**FOCUS SHIFTS TO MARES AT TATTERSALLS**

A roaring foal trade has given confidence to many ahead of the breeding stock section of the Tattersalls December Sale, which gets underway at 10 a.m. in Newmarket today.

With just 981 lots listed, this is the smallest December breeding stock catalogue since 1993 and--despite the

absence of some of the high-profile dispersals seen at recent renewals of the sale--there should be strong competition for the best lots.

There was an international crowd at Tattersalls' Park Paddocks yesterday, including a noticeably strong contingent of Australian buyers, who also made a splash at

the American breeding stock sales earlier this month and in the European horses-in-training market.

Many of the week's highlights are expected to come from fillies who have recently finished on the track. These include a duo from Mick Channon's stable--last month's GI E.P. Taylor S. winner Lahaleeb (Ire) (Redback {GB}), offered as [lot 1424](#); and G1 Premio Lydia Tesio heroine Eva's Request (Ire), who sells as [lot 1710](#).

Eva's Request was bred by Ballylinch Stud and the County Kilkenny farm is consigning 2006 Canadian Horse of the Year Arravale (Arch) on behalf of Robert Costigan and family as [lot 1532](#). The winner of both the G1 Del Mar Oaks and G1 E.P. Taylor S., she is offered with a Pivotal (GB) covering.

Trainer Jim Bolger's draft this evening (see p5&6) should provide further highlights. Three-time Group 1 winner Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) is presented as [lot 1389](#), and she will be followed into the ring by [lot 1390](#), G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third Oh Goodness Me (GB) (Galileo {Ire}). *Cont. p3*

**VODKA HOLDS ON IN STIRRING JAPAN CUP**

After 2400 meters, the G1 Japan Cup, which offered a purse of approximately \$5.9 million, was determined by the narrowest of margins. The wire arrived just in time for reigning Japanese Horse of the Year **Vodka (Jpn)** (Tanino Gimlet {Jpn}), who became the first Japanese-bred female to win the race in 29 renewals.

The five-year-old, who had done her best running at 1600 meters, came up 1 1/4 lengths short in this race last year and had only one win at the Japan Cup's 2400-meter distance, courtesy of her victory in the 2007 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby). She becomes the fourth horse to win seven Japanese Racing Association Group 1 races. "Though Vodka has won many Group 1 titles, the Japan Cup was special to me in that, after having finished third and fourth [in '08 and '07, respectively] in this truly

international and prestigious graded-race, somewhere in the back of my mind, there was always this unfinished job we had to finish," said winning owner Yuzo Tanimizu. "Her plans from now on will be decided only after I discuss the matter with my trainer and the staff who knows her best and has the ability to acknowledge when the time [to decide when she's had enough] comes." **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) concluded his career by finishing fourth, while the North American contingent--led by Just As Well (A.P. Indy)--could do no better than seventh. *Japan Cup cont. p2*

Vodka was denied by 1 1/4 lengths when third in this race last year, but would still go on to be named Japan's Horse of the Year off her victories in the G1 Yasuda Kinen and G1 Tenno Sho Autumn. The bay commenced her 2009 campaign with a troubled fifth in the G2 Jebel Hatta at Nad Al Sheba in March, and had no excuse when seventh in the G1 Dubai Duty Free later that month. She humbled her fellow females with a seven-length success in the G1 Victoria Mile back at Tokyo May 17, and got up by 3/4 of a length against open competition over the same course and distance in the June 7 G1 Yasuda Kinen.

She entered this spot on a two-race losing skid, however, as now-retired Company (Jpn) (Miracle Admire) edged her by a length in the G2 Mainichi Okan Oct. 11, and had her repeat bid in the G1 Tenno Sho Autumn fall two lengths short Nov. 1 when she finished behind Company and last year's Japan Cup hero Screen Hero (Grass Wonder). Ridden by Christophe Lemaire for the first time here, Vodka raced in the clear in fourth for the first 1400 meters before she was forced to wait behind horses on the final bend. She found a seam at the top of the stretch and was pushed along to claim the lead, but Lemaire waited to take out his whip until the 200-meter mark. His patience was rewarded as Vodka barely held off a fast-closing Oken Bruce Lee, who was in front one stride after the wire. "She was all ready to go at the head of the stretch, but knowing that the 2,400 meters was extra distance for her, I kept her in hand until the last 1 1/2 furlongs," Lemaire said. "I knew that the last 100 meters was going to be the toughest and also acknowledged a strong charge coming from behind, so I gave her the whip and prayed she would hold on. And she did, which proves what a fantastic mare she is." **Click for the Racing Post chart or free brisnet.com catalogue style pedigree. Video, courtesy the JRA.**

