrancis Dash]."

She stopped on a dime as the 2-1 favorite in the Oct. 24 GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland, but Flashing turned it around with the return to traditional dirt here. A troubled eighth in the Jan. 10 Busanda S. to open the year, the blaze-faced chestnut rolled through her next three starts, capping the winning streak with a game effort in the May 2 GIII Nassau County S. Flashing was beaten 31 1/2 lengths when third and last behind Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI Mother Goose S. June 27, but bounced back to take the GI Test S. Aug. 8. The sophomore tried all-weather in her next two, running third behind subsequent GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint heroine Informed Decision (Monarchos) in the Sept. 12 GIII Presque Isle Downs Masters S. and 12th in the Raven Run, but was on top of her game in the Gazelle. Jockey Richie Migliore opted to send Flashing right to the front and she led every step, opening up in the final drive to win as much the best. Favored Unrivaled Belle was second throughout. Ventura was making her final start here, and she arguably left the best for last. The quirky mare already had enough victories to fill a highlight reel, including the GI Just a Game S. and Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint in 2008, and the GI Santa Monica H. and, when taking on the boys, the GI Woodbine Mile S. this term. The runner-up in her Breeders' Cup title defense, the dark bay was back on the grass for her swan song, and she looked better than ever. Content to stalk Tuscan Evening while a little handier than her norm, Ventura edged closer on the turn and swung out as they straightened for home. Tuscan Evening dug in, but to no avail, as the crowd's odds-on choice powered away in a stakes-record-setting performance. Bobby Frankel had won eight of the last 13 runnings of this event; his assistant of more than three decades, Humberto Ascanio, who took Friday's GI Citation H. with former Frankel protegee Fluke (Brz) (Wild Event), kept the tradition alive. Buddy's Saint ran back to his GIII Nashua S. romp with this decisive victory. The bay hit the line a head to the good in his debut at Belmont Sept. 26, but was DQ'd and placed second for a bumping incident in the stretch. Undaunted by the colt's lack of experience, connections opted to send him to the Nov. 7 Nashua for his second outing, and the move proved a wise one. Pressured early, Buddy's Saint opened up on the field down the lane to win by 12 lengths, and he was odd-on to repeat in the Remsen. Kingfield Stables' budding star was content to settle in third through an opening half in :48. GI Champagne S. hero Homeboykris (Roman Ruler), a pace-pressing second early, edged to the front as jockey Jose Lezcano got Buddy's Saint into gear at the top of the lane, and track announcer Tom Durkin intoned, "The race is on." But, in fact, it was already over. Buddy's Saint put Homeboykris away without a struggle and opened up to score handily. He will winter at Gulfstream Park. A maiden winner at first asking, Tizahit rallied to take an off-the-turf affair at Monmouth Park Sept. 13. The dark bay came back to be second in the Blue Hen S. at Delaware Park Oct. 3, but showed little when a distant fourth in the Nov. 7 GIII Tempted S. at the Big A. She was looking to rebound with new jockey Edgar Prado in the irons here. Quickly into stride, Tizahit was eased back to sit third around the first turn. The filly was on the bit down the backstretch, edging into second, but Prado was biding his time. The Hall of Famer finally asked the question when they straightened for home and Tizahit responded, driving to the front and holding favored Protesting at bay in the final furlong. "Beautiful trip, everything worked out perfect," Prado said. "She broke running out of there and I was where I wanted to be most of the way. It was a slow pace and my filly was doing everything comfortably. When I asked her, she kicked it in strong. I don't think [Protesting] could have gone by today. She was just waiting for competition. Every time I hit her, she picked it up and kept on running. A year ago to the day, Calvin Borel guided Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) to a dominating victory in the Golden Rod S. before piloting her in her historic 2009 campaign. He may well have found his Derby mount for 2010 in the form of Super Saver, who led throughout in his two-turn debut. Runner-up in his 6 1/2-furlong bow at Saratoga Aug. 22, the bay rolled home by seven in a one-mile Belmont maiden Sept. 11. He set a strong pace in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 10 and held well to be fourth, and was well fancied in what could be a dress rehearsal for the first Saturday in May. Coaxed along by Borel through fractions of :23.33 and :46.75, Super Saver got his sternest test from Activity Report (Bernstein), who came to tackle the front runner on the turn. Super Saver turned back that challenge and opened it up late to score impressively. William's Kitten rallied from the tail to finish a clear second. "It was a big effort from him," commented trainer Todd Pletcher. "Obviously, it was his first time two turns and first Grade II performance. I was little concerned that the fractions were fast but [jockey] Calvin [Borel] is riding so well right now you've got to trust a guy's judgment when he's in the zone like he is." The winner is out of Supercharger, a full sister to the dam of WinStar sire Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat). The mare was purchased for \$160,000 with Super Saver in utero at KEENOV in 2006. Sassy Image justified favoritism with this determined performance. Runner-up in the Aug. 19 GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga, she was off the board in the Sept. 6 GI Spinaway S. back at the Spa and in the Oct. 9 GI Darley Alcibiades S. on the Keeneland Poly. That didn't stop the Churchill faithful from making her the 2-1 chalk in the Nov. 1 GIII Pocahontas S., and the filly lived up to the role, rallying to beat Decelerator by two lengths. It was deja vu all over again yesterday. Rated in fourth early, Sassy Image moved to challenge as they raced into the turn. Decelerator drove to the front from second as they approached the quarter pole, but she was soon joined by her Pocahontas nemesis, and once again could not match strides late. GOOD SHOW AT FOAL SALE

