## INTERACTION BESTS ELDERS IN PELLEGRINI

**Interaction (Arg)** (Easing Along), winner of the G1 Gran Premio Raul y Raul E. Chevalier as a juvenile, opened his three-year-old season with a four-length score in the G2 Clasico Ensayo Sept. 19, and entered

this spot off a nose victory in an Argentine classic, the Oct. 17 G1 Gran Premio Jockey Club. Off as the second choice here, he weaved through traffic in the stretch under a perfect ride from Peruvian maestro Edwin Talaverano--who picked up his fourth victory in South America's

most prestigious race and swept all three Group 1 events on the card--to deny Argentina's reigning Horse of the Year and last year's Pellegrini winner **Life of Victory (Arg)** (Incurable Optimist) a repeat score. Brazilian Group 1 winner **Jeune-Turc** was third. Interaction, who gave owner-breeder Jorge Cardemil of Chile his first victory in this race, becomes the first Pellegrini winner for his Argentine-based sire. ## STOUTE SHOTS FOR VASE WITH MOON

Sir Michael Stoute conditioned Daliapour (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) to a popular victory in the 2000 G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase and holds a strong hand as he bids for another this afternoon with Juddmonte Farms' **Spanish Moon** (El Prado {Ire}). It's been a very successful campaign for the five-year-old, who has wins in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and G2 Prix Foy in addition to a near miss in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. He enters this off a fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 7, but has thrived in the five weeks since. "He has arrived very well in Hong Kong and I was pleased with that piece of work," Stoute said after watching his charge gallop Friday. "This has been the plan with him for some time, I think he will like the track and he is still relatively fresh as this is just his fifth start of the year." **CX Hong Kong Vase cont. p5**

**Presvis** looks to join Jim and Tonic (Fr) (Double Bed {Fr}) in 1999 and Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) in 2005 to record victories in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup and this event in the same calendar year. Runner-up in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. prior to his QE II success in April, the five-year-old was extremely unlucky to miss by a neck in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup the following month. Rested with an eye on a return trip to the Orient, he resurfaced with a runner-up effort in the Listed Churchill S. over the Lingfield Poly Nov. 21, a race he is likely to have needed. "I hope that he has taken some improvement from his last run, because this is certainly a tougher

Prior to his win in last year's Cup, **Eagle Mountain** was an excellent runner-up to Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, but the situation is vastly different this time around. Sidelined for most of the year with a suspensory problem, the five-year-old was reportedly carrying too much condition when a well-beaten ninth in the International Mile Trial Nov. 22. "His fitness was the reason for his average run first-up," Stephen Jell, travelling foreman for trainer Mike DeKock told *SCMP*. "He has got the ability to win on Sunday, but it has just been a rushed preparation." **Vision d'Etat** was 10th in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 4, but returns to the trip over which he won the G1 Prix Ganay and G1 Prince of Wales's S. earlier this year. Hong Kong Derby hero **Collection** was an easy winner of the local Trial for this, but must prove he fits at this level.

(Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) in the trial for that race Nov. 22. He tries the metric mile for the first time. "Jockey Darren [Beadman] said to me after the Sprint Trial that this horse 'is a miler not a sprinter you know mate,'" related trainer

John Moore. "He might have been flat out keeping up in the Sprint, and with the owner's blessing, we've decided the Mile is the better option. I have no qualms about him getting the mile. He's a lovely, lengthy horse with one of the best strides a horse could have, and that comment comes from a great jockey like Darren. His stride is huge. For raw talent he's definitely the best horse I've had and he's a much stronger, better and wiser horse this time in."

"The horse himself has come along really well, everything has gone to plan," trainer Derek Cruz told *SCMP*. "He gave me more confidence with his last run--he wasn't going to finish anywhere, then really closed the race off. Now he's fully fit, he's really reaching for the ground in his work. He'll run a big, big race." **Alexandros**, the G1 Lockinge S. runner-up and Dubai Duty Free third, looks the best of the raiders.

**All Silent** looks to carry the Sprint title back to Australia for the first time since 2001. Winner of the 2008 G1 Emirates S. over 1600 meters, the bay came from well back to take the G2 Gilgai S. at Flemington Oct. 3

before returning to Group 1 glory in the Patinack Farm Classic Nov. 7. His wide barrier is of little concern to connections. "I've told [jockey] Nick [Hall] to ride him the same way as he has been in Melbourne and that's quietly," trainer Grahame Begg commented. Added Hall, "He's kicking and

squealing on the track. I can't believe how good he feels." Begg has tasted success at the International meeting before, sending out Monopolize (Aus) (Rubiton {Aus}) to back-to-back wins in the Hong Kong Bowl in 1995 and 1996.

**Sacred Kingdom**, victorious in the 2007 Sprint, annexed the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint at Kranji in May before weakening up the hill to finish fifth in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 20. His first-up run in the Nov. 22 Sprint Trial should prove useful, as he looked the winner in the final furlong before succumbing to Happy Zero's punishing late run. Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint winner **California Flag** should be the main speed from post four, and has done well since his arrival in Hong Kong. "He is not tucked up which is a really good sign for this horse," said trainer Brian Koriner. "I'd love him to have been just a little more relaxed, as he has been a bit hyped-up every morning, but maybe that's just because he's feeling good. Everybody expects he might go too hard on the speed but he can come back to the rider. He's just a naturally fast horse."