**Conduit Comes up Dry?...**

Two-time G1 Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Conduit (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), making his final start before he retires to stud at Big Red Farm in Japan, broke slowly from barrier 14 and settled near the rear. After encountering traffic at the top of the stretch, he was able to commence his rally once clear. He ran on to finish fourth, but lacked the turn of foot needed to challenge the top three. "He broke poorly--he didn't respond as he usually does," said jockey Ryan Moore. "He may have been tired not having enough time after his last start [G1 BC Turf Nov. 7]."

**North Americans Disappoint...**


**Just as Well** (A.P. Indy), winner of this year's GI Arlington H. and second in the GI Arlington Million and GI Northern Dancer S., fared the best of the North American invaders, showing mild late interest after racing in tight quarters on the final turn to finish five lengths behind the winner in seventh. "The horses on both sides closed in between the third and final turns, and I didn't have room, but I'm pleased with the outcome in such a big race," said jockey Julien Leparoux. "I'm proud of finishing the best among the American horses, too." **Interpatation** (Langfuhr), who upset the 2009 GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational, raced evenly to report home 14th. "I wish I could've kept up with the pace, but he just didn't have the speed," said his rider David Cohen. Last year's GI Canadian International S. winner **Marsh Side** (Gone West) was caught wide on the turns before fading to 17th. "He was through three furlongs out," jockey Javier Castellano said. "I don't know why."

**SUMMER BIRD OUT OF JAPAN CUP DIRT**

Leading Eclipse candidate **Summer Bird** (Birdstone) exited a Sunday workout in Japan with a chip in his right front ankle that has forced his withdrawal from the Dec. 6 Japan Cup Dirt. Owner K. K. Jayaraman told *Daily Racing Form*, "He breezed [Sunday] and came back and was not walking right." But he added, "[Trainer Tim Ice] said [the chip is] very small. We can take it out and run him in three or four months." The three-year-old captured the GI Belmont S., GI Travers S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup this year, making him the likely sophomore champion male. Fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last time out, he has earned \$2,323,040.

**Quality on Tap in Newmarket...**

In what should be a lively hour near the close of play tonight, G1 Oaks third High Heeled (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire})--who most recently won the G3 St Simon S. by six lengths--is offered by owners Steven and Karen Jenkins from Barry Hills' stable as [lot 1403](#).

Shortly afterward the four-year-old San Scharia (Ire) (Daggers Drawn), [lot 1411](#), can be expected to show an advance on the 165,000gns she cost owner Paddy Twomey at the same sale 12 months ago. She has gone on to win this season's G3 Chartwell S. at Lingfield, while her half-brother Spin Cycle (Ire) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) is now a listed winner.

[Lot 1419](#), The Miniver Rose (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}), heads from Richard Hannon's stable as the winner of this season's G2 Park Hill S. Stablemate Penny's Gift (GB) (Tobougg {Ire}), [lot 1416](#), won this season's G2 German 1000 Guineas. [Lot 1613](#), Song (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), has never raced, but the three-year-old--who was covered by Danehill Dancer (Ire) in April--can be expected to realize a serious amount when offered from Mary-Ann Penfold's Bugley Stud for Premier Bloodstock. She is a full-sister to five black-type performers, including G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Yesterday (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and three-times Classic-placed and Group 1 winner Quarter Moon (Ire), dam of this season's G1 Fillies' Mile third You'll Be Mine (Kingmambo). Song's only female sibling to be previously offered at auction, Because (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), sold for \$2.8 million at KEENOV in 2006.