Tattersalls's December Foal Sale finished in Newmarket Saturday afternoon, showing large advances on the 2008 trade. The strength of the four-day sale surprised many observers. The 20,200,000gns turnover for a reduced catalogue was up 39 percent on last year, the 32,716gns average rose by 26 percent and the 16,000gns median shot up by 52 percent. The clearance rate was 78 percent, compared to 60 percent last year.

Sales company Chairman Edmond Mahony was pleasantly surprised by the strength of trade for foals. "After the successful October Yearling Sales, we approached this week's December Foal Sale with a sense of guarded optimism, but I think it would be fair to say that the strength of the trade over the last four days has exceeded our expectations," commented Mahony. "This year's foal catalogue was 25-percent smaller than its 2008 predecessor, but it has generated a 39-percent increase in turnover, and an average up 26 percent to a figure only bettered twice, in 2006 and 2007.

"Equally encouraging has been the clearance rate of nearly 80 percent, which demonstrates the enduring demand for quality that has been the key to a 2009 Tattersalls sales season that has consistently outperformed expectation. These are still challenging times and it would be wrong to pretend otherwise, but this week's returns can only help to bring back a measure of confidence to an industry that, like so many others, took a battering last year. We have a good, solid breeding stock catalogue to look forward to next week, and the usual cosmopolitan crowd should ensure trade to match the vibrant sale we have enjoyed this week."

Tattersalls' December breeding stock sale begins tomorrow morning at 10 a.m.

Hamdan Al Maktoum's racing manager Angus Gold bought yesterday's top lot, a 250,000gns Invincible Spirit (Ire) colt consigned from Bernie Cooke's Bryanstown House Stud. Timmy Hyde was underbidder on the colt, who sold as [lot 1079](#).

“He was a cracking colt and of what I’ve seen he was the standout of the day,” said Angus Gold. “The sire has done great, and I think the mare is going to turn out to be decent, because her Oasis Dream (GB) yearling was for me the standout filly at Deauville this year.”

Gold added, “This is just the most extraordinary business. I don’t think I’ve ever seen more people at this sale--certainly not so many different groups of buyers--from the very start of the first day onwards. The pinhooking bit of the market actually seems stronger here than in America at the moment, in terms of the number of different investors.”

Lot 1150, a Danehill Dancer (Ire) colt out of G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner Spinola (Fr) (Spinning World), was offered from Felipe Hinojosa’s Chevington and Loughtown Studs. He was also signed for by the Spanish owner/breeder in the name of his Yeguada de Milagro. “I was just on the limit between being a buyer and seller; he’ll be staying here in England and I will try and sell him again next year,” said Hinojosa.

