## KINSALE KING RULES UNDERWOOD

**Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor) took charge soon after the break and determinedly held off **Delta Storm** (Storm Boot) to give trainer Carl O'Callaghan the first stakes

victory of his young career in yesterday's Gill Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood Park. "I was confident, very confident," said O'Callaghan, who celebrates his 34th birthday today. "He trained so good going into the race. He's got a lot of heart, and that's what it's all about--heart." Kinsale King, breaking from the rail, drifted out at the break and bumped **Machismo** (Trippi), but was soon straightened and set fractions of :23.23, :46.53 and :58.00 with Delta Storm in close attendance. He opened up in upper stretch, but Delta Storm closed the gap late to just miss by a neck. "The first time I rode him, I found out he's a much better horse on the lead, so I was going to send him no matter what," winning rider Martin Garcia said. "I let him get comfortable on the lead. He has so much heart, he keeps going and going, he wasn't going to let anyone by. He's just a different horse when he's in front. Especially today, he ran with some really nice horses. I was surprised the way he won last time, but not today." **Cont. p3**

## PRIVATE SALE BOOSTS ARQANA SUNDAY

Arqana's December Breeding Stock Sale took on a more low-key air yesterday after a tumultuous first day's trading, and it was a private sale which topped proceedings at €140,000. Consigned by Haras du Mezeray as [hip 419](#), **Plata de Ley** (Elusive Quality) is a three-year-old daughter of Highest Standard (Silver Deputy), who is herself a half to the Niarchos family's great queen Coup de Folie (Halo). Bought back initially, the relative of Machiavellian was later sold to Sylvain Vidal who said, "This one is destined to be bred to Le Havre (Ire). I was happy to secure that deal privately, as she is a very good-looking filly, but more than anything else, she hails from a superb, outstanding family, and you can't ask for much more in terms of pedigree." **Cont. p3**

## KEY TO THE 'CITY'

**Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure) continued his upward trajectory with a front-running score as the 2-1 favorite in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup Dirt, which carried a purse of approximately \$3 million. Owned by Yushun Horse, the four-year-old had won seven of his last nine starts, but had yet to pick up a Group 1 tally. He opened his 2009 campaign with two losses before he found his best form, and he entered this spot off three consecutive victories. "His training towards this race had gone smoothly, and I am happy that he was able to produce his ability to his fullest in this race," said winning trainer Akio Adachi. "He is still a baby in many ways and has room for improvement, but physically, he has matured considerably. [Jockey] Tesuzo Sato has devoted his time in helping out with his training--he had problems of leaning on the bit--and I think the efforts have enabled him to put his full power to use. As for his future plans, including possible overseas endeavors, that will have to be discussed with the owners."

Second on seasonal bow in the G3 Heian S. at Kyoto Jan. 25, Espoir City was denied top honors by 1 1/2 lengths when fourth in the G1 February S. at Tokyo Feb. 22. The chestnut earned his first international group victory with a score in the G3 March H. at Nakayama Mar. 29, and followed that effort with a 3/4-length triumph over last year's Japan Cup Dirt winner Kane Hekili (Jpn) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) in the May 5 Kashiwa Kinen at Funabashi. The four-year-old returned from his summer break in the Morioka's Championship Nambu Hai Oct. 12, and made short work of his 14 opponents with a four-length victory. Favored here off that effort, Espoir City quickly seized the lead and was allowed to dictate terms under a snug hold as he was tracked by Tizway (Tiznow) in second. He opened on the field under minimal urging at the top of the stretch, increased the margin when set down for the drive and was geared down once safe. "[Espoir City] was able to cruise comfortably until the last turn, at which point I was met with my next concern--which was his habit of leaning on the bit--but his training paid off, and I am really happy," said winning jockey Tetsuzo Sato. "It has always been my dream to challenge overseas--my chance to go to the Arc with Tap Dance City (Pleasant Tap) was canceled due to injury--and meeting up with Espoir City has revived my hopes. I know Espoir City has a lot more room for improvement, and with a little more experience racing in various positions--he doesn't need to have the lead--I know he can be competitive in big races overseas." Tizway (Tiznow), third in the G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup and the only foreign starter in the field of 16, dropped back leaving the backstretch and faded further in the stretch to finish 12th. **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#) or the free [brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#). Kinsale King, making just his sixth career start, was a maiden winner at Santa Anita in March of 2008, but was off the board in two outings for trainer Eoin Harty. Transferred to O'Callaghan's barn for his last start, the four-year-old gelding returned from 10 months on the sidelines to blitz six furlongs in 1:08 2/5 while winning an Oct. 30 optional claimer at Santa Anita by three lengths as a 61-1 longshot. "He's always had trouble with his feet--he's had a lot of quarter crack problems," O'Callaghan said, explaining his charge's lengthy absence. "My blacksmith has been there every day with me, side by side, nursing him through the feet. We loved him last time, but he wasn't 60-1 today, was he?" # Arqana December Sale

