FRANCE, HONG KONG SHINE AT SHA TIN

French invader **Vision d'Etat** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) overcame last-minute injury concerns and charged to the lead late to land the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup, the highlight of Sunday's Hong Kong International Races day at Sha Tin. The day was dominated by performances from the home team and the visiting French, with local favorite **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan) winning a record third straight G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile and **Sacred Kingdom** (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) taking his second G1



Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile. France plundered the

day's other Group 1 events, with Vision d'Etat's 3/4-length victory coming in the wake of unbeaten **Daryakana** (Fr) (Selkirk)'s victory over the boys in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase. "We have enjoyed a tremendous day's racing, one of the best we have ever staged here on this great occasion," said Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges, chief executive officer of the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "We have an attendance of over 56,000 at Sha Tin--10,000 more than last year--and the betting turnover was very healthy, the highest in seven years. It all goes to show that Hong Kong racing is vibrant and thriving. It won't be easy to take this meeting to a higher level, but that's what we strive for." Betting turnover for the day was reported over a billion Hong Kong dollars. "Today's meeting was billed as the greatest show on turf, and we believe we lived up to expectations," said William Nader, the club's executive director of racing.

French jockeys won three of the four races, with Gerald Mosse winning on Daryakana, Olivier Doleuze on Good Ba Ba and Olivier Peslier guiding Vision d'Etat home first in the Cup. Hong Kong runners filled the first four places in both the Sprint and the Mile, with local horses winning the Sprint for the eighth year running and the Mile for the fourth straight time.

NO STOPPING VISION D'ETAT

Arguably the classiest member in the field for the afternoon's richest event, **Vision d'Etat** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) was nonetheless let go as the third choice in the G1 Hong Kong Cup and made those non-believers pay dearly with a cozy success over **Collection** (Ire)

(Peintre Celebre) and **Presvis** (GB) (Sakhee). Trainer Eric Libaud was relieved his charge even made it to the post Sunday, let alone put up a superb winning effort. "It's amazing, because yesterday we thought he would not run, as he had developed an infection in his off-hind fetlock," he explained. "But we looked after him throughout the rest of the day and it improved. The club's vets did a terrific job, and I have to thank them very much." The win was the second at the International meeting for Libaud, who sent out Ange Gabriel (Fr) (Kaldounevees {Fr}) to take the Vase in 2002. Winning jockey Olivier Peslier was recording his seventh HKIR victory. **Cont. p2**

Never worse than third at distances up to 2100 meters, Vision d'Etat closed a French Derby-winning sophomore campaign with a fifth to Zarkava (Fr) (Zamindar) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Third on his seasonal return in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt Apr. 5, Vision d'Etat put together back-to-back wins at the top level, taking the Apr. 26 G1 Prix Ganay at home before carrying Olivier Peslier to a narrow success in Royal Ascot's prestigious G1 Prince of Wales's S. June 17. Freshened for a fall blitz, the four-year-old chased Spanish Moon (El Prado {Ire}), but settled for second in the G2 Prix Foy Sept. 13 before finishing a midpack 10th in this year's Arc Oct. 4. As expected, Japan's Queen Spumante (Jpn) (Jungle Pocket {Jpn}), assumed command here, but only after working a bit to get there into the first turn. Defending champion Eagle Mountain (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) got a perfect spot in centerfield, chased by Vision d'Etat with odds-on Collection watching that one's every move. The Japanese mare still held the call on the final bend, but the real action was happening behind her. Collection began a run in earnest, but Peslier countered on Vision d'Etat, keeping the local hopeful pinned down towards the fence as push came to shove at the 400-meter mark. While Collection was forced to race in traffic in upper stretch, Vision d'Etat had a much clearer run, and, while Collection did have to find some gaps, there were really few excuses, as the French raider had the superior acceleration in the run to the judge. Presvis, winner of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup over course and distance in April, stayed on late into third. "He was a bit lazy down the backstretch, but he behaves like that when he is at his best, like at Royal Ascot when he won the Prince of Wales's S.," Peslier said of the winner. "This is what he does when he is relaxed and when he is in good form. I didn't want to get to the lead too soon because I was worried he might try and stop in front. He kept fighting today." As for what is next for Vision d'Etat, trainer Eric Libaud said, "He will stay in training, and we'll have to think about Dubai next."

