GOLDEN RULE

No track record. No nine-length margin of victory. No matter. WinStar Farm's **Rule** (Roman Ruler), who smashed the track record when demolishing the competition in the Nov. 6 Jean Lafitte S. on the eve of the Breeders' Cup, received a much sterner test in Friday night's GIII Delta Jackpot S. That came in the form of **Uh Oh Bango** (Top Hit), who'd posted the year's top two-year-old Beyer (102) when winning the Prairie Meadows Freshman S. Sept. 18. The Jackpot, competitive on paper, boiled down to a virtual match race between the two most dominant horses--figure-wise--in the race, with odds-on Rule getting just the better of his game foe in the finish. "He had to work today," winning jockey John Velazquez said. "It was a little different than it was when he was here before, quite bit heavier. Once I got after him, he put in a good fight. It was well done. He wasn't allowing (Uh Oh Bango) to go by. He did just enough." Produced by a half-sister to 2003 GI Kentucky Derby winner Funny Cide (Distorted Humor), Rule showed gradual improvement this summer, following up on a debut third at Belmont July 19 with a runner-up effort at Saratoga Sept. 5. He wired the field in a one-mile Belmont maiden Oct. 8 before his overwhelming performance in the Bayou four weeks back.

"Benny always came to run and was long one of my favorites at the barn," said Michael lavarone, president of IEAH Stables. "He gave us plenty of thrills and his ability and heart cannot be questioned." The G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and GI Frank J. de Francis Memorial Dash S. hero has been acquired by Greg James. James, who purchased Benny the Bull for \$38,000 as a KEESEP yearling, sold a majority interest in the dark bay following an eye-catching score in the

In the barn of Dale Romans, you need to speak up if you're a member of the fairer sex, as the shedrow contains the likes of MGSW Sassy Image (Broken Vow) and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf victress Tapitsfly (Tapit). Quiet Temper had been just a touch slower to come around, finishing a well-beaten second to next-out SW Proud Zoe (Proud Accolade) in her six-furlong bow at Saratoga Aug. 10 before missing by a neck at the Spa over seven panels Sept. 6. Stretched to Belmont's one-turn mile

Oct. 4, she was forced to play second fiddle yet again, this time to subsequent GIII Tempted S. winner Ailalea (Pulpit). Four wide into the first turn, but never far from the pace of favored Truth and Justice (Yes It's True), Quiet Temper raced wide out into the track on the backstretch, took command with a rush leaving the turn and rocketed clear."She broke really sharp and placed herself forwardly going into the first turn," Albarado said. "On the second turn I squeezed her a little bit and she just took off with her ears pricked. She looks like she will go on. She galloped out awfully nice crossing the wire. She'll be fun next year." Truth and Justice took a bad step in the stretch and was eased home by jockey Joe Bravo.

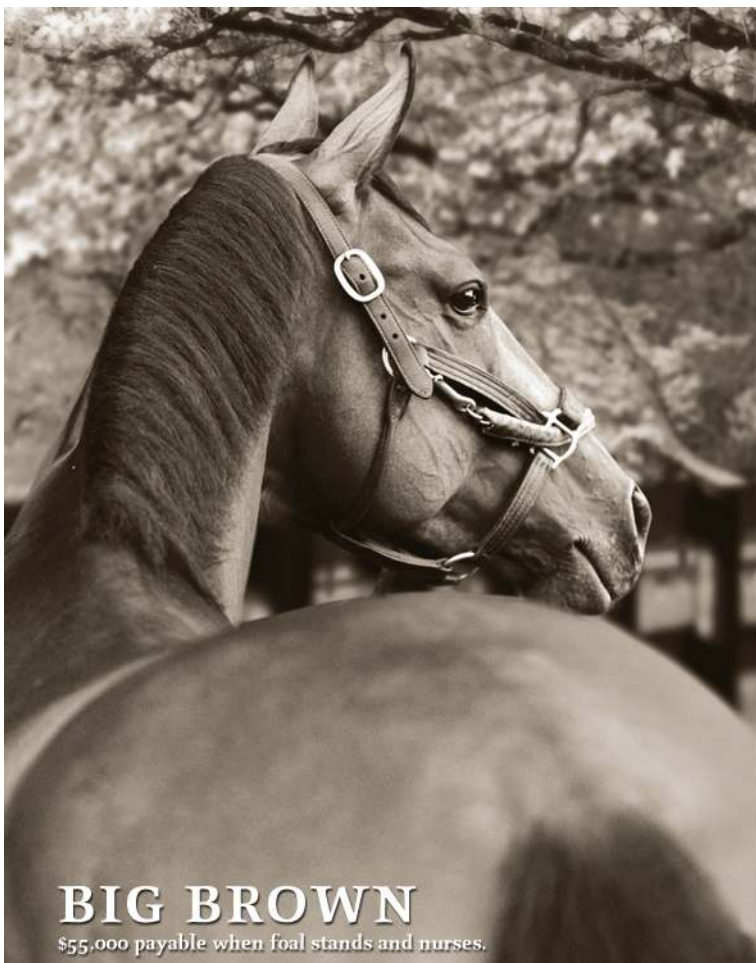

DEAUVILLE CURTAIN CLOSER GETS UNDER WAY With most of Europe's major auctions now done, today sees the switching of attention to Deauville for Arqana's December Sale, which acts as a season finale.

With the statistics holding up in Kildare and Newmarket, hopes are high that the first three days of mares and foals and Tuesday's Yearling Sale will compare favorably with the 2008 renewal. That saw the subsequent G1 Prix

Jean Romanet heroine **Alpine Rose (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) sold as the top price of €550,000, and she graces the front cover this time alongside fellow high-class graduates **Jukebox Jury (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}). The latter sold three years ago as a yearling for just €39,000.