A pair of fillies shared the top spot on €100,000 during yesterday's second session of the Arqana December Breeding Stock Sale. First of those was the Freddy Head-consigned [hip 352](#), the three-year-old **Belesta (GB)** (Xaar {GB}), whose group-winning dam Bellarida (Fr) (Bellypha {Ire}) has also produced the talented trio of Bellona (Ire) (Bering {GB}), In Clover (GB) (Inchiner {GB}) and Bayourida (Slew o' Gold). The latter is responsible for this year's G2 Prix Hocquart runner-up Telluride (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}), who took the Listed Prix Vulcain at Deauville in October. Hubert Guy of BMS Bloodstock was not to be denied and commented, "I bought this filly as a broodmare prospect for Mr. Lemoine Boucaud of Haras de Rabodanges. She has the pedigree--being from a strong family--and the looks but, even though she is a winner, we would like to improve her race record and have her earn some black type before going to stud. This is why the immediate plan is to send her back in training and see from there." Thirty lots later, that price was matched by Vidal for Michel Roussel's four-year-old **Isanou (Fr)** (Zamindar) ([hip 382](#)), who captured this year's Listed Prix Miss Satamixa. "Like all the mares I have bought recently at various sales, she is to go to Le Havre for his first season at stud in 2010," her buyer said. "Within our budget, we try to get a good balance between breeding and race record, and we seek young mares that have never been bred or have had one or two foals at the most. This one lacks a little bit of pedigree, but she is gorgeous and has the right race record." Vidal earlier paid €55,000 for a pair of fillies to bolster the first book of Gerard-Augustin Normand's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hero. [Hip 273](#), the four-year-old **Scape Grace (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), is in foal to Verglas (Ire) and is a daughter of the G3 Prix de Psyche winner Serisia (Fr) (Exit to Nowhere) from the Haras de la Louviere family that has sold well over the past few weeks. [Hip 282](#) is the three-year-old **Dasani (Fr)** (Dansili {GB}) from the Wertheimer draft and is a half to this year's G3 Prix d'Aumale runner-up Baahama (Ire) (Anabaa) from the family of Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa). **Cont. p4**

Yesterday's lack of big-selling mares, which was a contrast to the high prices witnessed during the second day 12 months ago, saw the session average of €17,571 fall by 31 percent. The median, however, was up again as the session figure of €13,000 represented an eight-percent rise and the overall median of €18,000 is up by 38 percent. Selling of the mares concludes today with a session beginning at 11 a.m.

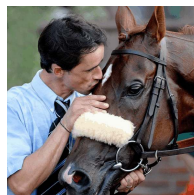

 **NORTH AMERICA** 

**RACING SYMPOSIUM BEGINS** The 36th-annual Symposium on Racing and Gaming begins today in Tucson, Arizona. Presented by the University of Arizona's Race Track Industry Program, the four-day conference encompasses various facets of the racing and casino gambling industries. Today's lone panel is the Second Annual Conference on Officiating Horseracing, which is offered in conjunction with the Racing Officials Accreditation Program. Designed for racing regulators, the panel will look at the process of successfully prosecuting a drug violation case. Tuesday will feature consecutive panels highlighting recent efforts to make regulation in North America more uniform. The first will describe an attempt to create "a broader Interstate Compact for Racing" and model legislation states can use to join the compact. Afterward, Tommy Thompson of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association will announce the findings of the Safety and Integrity Alliance following its first year of existence. Thursday will include a discussion of how drug testing thresholds should be set and will include testimony from veterinarians from throughout the United States. How racing might be able to take advantage of new technology and products is a common theme of the marketing panels. On Tuesday, Gerard Cunningham, president of Betfair's United States operations, will describe his company's plans for the U.S. market and the future of ADW platform and television network TVG, which Betfair acquired last January. A Wednesday panel will look at how racing might be able to capitalize on the growth of free video on the Internet, while a Thursday discussion will look at the impact of social media. A full Symposium schedule and list of speakers and moderators is available on the [RTIP website](#).

**F-T MIDLANTIC DECEMBER SALE TODAY** The Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed Sale begins today at 10 a.m. at the Timonium Sales Pavilion in Timonium, Maryland. A total of 344 horses have been catalogued for the one-session auction, which features mostly in-foal mares and weanlings. "We have an attractive roster of weanling sires," said Midlantic Director of Sales Paget Bennett. "There is a good cross-section of proven national stallions and rising young stars." During last year's Midlantic December sale, 186 horses sold for \$1,169,400. The average was \$6,287 and the median was \$3,000. There were 109 horses reported as not sold. 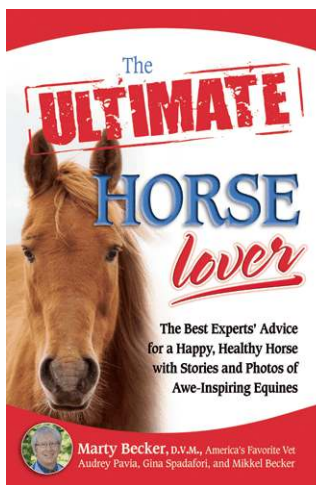