Duke of Marmalade (Ire)'s first book of mares includes Lasting Chance (American Chance), the dam of recent HK-2 Hong Kong International Cup Trial winner Collection (Ire) (Peintre Celebre {Ire}). Hailing from the consignment of Peter Savill from his Ballykilbride Stud, she is offered as [lot 1730](#). *Cont. p4*

[Lot 1366](#), Aidan O'Brien's 2008 Listed Cheshire Oaks winner Sail (Ire) (Sadler's Wells)--a sibling to three other black-type winners--is another from Duke of Marmalade's first book. [Lot 1586](#), G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Ask for the Moon (Fr) (Dr Fong), is the dam of last week's 400,000gns December Foal Sale top lot, a Galileo (Ire) colt bought by Demi O'Byrne. Ask for the Moon, who was covered by Holy Roman Emperor, is offered from James Hanly's Ballyhimikin Stud.

Offerings from the Niarchos Family's Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard always have a big following, and this year's pick could be [lot 1384](#), four-year-old Strawberry Pledge (Kingmambo), who is offered in foal to Pivotal (GB). She is a full-sister to G1 Oaks winner Light Shift (Kingmambo).

Tattersalls marketing director Jimmy George commented yesterday: "Our 2009 sales have--almost without exception--exceeded expectations, which has given the industry a real shot in the arm. We've got a good, solid catalogue as ever this week, and the sales paddocks have been very busy on Sunday with a real cross-section of buyers from all over the world." The sale runs today through Thursday, starting at 10 a.m. each day.

**Bailey Holds Court...**

Alan Bailey is adept at profiting from thrifty purchases, and the shrewd Newmarket trainer expects a healthy return when he consigns two of his bargain buys at the Tattersalls December Sale.

Bailey paid just €10,000 for Aspen Darlin (Ire) (Indian Haven {GB}) as a yearling at Tattersalls Ireland in September 2007, and the filly--who sells as [lot 1412](#) here--went on to more than repay that outlay in a fantastic juvenile campaign last year.

Racing in the colors of the Indian Haven Syndicate, which also owns her G1 Irish 2000 Guineas-winning sire, Aspen Darlin won three of 10 juvenile starts, including the G3 Firth of Clyde S. over six furlongs. The bay filly out of the unraced Manuka Magic (Key Of Luck) also finished a close second in the G1 Cheveley Park S. and filled the same berth behind this season's G1 E.P. Taylor S. heroine Lahaleeb (Ire) (Redback {GB}) in the G2 Rockfel S.

Aspen Darlin's career was cut short by a freak accident on her sole three-year-old outing in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket in May, won by Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway).

"She would have achieved a lot more but for the injury she picked up," commented Bailey. "She half sat down in the stalls before the 1000 Guineas and the tendon came over the hock. It's a very painful injury and she pulled like mad due to the pain. Jimmy [Quinn] managed to get her pulled up, and she's fine for breeding but not for racing."

I picked her up for €10,000, and her Balmont half-brother sold for 115,000gns at Tattersalls in October, so we were pleased to see that."

Bailey believes Aspen Darlin has the right attributes to make a successful breeding proposition, given her obvious game attitude and evident ability.

"What people don't realize is that she ran in three group races in 19 days," Bailey said. "She won the Group 3, was beaten a half-length in the Cheveley Park and was second in the Rockfel when drawn on the wrong side of the track. She is not very big, but is as tough as can be," he remarked. "Her ears would go back and she would battle. Aside from the freak injury, she was very sound. That injury tends to happen more to steeplechasers and eventers. It was terribly bad luck and, while I don't think she would have beaten Ghanaati, I'm certain she would have made the frame [in this year's 1000 Guineas]. The owners own Indian Haven, and initially she was to be sold at the end of her two-year-old career. They had so much fun that they decided to keep her as a three-year-old and then the injury happened, which was unfortunate."

Bailey will also offer [lot 1413](#), Spiritual Healing (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). The three-year-old filly was bought for a mere 6,000gns at Tattersalls in May, having sold at Goffs in November 2006 for €55,000 and for 68,000gns at Doncaster as a yearling the following August.

Despite not racing since winning a Southwell maiden for Jamie Osborne in February this year--the second of two career starts--Bailey's investment already looks to have been inspired, given the subsequent exploits of her year-younger half-brother Big Audio (Ire) (Oratorio). The juvenile won twice in listed company this year--including the Chesham S. at Royal Ascot--and sold for 175,000gns at Tattersalls last month.