With the emphasis on youth, the 559 mares catalogued contain 77 black-type performers and 16 group winners, while among the 186 foals are the first representatives of Authorized (Ire), Dylan Thomas (Ire), Lawman (Fr), Manduro (Ger), Rail Link (GB), Stormy River (Ire) and Turtle Bowl (Ire). Most are eligible to the French premiums. Two notable additions to the catalogue were recently announced. They are [hip 20](#), the Haras du Logis-consigned six-year-old black-type earner **Mrs Snow (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) from the immediate family of Wiener Walzer (Ger) (Dynaformer) in foal to New Approach (Ire); and Haras de Saint Pair's [hip 50](#), a filly foal by Street Cry (Ire) out of the 2006 GII Honey-moon Breeders' Cup H. and GII San Clemente H. winner Attima (GB) (Zafonic). Eric Hoyeau, executive president of Arqana, commented, "Once again this year we will have major international buyers attending the sale and being active in all segments. We expect three different Japanese groups and one from Australia and New Zealand. Even though the exchange is not very favourable to them, Americans will be there, as they are always in search of French blood and are especially interested in fillies out of training. There will be people from Turkey, who have been quite active in Ireland and here last year. There will be also buyers from all European countries, and we have had a lot of communication in Eastern Europe. We also expect, as every year, people from Tunisia and Morocco and new clients from Libya. There were a few mares with French blood on other markets in Europe, and that shows how much vendors trust the Arqana sale. There are a lot of black-type fillies out of training, Classic winners, Group 1 and Group 2 winners with some exceptional pedigrees. Maybe we lack some young mares in foal, but it is a trend worldwide, as there are very few available on the market. In the past, French breeders didn't like selling foals too much because most of them were exported and were not eligible for French premiums anymore, but pinhookers now fully understand that it is best to keep them in France and sell them back here in order for the yearlings to keep that eligibility." 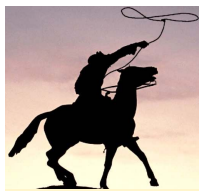

RACING Round-Up

PENNSYLVANIA STAKES LOSE GRADES Citing the failure to meet the drug testing protocol as set out by the American Graded Stakes Committee and the trustees of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, the 2009 renewals of the GII Pennsylvania Derby, GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. and the GIII Presque Isle Downs Masters S. will be recorded as ungraded events. As a precondition for graded stakes races to remain eligible to retain their grade, the AGSC requires that more extensive analytical testing be performed on samples collected from horses participating in graded stakes. The grades for the 2010 have been reinstated providing that the requirements of the committee's protocol are met.

WOOD MEMORIAL ANCHORS NYRA STAKES

Officials at the New York Racing Association have announced the stakes schedule for the 2010 winter/spring meeting, which begins Jan. 1. Anchoring the 10 graded stakes on the calendar, as always, is the GI Wood Memorial, the traditional New York prep for the GI Kentucky Derby, to be held Saturday, Apr. 3. "In the current economic climate and with other racing jurisdictions reducing racing days and adjusting their stakes schedule, we feel that it is prudent to make the decision on the Aqueduct stakes program only at this time," NYRA President and CEO Charles Hayward said. "We plan to monitor and review handle trends over the next three months, which will allow us to keep the proper balance between the stakes program and the overnight purses going forward." Shelved from the 2010 stakes schedule is the GII Bed O'Roses H.; it will be replaced by the GII Distaff S. over the same seven-furlong distance. Also on hiatus is the \$100,000 Next Move H., which was downgraded to ungraded from Grade III. In its place, NYRA is reviving the historic Ladies' H., to be run over nine furlongs Mar. 27. In other changes, the GIII Comely S. for three-year-old fillies will see its purse cut to \$100,000 from \$150,000 after it was downgraded, and the purse money for the GI Carter H. Apr. 3 will be \$250,000, down from \$300,000 in 2009.

Queen's Plate to Be Run in July:

The Queen's Plate, the first leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, has been pushed back next year to Sunday, July 4, from its traditional spot on the calendar on the third Sunday in June, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The publication says that no official reason was given for the postponement, but speculation exists that the race was moved to coincide with a visit from Queen Elizabeth II, who will be in Canada from June 28 through July 6. It would mark the first time since 1997 that the Queen was on hand for the Plate and the second time since 1973. "We'll have to play with the rest of the stakes schedule a little bit to accommodate the preps," Steve Lym, racing secretary and director of racing at Woodbine, told *DRF*.

Officials at Woodbine Entertainment Group, which operates Woodbine Racetrack, have announced that David S. To coincide with the occasion of the 75th anniversary of Santa Anita Park in Arcadia, California, officials at the track have announced that a life-sized bronze statue of the immortal John Henry will be unveiled on opening day of the winter/spring meet Dec. 26. Sculpted by Nina Kaiser, the statue will stand 15.2 hands and will weigh about 1000 pounds. "Without a doubt, John Henry was one of the most popular horses to ever compete here at Santa Anita and he probably meant more to our sport and to our business than any other horse you can think of in the 1980s," said Santa Anita President Ron Charles. "He was immensely popular with our fans because I think people related to him on so many levels." When he was retired in 1985, John Henry was racing's all-time money earner with \$6,591,860. John Henry resided at the Kentucky Horse Park from 1986 until his death at the age of 32 in 2007. The statue unveiling takes place in the Paddock Gardens following the third race on opening day.
