HE'S NUMBER ONE

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) drew post one, hit the wire first and is sure to be named the champion two-year-old in America after taking yesterday's GI CashCall Futurity at Hollywood Park. Perfect in his first four career starts, the striking bay scored back-to-back wins in the GI Del Mar Futurity and GI Norfolk S., and started the 2-1 favorite in the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita. His late run came up just short that afternoon, however, and he had to settle for second, a head behind Vale of York (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). The colt was uncharacteristically far back on Breeders' Cup Day, but trainer Bob Baffert was determined the CashCall Futurity would be a different story. "I told [jockey Garrett Gomez] that I wanted him closer today," Baffert said. "We left him too much to do last time." Not Leaving It to Luck...

Lookin at Lucky came charging down the stretch in the BC Juvenile, but was bumped close to the wire and couldn't get to Vale of York. Plotting a change in tactics, Bob Baffert had the May foal on his toes for the Futurity, and this time he broke sharply from the rail and was taken in hand to sit just off fellow Baffert trainee **The Program** (Harlan's Holiday). Lookin at Lucky was on the bit as he tracked the leader from the inside early. Edging up to the frontrunner's flank on the backstretch, he was gifted an opening on the inside by his stablemate and powered through to get on even terms on the final bend. Garrett Gomez sat chilly til the stretch, then went to work, and the future Eclipse winner went about his business, holding second choice **Noble's Promise** (Cuvee) at bay late to win by a measured 3/4 of a length. Lookin at Lucky will have an abbreviated pre-Triple Crown campaign. "He'll get a break now, and I'll run him two times before the [Kentucky] Derby," Baffert remarked, adding, "I'll probably run him on dirt." It was the fourth winner on the card for Baffert, and a record fifth victory in the Futurity.

There are a couple of equipment changes to note today. **Beautician**, second in three of her four starts since earning her lone win in a maiden test at Churchill in June, dons blinkers. The grey completed the exacta behind Hot Dixie Chick (Dixie Union) in the GIII Schuylerville S. and GI Spinaway S., and was most recently a 3/4-length runner-up in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. "I think [blinkers] will help her focus," Jordan Blair, assistant to trainer Ken McPeek, told *Daily Racing Form*.

Conversely, **It Tiz** sheds the hood after running third in the Moccasin S. going seven panels at Hollywood Nov. 22. Fourth in both the GI Del Mar Debutante S. and GI Oak Leaf S., she dropped back to an entry-level allowance at Oak Tree Oct. 29 and closed to win it by 1 3/4 lengths. Connections opted to try blinkers for the Moccasin, but **It Tiz** was rank early and hit the line five lengths behind **Bickersons**, with **Miss Heather Lee** another 2 1/2 lengths ahead of her in second. "The Moccasin didn't go that great, but she still ran third, and she's not a sprinter," said trainer Mark Glatt. "We'll take our best shot."



NEWS TODAY

CARLSBAD EUTHANIZED Carlsbad (Rocky Bar), winner of three graded stakes in California, was euthanized after breaking down following a workout at Santa Anita Saturday, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The probable favorite for next Saturday's GI La Brea S., she suffered an open fracture of her right front ankle after completing seven furlongs in 1:26.80, trainer Jeff Mullins told *DRF*. Owned by her breeder Dennis Weir, the

Arizona-bred opened her career with four open-length victories at Turf Paradise before annexing the GIII Santa Paula S. at Santa Anita. The three-year-old added a triumph in the GII Hollywood Oaks, and established a Del Mar Polytrack record of 1:14.93 for 6 1/2 furlongs when she captured the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. by four lengths. The dark bay was a close second in her final start, leading in the stretch of the GII Thoroughbred Club of America S. at Keeneland before yielding late to subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint S. winner Informed Decision (Monarchos). Carlsbad won seven of 10 starts and earned \$437,126.

Went to Baffert following a decent figure maiden win, but has failed to improve in two starts since. She's several Thoro-Graph points short of being competitive here. As she goes long for the first time, it's worth noting her full-sister was much better sprinting (far right of sheet).

2 It Tiz	Tiznow	Glatt

Had a wide trip in the Moccasin (3w, upper left), and earned almost the identical figure to Miss Heather Lee once we adjusted for ground loss. The two are very similar in ability and pattern, and neither is a serious threat here.

3 Blind Luck	Pollard's Vision	Hollendorfer

Ran a very big figure in her debut at Calder, but didn't improve on it until last time, when, after adjustment for her wide trip, she earned the best figure in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. On the plus side, this filly is fast, solid and ran well over dirt, which means she should handle the dirt-like Cushion Track. But she also looks like an early developer, making a repeat of her last more likely than another forward move.

4 Amen Hallelujah	Montbrook	Dutrow Jr

Is borderline competitive on number power based on her last three, but they were earned over Polytrack, and it's anyone's guess as to how she'll handle Cushion or dirt. The bigger problem is that she's shipping from the East Coast in December, and those that try almost never run well.

5 Bickersons	Silver Deputy	Breen

Has shown she can handle dirt, Pro-Ride and Cushion, and is another that is a borderline fit on ability. If she clears early and gets the rail, she should get a check.

6 Rose Catherine	Speightstown	Pletcher

Showed nothing in two dirt tries before exploding on grass, and ran second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, despite shipping cross-country and bouncing considerably. Since Cushion is more like dirt than grass, it's tough to like her chances here, but we won't be rushing to run against her in any grass races. If she stays in one piece, she's going to have a serious career.

7 Beautician	Dehere	McPeck
---------------------	---------------	---------------

Ran enormous figures in her first three starts, two of them losses to Hot Dixie Chick (Dixie Union), who is the best juvenile filly in the country. Both those efforts were even better than they looked due to wide trips (5w, 3w). This filly followed those starts with a fifth in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. over Polytrack at Keeneland following a nightmare trip, and a second over turf-like Pro-Ride in the Breeders' Cup. She's been training in California since and, with good rest and a return to a dirt-like surface, all systems are go for a top effort.

BOTTOM LINE: On her best, Beautician is better than these, and she is likely to deliver a top performance. The Race Shape shows that several of these have similar early speed, so she will have to avoid getting caught wide--that's where Gomez earns his money.

Jerry Brown formed Thoro-Graph in 1982 to service the needs of horsemen and professional handicappers. 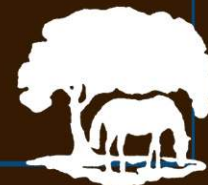

Gulfstream Park Backstretch Flooded by Downpour:

A severe rainstorm that dumped more than a foot of rain on the Hallandale, Florida, area, during a 48-hour period that ended Friday forced the evacuation of about 600 horses on the Gulfstream Park backstretch. More than half of the track's barns, as well as the dormitories, were flooded, with as much as two feet of standing water in the stalls, feedrooms and tackrooms. The majority of the horses were able to be moved to barns that were not affected by the flooding, but 90 were sent to Calder Race Course, and others vanned to Palm Meadows and Payson Park. Recently appointed general manager at Gulfstream, Ken Dunn told *Daily Racing Form*, "We've had plenty of people come to the forefront to help us cope with this situation as best as possible, particularly trainer Tim Ritvo and our stall supervisor Stacy Gunderson, as well as the folks at Calder. It's very frustrating sitting here waiting for Mother Nature to take its course and for the water level in the canals to recede, so we can best manage the situation. Fortunately, the racetrack weathered the storm well." The track was, in fact, open for training Saturday, and was listed as "good." DRF also reported that Gulfstream officials hoped to compensate the backstretch workers who lost belongings and trainers who had feed and equipment destroyed by the floodwaters.