Patrick Cooper of BBA Ireland outbid agent Cathy Grassick at 170,000gns for **lot 1185**, a first-crop Authorized (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) half-sister to G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third Oh Goodness (GB) (Galileo {Ire}). She was offered from breeder Sir Eric Parker’s Crimbourne Stud, and her dam Coyote (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) will be among the first book of mares to visit Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) next year.

“We tried very hard to find a nice filly in October Book 1, so I’m pleased to have got this one eventually,” said Cooper. “She won’t be coming back as a yearling, but has been bought for a client to join Ralph Beckett when the time comes.”

Earlier in the day, pinhooker Timmy Hyde of Camas Park Stud paid 140,000gns for a first-season Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) colt out of Group 3 winner Jessica’s Dream (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) that was sold from Crimbourne Stud. Friesan Fire Entered for Return...

Vinery Stable LLC and Fox Hill Farms' **Friesan Fire** (A.P. Indy), unraced since finishing 10th behind Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI Preakness S.

May 16, makes his return to the races Thursday at the Fair Grounds. The bay colt, previously trained by the now-retired Larry Jones, ran the table in the three-year-old series at the Fair Grounds over the winner, sweeping the GIII Lecomte S., the GIII Risen Star S. and the GII Louisiana Derby. Sent off the 7-2 favorite in the GI Kentucky Derby May 2, he was bumped and squeezed and grabbed a quarter early on and dropped back to finish a remote 18th of 19. He was examined following his dull Preakness run and was found to have a stress fracture in his left fore.

He also had a non-displaced chip fracture in his right front fetlock and underwent surgery in late May. Upon Jones' retirement, Friesan Fire was turned over to Steve Asmussen, and the colt has trained steadily since late October, capped by a six-furlong move in a race-like 1:12 3/5 Nov. 23. Shaun Bridgmohan has the call in the day's eighth race, to be contested over a mile and 40 yards. The competition is headed up by **Good and Lucky** (Wild Rush), who won the Tenacious H. last January at the Fair Grounds and was runner-up to Fox Hill's Honest Man (Unbridled's Song) in the GIII Mineshaft H. the following month.

Rachel Alexandra Arrives at Fair Grounds...

Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) arrived safely at the Fair Grounds in New Orleans, which will serve as her winter base, late Friday afternoon. The GI Preakness S. winner and Horse of the Year candidate traveled from Churchill Downs, where earlier this week she returned to the track for the first time since winning the GI Woodward S. in September. "She'll walk [Saturday]," Steve Asmussen said of his training plans. "She'll tack-walk at least a day, and if she drops her head and walks around the barn good, we'll start taking her and jogging her. I was going to wait until we got here to jog her, but I just thought with her being at Churchill quite a bit, it would be better just to take her out and jog her on the track there. We did that maybe three days, knowing we were coming [Friday]." Asmussen said the winner of five consecutive Grade I races will return to the races in March or April. "At this time of year, you're talking about weather and holidays and all that," he said. "Everything will be about her physical condition from one day to the next and will culminate with racing, but it's going to be about what she's up to today. You don't want her to be stale or disinterested, and you don't want her doing too much."

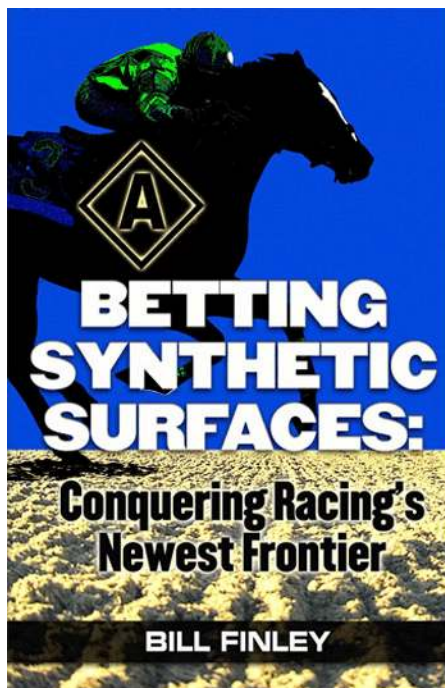