The pair's unraced dam, Tarbela (Ire) (Grand Lodge), is out of the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third Tarwiya (Ire) (Dominion {GB}), who is from the wider family of this season's unbeaten G1 Prix Morny victor Arcano (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}).

"I bought Spiritual Healing at Tattersalls in May out of the Mountgrange Stud dispersal, and she's a well-bred filly," Bailey said. "I own a half [interest] with Peter Gleason. I bought her, because I had one in the race she won at Southwell. It wasn't the hottest race, but she beat the odds-on favorite and was as green as grass. When she went to the sale, I liked her and actually thought I would have to pay a lot more than I did."

"She had setbacks at Jamie Osborne's, which I didn't know until I got her," he continued. "She came right, but we thought we would leave her. I had sold half to Peter and he wanted to put her in this sale. I would have quite liked to have run her because I am sure she would have won again. She does look like she will make a cracking broodmare; she is a very good-looking filly. They will both go to Tattersalls and hopefully, they will sell nicely. I have no say with regard to Aspen Darlin but, if Spiritual Healing doesn't make the right money, we will get her covered by a good sire ourselves."

### *All Eyes on 'Lashes'...*

A champion at a mile, 10 and 12 furlongs, Lush Lashes (Ire) (Galileo) is a rare commodity. Catalogued as [lot 1389](#), Jim Bolger's filly is the pick of an enticing draft being offered at Park Paddocks from her trainer's Glebe House Stables in County Carlow. After securing the Goffs Fillies' Million at The Curragh on her career debut as a two-year-old in September 2007, Lush Lashes went on to be crowned champion Irish filly at the aforementioned three distances in 2008. Her stellar three-year-old season included Group 1 victories in the Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, the Yorkshire Oaks and the Matron S., as well as near-misses in the G1 Nassau S. and G1 Prix de l'Opera. *Cont. p6*

Bolger bought the filly as a yearling for €80,000 at Goffs in September 2006, and raced her in the colors of his wife, Jackie. Out of the winning mare Dance For Fun (GB) (Anabaa), Lush Lashes is from the family of G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero Saumarez (GB) (Rainbow Quest) and this season's Group 1-placed juvenile Buzzword (GB) (Pivotal {GB}).

"I have a partner in Lush Lashes and my partner isn't interested in breeding, so she has to be sold," Bolger revealed. "She was champion Irish filly at a mile, a mile and a quarter and a mile and a half, so her class is there for all to see. She is also the only horse in the world to win a race worth a million first time out."

The Bolger consignment numbers 13 and includes a further trio of Pattern race winners, alongside a clutch of fillies who did not quite live up to their exciting pedigrees when tested on the track.

"It's a good group of fillies we have going there," remarked Bolger. "Oh Goodness Me was third in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and is a Group 3 winner. She is from a very good family and is a really attractive mare. She is a very good model as are all of them. Maoineach (Congaree) [lot 1391] is a medium-sized filly, but she is a good-bodied filly and was very quick, as she showed when winning Group 3 races at six and seven furlongs. "Prima Luce (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) [lot 1392] is a very attractive mare and is a Group 3 winner at seven furlongs. She is in foal to Shamardal who is the number one first-season sire, so hopefully she will prove popular."

Athasi S. heroine Prima Luce is out of the unraced Ramona (GB) (Desert King {Ire}), a half-sister to G1 Irish 2000 Guineas runner-up Verglas (Ire) (Highest Honor) and Group 2-winning sprinter Cassandra Go (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), herself the dam of multiple Group 1 winner Halfway To Heaven (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}).

With Prima Luce's departure, Bolger is pleased to welcome the four-year-old mare's yearling half-brother to his yard. John Ferguson purchased the colt for 90,000gns at Tattersalls in October.

"We just got her Shamardal half-brother today to train for Sheikh Mohammed," Bolger said. "He arrived this morning, so the connection will be continued."

Fluid foal trade at Tattersalls last week has left Bolger optimistic of a good sale. That positivity is no doubt boosted by glancing at the page of a filly like [lot 1426](#), Angels Story, and seeing the bold names of G1 Oaks winner Love Divine (GB) (Diesis) and her G1 St Leger-winning offspring Sixties Icon (GB) (Galileo).

