BC BOARD APPROVES STRATEGIC PLAN

At its December meeting yesterday in Lexington, Kentucky, the Breeders' Cup Board of Directors approved a long-term strategic planning initiative, which could result in a permanent home for the Breeders' Cup World Championships. The cornerstones of the plan, according to a press release, are:

- Discussing the possibility of a single permanent host site location for the Breeders' Cup World Championships;
- To establish a new Breeders' Cup Racing Series in partnership with North American and European racetracks to help market the road to the championship event;
- Expand brand marketing and commercial development programs, with an emphasis on digital marketing and social media;
- Take a new approach to nominations to significantly expand the number of Breeders' Cup-eligible horses.

"This is the culmination of a year-long strategic planning process designed to ensure the Breeders' Cup continues to thrive and grow as one of the world's premier sporting events and as the definitive international event in our sport," said Breeders' Cup Chairman William S. Farish Jr.

Having approved these strategic recommendations, the Board has tasked the management team with developing a specific business plan in each of the four areas, with a goal of approving the final plans

at our April 2010 meetings." Satish Sanan, the BC board member who chaired the Strategic Planning Committee, added, "For 26 years, the Breeders' Cup took one approach. We understand that a new approach means significant change, but the Strategic Planning Committee believed a new approach is warranted if the property is going to evolve, adapt and grow in a changing marketplace." The Board also revealed that Matthew Lutz, who had served as the Breeders' Cup's chief financial officer since 2007, has been promoted to chief operating officer/CFO.

STATELY VISION

Excepting his two unplaced effort in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) has been a model of consistency in his 12-race career, with eight victories and two minor placings from his other starts. Trained by Eric Libaud, a former assistant to Alain de Royer-Dupre who sent out Ange Gabriel (Fr) (Kaldounevees {Fr}) to score in the 2002 Vase, Vision d'Etat defeated 19 fellow sophomores to land last year's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club and came back this season to post wins in the

G1 Prix Ganay over an extended 10 furlongs Apr. 26 and a half-length victory from Tartan Bearer (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}) in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 17. He was runner-up to Spanish Moon (El Prado {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Foy Sept. 13 before finishing a midpack 10th in the Arc. Those performances suggest he may not quite be a 12-furlong horse in top company and drops back to his best trip this weekend. "He's maturing with every run and is more laid back now that he used to be," Libaud commented. "He's more of a 'Zen' horse now. Vision d'Etat is mentally very well, which is the most important thing in this kind of challenge." Olivier Peslier, a six-time winner at the International meeting, has the call Sunday afternoon.

Balding Goes for Second Vase...

Only 36 years of age and on his own for just under seven seasons, trainer Andrew Balding has made a spectacular start to his career and shoots for a second G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase with **Buccellati (GB)** (Soviet Star). The son of the legendary Ian Balding, Andrew was an amateur rider and served his father as assistant trainer before taking over at Kingsclere Stables in January 2003. It did not take long for the junior Balding to make his mark, as he was represented by 2003 G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Casual Look (Red Ransom) in his first at bat.

Later that season, the yard was represented by Phoenix Reach (Ire) (Alhaarth {Ire}), third in the G1 St Leger S. before invading North America for a win in the G1 Pattison Canadian International S. He failed to hit the board in his first four outings of 2004, but, returned on just two weeks' rest off a deceptively good sixth in the G1 Japan Cup, came from off the pace for a 26-1 upset in that year's Vase. Phoenix Reach would go on to take the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic to complete a rare Group/Grade I trifecta. Buccellati was a progressive four-year-old in 2008, taking the Listed Godolphin S. and the G3 St Simon S. prior to a decent sixth in the Vase, two lengths behind the victorious Doctor Dino (Fr) (Muhtathir {GB}). Winner of the G3 Ormonde S. this season, he was well held when fourth to Spanish Moon (El Prado {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Foy Sept. 13, but bounced back with a solid third-place effort in this year's Canadian International Oct. 17. Balding is looking for improvement on last year's effort. "The horse seems that much better this year," he commented. "While his draw [9] is not as good as I had hoped, it is two better than last year. We are hoping for a share of the prizemoney again." William Buick, who guided Lahaleeb (Ire) (Redback {Ire}) to an upset win in the G1 E.P. Taylor S. on the International undercard, has the call.

SLIMMED-DOWN CATALOGUE FOR CXHKIS

A total of 20 two-year-olds in training, acquired at sales venues from the U.S., Europe and Australasia, is set to go under the hammer this morning (HK time) at the unique Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International Sale, to be held in the parade ring at Sha Tin Racecourse.

During last year's event, 30 horses were sold for gross receipts of HK\$87.2 million (about \$11.2 million), but this year's offering has been reduced by about 50 percent.

"Numerically, [this] will not be the biggest sale we have ever had because we are focusing on quality, and we have 20 very carefully selected individuals with conformation and pedigrees geared to Hong Kong," commented Mark Player, head of International Races, sale and development for the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "We feel we have zoned in on the right individuals, and it has been reflected with their presentation."