**Viva Pataca (GB)** (Marju {Ire}) makes a fourth appearance at the International meeting, his best result coming in a runner-up effort as the 3-10 chalk behind Ramonti (Fr) (Martino Alonso {Ire}) in the 2007 Cup. The seven-year-old was a solid fourth to Packing Winner (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) when both were first up in a domestic Group 3 over 1600 meters Oct. 25, but there were fewer excuses when he could do no better than split the field of 14 in the Nov. 15 International Cup Trial won by Collection (Ire) (Peintre Celebre).

A trio of horses from last year's Vase returns, headed by **Jaguar Mail (Jpn)** (Jungle Pocket {Jpn}), who closed strongly to be third by a neck at odds of 5-2. He has been off form since and adds blinkers for the first time today. **Youmzain (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) was a little more than two lengths behind Spanish Moon in the Sheema in fourth, but has not missed the top three in four subsequent appearances in some of Europe's most important races. Winner of the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 6, the Jaber Abdullah colorbearer was most recently second for the third straight season in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 4.

Fillies and mares have left their mark on the International races, and this year's running is not short on females, with five spread across the four races. The Vase has been won on three occasions by fillies, most recently by **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in 2005. **Black Mamba (NZ)** (Black Minnaloushe), purchased by Hong Kong-based Siu Pak Kwan for \$1.5 million at FTKNOV, gave a good account of herself when facing males in the 2008 GI Hollywood Turf Cup, finishing fourth by two lengths to the high-class **Champs Elysees (GB)** (Danehill). She is joined in the Vase by the Aga Khan's **Daryakana (Fr)** (Selkirk), who puts a perfect record of four-for-four on the line in her first try against the boys. The Mile was won in dramatic front-running fashion by the late **Sunline (NZ)** (Desert Sun {GB}) in 2000, while the Aga Khan's **Darjina (Fr)** (Zamindar) flew home to just miss in third to **Good Ba Ba (Lear Fan)** in 2007. American-bred **Sweet Hearth (Touch Gold)** represents France and rates a longshot look off her runner-up effort in the G1 Prix de la Foret Oct. 3, a race in which **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) was a half-length back in third. Though **Queen Spumante (Jpn)** (Jungle Pocket {Jpn}) looks up against it in the Cup, she should at least have some say in the outcome. In her 76-1 upset of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 15, she opened a long lead and never came back to the field. Whether she can do that this afternoon remains a huge question. The green and red silks of the Aga Khan will be carried astride **Ashalanda (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), who enters the Cup off a score in the G2 Pride S. at Newbury Oct. 17. That race is named in honor of the diminutive filly who just missed in the 2005 Cup before exacting revenge the following December. Alexander Goldrun (Ire) (Gold Away {Ire}) registered a breakthrough success for the fairer sex in the 2003 Cup, just lasting over local favorite **Bullish Luck (Royal Academy)**.

**Vision d'Etat Cup Status in Some Doubt...**

It's bad timing because it's nothing really that serious at all--in a day or two he'll be fine so let's hope it clears up quickly." Stewards later issued a statement, explaining that Vision d'Etat will be subjected to a race-day veterinary examination following which a decision will be made as to his ability to take his place in the Cup field.

**Cirrus des Aigles Exits Productive Heat...**

The G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris has produced two previous winners of the G1 Hong Kong Vase--**Ange Gabriel (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}) in 2002 and **Vallee Enchantee (Ire)** the following year. This year's winner, **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) has been something of a talking horse this week in trackwork, but must overcome an outside alley this afternoon. "The draw in 10 is a bit of concern but I am confident that his rider, Franck Blondel, will sort it out," commented trainer Corine Barande-Barbe. "He could lead, but we'll see how it develops, because they will probably go quicker here than at home in France." The sophomore has won three of his last four outings, preceding his Prix du Conseil win with another in the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange Sept. 19.

**LEE EATON DIES** Lee Eaton, founder of the sales agency that carries his name to this day, passed away Thursday, Dec. 10, in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, of natural causes following a 5 1/2-year battle with brain cancer. He was 76 years old. For 40 years, Eaton operated a sales agency that became one of the most respected and commercially successful in the industry. He operated Eaton Sales until late 1995, when he sold the business to Tom VanMeter and Reiley McDonald, and subsequently relocated to Florida. "The fact that Reiley McDonald continues to operate under the Eaton banner is a real testament to just how valuable the name is as a brand," said Ric Waldman, a close personal friend of Eaton and son of Marvin Waldman, who partnered with Eaton and Sam Lyon to breed 1976 Kentucky Derby winner Bold Forbes. Bill Betz worked for Lee Eaton in the 1970s, and credits him with being a pioneer in the business. "Lee revolutionized the professional consignment business," Betz commented. "He was the first who made a career out of it, using different techniques and technology as they became available to track horses and research pedigrees. Lee was the first one who could deal with hundreds of horses and consignments, and he was the king of that for many years. He ran a very professional farm, and was very successful as a breeder in his own right." He continued, "Lee was very intense and very demanding. He was very religious and gave back a lot to Christian organizations. He was tough to work for in that he was driven and demanding, and he expected the people who worked for him to be the same. Having said that, I couldn't have thought of a better learning experience for a young guy coming into the business." Eaton is survived by his wife, Helen, and two sons Eddie and Loren. Visitation will be held Friday, Dec. 18 at Baird-Case Funeral Home, 4343 N. Federal Highway in Fort Lauderdale. Funeral services are scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 19 at Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church, 5555 N. Federal Highway, Fort Lauderdale.