"They're a nice consignment; we have a lot of nice fillies," the Derby-winning handler commented. "Angels Story for instance has two Classic winners on her page and is a very attractive mare. Everything is selling well, so I would be going there confident that it will be a strong sale. But no doubt there will be bargains for some people as well."

**No Place Like Home...**

A pair of globe-trotting fillies are due to step out at Tattersalls this week having earned their Group 1-stripes racing out of trainer Mick Channon's historic West Ilsley Stables.

Lahaleeb (Ire) (Redback {GB}) heads to Park Paddocks fresh from a career high victory in the GI E.P. Taylor S. at Woodbine, while stablemate Eva's Request (Ire) (Soviet Star), consigned by Rathbarry Stud, is set to appear at Newmarket having not long stepped off a return flight from Japan.

A Group 2 winner over seven furlongs as a juvenile, Lahaleeb scored over the same distance in Group 3 company on her three-year-old debut and then claimed the runner-up berth in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas over a mile. The filly is from the Cheveley Park Stud family that has produced Group 1 winners Entrepreneur (GB) (Sadler's Wells), Virtual (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), Exclusive (GB) (Polar Falcon) and Echelon (GB) (Danehill).

Lahaleeb stretched out over 10 furlongs to wrap up her 2009 campaign with Grade I success in Canada, and Channon believes that her racing days need not be over yet.

"Lahleeb has got another good year or two in her if they want to race her, but if it is decided that she goes to stud, well she can do either," Channon remarked. "She's from a good family. She was very good in the Irish 1000 Guineas and it was unfortunate that the ground was too firm in the English 1000 Guineas. We should have learnt our lesson after Newmarket, but we ran on fast ground again, which we shouldn't have. But you run them for big money and you have a go. She came right again at the backend in the E.P. Taylor S., and now we will see how she gets on at the sales. The owners are coming over from Kuwait, so I will see them there. I would have thought they would want a good price for her, they certainly will not let her go cheap."

Channon also plotted the top-flight success of Eva's Request, who improved throughout the season. A Group 3 winner over seven furlongs as a juvenile in 2007, the four-year-old scored in the G3 Princess Elizabeth S. at Epsom in June and enhanced her reputation with a lucrative success over a mile in the Tur-2 Istanbul Trophy in September.

A first attempt at 10 furlongs the following month brought victory in the G1 Premio Lydia Tesio at the Capannelle in Rome and then she made a good effort to finish a close 10th in a bizarre renewal of the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto, Japan, Nov. 22.

"Eva's Request has had a great season," reflected Channon. "Although she got beaten in Japan last time, she was beaten barely three lengths, and it was a

strange race. At least we tried to go and win the race, whereas a lot of them just flew at the finish. She proved herself in the Group 1 in Italy and before that in Turkey, and she won the Group 3 on Derby Day as well. She is a high-class filly and is also from a good family. She is a half-sister to a

Group 1 winner, so she has a pedigree to go with her talent. I would hope she would make a lot of money for the owner."

Eva's Request was knocked down to owner Liam Mulryan for €150,000 at Goffs in September 2006, and the Galway property developer also purchased her half-sister, the G1 Moyglare Stud S. heroine Priory Belle (Ire) (Priolo), for 170,000gns at the 2007 Tattersalls December Mares Sale.

"I think there is another season of racing in Eva's Request if whoever buys her wants to go that route," Channon opined. "There are a lot more good options for fillies and mares now. When your are running for a quarter of a million or for \$350,000 like in the E.P. Taylor, there are lots of races, so owners are tending to keep fillies in training more. Speaking as a trainer, they're no good to me when they're sold, they can't win races for me when they're in the paddock, but I fully understand the economics of it all. As an individual, Eva's Request is a very nice filly--she is rangy--and, while Lahaleeb is not perfectly correct, she is a real nice filly. But they are racehorses and they can't be everything. They will both certainly make good broodmares, but they are race mares first and they have been fantastic in that respect. "I don't think the owners of either filly will let them go for a bargain. If the money is right, someone will have a nice filly on their hands with either one. And I'd love to train them!"

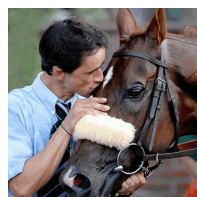

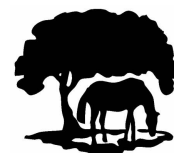