Little Hong Kong has produced some pretty good milers over the years, including Fairy King Prawn (Aus), Electronic Unicorn and Bullish Luck. With an unprecedented third straight victory in the G1 Hong Kong Mile, Good Ba Ba ranks with some of the greats the country has produced. Following the first of his now three wins in this event, Good Ba Ba took the 2008 G1 Champions Mile, but could do no better than fourth in defense of his title this year when the yielding ground did not suit. The recipient of a well-deserved break after that Apr. 26 event, Good Ba Ba returned to action with an even seventh in domestic Group 3 company over this distance Oct. 25. The screws were tightened just a bit more for his latest, the Nov. 22 International Mile Trial, and he finished with good energy to fill out the third spot behind Fellowship, beaten just 1 1/2 lengths. The betting public expected a changing of the guard of sorts and made Happy Zero--who pegged back Sacred Kingdom in the Sprint Trial--their odds-on favorite trying the mile for the first time. Good Ba Ba took a bump at the break and raced three from the rear, tracking intently the every move of Happy Zero, who raced a couple of spots ahead. The two were pulled out for their runs and went after pacesetter Egyptian Ra (NZ) (Woodborough), last year's third-place finisher. Happy Zero got first run, and, as they raced into the final furlong, looked like he would go on to justify the crowd's faith. But Good Ba Ba kept plugging away and drove past Happy Zero in the final 50 yards for a history-making score. The victory was especially sweet for Olivier Doleuze, who was sacked in favor of Christophe Soumillon last year. "Last year, I was sorry to lose the ride, so to be back on him again is like a dream," the Frenchman explained. "It looks like he might stay a bit longer now, now we can step him up in trip to maybe 2000 meters, because it took him a little longer than normal to really get going from the top of the straight. Having passed that test, she was given her chance in the G2 Prix de Royallieu Oct. 3, and she turned in the most impressive and convincing performance of her career, drawing off to score by 2 1/2 lengths. In a race won by such female luminaries as Borgia (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}), Vallee Enchantee (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) and Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}), Daryakana was made the third choice in her Group 1 debut. Hong Kong's Packing Winner (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) and Jackpot Delight (NZ) (Danasinga {Aus}) cut out the pace up front, while favored Spanish Moon was close up in fifth out of the straight the first time. Daryakana dropped straight out the back and was content to trail as an even tempo developed up the backstretch. Still last as they rounded the final bend, Daryakana was switched out to the grandstand side, responded when asked for her best inside the final 200 meters and pinned back Spanish Moon in the waning strides. "The pace was fast enough to help to take plenty of time in behind, because I know she has a great turn of foot," commented winning rider Gerald Mosse. "I was able to gradually pick them up, and she flew in the final 100 meters to lead on the line. She is a superb long-distance filly. She's not the biggest, but she's all heart." With nine individual Group 1 winners signed on, this year's G1 Hong Kong Sprint was positioned to be the definitive event of the season, and it was its 2007

champion who proved best and led home a top four sweep for the home team. After missing out on a title defense with notoriously bad feet, the veteran was slow to find his best form, but did so emphatically in May, taking a domestic Group 2 affair before shipping outside of Hong Kong to annex the KrisFlyer International Sprint at Kranji 16 days later. The effort

earned the gelding a trip to Royal Ascot, and he did not disgrace himself when fifth in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. June 20. Rested thereafter, he was first-up in the International Sprint Trial Nov. 22 and came to win the race in the final furlong, only to be swallowed up by Happy Zero (Aus) (Danzero {Aus}).

That he was a strong favorite here was as much a compliment to Happy Zero as it was a reflection of his own talent, and he made no mistake from close range. Sacred Kingdom actually won the break, but took back a bit to let California Flag (Avenue of Flags) and Japan's Laurel Guerreiro (Jpn) (Jungle Pocket {Jpn}) slug it out up front. The Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint hero showed the way into the lane and led deep into the final furlong, but Sacred Kingdom tackled with 100 meters to come and held One World safe to the wire. "I had a lovely run in midfield, but I didn't want to get there too quickly," winning jockey Brett Prebble admitted. "When I was coming off their backs at the top of the straight, I had to count to 10 because he's getting smarter as he gets older and he nearly pulled up on me there in the end. To be honest, I expected he would perform like that but it's great when it all works out." Joe Talamo, who was beaten under two lengths on California Flag, said his mount never got a breather. "If I hadn't had the Japanese horse taking me on, we might have been able to hang on. He was always making me do too much," he offered. 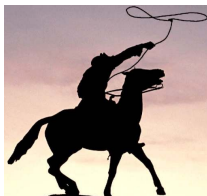

THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

December 13, 1986...Jockey **Kent Desormeaux** picked up his first stakes win, riding Godbey to victory in the Maryland City H. at Laurel.