Previous graduates of the sale--restricted to licensed Hong Kong owners--include **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan), who sold for HK\$1.7 million in 2004 and will shoot for an unprecedented third straight victory in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile Sunday afternoon; **The Duke (Aus)** (Danehill), an HK\$1.6-million graduate who took the 2006 Mile; and **Scintillation (Aus)** (Danehill), a multiple stakes winner in Hong Kong. While the final of the mighty Danehills have made their way through this sale for the last time, there is plenty of pedigree appeal this afternoon. Among the horses expected to attract the most attention is hip **17**, a gelded son of Mr. Greeley from Shawklit Delight (Pine Bluff). Purchased for \$250,000 out of last year's Keeneland September sale, the striking chestnut made a favorable impression in his under-tack breeze-up down the Sha Tin straight last Saturday ([video](#)). He is a half-brother to Shawklit Mint (Air Forbes Won), winner of the GII Vagrancy H. Hip **13** is a son of Flying Spur (Aus), sire of Inspiration (Aus), who upset last year's G1 Hong Kong Sprint at 66-1. A son of Miss Mocha (NZ) (Senor Pete), the August foal cost A\$230,000 at Magic Millions earlier this year.

'Stardom' Bound for California...

Stardom Bound (Tapit) is slated to return to California for the GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita Jan. 17, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "That race is going to tell us everything," Michael Iavarone, co-president of IEAH Stables, told *DRF*. "If she doesn't run huge there, then we got to look at other options.

If she wants to show us she still wants to be a racehorse, we'll continue on. If she wants to show us she wants to be a mommy, we'll consider that, too." The grey filly earned championship honors in 2008 when she ran the tables in her division for trainer Chris Paasch, capped by a stirring victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Sold to IEAH Stables and partners for \$5.7 million at FTKNOV following that win, Stardom Bound captured the GI Las

Virgenes S. and GI Santa Anita Oaks for the late Bobby Frankel, then was turned over to Rick Dutrow Jr. prior to the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland. She was sidelined following that effort, and most recently had a troubled trip when fifth in the GI Gazelle S. at Aqueduct Nov. 28. "That was a failed attempt to see if she could handle kickback," Iavarone continued. "Going into the first turn, I knew we were in trouble. She looked like a corkscrew. What [jockey] Mike [Smith] did was get off the rail out in the clear and she got rank on him." Currently in Florida, Stardom Bound will be housed with Gary Stevens, who also trains IEAH colorbearer Diamondrella (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}).

Raced in Peru by Gonzalo de la Puente's Stud Altamar, Lady Shatzi annexed the G1 Clasico Enrique Ayulo Pardo (Peruvian Oaks), G1 Clasico Derby Nacional (Peruvian Derby) and that nation's premier event, the G1 Clasico Jockey Club del Peru, during her championship season. Purchased by U.S. owner

Robert Shoukry in August, Lady Shatzi finished last of eight in her first U.S. start after having reportedly bled in the GIII Spend a Buck H. at Calder Oct. 17. Peruvian classic winner **Pechito (Arg)** (Interprete {Arg}), third in the Spend a Buck, was voted champion three-year-old colt on the dirt. Claudio Pizarro's Stud El Catorce's **Morena (Per)** (Privately Held), third in the GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga and most recently second in the GII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 26, was named champion older female on dirt. U.S.-bred **Al Kadir** (Aljabr), a MGSW in Peru and third in Argentina's G1 GP Miguel A. Martinez de Hoz, received honors as champion older male on the dirt, and Kentucky-bred **Zeide Isaac** (Freud), runner-up in the South American championship G1 Gran Premio Latinoamericano in Sao Paulo, was honored as champion older male on the turf. The other champions were: **Golden Rock (Per)** (Janfranco), miler; **Precursor (Per)** (Spend One Dollar), two-year-old male; **Lady Arianna (Per)** (Play the Gold), two-year-old filly; **Maitena (Per)** (Apprentice), three-year-old turf filly; **Buen Mar (Per)** (Privately Held), three-year-old turf horse; **Pangoa (Per)** (Privately Held), turf mare; **Alado (Per)** (Apprentice), sprinter, **Privately Held** (Private Account), top sire; and **Charytin (Per)** (Summing), re-elected top broodmare. Stakes-placed Privately Held, 15, boasts Broodmare of the Year Best in Show as his third dam, making him from the family of champions Try My Best, El Gran Senor, Domedriver (Fr), Redoute's Choice (Aus), Xaar (GB), Rags to Riches and Peeping Fawn. His dam, Aviance (Ire) (Northfields), beat the boys in the G1 Phoenix S. at two, and produced G1SW Chimes of Freedom (Private Account), dam of champion Aldebaran and GISW Good Journey; SW Imperfect Circle (Riverman), dam of champion Spinning World; and MGISW Denon (Pleasant Colony).