December 15, 1973...**Sandy Hawley** became the first jockey in history to win 500 races in a single year when he rode Charlie Jr. to victory in the third race at Laurel Racecourse.

December 17, 1936...Crooner **Bing Crosby** announced plans to construct a new racetrack, to be called the Del Mar Turf Club.

December 17, 1993...Fire destroyed the 122-year-old grandstand of **Fair Grounds**, the nation's third-oldest racetrack.

Seven years ago, a filly bred by Michael Prentiss broke her maiden during the Hollywood Park fall meeting, then went on to post a 30-1 upset in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. for owner J. Paul Reddam. Named Elloluv (Gilded Time), the bay found additional success as a three-year-old, winning the GI Ashland S. and placing second in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, and sold for \$1.75 million at the following year's KEENOV sale.

This year, She's Funomenal (Fusaichi Pegasus), also bred by Prentiss's North Wales LLC, has made positive first impressions at Hollywood's fall meet. While Prentiss sold Elloluv to Reddam for \$120,000 at the 2002 KEEAPR sale, he retained an interest in She's Funomenal, whom he owns in partnership with John Stuart of Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services, STD Racing Stable, Summit Racing and trainer Jerry Hollendorfer.

Prentiss claimed the juvenile's dam Elderberry Drive (Strawberry Road {Aus}) for \$50,000 at Gulfstream back in 1996, and she was a well-beaten sixth in a Keeneland allowance in her lone start for her new connections before she was retired to broodmare duty. Even though her second foal Fistfite (Two Punch) became a graded stakes winner, her breeding early career was marked by misfortune.

"It seemed like everything we had died or got sick or one thing or another," Prentiss said.

After Prentiss sent Elderberry to Fusaichi Pegasus in 2006, the bad luck continued.

"John Stuart and I decided to breed her to Fusaichi Pegasus, and we had a very nice-looking filly," Prentiss said of She's Funomenal. "We took her to Saratoga with high expectations, but she had a rear ankle that was big. It X-rayed fine, but at the sale, it just kills you."

But it may have worked out for the best. **Cont. p4**

"We took her out of the sale, and we made a deal with Jerry Hollendorfer to sell her, but we kept a third of her," Prentiss said.

Hollendorfer later offered an interest in She's Funomenal to Brett Lindenbaum and Bob Ike of Summit Racing, who had previously declined the opportunity to buy into the eventual GI Oak Leaf S. winner and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies third Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision).

"Blind Luck was a horse I had liked a lot, but I thought was priced too high," Lindenbaum said. "Sometimes, you make those mistakes."

Opportunity would not evade Summit Racing this time.

"I knew the Fusaichi Pegasuses hadn't been doing well, but the bottom side had some runners in it," Lindenbaum said of She's Funomenal. "We had bought some good horses and had some extra money to spend, and we thought the price was right."

After her impressive maiden victory, Hollendorfer wanted to enter She's Funomenal in a NW1X allowance. However, Hollywood did not include such a race in the condition book, but instead offered the restricted Ifyoucouldseemenow S., which presented the chance to pick up black-type. Hollendorfer, who believes two turns are in the filly's future, remains optimistic after yesterday's victory, even if it wasn't as flashy as her debut performance.

"I thought it was real gutsy and she galloped out well," Hollendorfer said, "so I thought it was a good race for her." -J.F.

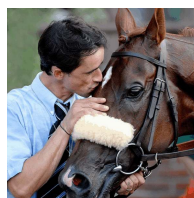

ITALY TO BE SUSPENDED FROM EBF Italy will be suspended from the European Breeders' Fund starting Jan. 1 because of its on-going failure to meet with EBF regulations, according to an EBF statement released yesterday. Despite lengthy negotiations, Italy has failed to guarantee at least 70 percent of its two-year-old maiden races will be restricted to EBF eligible horses. The suspension means Italian racing will be severely restricted in accessing EBF funding for races in 2010 and 2011. From the 2010 covering season, stallions based in Italy can pay EBF contributions to the EBF co-ordinating committee to ensure that the progeny conceived in the year the payment is made can compete in EBF races elsewhere in Europe. "This has been rumbling on for a while," EBF chief executive Sam Sheppard told *Racing Post*. "Despite the best efforts of the EBF's co-ordinating committee's Italian representative Dr. Annibale Brivio-Sforza, we have unfortunately been unable to persuade the Italian racing authorities to ensure EBF rules and regulations. Italy is one of the main European racing countries and it belongs within the EBF.
